Last Month was the auction raising between \$600 and \$900 for the Post Card Museum, APS and the Club - we'll get the final number at the next meeting.

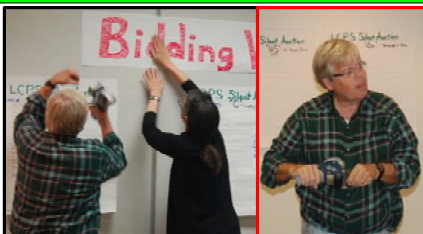
This month we'll discuss next years program, look back at our 75th year and, as usual, maybe trade a few more stamps?

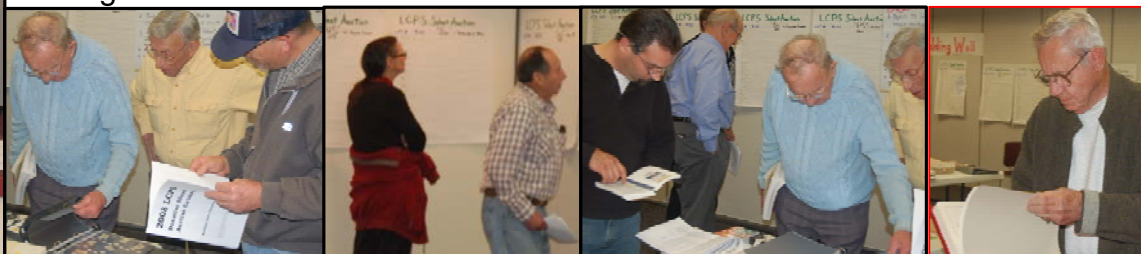
Treasures' Report: Checking - \$1,021.74 Savings – 1,520.20 — Total: 2,541.94

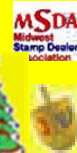

- The Civilian Conservation Corps is established
- United States repeals prohibition of alcohol and outlaws cannabis
- The movie "King Kong"
- Walt Disney's classic Silly Symphony cartoon "The Three Little Pigs"
- The Lone Ranger debuts on American radio
- Mount Rushmore National Memorial dedicated
- Chicago Worlds Fair
- The first drive-in theater opens in Camden, New Jersey
- First Major League Baseball All-Star Game is played in Chicago
- Construction of Golden Gate Bridge begins in San Francisco
- Wiley Post becomes the first pilot to fly solo around the world
- Albert Einstein moves to the USA
- The Dow Jones Industrial Average rises 39 points to 92.84



Elsewhere in the world -

- First alleged modern sighting of the Loch Ness Monster
- Adolf Hitler becomes German Chancellor.
- "Enabling Act" suspends civil liberties in Germany.
- All political parties in Germany, except Nazi party, banned
- Dachau concentration camp opened.
- Gestapo established
- Nissan Motor Company is organized in Tokyo, Japan
