On Valentine's Day this year, the U.S. Postal Service will issue two ENGRAVED/INTAGLIO stamps in the popular Weddings series: the 49c Forever Vintage Rose stamp and the 70c Vintage Tulip stamp. This is one of the few times the USPS has opted for this method of production usually opting for the less expensive gravure and offset methods.

Both feature elaborate floral line drawings from engraved plates originally created by naturalist artist Maria Sibylla Merian (1647-1717). The drawings, from the Dover Pictorial Archive, were reprinted in Flowers, Butterflies, and Insects. She also produced the drawings for Scott 3126-3129 (citron and pineapple with bugs) issued in 1997.


