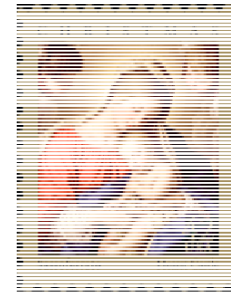
Dear Dr. Willer,
