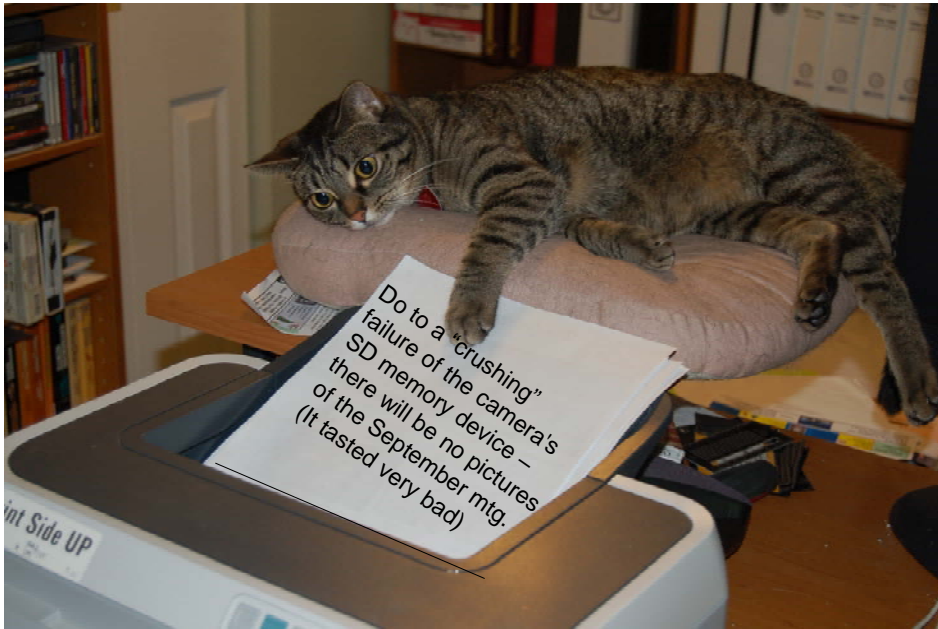


Perforations

Since then there have been eight additional stamps issues depicting seven more diseases that impact the health of the nation. They are:

- Cancer Detection - Scott 1754 (1958)
- Tuberculosis - Scott 1823 (1980)
- AIDS - Scott 2806 (1993)
- Breast Cancer - Scott 3081 (1996)
- Breast Cancer - Scott B1 (1998)
- Prostate Cancer - Scott 3315 (1999)
- Diabetes - Scott 3503 (2001)
- Sickle Cell Disease - Scott 3877 (2004)

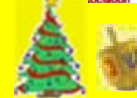
