New Facilities Program To Expand Wireless Communications

Facilities Realty Asset Management at Headquarters has initiated a new revenue-generating program. This program involves the development of antenna sites on postal properties nationwide for the wireless communications industry. The new antenna sites will help the Postal Service and telecommunications companies meet public and business demands for state-of-the-art wireless technology for new items such as data transfers, digital phones, and two-way pagers. Revenue that is realized in the form of rent from the wireless sites could be very profitable for the Postal Service, and will go toward keeping postage costs stable.

Sites will be secure. The antenna sites primarily will be rooftop installations or monopoles (similar to oversized flagpoles, ranging from 80 to 150 feet tall) that hold low-power, traditional radio transmitters and create no audible noise. Radio frequency emissions are totally safe for postal employees and customers. They meet Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), Federal Communications Commission (FCC), and American National Standards Institute (ANSI) requirements.

To realize the desired results, the Postal Service has selected UniSite, Inc., of Richardson, Texas, to serve as its

Antenna Site Manager. UniSite will be contacting facility managers to obtain information about their facilities and to make preliminary assessments of the facilities for siting antennas. When calling managers, UniSite will use an authorization code for easy identification and to ensure safety, security, and program integrity. Administrative support managers will provide this code to each facility manager. If the site meets the basic criteria, UniSite will make an appointment with the administrative support manager to visit and inspect the property. Administrative support managers and facility managers are encouraged to participate with UniSite (or its contractor) in the inspection and to provide input on the possible location of the antenna site. Administrative support managers will be responsible for reviewing the site plan, which will depict the location of the monopole and equipment shelter.

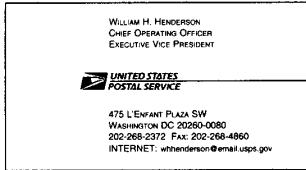

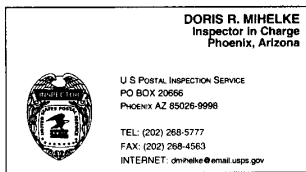

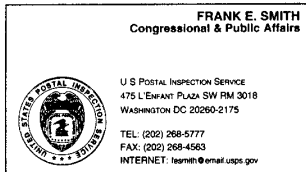

Postage Meter Direct Distribution Centers for Meters

The Direct Distribution Center (DDC) Program for postage meters was developed to facilitate the processing and distribution of meters into and out of service at the meter manufacturers' facilities. The program is administered by Retail Systems and Equipment at Headquarters. Any request to establish a DDC, or to process meters not licensed within the area served by the DDC, must be referred to that office for evaluation and response.

Eight authorized DDCs are currently in operation. Each center is staffed by postal clerks who set, examine, and check meters into and out of service for a fee. These clerks perform the functions and procedures normally conducted at the retail windows of the licensing post office.

Processing meters through the DDCs has proved to be an efficient way of providing better service to our meter customers and generating new revenue for the Postal Service. Each meter processed through the DDC represents time savings by moving this transaction away from the retail window operation. In addition, that same transaction represents new revenue generated from the on-site fees and postage.

Postmasters must notify Retail Systems and Equipment of any effort or request by a meter manufacturer to create a direct distribution operation.

Express Mail Service Directory — Distribution of IRT Update Diskettes

All post offices that use UNISYS II, UNISYS III, or MOS integrated retail terminals (IRTs) to accept Express Mail should receive by June 7 an Express Mail directory update diskette from UNISYS or MOS. If more than one type of IRT is used for Express Mail, offices should receive a separate diskette for each type. If an office has a weighing and rating unit (WRU), it should receive a UNISYS III or WRU diskette to update the directory on the WRU.

HANDBOOK F-10 REVISION

International Travel

Employees traveling internationally on official business for the Postal Service will be allowed to use business class seating if the duration of their flights exceeds 10 hours. All international travel will be audited by Finance.

643.5 Use of business class seating

Employees traveling overseas on official travel may fly business class if the duration of their flights, including layovers to change planes, exceeds 10 hours. The following restrictions apply to trips where business class seating is requested:

- a. The point of departure and return must be the employee's regular duty station.
- b. The flight must be by the most direct route possible to the employee's destination.
- c. The flight may not be combined with a domestic trip.
- d. All business class travel accommodations for postal employees, with the exception of postal officers, must be obtained from the Headquarters travel agency.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 96-12

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail

postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

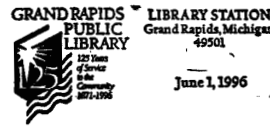
Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Folk Heroes Commemorative Stamps

The Postal Service will issue four 32-cent Folk Heroes commemorative stamps (Item 4409), in a pane of 20, on July 11, 1996, at the Postage Stamp Mega Event in Anaheim, California. The stamps go on sale nationwide July 12.

Designed by David LaFleur of Derby, Kansas, the stamps feature John Henry, Paul Bunyan, Mighty Casey, and Pecos Bill, four characters from American folklore.

According to legend, John Henry, a super strong steel driver who was born with a hammer in his hand, could drive steel for 10 hours without stopping. He became the subject of many tales and songs of railroad tunnel laborers.

Paul Bunyan, a giant lumberjack, was abandoned as a toddler by his parents because he had grown so big they were unable to care for him. He was the king of the nineteenth century loggers who chopped down acres and acres of trees. The origin of the stories about Bunyan are unknown.

Mighty Casey was a baseball giant who, at his moment of potential triumph, approached the plate with arrogance and confidence, and then struck out at bat. Ernest Lawrence Thayer's poem, *Casey at the Bat*, became an American classic due to the oratory skills of a performer

named William DeWolf Hopper, who claimed to have recited it over 10,000 times.

Pecos Bill was a super cowboy who embodied the wildness of America's frontier. According to legend, he was raised by coyotes and was so tough he could ride a mountain lion and use a rattlesnake as a whip. The original saga was written by Edward O'Reilly, but many others expanded upon the yarns in other books, articles, poems, recordings, and plays.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 30 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase the new stamps at their local post office, affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service returns the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by August 10, 1996.

The Philatelic Fulfillment Service Center also offers first day covers for new stamp issues and postal stationery items postmarked with the official first day of issue cancellation. Each item has an individual catalog number and is offered in the quarterly *Stamps etc.* catalog. Customers may request a free catalog by writing to:

First day covers remain on sale for at least 90 days after the stamp's issuance.

Distribution

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive approximately half their standard distribution for a 20-stamps-per-pane issue, rounded up to the nearest master carton size of 70,000 stamps. SDOs and SDNs will make subsequent automatic distributions to post offices for half their standard distribution, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before July 1, 1996.

Philatelic Requirement

SDOs and SDNs with authorized philatelic centers will receive the following automatic distribution of these stamps in six positions for subsequent distributions to each center:

Additional Supply

All accountable paper depositories (APDs), except New York, New York, and the Kansas City SDN, will receive 1,540,000 stamps as back-up quantities. New York, New York, and the Kansas City SDN will receive 1,610,000. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate APD, using a separate Form 17. All other post offices requiring additional stamps must requisition them from their designated SDO on a separate Form 17, or SDN, using a separate Form 17-S, *Stamp Distribution Network Stamp Requisition*. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from their APD using a separate Form 17.

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale, generally 1 year from the date of issue. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.

POSTAL EMPLOYEES

Requirements Related to Election Campaigns

Campaigning on Postal Premises

Because 1996 is an election year, candidates may seek to use postal premises for campaign purposes. Postal regulations (*Postal Operations Manual* 221.6, 39 CFR 232.1, and Poster 7, *Rules and Regulations Governing Conduct on Postal Property*) prohibit campaigning for election to public office on leased or owned postal property. Personnel should advise individuals inquiring about the availability of postal property for such purposes of the prohibition and give them a copy of the regulations. The following points will help you to interpret and apply the regulation:

- The focus of the regulation is to identify activities that are “prohibited.” Activities that are not prohibited by any of the regulations are permitted. For example, informational leafleting would not be prohibited, unless it was carried on in a way that disrupted conduct of postal business.
- The regulations cover only activity on postal premises. Activity outside postal property, even if it affects our premises, is not governed by our regulations.
- Campaigning for election to public office is prohibited, even if the candidate is independent of any political party. The prohibition does not extend to similar activities related to political issues other than election, such as issue-oriented petitioning or campaigning for a referendum or ballot initiative. However, issue-oriented political activity on postal premises must conform to other regulations. For example, there are prohibitions against depositing posters or literature on postal property, obstructing entrances, any activity that tends to impede or disturb the public in transacting postal business, the sale of goods, and the solicitation of contributions.

Local managers should pose questions about the Postal Service’s conduct regulations to their district or plant manager or designee, who should contact counsel in the appropriate area legal office. When necessary, counsel will coordinate with the Inspection Service to enforce the regulations.

Hatch Act Considerations

A related issue for postal employees is the extent to which their political activity, including off-duty activity, is consistent with the Hatch Act. The Office of Special Counsel, which investigates possible Hatch Act violations, has prepared the following examples of permitted and prohibited activities for federal, including postal employees:

- **May** be candidates for public office in nonpartisan elections.
- **May** register and vote as they choose.
- **May** assist in voter registration drives.
- **May** express opinions about candidates and issues.
- **May** contribute money to political organizations.
- **May** attend political fundraising functions.
- **May** attend and be active at political rallies and meetings.
- **May** join and be an active member of a political party or club.
- **May** sign nominating petitions.
- **May** campaign for or against referendum questions, constitutional amendments, municipal ordinances.
- **May** campaign for or against candidates in partisan elections.
- **May** make campaign speeches for candidates in partisan elections.
- **May** distribute campaign literature in partisan elections.
- **May** hold office in political clubs or parties.
- **May not** use their official authority or influence to interfere with an election.
- **May not** collect political contributions unless both individuals are members of the same federal labor organization or employee organization and the one solicited is not a subordinate employee.
- **May not** knowingly solicit or discourage the political activity of any person who has business before the agency.
- **May not** engage in political activity while on duty.
- **May not** engage in political activity in any government office.
- **May not** engage in political activity while wearing an official uniform.
- **May not** engage in political activity while using a government vehicle.
- **May not** solicit political contributions from the general public.
- **May not** be candidates for public office in partisan elections
- **May not** wear political buttons on duty.

NOTICE TO ALL POSTAL EMPLOYEES

Oleoresin Capsaicin (OC) or Pepper Spray

Presently 48 states have legalized the use of Oleoresin Capsaicin (OC), commonly referred to as pepper spray, for use by private citizens for self-defense. In most states, it is much easier to obtain than tear gas and requires only minimal training before the applicant is certified to use the product.

Exposure of Postal Employees

Owing to the widespread availability of OC, it is possible that it might fall into the hands of individuals who will use it for purposes other than self-defense. Postal employees interact with the public on a continuous basis and because of this exposure to the general public routinely encounter individuals from all walks of life. We deliver billions of pieces of mail annually to millions of homes and businesses 6 days a week. We operate numerous post offices and employ a significant number of career employees. Although the number of crimes committed against them remains relatively low, postal employees occasionally come under criminal attack. It is possible that some postal employees might be attacked by someone who sprays them with an OC product. In the unlikely event that this happens, postal employees should be aware of the basic first aid required to minimize the effects of the attack and promote a quick recovery.

What Is Oleoresin Capsaicin (OC)?

Although OC can be produced synthetically, it is a naturally occurring substance found in the oily resin of cayenne and other varieties of peppers. Selected peppers are dried and ground into a fine powder. The oleoresin in the powder is extracted with the addition of an organic solvent. Once the oleoresin extraction is complete, the solvent in the solution is removed via evaporation or distillation. When the solvent is removed, the remaining oily substance is raw Oleoresin Capsaicin, the strength of which is dependent on the grade of peppers used. These OC solutions are produced for the food and pharmaceutical industries as well as for use in pepper sprays. The OC is used in salsas and hot

sauces to increase the heat levels. The pharmaceutical applications are analgesics in heat creams and rubs.

OC sprays are available in a variety of different concentrations, usually anywhere from 5 to 10 percent for manufactured aerosols. These percentages may be misleading, however, because it is the strength of the OC in the spray that determines its effectiveness, not its percentage by volume. The strength of the OC depends on the grind of the pepper before oil is extracted.

Physiological Effects of OC

Contact with OC particles in a sprayed mist incapacitates subjects by inducing an almost immediate burning sensation of the skin, and burning, tearing, and inflammation of the tissues around the eyes, causing involuntary closure. When the agent is inhaled, the respiratory tract is inflamed, resulting in a swelling of the mucous membranes lining the breathing passages and temporarily restricting breathing to short, shallow breaths. Ingestion can cause nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea. The traditional tear gas agents also cause painful tearing and respiratory discomfort but do not have the same inflammation and swelling effects as does OC. OC sprays can have detrimental effects on people with preexisting respiratory problems such as asthma or emphysema, and medical attention should be sought immediately.

Personal Decontamination Procedures and Emergency First Aid

The attached poster provides basic personal decontamination and emergency first aid procedures for victims of Oleoresin Capsaicin (OC) or pepper spray attacks. Remember, each person is different and can react differently when exposed to OC. Side effects vary in type, intensity, and duration depending on the person. After exposure to an OC attack, postal employees should seek immediate medical attention.

Personal Decontamination and Emergency First Aid Procedures for Victims of Oleoresin Capsaicin (OC) or Pepper Spray Attacks



1. Remove yourself immediately from the presence of your attacker and the contaminated area to a position of safety that is well ventilated.
2. Immediately notify the local police and U.S. Postal Inspection Service and advise them that you have been a victim of an irritant attack and require immediate medical attention.
3. Keep calm, restrict any unnecessary physical activity, and try not to panic. Remember, OC or pepper spray attacks, although uncomfortable, have not been proven to be fatal. Wait until the police, postal inspectors, and paramedics arrive at your location. Their primary concern will be to determine the nature of the sprayed substance, render immediate first aid to you, and transport you to the nearest hospital or medical facility for follow-up medical attention as required. Remember, most OC or pepper spray victims recover fully within 45 minutes of the attack and do not require follow-up medical attention unless complications are experienced.
4. While waiting for law enforcement and emergency medical personnel to arrive, begin immediate first aid. Irrigate your eyes, face, and other affected areas with large amounts of clean water. Avoid rubbing your eyes and face and other affected areas. If absolutely necessary, use a clean paper towel in a blotting motion to dry the affected areas and then discard after one use.
5. Do not attempt to remove contact lenses. Wait for medical assistance to prevent more serious contamination.
6. Do not close your eyes but keep your eyes open to assist in recovery. Closing your eyes only amplifies the side effects of the OC or pepper spray.
7. Tearing of the eyes is a common side effect and is encouraged to further irrigate the eyes and relieve discomfort.
8. Attempt to breathe normally. Shortness of breath is a common side effect and produces panic attacks in some victims. Attempt to remain calm and breathe normally until the side effects subside. Failure to breathe normally will prolong and intensify the side effects. OC or pepper spray can cause more severe temporary side effects on victims who are asthmatics or suffer from emphysema.
9. Blow your nose as often as required to remove any discharge and any residual OC or pepper spray particulates. Use a separate tissue and discard after one use.
10. Do not apply any creams, lotions, oils, salves, petroleum jelly products, or bandages to the affected areas because this will only heighten the intensity and duration of the side effects.
11. Irrigate the skin with large amounts of clean cool water and expose the affected areas to fresh air.
12. As soon as it is practical, further relief may be achieved by showering with tepid water using a mild soap and shampooing the hair, washing downward from the hairline.
13. As soon as it is practical, clothing and other fabrics should be laundered either by machine washing or dry cleaning.
14. Surfaces can be decontaminated by washing with water and a damp cloth.
15. All OC or pepper spray products must meet federal guidelines for being environmentally safe.

Equipment Maintenance Allowance Schedules for Rural Routes

In accordance with the provisions of Article 9, Section 2.1.3 of the Rural Carrier National Agreement, effective June 8, 1996 (Pay Period 96-13), the equipment maintenance allowance (EMA) will increase from 35.0 cents per mile to 35.5 cents per mile. The EMA will be 35.5 cents per mile or a minimum of \$14.20 per day, whichever is greater.

Employees providing auxiliary assistance or serving auxiliary routes (auxiliary rural carriers, rural carrier reliefs, rural carrier associates, and auxiliary assistance under provisions of Article 9, Section 2.1.5) will receive an EMA of

35.5 cents per mile or \$4.15 per hour, whichever is greater, not to exceed the amount provided in the special equipment maintenance for the route stops and miles.

The EMA schedule on pages 42–43 supersedes all previously published EMA schedules. The optional EMA rate, effective October 28, 1995, remains at 39.9 cents per mile.
