The USPS also announced some of the stamps that will be issued this coming year: Barbara Jordan - Black Heritage, Gregory Peck - Legends of Hollywood, a new Civil War (replacement for the Nature of America) series (of five – Marty; something for the Civil War Round Table?), Mark Twain (Samuel Clemens) - Literary Arts, and 10 more Flags of Our Nation.

With the new postal rate of 46¢ scheduled for January 2011, we can also expect new Love/Wedding, Express/Priority, Hallmark Butterfly and redenominated חנוכה , العيد , Kwanzaa, and the Purple Heart stamps.

In all, it should prove to be an expensive year.

On October 21 the nations first Holiday Forever stamp will be issued. The (44¢) special stamps will feature four varieties Evergreens - the special stamps include: ponderosa pine, eastern red cedar, blue spruce and balsam fir.

They will be issued in three formats; pane of 20 (convertible booklet format), ATM pane of 18 and picture postal cards.
