Fiscal Year Closing Guidance

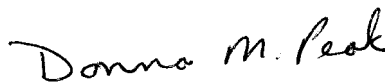
Message From the Controller

I encourage each of you to continue your efforts to control expenses. It is important that we carry this effort through to the end of the fiscal year.

While we must make accruals for goods received and services rendered, we must also control discretionary activity. This does not mean curtailing business; but it does mean making prudent choices, deferring or eliminating noncritical activity, and not purchasing goods or services at year-end simply because we have available budget funds.

We need to encourage our contractors to bill us in a timely manner so we can recognize the expense prior to the close of accounting period 13.

The following instructions will assist you, when appropriate, in helping the Postal Service close its financial books in a timely and efficient manner. Please note the minimum expense accrual is \$10,000.

I. Instructions for Fiscal Year Closing

All organizations are requested to limit their expenditures to essential spending. Accordingly, all vice presidents should review discretionary spending to ensure the Postal Service attains its financial target for this fiscal year (FY).

The government fiscal year comprises 365 days (366 in leap years) always ending on September 30. However, for internal reporting purposes, the Postal Service reporting cycle comprises 13 accounting periods (APs) of 28 days each, totaling 364 days. This year the Postal Service reporting cycle for internal reporting ends on September 7, 2001. AP 14 is an estimation period used to convert the Postal Service's internal reporting cycle to the government fiscal year.

The instructions and reporting dates in this *Postal Bulletin* supplement procedures followed during the normal AP or quarterly reporting schedule.

II. Capital and Expense Commitment or Accrual Activities

A. Capital

Purchasing will not accept capital and expense requisitions after August 17 unless work is currently under way on advance requirements or the buying manager grants an exception. Capital commitments, particularly Postal Service support equipment, should also be limited to essential needs.

Purchasing will attempt to issue the required contract in time for the San Mateo Accounting Service Center (ASC) to

process against FY 2001 funds. Contracts for requisitions requiring issuance of a solicitation or negotiation with vendors received prior to September 7 may not be issued in time for processing against FY 2001 funds. Requisitions received September 8 and after will be processed against FY 2002 funds.

Purchasing will process all requisitions for the issuance of contracts against FY 2001 funds according to the following priorities:

Priority 1 — Capital commitment requisitions.

Priority 2 — Expense commitment requisitions.

Commitment documents with award dates prior to and including September 7 must be forwarded to reach the San Mateo ASC not later than September 10. Appropriate receiving reports or certified invoices for goods and services received by September 7 must be forwarded to the San Mateo ASC for receipt *no later than September 10*. Please expedite processing of receiving reports and certified invoices as these documents are used to charge costs to the proper FY. Additionally, review contracts to ensure sufficient funds are available to cover accruals.

B. Unpaid Expenses or accruals for goods and services received September 7 and prior. Expense accrual limit for FY 2001 is \$10,000.

If it is impossible to furnish a certified invoice in time to reach the San Mateo ASC by September 10, a *minimum of \$10,000* may be accrued per contract sequence number or miscellaneous (noncommitment) purchase or service.

Complete PS Form 8163, *Request for Fiscal Year 2001 Expense Accrual*, a copy of which is found on page 5 of this *Postal Bulletin*. Documentation supporting accruals must be attached (see PS Form 8163 for examples of proper vendor documentation). Processing of all FY 2001 documents ends on September 14. Documents received at the San Mateo ASC pertaining to activity occurring September 8 and later will be recorded in FY 2002.

III. Liquidation of Accruals

When submitting an actual certified invoice, include the statement "Accrued to FY 2001" on the face of the document.

Accruals must be liquidated as soon as possible. Offices must monitor their accruals and payments to ensure that the accruals are properly liquidated. All FY 2001 accruals processed by the San Mateo ASC that remain unliquidated at the end of AP 06, FY 2002, will be reversed automatically as a prior year credit. Subsequent payments will be charged to the appropriate budget finance number as a FY 2002 expense.

Schedule I — Accrual Processing Information

The following are examples of items that *may* be accrued using PS Form 8163 if goods or services have been received September 7 and prior; no receiving report has been sent; the dollar amount of service rendered exceeds \$10,000; and you will not get an invoice to certify for payment by *September 7*:

Service Maintenance Contract — Copier

Review the last invoice processed to determine the amount to accrue from the service ending date through September 7.

To estimate the accrual amount, perform the following calculation:

- Calculate number of days to accrue.
Billing period last invoice = 7/26 – 8/24
Number of days to accrue = **14** (8/25 – 9/7)

- Calculate the daily rate.
Divide the last invoice amount by the number of days in the billing period to determine a daily rate.
Invoice amount = \$30,000
Billing period = 30 days (7/26 – 8/24)
Daily rate = **\$1,000** (\$30,000 / 30 days)
- Calculate the accrual amount.
Multiply the daily rate calculated by the number of days that will be accrued.
Accrual amount = \$1,000 x 14 = \$14,000

Utility Billing Accrual — Natural Gas

- Use the accrual amount calculation for service maintenance as shown above.

Other Goods or Services Accrual — Consultant Contract

- Calculate the accrual amount.
Check with the vendor to validate the cost of goods or services received during the period 8/14 – 9/7 and obtain the necessary supporting documentation.

Note: Do not accrue if the amount is less than \$10,000.

DMM REVISION

Information-Based Indicia

Effective July 17, 2001, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) P030.1.4 was revised to allow the use of information-based indicia (IBI) to show evidence of postage in the same manner as letterpress and digital meter stamps. This extends the use of IBI to all mail classes except Periodicals. Existing regulations on classes of mail that apply to metered mail now apply to mail bearing IBI. In particular, mailers using IBI can receive qualifying discounts for presorted mail.

1.4 Classes of Mail

[Revise 1.4 to read as follows:]

Postage may be paid by printing postage meter stamps (including letterpress, digital, and information-based indicia) on any class of mail except Periodicals. Information-based indicia (IBI) include human-readable information and a USPS-approved two-dimensional barcode with a digital signature and other required data fields. Metered mail (including mail bearing IBI) is entitled to all privileges and subject to all conditions applying to the various classes of mail.

POM REVISION

Delivery Confirmation Service and Signature Confirmation Service

Effective July 26, 2001, the *Postal Operations Manual* (POM) is revised to update Signature Confirmation service information in 811.1, and Delivery Confirmation service information in Section 817. We are also adding a new section 818 to include Signature Confirmation service.

817 Delivery Confirmation Service**817.1 How to Mail**

[Revise the introductory sentence in 817.1 to read as follows:]

Two options are offered for this service: a retail option available at any Post Office; and an electronic option for mailers who apply identifying barcodes to each piece, establish an electronic link with the Postal Service to exchange acceptance and delivery information, and provide an electronic file of Delivery Confirmation service pieces that are entered for mailing.

[Replace current items a and b with the following:]

- a. Retail option Delivery Confirmation service provides the sender with access to information about the date

an article was delivered and, if delivery was attempted but not successful, the date of the delivery attempt. The retail Delivery Confirmation service process involves the collection and storage of delivery information and provides the delivery information through the Postal Service web site or a toll-free number (as stated in 817.24). Customers can obtain, free of charge, PS Form 152, *Delivery Confirmation*, at Post Offices or from rural delivery employees. Retail option Delivery Confirmation service can be used only with Priority Mail and Package Services.

- b. Electronic option Delivery Confirmation service provides the sender with information about the date and time an article was delivered, or if delivery was attempted but not successful, the date and time of the delivery attempt. Delivery information can be accessed by visiting www.usps.com or through the electronic file. A mailer who wants to use the electronic option must supply the Postal Service with an electronic file that includes a list of the mailpieces. Electronic option Delivery Confirmation service may only be used with Priority Mail service, Standard Mail service pieces when subject to the residual shape surcharge, and Package Services.

817.2 Delivery**817.21 Procedure**

[Revise 817.21 to read as follows:]

Delivery Confirmation service mail for delivery by carriers must be taken out on the first trip after receipt, unless the addressee requests that the postmaster hold the mail at the Post Office. Delivery employees from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code into the handheld scanner when delivering Delivery Confirmation service items.

817.22 Rural Delivery

[Revise 817.22 to read as follows:]

Rural carriers from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code into the handheld scanner when delivering Delivery Confirmation service items. For more information on delivery by rural carriers or at personnel and nonpersonnel rural units, see POM 65 Rural Delivery Service.

817.23 Highway Contract Route Delivery

[Revise 817.23 to read as follows:]

Highway contract route carriers deliver Delivery Confirmation service mail if required by the carrier's contract, but delivery is made only at the customer's mailbox or along the route. Electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner at delivery.

817.24 Delivery Records

[Revise 817.24 to read as follows:]

Customers will have access to delivery status information for 6 months by visiting the Postal Service Web site at www.usps.com or, for retail customers only, by calling toll-free 1-800-222-1811.

817.25 Notice of Arrival

[Revise 817.25 to read as follows:]

The carrier must leave a notice of arrival using PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, if the Delivery Confirmation service article cannot be delivered because it will not fit into the mail receptacle or the parcel is endorsed under the standards in DMM D042.7.0. Delivery employees from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner. If the article is undeliverable it is brought back to the Post Office and held for the addressee. If the article is not called for within 5 calendar days, a final notice is issued. If the article is not called for or redelivery of the article is not requested, it must be returned to the sender after 15 calendar days, unless the sender had specified on the mailpiece that it be held a fewer number of days in accordance with DMM M012. Employees in electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner when returning mail to sender.

817.26 Delivery at Post Office

[Revise 817.26 to read as follows:]

Hold Delivery Confirmation service items at a place convenient for the public to call if addressed for Post Office box, general delivery, firm callers, or if PS Form 3849 is left for addressee to call. Place PS Form 3849 in the Post Office box for box-service customers. Delivery Confirmation service items do not require a signature, so PS Form 3883, *Firm Delivery Receipt for Accountable Mail and Bulk Delivery Mail*, or PS Form 3883a, *Firm Delivery Receipt*, may be used when customers receive an average of 10 or more Delivery Confirmation service items at one delivery.

817.3 Carrier Controls

817.31 Assignment

[Revise items a and b to read as follows:]

* * * * *

- a. *Individual Pieces*. Deliver Delivery Confirmation service items in the same manner as other Priority Mail and Package Services items.
- b. *Firm Mail*. Prepare PS Form 3883 or PS Form 3883a in duplicate for customers who receive an average of 10 or more pieces at one time. Use the duplicates of the firm sheet as chargeout, and recycle the duplicate forms after the delivery employee has turned in the firm sheet and the signed PS Form 3849. PS Form 3883 may include other special service items. A minimum of six items is required for a mixed PS Form 3883. All items must be scanned and PS Form 3883 must be scanned to create an electronic link of all pieces to the firm sheet. Offices with firm print work stations will use these systems to create bar-coded firm sheets.

Use procedures in 817.25 to handle Delivery Confirmation service mail that is undeliverable or must be forwarded.

817.4 Verified Mailing Receipts

817.41 Retail Customers

[Revise items b and c to read as follows:]

- b. Make certain that the correct postal charges have been paid with affixed adhesive or meter stamps.
- c. Deposit the article in the mail.

817.42 Large-Volume Mailings

[Replace existing 817.42 with the following:]

* * * * *

When accepting Delivery Confirmation service articles submitted under a Manifest Mailing System agreement, follow the acceptance procedures listed in Publication 401, *Guide to the Manifest Mailing System* (MMS), for insured, COD, certified, and return receipt for merchandise articles, using the Delivery Confirmation service package identification code as the article number.

For large-volume mailings that include Delivery Confirmation service articles not submitted using an approved Manifest Mailing System agreement, follow the steps below.

These steps are in addition to any other acceptance and verification procedures required in Handbook DM109, *Business Mail Acceptance*, for the method of postage payment used or presort discounts claimed:

- a. Randomly select sample pieces from the mailing according to the sample size chart below.

Articles in Mailing	Sampling Size
1–299	10 percent of mailing
300–1,999	30 articles
2,000–3,999	40 articles
4,000–5,999	50 articles
6,000–7,999	60 articles
8,000–9,999	70 articles
10,000–99,999	100 articles

- b. For each sample piece selected with Delivery Confirmation service check the following:
 - (1) That the article number is listed on PS Form 3877, *Firm Mailing Book for Accountable Mail*.
 - (2) That the postage and fees are correctly paid and entered on PS Form 3877.
 - (3) That the article is properly endorsed.
- c. If the postage and/or fees on a sample article are not correct, take an entirely new sample that is the same size as the original sample. If the second sampling is correct, accept the mailing and make a postage and/or fee adjustment for the incorrect postage amount. If the second sampling has an error, return the mailing to the mailer for correction.
- d. Postmark and sign the firm mailing book in ink and give it to the mailer. Enter the time the articles are mailed if requested to do so by the mailer and initial in ink by the entry.

818 Signature Confirmation Service

818.1 How to Mail

818.11 Service Options

There are two options offered for this service: a retail option available at any Post Office; and an electronic option for mailers who apply identifying barcodes to each piece, who establish an electronic link with the Postal Service to exchange acceptance and delivery information, and who provide an electronic file of Signature Confirmation service pieces that are entered for mailing.

- a. Retail option Signature Confirmation service provides the sender with signature proof of delivery on request and information about the date and time an article was delivered or, if delivery was attempted, the

date and time of the delivery attempt. The retail Signature Confirmation service process involves collecting and storing delivery and signature information and provides the delivery information through the Postal Service Web site or a toll-free number (as stated in 818.24). The sender can request that a copy of the Signature Confirmation service signature and delivery information be sent by fax or mail. Customers can obtain, free of charge, PS Form 153, *Signature Confirmation*, at Post Offices or from rural delivery employees. Retail Signature Confirmation service can be used with Priority Mail service and Package Services.

- b. Electronic option Signature Confirmation service provides the mailer with signature proof of delivery on request and information about the date and time an article was delivered, or if delivery was attempted, the date and time of the delivery attempt. Delivery information can be accessed by visiting www.usps.com or through the electronic file. The signature information can be requested by visiting the Web site or calling the toll-free number. A response letter will be faxed or mailed to the sender according to his or her request. A mailer who wants to use the electronic option must supply the Postal Service with an electronic file that includes a list of the mailpieces. Electronic Signature Confirmation service can be used with Priority Mail service and Package Services.

818.12 Signature Waiver Option

Customers can choose the waiver of signature option at the time of mailing. The delivery employee signs for the item if no one is available to sign and the item can be left in a secure location. No image of the delivery employee's signature is provided in the customer response letter, if the sender requests the delivery information. This option is not available when Signature Confirmation service is combined with other special services.

818.2 Delivery

818.21 Procedure

Signature Confirmation service mail for delivery by carriers must be taken out on the first trip after it is received, unless the addressee requests that the postmaster hold the mail at the Post Office. When the waiver of signature option has been chosen the delivery employee must sign for the item at the time of delivery if no one is there to receive it and the item can be left in a secure location. Delivery employees from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner when delivering Signature Confirmation service items. Corresponding PS Form 3849 must be scanned and properly completed.

818.22 Rural Delivery

Rural carriers from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code into the handheld scanner when delivering Signature Confirmation service items. The corresponding PS Form 3849 must be scanned and properly completed. For more information on delivery by rural carriers or at personnel and nonpersonnel rural units, see POM 65, Rural Delivery Service.

818.23 Highway Contract Route Delivery

Highway contract route carriers deliver Signature Confirmation service mail if required by the carrier's contract, but delivery is made only at the customer's mail box or along the route. Electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner at delivery. Corresponding PS Form 3849 must be scanned and properly completed.

818.24 Delivery Records

Customers will have access to the delivery status and signature image for 1 year by visiting the Postal Service Web site at www.usps.com or, for retail customers only, by calling 1-800-222-1811.

818.25 Notice of Arrival

The carrier must leave a notice of arrival using PS Form 3849, *Delivery Notice/Reminder/Receipt*, if no one is available to receive the Signature Confirmation service article. Delivery employees from electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner. Articles that have the signature waived and can be left in a secure area must be signed for by the carrier and delivered. If the article cannot be delivered, it is brought back to the Post Office and held for the addressee. If the article is not called for within 5 calendar days, a final notice is issued. If the article is not called for or redelivery of the article is not requested, it must be returned after 15 calendar days, unless the sender specifies a fewer number of days on the mailpiece in accordance with DMM M012. Employees in electronic record management offices must scan/enter the mailpiece barcode and enter the appropriate event code in the handheld scanner when returning mail to sender.

818.26 Delivery at Post Office

Hold Signature Confirmation service items at a place convenient for the public to call if addressed for Post Office box, general delivery, firm callers, or if PS Form 3849 is left for addressee to call. Place PS Form 3849 in the Post Office box for box-service customers. PS Form 3883, *Firm*

Delivery Receipt for Accountable Mail and Bulk Delivery Mail, or PS Form 3883a, *Firm Delivery Receipt*, can be used for a firm or customer that receives an average of six or more Signature Confirmation service items at one delivery. Corresponding PS Form 3849 must be signed when using PS Form 3883.

818.3 Carrier Controls

818.31 Assignment

Send Signature Confirmation service mail, including Signature Confirmation service mail for firms, to a unit or employee designated to assign this mail for delivery, and follow these procedures for each type of mail:

- a. *Individual Pieces.* Deliver Signature Confirmation service items in the same manner as other Priority Mail service and Package Services items. Signature Confirmation service items must be signed for by the addressee or addressee's agent in accordance with POM 818.2.
- b. *Firm Mail.* Prepare PS Form 3883 or PS Form 3883a in duplicate for addressees who receive an average of 6 or more pieces at one time. Use the duplicates of the firm sheet as chargeout, and recycle the forms after the delivery employee has turned in the firm sheet and the signed PS Form 3849. PS Form 3883 may include other special service items. A minimum of six items is required for mixed PS Form 3883. All items must be scanned and the PS Form 3883 barcode scanned to create an electronic link of all pieces to the firm sheet. Offices with firm print work stations will use these systems to create barcoded firm sheets.

818.32 Delivery to Military Installations

Signature Confirmation service is not available to APO/FPO addresses.

818.33 Undeliverable

Use procedures in 818.25 to handle Signature Confirmation service mail that is undeliverable or must be forwarded.

818.4 Verified Mailing Receipts

818.41 Retail Customers

Verify individual mailing receipts as follows:

- a. Apply and scan Signature Confirmation service bar-coded label.
- b. Verify completion of Signature Waiver information for customers choosing option.
- c. Make certain that correct postal charges are paid by affixed adhesive or meters stamps.
- d. Deposit the article in the mail.

818.42 Large-Volume Mailings

When accepting Signature Confirmation service articles submitted under a Manifest Mailing System agreement, follow the acceptance procedures listed in Publication 401, *Guide to the Manifest Mailing System* (MMS), for insured, COD, certified, and return receipt for merchandise articles, using the Signature Confirmation service package identification code as the article number.

For large-volume mailings that include Signature Confirmation service articles not submitted using an approved Manifest Mailing System agreement, follow the steps below. These steps are in addition to any other acceptance and verification procedures required in Handbook DM109, *Business Mail Acceptance*, for the method of postage payment used or presort discounts claimed:

REMINDER

Free Mail Program for Members of the Armed Forces

All Postal Service employees who handle and deliver mail should be aware of the free mail privilege for members of the Armed Forces. For such mail, employees must not collect postage upon delivery or return mail to the sender for postage.

Authorized persons may mail without postage letters, postcards, and sound recordings (audio and videotapes) having the character of personal correspondence to any place in the United States, its possessions or territories, or any military Post Office (APO/FPO).

Postal Service employees must process and deliver free mail that meets the following requirements:

- Mail has a complete APO or FPO return address.
- Mail has the word "Free" in the upper right corner with an APO or FPO postmark.
- Mail has a complete delivery address.

Free mail may *not* be registered, insured, or certified.

Free mail privileges are authorized for members of the Armed Forces and designated civilians directly supporting military operations in the following locations:

- Aboard ships in the Adriatic Sea
- Aboard ships in the Ionian Sea north of the 39th parallel
- Albania

- Former Republic of Yugoslavia
 - Bosnia-Herzegovina
 - Croatia (including Zagreb)
 - Macedonia
 - Serbia-Montenegro (including Kosovo and Vojvodina)
 - Slovenia
- Hungary
- Zakho (which is south of the Turkish border in the no-fly zone of northern Iraq)

Members of the Armed Forces who are hospitalized in a facility under the jurisdiction of the Armed Forces due to disease or injury as a result of service in these designated areas also receive free mail privileges.

For more information about free postage for mail sent to and from members of the Armed Forces, see *Domestic Mail Manual* E030 (which is based on 39 USC 3401 and Executive Order 12556 (April 16, 1986)).

Coming Soon — Online Shipping e-Label at www.usps.com

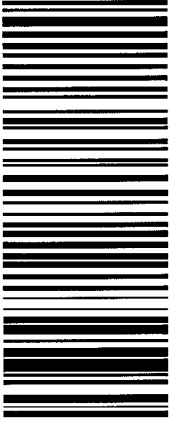
The Postal Service has now made it easier for small-volume Priority Mail® service shippers to use electronic option Delivery Confirmation™ service. This value-added feature will soon be available via the new USPS Shipping Web site at www.usps.com, and will provide mailers with easy-to-access information to meet their shipping needs. This site will allow shippers to print from their computers an Online Shipping e-Label that has sender information, recipient information, and a Delivery Confirmation barcode. Acceptance information is electronically sent to the Product Tracking System to meet electronic option requirements. Initially, the Online Shipping e-Label will be limited to Priority Mail service with electronic option Delivery Confirmation service. A future version will include Signature Confirmation™ service.

The Online Shipping e-Labels use the new Postal Service standard format with an "e" insignia before the USPS Delivery Confirmation text above the barcode. Customers apply the e-label to their Priority Mail package and can then

use adhesive or meter stamps to pay for their mailing. If customers bring packages to the retail counter, the process for weighing and rating those pieces is the same as with other e-label Delivery Confirmation service pieces as discussed in the Retail Coaches' Corner, *Postal Bulletin* 22052 (6-14-01, page 83). Retail employees do not scan the Delivery Confirmation service e-label/barcode; instead they merely weigh and rate the packages for postage only. Customers are not charged the retail Delivery Confirmation service fee when they use this new electronic label. Additionally, customers who require proof of mailing can bring the Online e-Label Record to the retail counter for a round date, like any other special service receipt.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on non-dutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C024.1.1C. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail (A) are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

42"	72" length and girth combined
over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth
Maximum length 48"	

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those allowable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail (A), and Standard Mail (B) (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Finance

Accountbooks and Statement of Accounts for Postal Fiscal Year 2002

The material distribution center (MDC) has completed an automatic distribution of PS Form 1551, *Accountbook for Post Offices and Financial Reporting Units — CAGs A–L*, and PS Form 1555, *Statement of Account for CAGs H–L*, for postal fiscal year (PFY) 2002. These forms have an edition date of June 2000, the same as last year. The forms are to be used by statement of account (SOA) CAG H–L offices only.

Any offices with remaining forms from last year may use them in PFY 2002.

These forms were distributed in bulk quantities to district accounting offices (DAOs) only and should be distributed by the DAOs to the field no later than August 24, 2001. If your office does not receive its forms by this date, contact your DAO, not the MDC.

All CAG H–L offices that submit a manual SOA are to begin using the forms at the beginning of PFY 2002 (9-8-01).

DAOs requiring forms in addition to the automatic distribution may requisition them as follows:

Holiday Celebrations — EID

The Postal Service will issue a 34-cent *Eid* commemorative stamp (Item Number 562100) in Des Plaines, Illinois, on September 1, 2001. The stamp, designed/calligraphed by Mohamed Zakariya of Arlington, Virginia, goes on sale nationwide September 1, 2001. The stamps will be produced in panes of 20; the panes may be split and the stamps may be sold individually.

The *Eid* stamp commemorates the two most important festivals in the Islamic calendar: Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha. The "Eid mubarak" phrase featured in Islamic calligraphy on the stamp can be paraphrased "May your religious holiday be blessed." In 2001 Eid al-Adha was celebrated on March 6, and Eid al-Fitr will be celebrated on December 16. The first of the Muslim lunar month of Shawwal, Eid al-Fitr signifies "The Feast of Breaking the Fast" and marks the end of Ramadan, the month of fasting. Eid al-Fitr is observed by offering special alms with prayers, feasting, exchanging gifts, and visiting family and friends. Eid al-Adha comes at the end of the annual period of

pilgrimage to the holy city of Mecca. The *Eid* stamp joins the *Holiday Celebrations* series.

Distribution

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) will receive one-half of their standard automatic distribution quantities for a PSA sheet stamp. Distributions are rounded up to the nearest master carton size (40,000 stamps).

Initial Supply to Post Offices

SDOs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to Post Offices for one-half of their standard automatic distribution quantities using PS Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs must not distribute stamps to Post Offices before August 23, 2001.

Additional Supply

Post Offices requiring additional stamps must requisition them from their designated SDO using PS Form 17. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate accountable paper depository (APD) using a separate PS Form 17.

For fulfilling supplemental orders from SDOs, the San Francisco and Chicago APDs will receive 1,760,000 stamps; the Memphis and Washington, DC, APDs will receive 1,720,000 stamps; the New York APD will receive 2,000,000 stamps; and the Denver APD will receive 480,000 additional stamps.

Philatelic Requirement

SDOs with authorized philatelic centers will receive an automatic distribution of these stamps in 10 positions for subsequent distribution to each philatelic window.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage. Items submitted for cancellation may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for cancellation, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

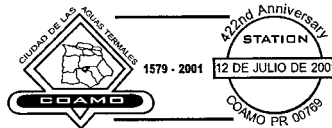

Processing International Mail Trays

All Post Offices responsible for processing inbound international mail should be aware that the *only* return destination for empty and/or damaged international mail trays and lids is your local International Service Center (ISC), and not the mail transport equipment service centers (MTESCs).

Light blue international mail trays (IPC trays) and their black lids are the property of the International Post Corporation (IPC), and are marked as such. They are *not* the property of the Postal Service. The Postal Service and its Post Offices other than the ISCs are not authorized or funded to handle IPC trays and lids.

The manufacturer warrants IPC trays and lids against damage; therefore, all damaged trays and lids must be promptly returned to the servicing ISC for subsequent return to the supplier.

Plant managers must advise their opening units to return IPC trays to the nearest ISC by return transportation.

Proper Identification of Damaged Mail Transport Equipment Rolling Stock

All users of mail transport equipment (MTE) are requested to promptly identify, "red tag," and isolate damaged or defective wheeled containers used to transport mail. Damaged rolling stock must be removed from service and placed in a holding area for return to the servicing mail transport equipment service center (MTESC).

Although all MTE items passing through the MTESCs are scanned for obvious defects, use of the orange PS Form 4707, "Out of Order" tag, will ensure that broken rolling stock is identified and scheduled for repair. Please help the MTESC network keep your rolling stock serviceable by tagging all defective containers.

Removal of Trash From Mail Transport Equipment

Please disregard the article titled "Notice: Removal of Trash from Mail Transport Equipment" in Postal Bulletin 22051 (5-31-01, page 59). The article that appears here has the correct information.

Mail processing centers and facilities must immediately stop shipping excess or broken office and workroom furniture, equipment, garbage, and trash to the mail transport equipment service centers (MTESCs) in excess containers or cardboard boxes. Incidents of this type have increased sharply during 2001. This practice creates environmental health and safety problems at the receiving MTESCs, which must spend unbudgeted funds to dispose of the refuse through waste management contractors.

Future shipments of this type will be returned to the originating offices, which will be billed for the additional shipping and handling expenses.

Refer to Handbook AS-701, *Material Management*, for instructions on disposing of unneeded or broken equipment.

Commercial Mail Receiving Agency (CMRA) — Toll-Free Number and Web Site

On August 1, 2001, the Postal Service will implement a toll-free number **(1-888-209-8726)** that will allow Postal Service customers to verify whether an address with a pound sign (#) secondary designator is an address located at a CMRA. Postal Service customers may also verify these types of addresses on the Internet by following these instructions:

1. Go to <http://www.usps.com>.
2. Click *Find ZIP Codes*.
3. Enter the address on the *ZIP+4 Code Lookup* home page, and click the *Process* button.

The database will return the standardized address and indicate if it is located at a CMRA.

REMINDER

Commercial Mail Receiving Agency (CMRA) — Relocation Procedures

When a CMRA relocates, it may file a change-of-address (COA) order for the entire agency. The Postal Service does not accept COA orders for individual customers of CMRAs. The CMRA must forward the mail of customers who terminate their relationship with the CMRA because of the move, with payment of new postage.

To process mail for a CMRA that has relocated:

- Forward mail for the CMRA and its customers to the new address without payment of new postage.
- Forward the mail from the current delivery unit to the new delivery unit and bypass the Computer Forwarding System (CFS) unit.

- Package the mail in the appropriate container (e.g., a bundle, half- or full-size letter tray, or flat tray), and label the container with the CMRA name and new address.
- Dispatch the container to the new delivery unit.

REMINDER

Commercial Mail Receiving Agency (CMRA) — August 1, 2001, Compliance Date For Addressing Standards

On March 25, 1999, the Postal Service published a final rule in the *Federal Register* (64 FR 14385–14391) to amend *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) D042.2.5 through D042.2.7, which would clarify how to address mail for CMRA private mailbox holders. However, the effective date of the rule was delayed until August 1, 2001, to ease the transition to the new standard for CMRA customers.

The final rule requires private mailbox holders to use *PMB* (private mailbox) as a secondary address designation instead of *suite* or *apartment*, which imply that the addressee is physically located at the address.

The *PMB* addressing requirement was adopted along with other provisions to:

- Increase the safety and security of the mail.
- Protect the interest of consumers and businesses by reducing the opportunities to use the mail for fraudulent or deceptive purposes.
- Let people know that their correspondent receives mail through a CMRA and does not maintain an office or other physical presence at that address.

On August 16, 2000, the Postal Service published a final rule in the *Federal Register* (65 FR 49917) to amend DMM D042.2.6e, which would revise the addressing requirements to permit private mailbox holders to use the pound sign (#) instead of *PMB* as the secondary designation, in certain conditions. The preferred address formats for CMRA customers are:

JOE DOE
PMB 234
RR 1 BOX 12
HERNDON VA 22071-2716

JOE DOE
#234
10 MAIN ST STE 11
HERNDON VA 22071-2716

If the four-line address cannot be used, a three-line format is acceptable. The *PMB* and number must be included at the end of the street address line. **Exception:** When the CMRA's physical address contains a secondary address element (e.g., rural route box number, pound sign (#), suite, or other term), the CMRA customer must use *PMB* in the three-line format. In this case, mailers must use the following formats:

JOE DOE
10 MAIN ST STE 11 PMB 234
HERNDON VA 22071-2716

JOE DOE
RR 12 BOX 512 PMB 234
HERNDON VA 22071-2716

The Postal Service recognized that CMRA customers could incur some out-of-pocket expenses and would need time to notify correspondents of the change in their address in order to comply with the new regulation. Therefore, the Postal Service set the effective date of the requirement a full year after the rule was adopted, allowing CMRA customers to minimize costs by enabling them to:

- Deplete existing stationery.
- Advise correspondents of the new address in the course of ordinary business rather than through a special communication.
- Make any other needed changes to comply with the address requirement.

The CMRA is obligated to enforce addressing requirements. If a CMRA customer fails to comply, the CMRA must terminate the relationship with that customer. Rather than returning mail, postal managers observing CMRA customer's mail that is improperly addressed, should notify the CMRA in writing and provide it with a reasonable time to correct the violation. However, the rule states that the Postal Service *may* return mail addressed to a CMRA customer with an improper secondary designator (e.g., suite, apartment) in the complete customer address.
