Pay Telephone Management

During the past year pay telephone vendors have become more aggressive in their efforts to place telephones in postal facilities. This increased level of marketing is due to competition and market conditions. Pay telephone agreements are usually established with terms and conditions which stipulate the length of the agreement, commission rates, and the long-distance carrier for directly dialed calls.

Before making an oral or written agreement with a pay telephone provider, the installation head must ensure that there are no existing agreements or contracts which obligate the Postal Service to a specific provider. If the installation head is unsure about the agreement with the

incumbent pay telephone provider, he or she should consult the District Information Systems Manager. If Information Systems is unable to provide any information on existing pay telephone systems, the installation head should consult the Purchasing and Materials Service Center. Failure to research completely any existing agreement or contract may result in the Postal Service violating contractual agreements with incumbent providers and may lead to legal action. *Follow the policy of Management Instruction AS-840-95-6, Acquiring Pay Telephones, for all agreements or contracts involving pay telephones.*

Training Video for Postage Meters

Retail Systems and Equipment, which has responsibility for the administration of the postage meter program, has developed a training video for employees on the licensing, setting, and examination of postage meters. The video should be viewed by all postal personnel involved with postage meters and meter customers.

Ordering Postage Validation Imprinter (PVI) Labels

Because MOS Scale International, Ltd., can no longer use USPS G-10 permit labels, the cost of postage will be included in the label price. Effective March 15, 1996, the price of Postage Validation Imprinter (PVI) labels is increased and the contract terms are changed to "FOB Origin — Prepaid."

Beginning March 15, 1996, postal personnel can order PVI labels using the following shipment options:

1. Express Mail for emergencies, using the ordering facility's account number. The price is \$43 per box.

2. First-Class Priority Mail for expedited service. The price is \$57.75 per box postpaid.
3. Fourth-class mail for regular mail service. The price is \$53.10 per box postpaid.
4. Government Bill of Lading for large shipments. The price is \$43 per box.

MOS Scale International, Ltd., remains the mandatory source of supply for Postage Validation Imprinter labels.

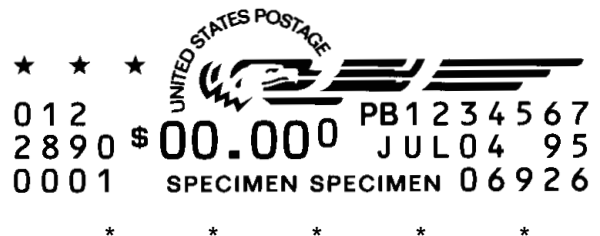

ASM REVISION

Mail Security

Postal Operations Manual (POM) 165.2, 424.13, and 424.14 provide instructions to employees on handling mail in the workplace. Because of pending revisions to the POM, these guidelines are now more appropriate for inclusion in Administrative Support Manual (ASM) 27, Security.

271.6 Employees

271.61 General

The following responsibilities pertain to the general integrity and security of the mails and the handling of personal mail in the workplace.

Note: Refer to 274 for additional mail security requirements.

271.62 Employee Requests for Mail

Mail addressed to a postal employee or an employee's family may not be withdrawn from the mail without approval from a supervisor.

271.63 Placing Mail on Person or in Personal Receptacles

Employees must not place mail in their pockets or clothing, in their lockers or desks, or in any other personal receptacles.

271.64 Employees' Personal Mail

271.641 Guidelines

Employees must not receive personal mail at their place of employment. Mail that is addressed to an employee at any postal facility's address is generally considered to be addressed to and intended for the Postal Service, rather than the employee. This mail may be opened by the Postal Service, without the employee's knowledge or consent, after it is delivered to that facility. Mail that is addressed to an employee at a postal facility's address and that is known or appears to be intended for the employee personally may be refused, but must not be opened.

271.642 Exceptions

Exceptions are as follows:

- a. Official USPS mail or circulars and other mail or circulars that appear to relate to postal employment (such as mail or circulars from the employee unions or from postal uniform vendors) and are intended for individual employees must be delivered without being opened.
- b. In the case of an apparent emergency, the Postal Service must accept delivery of personal mail addressed to an employee, and the head of the facility (or designee) must attempt to deliver the mail to the employee.

REMINDER

Prohibited Use of G-10 Labels

Effective March 1, 1996 (except as noted in Postal Bulletin 21907 (11-23-95)), Postal Service contractors and suppliers are prohibited from using G-10 permit labels to ship ordered supplies. Accordingly, contracting officers are responsible for modifying the method of delivery in affected contracts and agreements. Use account number 52155 to record postage reimbursement charges (f.o.b. origin —

prepay and add) if contracts and agreements are modified to reimburse contractors for prepaid postage used to ship ordered supplies.

POM REVISION

Philadelphia Mail Recovery Center to Close

Effective May 31, 1996, *Postal Operations Manual* 652 is revised to reflect the closing of the Philadelphia Mail Recovery Center and the transfer of its function to the Atlanta Mail Recovery Center.

The transition begins on May 31, 1996, and all arrangements associated with the closing of the Philadelphia Mail Recovery Center will be completed no later than August 30, 1996.

The closing of the Philadelphia Mail Recovery Center will reduce the current number of mail recovery centers to three.

Reassignments Affecting the Zone Chart Program

Effective immediately, several ZIP Codes have been reassigned that require the modification of the Official National USPS Zone Charts. These changes may be rendered manually. The 1996 issue, due in July, will reflect these changes. The realignments were necessary to facilitate the processing of military mail and enhance the processing of mail addressed to Evanston IL 602. These realignments will help the Postal Service provide more effective, efficient service to customers and will meet operational needs.

The reassignments include ZIP Code 340, which has been assigned to the New Jersey bulk mail center (BMC) from the Jacksonville, Florida BMC. Mailers who deposit military mail (340) at the New Jersey BMC qualify for a DBMC rate (Zone 5). The other assignment affects ZIP Code 602 (Evanston IL), which consists of a single three-digit zone chart. ZIP Code 602 will be combined with 600, 601 and 603–608. The new zone chart will reflect 600–608.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2966-A is required. Prepaid mail from a contractor addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use—Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or an exemption endorsement.

B1. Form 2966-B is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

B2. Form 2966-A is required except on official mail, which does not require customs declaration or exemption endorsement. The AAFES will furnish a computer listing of all items mailed from its activities to Philippine APOs. Other mail order companies must either use Form 2966-A on each item or provide computer lists. Computer listings must include a description of the items, the dollar values of the items, and complete address including the PSC box number and APO of the addressee, the date of mailing, the insurance registry number, if applicable, and the serial number of any item over \$25 in value and any electrical item with a plug over \$15 in value.

B3. Form 2966-A is required for mailing between MPOs. Prepaid mail from contractors addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use—Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or exemption endorsement.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C022.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, second- and third-class mail are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

Length

- 42" 72" length and girth combined
- over 42" to 44" 24" girth
- over 44" to 46" 20" girth
- over 46" to 48" 16" girth
- Maximum length 48"

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including thoseailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 11 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All second-class, third-class, and fourth-class mail (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 96-7

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail

postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 Code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Products and Pictorial Cancellations Featuring Olympic-Related Subjects

The Postal Service will issue stamps commemorating the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games on May 2 and July 19 in Atlanta, Georgia. As we approach the issuance of these stamps, it is important that we abide by the terms of the Postal Service's agreement with the United States Olympic Committee (USOC). Following is information on the limitations on the use of the stamp and its design in products and pictorial cancellations.

The Postal Service obtained authorization from the USOC to incorporate the Olympic rings and other Olympic marks on the stamps, specific philatelic products produced or coordinated at the Headquarters level, and the advertising and promotion of those products. Except for these items, **THE USE OF ANY OLYMPIC MARK IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. This restriction applies to pictorial cancellations and local philatelic products, whether or not actual stamps or stamp reproductions are used.** Olympic marks include, but are not limited to, the following words and graphics: Olympic, Olympiad, Olympic Games, Olympic Centennial Games, United States Olympic Committee, USOC, Atlanta Centennial Olympic Games, ACOG, Atlanta Centennial Olympic Properties, ACOP,

Atlanta 1996, Olympic rings, USOC wreath, Atlanta torch, Whatizit character, Izzy character, or Olympic pictograms.

It is unlikely that Headquarters or the USOC will authorize pictorial cancellations that feature words or graphics previously mentioned. However, we have established procedures for requesting approval for all Olympic-related pictorial cancellations.

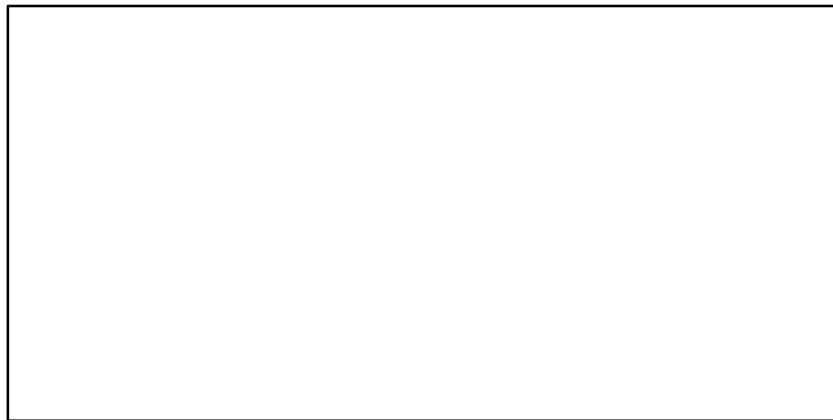

Cal Farley Stamp (Great Americans Series)

The Postal Service will issue a 32-cent Cal Farley definitive stamp (Item 1079) on April 26, 1996, in Amarillo, Texas. The stamp goes on sale nationwide April 27.

Designed by Dennis Lyall of South Norwalk, Connecticut, the stamp features a portrait of Cal Farley, a great humanitarian who founded Boys Ranch near Amarillo, Texas, to help disadvantaged, homeless, or troubled boys.

Farley was born on Christmas Day in 1895 to a family of six children. Raised on a Minnesota farm where times were hard, Farley left home as a young boy to pursue a career of semipro baseball and wrestling. He later settled in Amarillo, Texas, and during the Depression helped organize the Maverick Club, which provided organized athletics to boys as an alternative to the streets. Years later, Farley's dream was realized when an Amarillo businessman donated the land on which he could establish a home for disadvantaged boys. Since Farley's death on February 19, 1967, the Ranch, which began admitting girls in 1992, has become the home of over 400 boys and girls. In addition to homes, the Ranch also includes numerous facilities for health, education, athletics, and worship.

1996 Centennial Olympic Games Stamps (Classic Collection)

The Postal Service will issue twenty 32-cent 1996 Centennial Olympic Games stamps (Item 5503), in a pane of 20, commemorating the 100th anniversary of the modern Olympic Games on May 2, 1996, in Atlanta, Georgia. The stamps go on sale nationwide May 3.

Designed by Richard Waldrep of Sparks, Maryland, the stamps feature twenty Olympic athletes in action during men's cycling, women's diving, women's running, men's canoeing, the decathlon, women's soccer, men's shot-put, women's sailboarding, women's and men's gymnastics, freestyle wrestling, women's softball, women's and men's swimming, men's sprinting, men's rowing, beach volleyball, men's basketball, equestrian, and men's hurdles. Explanatory text is printed on the back of each stamp.

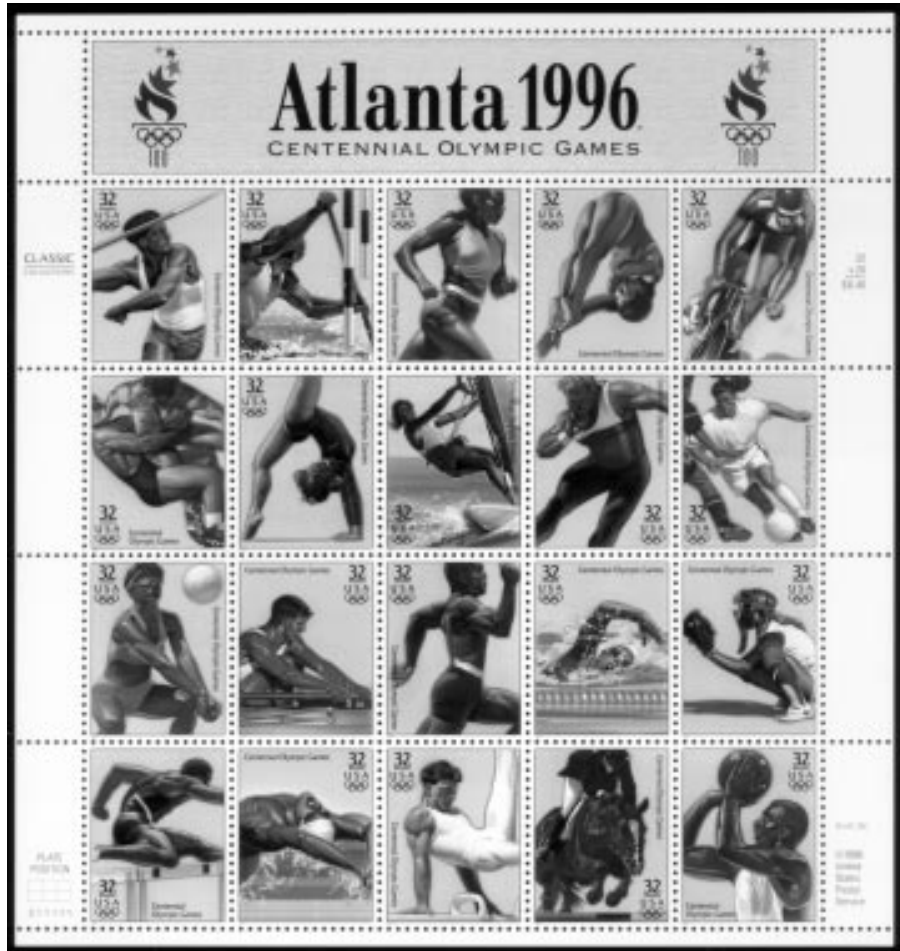
The modern Olympic Games, conceived by Frenchman Baron Pierre de Coubertin, were held for the first time in Athens, Greece. The Olympic Games represent one of only two places today where people from all parts of the world gather, the other being the United Nations. These athletes represent an almost complete economic cross section of the world's population.

All stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive approximately two panes of the Centennial Olympic Games (Classic Collection) issue for each pane of 50 stamps furnished on their standard automatic distribution, rounded to the nearest carton size of 2,500 panes. SDOs and SDNs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to post offices using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before April 25.

The advice of shipment will state the quantity of panes shipped, not the number of stamps shipped. When ordering additional stock, quantities must be designated in panes.

Sales Policy

Sales are restricted to full panes of 20 stamps. No individual, single-stamp sales are permitted.

These stamps should be available at regular service windows until they are officially removed from sale, generally 1 year from date of issue. All post offices must initially acquire at least a 60-day supply of each new commemorative stamp before the sale date and have the stamps available at all service windows on the sale date. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through the normal ordering procedures.

IMM REVISION

Global Priority Mail

Global Priority Mail is an expedited airmail service providing fast reliable, and economical delivery of all items mailable as letters. Although a Global Priority Mail item will travel in the normal airmail stream between the United States and the destination country, the item will receive priority handling in the United States and, typically, in the destination country. In the United States, after the item is deposited, the Postal Service will transport it in a dedicated stream to the appropriate gateway for dispatch. Upon arrival in the destination country, the item will also receive priority handling. Service is available only in certain ZIP Code areas in the United States and only to certain countries.

The Postal Service is now expanding the number of acceptance points to make the service more widely available. The new acceptance points are set forth below. The Postal Service is also adding weight variable rates. With the new rates, customers may use their own packaging for items weighing up to 4 pounds. Each variable weight item must bear a Global Priority Mail sticker provided by the Postal Service. These changes will make Global Priority Mail available to more customers and should make the service more useful, by making it easier to mail items other than documents or letters.

A transmittal letter making the changes in the pages of the *International Mail Manual* will be published and transmittal automatically to subscribers.

Effective immediately, part 226 of the *International Mail Manual* (IMM) is revised as follows:

International Mail Manual (IMM)

2 Conditions for Mailing

226 Global Priority Mail

226.1 General

226.11 Definition

Global Priority Mail is an expedited airmail letter service providing fast, reliable, and economical delivery of all items mailable as letters or merchandise up to 4 pounds. Global Priority Mail items receive priority handling in the United States and in destination countries. Service is available only to destination countries identified in 226.2, from post offices identified in 226.3.

226.12 Permissible Items

All items sent as letter class mail (see 221.1) are accepted in Global Priority Mail provided the contents are

mailable and fit securely in the envelope. Global Priority Mail items may contain dutiable merchandise unless the country of destination specifically prohibits dutiable merchandise in letters (see 224.51). Any item that is prohibited in international mail is prohibited in Global Priority Mail. Refer to the "Country Conditions of Mailing" in the individual country listings for individual country prohibitions.

226.13 Packaging

Items must fit comfortably within the flat-rate envelope without distorting or bursting the container. No excessive use of tape to keep the envelopes from bursting, only one piece of tape may be used to secure the flap.

226.4 Postage

226.41 Flat-Rate Envelopes Postage

Each Global Priority Mail flat-rate envelope is charged at a flat rate. The rate is based on the geographic rate zone regardless of its actual weight. Postage is required for each piece.

226.42 Variable Weight Option Postage — Single Piece Rates

226.43 Global Priority Mail Sticker — Volume Rates

226.431 Minimum Quantity Requirement

The mailer must have a minimum of five or more pieces to one or more Global Priority Mail countries. The minimum does not apply to each geographic zone rate.

226.432 Mailing Statement

Postage for volume rate mail and permit imprint must be computed on Form 3653, *Global Priority Mail Statement of Mailings*.

226.5 Payment Methods

226.51 Postage Payment Methods

Nonidentical weight piece mailings must have the applicable postage affixed by adhesive stamps, meter stamps or if presented at a post office, postal validation imprinter (PVI labels). Identical weight piece mailings may be paid by meter stamps, adhesive stamps, PVI labels or permit imprint subject to certain standards. To use permit imprint, the mailing must consist of 200 or more pieces and be of identical weight. The 200 pieces criteria for permit imprint applies to both volume rate and flat-rate mail. Mailers may use permit imprint with nonidentical weight items only if authorized by the USPS under a Manifest Mailing System (MMS), in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) P710.

226.52 Postal Marking Related to Volume Rate Postage

When pieces are paid at the volume rate and paid by stamps or meter impression, each piece must be legibly marked with the words "Volume Rate Global Priority Mail." If stamps are used the endorsement must appear on the address side of each piece and must be applied by a printing press, hand stamp or other similar printing device. If meter impression is used the endorsement must be in the ad plate or the slug area. If part of the slug, the abbreviation GPM Vol. Rate may be used. See DMM P030.4.14 for specification of size requirements.

226.53 Permit Imprint Content and Format

All permit imprints on Global Priority Mail must show city and state, "Global Priority Mail," U.S. Postage Paid, and permit number. They may show the mailing date, amount of postage paid or the number of ounces for each postage.

226.54 Meter Stamps Content

At a minimum, a meter stamp must show the month, day and year in the postmark, city and state designation of the licensing post office, the number, and the amount of postage. See DMM P030.4.6.

226.6 Preparation Requirements

226.61 Addressing

All items must bear the complete delivery address of the addressee and the full name (no abbreviations) of the destination country. See 122.

226.62 Marking

Global Priority Mail items must be mailed in special envelopes (EP-15A, EP-15B) or with the Global Priority Mail sticker (DEC-10) provided by the Postal Service. (These supplies may be obtained by calling 800-222-1811.) Unmarked pieces are subject to the applicable LC/AO airmail regular rates and treatment. Pieces paid at the Global Priority Mail sticker rate must be affixed to the address side of the package.

226.63 Customs

A green customs label must be affixed if the package is 1 pound or more, regardless of its contents. Only documents and correspondence under 1 pound do not require a customs form.

226.7 Size and Weight Limits

226.71 Size Limits

226.72 Flat-Rate Envelope Sizes

- a. Small Size — 6 x 10 inches.
- b. Large Size — 9 1/2 x 12 1/2 inches.

226.73 Package Sizes for Variable Weight Option

- a. Minimum length and height: 5 1/2 x 3 1/2 inches.
- b. Minimum depth (thickness): .007 inches.
- c. Maximum length: 24 inches.
- d. Maximum length, height, depth (thickness) combined: 36 inches.

226.74 Rolls

- a. Minimum length: 4 inches.
- b. Minimum length plus twice the diameter combined: 6-3/4 inches.
- c. Maximum length: 36 inches.
- d. Maximum length plus twice the diameter combined: 42 inches.

226.75 Weight Limits

Items sent as Global Priority Mail in envelopes and the variable weight option must not exceed 4 pounds.

226.76 Special Services

Mailers may obtain certificates of mailing (see 310). No other special services such as registry, insurance, restricted delivery, return receipt, or recorded delivery are available.

226.8 Mailer Preparation

226.81 Mailer Requirement

Global Priority Mail claimed at the volume rate must be separated by geographic rate zone (Western Europe, Pacific Rim, and Canada) when presented to the business mail entry unit unless otherwise authorized by the USPS. All pieces in a permit imprint mailing and metered mail must be facing the same direction.

226.82 Deposit of Mail

Global Priority Mail pieces paid by permit imprint and pieces claimed at the Global Priority Mail volume rates

must be deposited at a business mail acceptance unit as authorized by the postmaster in the designated Global Priority Mail sites for weighing. Flat-rate envelopes with postage affixed may be deposited in any Express Mail Street collection or other such place where Express Mail is accepted. Metered mail must be deposited in locations under the jurisdiction of the licensing post office except as permitted under DMM P030.

226.83 Pickup Service

On call and scheduled pickup service are available for Global Priority Mail from the designated Global Priority Mail acceptance cities. There is a charge of \$4.95 for each pickup stop, regardless of the number of pieces picked up. (See DMM D010 for standards of pickup service.) Pickup is not available for Global Priority Mail pieces if paid by permit imprint or claimed at the volume rate.
