DMM REVISION

Requirements for Cover Pages and Protective Covers

Effective December 30, 1999, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) C200.1.6, C200.3.5, and C820.6 are amended; C600.1.2 is added; and E612.3.4 is deleted to provide, under certain circumstances, an exception to the requirements for cover pages and protective covers for publications mailed at Periodicals and Standard Mail (A) rates to allow for short covers. These changes include “cover pages” in the existing DMM requirements and also provide an exception for flat-size pieces qualifying for automation/non-automation rates. These changes also apply to the front and back cover pages or protective cover of a publication. All mailpieces with short covers must be secured (tabbed, wafer sealed, or glue spotted) to prevent an open edge from jamming in processing equipment.

These revisions will appear in the next printed version of the DMM and are included in the monthly update of the online DMM available via Postal Explorer (<http://pe.usps.gov>).

6.0 TABS, WAFER SEALS, TAPE, AND GLUE**6.1 General**

Although not required, mailpieces may be prepared with tabs, wafer seals, cellophane tape, or permanent glue (continuous or spot) if these sealing devices do not interfere with the recognition of the barcode, rate marking, postage information, and delivery and return addresses. Cellophane tape may not be placed over the barcode or where any part of the barcode will be printed. Tabs or seals placed in the area on which any part of the barcode is printed must contain a paper face meeting the standards for background reflectance. Tabs, wafer seals, and tape must have a peel adhesion (shear strength) value of at least 15 ounces/inch at a speed of 12 inches/minute after application to a stainless steel plate; the test is to be conducted 10 minutes after the material is applied to the plate.

6.2 Short Covers

Flats may be prepared with a cover page or protective cover that is less than 3/4 inch from each edge if the cover page is affixed with at least two tabs, wafer seals, or glue spots placed within 1 inch of the top and bottom edges of the cover page or protective cover.

Optional Endorsement Lines

Mailers have expressed concerns with the handling of shrink-wrapped bundles of flats where the top piece is printed with an optional endorsement line (OEL). Despite clear identification of the sortation to either 5-digit or carrier route, these bundles are delivered as if they were a firm package. For pieces to be properly sorted and delivered, postal employees must pay attention to OELs.

Mailers may use an optional endorsement line to identify the sortation level of a package or bundle of mail. By printing an OEL on the first letter or flat in a bundle, the mailer eliminates use of adhesive package labels, such as the red D, green 3, pink A, or tan MXD. When an OEL replaces one of these package labels, it must indicate the type of package and appropriate ZIP Code information. The OEL can also replace facing slips on the top piece of a carrier bundle. In this case, carrier route information must be printed on the OEL. Mailers have the option of printing OEL information on all pieces in trays of non-carrier route automated letter-size mail, as long as this information corresponds to the sortation level of the tray.

Capital letters must be used in an OEL. The information must be right-justified to the end of the address block. Asterisks must be printed from the left margin of the label or address block to OEL information. In some cases, the OEL may contain an Address Change Service (ACS) participant code, which is located in the first eight positions to the left of the OEL.

Typically, the OEL is printed as the first line at the top of the address block or label. However, there are two cases where the OEL would not appear at the top of the address block: An address block barcode may be printed above the OEL, or an exceptional address format (i.e., CURRENT RESIDENT [OCCUPANT] or JANE DOE) may appear above an OEL.

To handle bundles properly, postal employees must pay careful attention to the optional endorsement line. Letter carriers must be alert to the OEL information printed on the top piece within shrink-wrapped flat packages. For example, a bundle printed with "*****CAR-RT SORT**C-001" must be opened at the delivery unit for distribution. A bundle printed with "*****FIRM 12345" must not be opened and must be delivered as a single unit.

REVISED FORM

Revision to PS Form 3849, Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt

Preparation for the enhanced signature capture program continues, with activation expected in spring 2000. To improve the high-speed scanning of the new barcoded PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, an additional design change is required.

The November 1999 version of PS Form 3849 (see page 8) includes the placement of the text "USPS" on the barcoded side of the form, below the delivery section. This change improves optical scanning recognition of the form. Also, the "If checked" block that designates that someone must be present for signature has been moved. Additional information about completing and using the form can be found in *Postal Bulletin 22002 (7-15-99)* and *Postal Bulletin 21987 (12-17-98)*.

Release of this version of PS Form 3849 is scheduled for January 2000. Any salmon-colored version dated after October 1998 will be valid with the enhanced signature capture process. Yellow PS Forms 3849 dated prior to October 1998 must be recycled before February 1, 2000.

Note: The use of multi-ply PS Form 3849 is not currently compatible with the enhanced signature capture and storage process. Offices using a three-part PS Form 3849 must recycle all copies prior to the enhanced signature capture implementation date this coming spring. Scanning of PS Form 3849 should not be done at this time.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on non-dutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C024.1.1C. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail (A) are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth
	Maximum length 48"

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail (A), and Standard Mail (B) (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

International Mail

International Customized Mail

On November 16, 1999, the Postal Service entered into an International Customized Mail (ICM) Agreement with a qualifying mailer. An Agreement is a negotiated, mailer-specific customized price and service offering for large volume international mailers. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 294, the Postal Service hereby makes public the following information:

- a. **Term:** The Agreement shall take effect June 5, 2000, unless such date prior to that is mutually agreed upon by both parties. The term of the agreement shall be three years and will terminate on midnight of June 5, 2003, or the third anniversary date of the start-up date prior to June 5, 2000.
- b. **Type of Mail:** Letter mail, correspondence, and printed matter. Every item must conform to the mailing requirements set forth by the USPS in the *International Mail Manual* (IMM) for all qualifying IPA mail and comply with the size and weight limits specified in the Agreement.
- c. **Destination Countries:** Mail covered under the Agreement shall be destined to Europe and the Middle East.
- d. **Services Provided by the Postal Service:** The Postal Service has agreed to:
 1. Furnish the Mailer or Mailer's mailing agents with the required international mail equipment and supplies.
 2. Provide the Mailer or Mailing agents pre-mailing consultation on mailing requirements.
 3. Transport mail from the Mailer's facility to USPS ISC.
 4. Provide tracking information either electronically or in print at a frequency mutually agreed upon.
 5. Assign a customer service representative to manage the account and serve as liaison.
 6. Contract with air and surface carriers, as appropriate, for qualifying mail to be transported Internationally for delivery by the destination foreign postal administrations.
- e. **Minimum Volume Commitments:** The Mailer has agreed to meet an overall minimum revenue commitment of \$13 million of IPA on an annual basis.
- f. **Worksharing:** The Mailer has agreed to:
 1. Tender the mailpieces to be delivered in accordance with preparation requirements specified in the Agreement.
 2. Produce tray labels to the specifications pursuant to the Agreement and affix such labels onto each tray of mail tendered to the USPS.
 3. Establish and maintain a permanent IP Address to which the USPS shall electronically transmit the tray tracking information described in Article 4.4.
 4. Establish and maintain the capability to receive at this Address, files named in accordance with the DOS 8.3 (eight.three) file naming convention and transmitted by the USPS using FTP.
 5. To pay for postage directly to the USPS for all Qualifying Mail in accordance with payment methods by permit imprint subject to the conditions stated in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) P040.
 6. To use unique permit dedicated to ICM Mail to track progress to revenue targets.
 7. To provide projections of mailings including date, weight, and volume to be tendered.
 8. Letter-size mail will be presented in trays if authorized by the acceptance office.
- g. **Rates:** The Mailer will pay postage, either directly or through their designated mailing agent, to the USPS for all Qualifying ICM Mail at twenty-five (25.0) percent off of the published rates for IPA in effect at the time of mailing.
 1. If the minimum commitment is not met, the USPS reserves the right to adjust the discount rate. The USPS shall have the option of recalculating rates for the balance of the term of this agreement based on actual revenue tendered in the previous year.
 2. The Mailer or the USPS may cancel this Agreement by giving the other party ninety (90) days notice in writing. If this Agreement is cancelled, upon termination, the Mailer will receive the published discount for Qualifying Mail in accordance with the IMM.
- h. **Penalty:** If the minimum commitment is not met, the Mailer will pay the USPS the difference of the amount of the additional discount received over the published discount it would have been entitled to, based on the volume of Qualifying Mail tendered as displayed in Exhibit 1 (below).
 1. The USPS reserves the right to adjust the ICM discount offered herein to reflect any change in the Mailer's mailing profile (including volume, weight,

destination, and dimension) by more than ten (10.0) percent, or should costs that it incurs in providing this ICM service increase by more than five (5.0) percent.

2. In each subsequent Agreement Year, the amount of the discount will be determined by the amount of revenue tendered to the USPS in the preceding Agreement Year. The recalculated discount will become effective by executing an amendment to this Agreement no later than 30 calendar days following the close of the previous Agreement Year.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (33 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items

submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

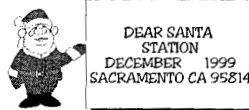

1999/2000 Tax Information — Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement

1. Current Mailing Address

To facilitate processing of 1999 tax information and to ensure correct and timely receipt of a 1999 IRS Form W-2, *Wage and Tax Statement*, all employees must have a current mailing address on file at the Distributed Data Entry and Distributed Reporting (DDE/DR) site. Current employees, as well as employees that have left the Postal Service, who have changed their address in 1999 and have not submitted PS Form 1216, *Employee's Current Mailing Address*, to their DDE/DDR site should do so immediately. All Form W-2s are sent to the address on file at the time of printing and will not be forwarded.

2. General W-2 Information

If an employee has earnings for more than one state, a separate Form W-2 will be issued for each state reported. The format of the 1999 Form W-2 has been changed from the 1998 version.

Additions include:

- a. Flexible Spending Account (FSA) information has been expanded to "FSA total contributions" (Box 10), "FSA dependent care" (Box 10a), and "FSA health care" (Box 10b).
- b. Employee contributions to Thrift Savings Program (TSP) information has been expanded to include an additional box for reporting "Prior year TSP contributions" (Box 15), but will not be used in 1999.
- c. The phone number for employees to use for employment verification information.

Deletions include:

Alternative transportation incentive information. This program was discontinued in 1996.

A copy of Form W-2 is shown on page 42 of this *Postal Bulletin*.

3. Source of Reported Wages

The wages, tips, and other compensation amount reported in Box 1 of Form W-2 is derived from year-to-date totals reflected on the employee's pay period (PP) 26-99 (or last pay period in pay status in 1999) Earnings Statement, plus several other totals from the Form W-2. Use the reconciliation table below to reconcile your Earnings Statement with your Form W-2.

If any checks issued during 1999 were canceled after the last Earnings Statement was printed, this reconciliation table is not applicable.

General questions:

Imputed Income Life Insurance

The "Imputed income life insurance" amount shown in Box 35 of the 1999 Form W-2 is the net result of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) computation for taxable insurance benefits less the amount an employee pays for optional insurance in the calendar year.

The IRS requires the Postal Service to report as income the cost of group term life insurance in excess of \$50,000 that is paid by the employer. The formula is based on an employee's age, salary, and life insurance coverage.

Thrift Savings Plan (TSP)

The following facts will clarify some of the common tax questions regarding the TSP:

- a. Box 14, "Employee contributions (TSP)," will contain employee TSP contributions only.
- b. Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation," has been reduced by the amount of the employee's TSP contributions shown in Box 14.
- c. Box 17, "State/terr. gross wages," has been reduced by the amount of employee TSP contributions in Box 14 for all states, except New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Puerto Rico.
- d. New York City and St. Louis are the only localities that allow income deferral for TSP. Box 20, "Local wages," will be reduced by the amount of employee TSP contributions only if New York City or St. Louis are indicated in Box 19, "Locality name."

Employee Business Expense (EBE)

Equipment maintenance allowance (EMA), carrier drive-out, vehicle hire, supervisor vehicle usage, and special delivery are all considered employee expenses. Box 32, "Employee business expense," will contain the nontaxable (not the total) EBE amount, while Box 33, "Taxable employee business expense," will contain the taxable EBE amount. The taxable amount

shown in Box 33 will also be included in Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation."

Flexible Spending Account (FSA)

The amount contributed to an employee's FSA for both health care and dependent care is shown in Box 10, and has been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation."

Health Benefit (HB) Pre-Tax

The amount contributed for HB premiums is considered pre-tax unless the employee declined the pre-tax benefit. The HB pre-tax amount is shown in Box 37, and has been deducted from Box 1, "Wages, tips, other compensation."

Alternative Transportation Incentive Program (ATIP)

ATIP was discontinued in July 1996 and is no longer listed on Form W-2.

State/Terr. Gross Wages

The amount in Box 17, "State/terr. gross wages," will equal Box 1 with the following exceptions:

- New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Puerto Rico do not allow income deferral. Therefore, the employee TSP, FSA, and HB pre-tax contributions are not deducted from their state gross. (Pennsylvania law was changed in 1997 to allow income deferral for flexible spending account health care (FSAHC) and HB pre-tax. Therefore, only these two amounts will be deducted from Pennsylvania state gross.)
- Pennsylvania is the only state that does not require the "Imputed income life insurance" to be added into the state gross.

Annuity Protection Program

Form W-2s are issued to former employees who receive payments from the Postal Service under the Annuity Protection Program. Any questions regarding these Form W-2s should be directed to:

Federal Tax Withholding Exemption

IRS regulations permit employees who anticipate no federal tax liability for 2000 to claim total exemption from federal tax withholding provided they owe no federal taxes for 1999. To renew the exempt status or to claim allowances consistent with the expected tax liability for 2000, employees *must* submit a new IRS Form W-4, *Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate*, for 2000.

If an employee does not submit a new Form W-4 claiming a continuation of their exempt status, they will be converted to a taxable status, effective PP 04-2000. If a new Form W-4 is not received from employees who claimed exempt in 1999, federal taxes will be withheld at the rate that would be applicable to a single employee with no dependent allowances. Employees with a current exempt status (as of PP 26-99) will receive messages on their Earnings Statements for PPs 02-2000 and 03-2000 informing them that a new Form W-4 is required.

Both first-time exemptions and renewals of these forms are dependent upon timely submission by employees. Make certain to submit your Form W-4 as soon as possible to avoid any processing delays.

Reminder: Personnel offices are reminded that IRS regulations require an employer to submit copies of all Form W-4s received from employees when an employee claims 11 or more withholding allowances or claims to be exempt from withholding. Form W-5 Renewal

IRS Form W-5, *Earned Income Credit Advance Payment Certificate*, which allows eligible employees to receive advance payment of their earned income credit, must be renewed for 2000. The certificate currently in effect expires at the end of the pay year and must be renewed by submitting Form W-5 as soon as possible. Employees are responsible for timely submission of their Form W-5, and preferred date of receipt in the personnel office is no later than December 8, 1999 (PP 26, 1999). Please note that IRS regulations specifically prohibit any retroactive changes or additions to the information submitted on the original W-5.

Reminder: Personnel offices are reminded that the IRS regulations mandate that all employers submit copies of all Form W-5s received from their employees. 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Guidance for the Second Year of the Uniform Purchasing Program

The following uniform purchase guidance applies only to Bulk Mail Entry (2320-28XX), Bulk Mail Clerks (2320-15XX), and Mailing Requirements Clerks (2345-32XX).

In September 1998, Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU) employees began a two-year pilot uniform purchasing program. During the first year, they were provided a pre-packaged set of uniform apparel by a sole-source vendor. These employees were also terminated from the preexisting Uniform Program, and the Postal Service paid vendors directly for their garments.

For the second year, beginning in September 1999, the pilot program employees have returned to the preexisting method of purchasing uniforms. These employees can now contact vendors of choice from a list and spend their uniform allowance on any combination of garments needed before the allowance year expires (September 2000). As before, these employees are not obligated to spend all their allowance through one vendor, but they are responsible for any amounts that exceed the established annual allowance for purchases through one or more vendors. The list of approved BMEU vendors may be obtained through the employee's district BMEU office or district finance office.

Employees should expect to find several variations of the same garment available through different vendors. Also, some items are not available at all through some vendors. Employees are encouraged to compare styles, prices, or other factors relating to a garment before making a final selection. The following are general requirements for reimbursement of approved items.

Logo top-weight garments and caps — The approved logo distinguishes BMEU employees from employees in other programs and provides the professional style established for this group. Only the specially embroidered items (caps, polo shirts, denim shirts, striped oxford shirts, cardigan sweaters, hooded sweatshirts, jackets, or parkas) obtained from approved vendors are reimbursable under the BMEU workclothes program. Employees must wear the polo, denim, or striped oxford shirt to work. In addition, employees may wear their own turtleneck shirt (non-reimbursable) underneath the long-sleeved denim or striped oxford shirt.

Bottom-weight garments — Several pants, skirts, shorts, and skorts with a softer touch have been specially selected for reimbursement under the BMEU workclothes program. Employees may substitute their own navy blue pants or blue denim jeans (neither of which is reimbursable); these must be neat and clean in appearance, bearing no holes, tears, patches, or other distracting features.

Footwear — Only regulation black shoes bearing an SR/USA tag are authorized for wear and are reimbursable under the uniform allowance program.

a. Open Merchandise section. The Open Merchandise area has postal products, including shrink-wrapped stamps, on display for the customer to select. The customer selects the stamps from those on display and takes the purchase to the cash wrap counter or to the full-service window.

The cash wrap counter must be staffed at all times because it is designed to serve customers with quick transactions, such as purchasing stamps and retail products. Customers enjoy the expanded opportunities to select merchandise with little assistance and having separate cashiers to speed their simple transactions. This counter is not designed to provide full-service transactions that are time consuming nor to accept and secure mail or packages. Staffing the cash wrap counter not only serves customers more quickly but also discourages theft.

If there is downtime at the cash wrap, the window clerk should act as a lobby director and assist customers in the full-service line to complete forms and stock and organize the Postal Store area. For further details on the duties and responsibilities of a lobby director, refer to part 76 of this handbook.

b. Limited Merchandise section. This area houses a Limited Merchandise section which, because of limited space and other considerations, displays no shrink-wrapped stamps and only a select variety of products for customer self-selection.

Note: When possible, correct location for the open or limited merchandise section is on the right side of the service lobby and to the right of the parcel slide, see Handbook AS-504, *Standard Building Designs*. This location serves many purposes. One, it reinforces the natural tendency of people to go to their right. Second, it places the merchandise area to the right of the customer. Third, it prevents the parcel slide from acting as a barrier between the customer and the merchandise. Fourth, it places the customer in the closest possible proximity to the merchandise and the cash wrap clerk.

This design increases the tendency of the customer to shop the merchandise area with their eyes and perhaps leave the line. It also allows the cash wrap clerk easy access to the customer to provide assistance and introduce this new service option.

Private retail companies have used evaluators to provide a “snapshot photo” of service to assess their service levels and identify improvement opportunities. Some postal service districts have used a contract “customer evaluator” for a number of years. Now the postal service has a standardized, national Mystery Shopper Program, which ensures consistent procedures, methods questions, and ratings on a national level. A standardized program also ensures comparability across all areas and districts.

The Postal Mystery Shopper Program is an excellent tool for process improvement. It documents a customer’s experience at a retail unit. The program uses independent contracted “customers” who visit post offices and evaluate the office from the customer’s perspective by answering a standardized questionnaire. The answers are grouped into categories:

- a. Operational efficiency.
- b. Sales skills and product knowledge.
- c. Courtesy and professionalism.
- d. Retail products and services.
- e. Facility appearance.

541.2 Benefits

Some of the Benefits of Mystery Shopper evaluations are:

- a. Evaluations.
- b. Actual information about customer waiting times and service in five minutes.
- c. Checking self service vending machines for full stock and operating condition.
- d. Feedback on sales skills and knowledge (do clerks ask customers about desired arrival time of the mail piece, explain the product, offer any special services, additional products, and use of debit or credit cards?).
- e. Feedback on employee courtesy and professionalism.
- f. Feedback on retail packaging products and selected forms and supplies.
- g. Feedback on exterior and interior appearance and signage.

541.3 Retail Unit Proficiency Index (RUP)

A retail unit’s Mystery Shopper performance is one of the key measures of retail service. Mystery Shopper data is a primary source of the Retail Unit Proficiency Index (RUP).

New Dollar Coin

In spring of 2000, the U.S. Mint will begin release of a new dollar coin that will eventually replace the present Susan B. Anthony (SBA) coin. The new coin is golden in color with a smooth edge and a wider border and bears the image of an eagle on one side and Sacagawea on the other. Sacagawea is the Native American who, at the age of 15, guided the Lewis and Clark expedition west in 1804.

This new coin has been thoroughly tested in postal vending machines and is known to function the same as the SBA. Therefore, when they are released, golden coins may be combined in all vending machines with SBA coins to be used as change. All machines are known to accept the golden coin for purchases.

Domestic Mail Manual sections PO30 4.8, 4.9, and 4.12 contain the requirements for meter dating. Newer postage meter models have the capability to print “2000.” Older models do not have the same capability but can print “00” (double zeros) for the year 2000. Double zeros are acceptable for printing the year 2000.

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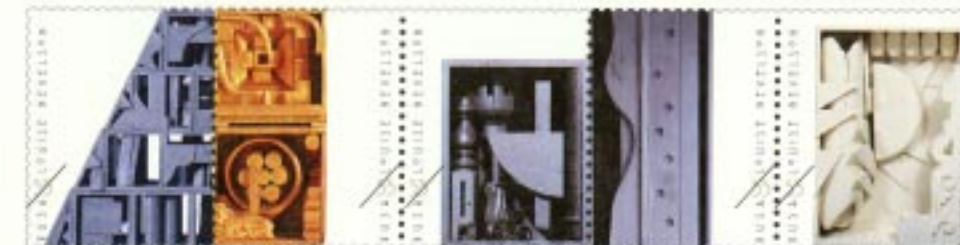
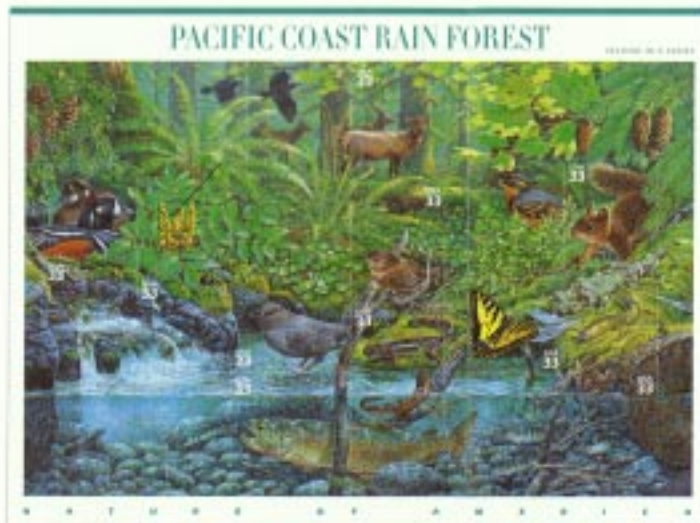
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
