In the continual effort to provide a 'quality' monthly newsletter, I get to experiment with many cutting edge electronic publishing devices.

This month it was the mark 0.1 "Rita" keyboard translation device. The micro sixteen pound device automatically installs itself on top of your standard keyboard and when *perfected*, all you have to do is 'stroke' the input device to produce an output.

In its current stage of development you do get is a low "purring" sound and letters do appear (randomly) on the screen.
