

Gerald T. "Jerry" Nylander, age 74, a resident of Prospect Heights, IL, formerly of Chicago's Roseland neighborhood, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, January 5, 2023. He was born on May 27, 1948, in Chicago, IL.

Beloved son of the late Magnus and Ann Nylander, adored cousin of many, including, Janice (Randy) Tylin of Naperville, Paul Bailey of Naperville, and the late Bob (Julie) Bailey, friend of many.

Jerry grew up in Chicago's Roseland neighborhood, attended Van Vlissingen School, was a graduate of Fenger High School and earned a bachelor's degree from The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign.

Jerry was employed many years as a sales representative for The American Genre Film Archive (AGFA).

Jerry was an avid stamp collector particularly in the Washington/Franklin Issues of the early 20th century — discovering a new Double-Line watermark that was written up in the 2009 August 24 issue of Linn's Stamp News. He later presented this discovery at our October 2009 meeting.

He was very active member in the **Chicago Philatelic Society** — a driving force behind the area's largest stamp show — **Chicagopex** held in November just before Thanksgiving for the last seven years.

He will be sorely missed in our Philatelic community
