In the past, the Scott Catalogue was available in an electronic CD/DVD PDF-format along with the standard published version. In 2009, hackers were able to 'crack' the security code of the CD version. In response, Scott did not issue 2010 version of the CD but and tinkered with a subscription Internet based product.

According to an article published on the Virtual Computer Club website [http://www.virtualstampclub.com/] Scott Publishing editor Jim Kloetzel confirmed that Scott is moving in that direction at NAPEX and said sometime this year we will see new Scott products, include applications for iPads and mobile units.

Scott has plenty of examples to look at overseas, as other stamp catalogues most notably Michel [http://www.briefmarken.de/], have already produced electronic versions as will as the lesser known Israeli postal catalog [http://english.israelphilately.org.il/?EN].

Collector cost have not yet been set, but an on-line version will defiantly be nice in that you can adjust the size of the 'print' to better read the information, search by topic/subject and see better images of the stamps.

This group was founded in 1896 to further the study of philately, promote the hobby and provide a social, educational, and non-commercial setting for the enthusiastic enjoyment of our common passion stamp collecting.

In general, the power of **GOOGLE** [google.com] has increased over the years, and as more stamp related web sites come online, they are too included in the search index.

Even if you do not have a computer and/or an Internet hookup at home, try the local libraries. Do not know how to use a computer? – the libraries offer free courses.
