Grading stamps (from Professional Stamp Experts) –

When looking at stamp materials offered at auction (catalog or online), at shows or in the rarer Stamp Store, the following modifiers are used to describe the **gum condition** of stamps offered (see figure above).

ADJECTIVAL	DESCRIPTION	ABBREVIATION
O.G.	Never Hinged Flawless original gum, never hinged	OG nh
O.G. Previously Hinged	Hinged Original Gum, previously hinged	OG ph
O.G. Hinged	Hinged Original Gum, hinged (hinge on stamp)	OG h
Disturbed O.G.	Disturbed original gum	DOG
Part O.G.	Some of the original gum remains	POG
No Gum	None of the original gum remains	NG
Regummed	The stamp has had new gum applied	RG
No gum as issued	The stamp was originally issued without gum	NGAI
