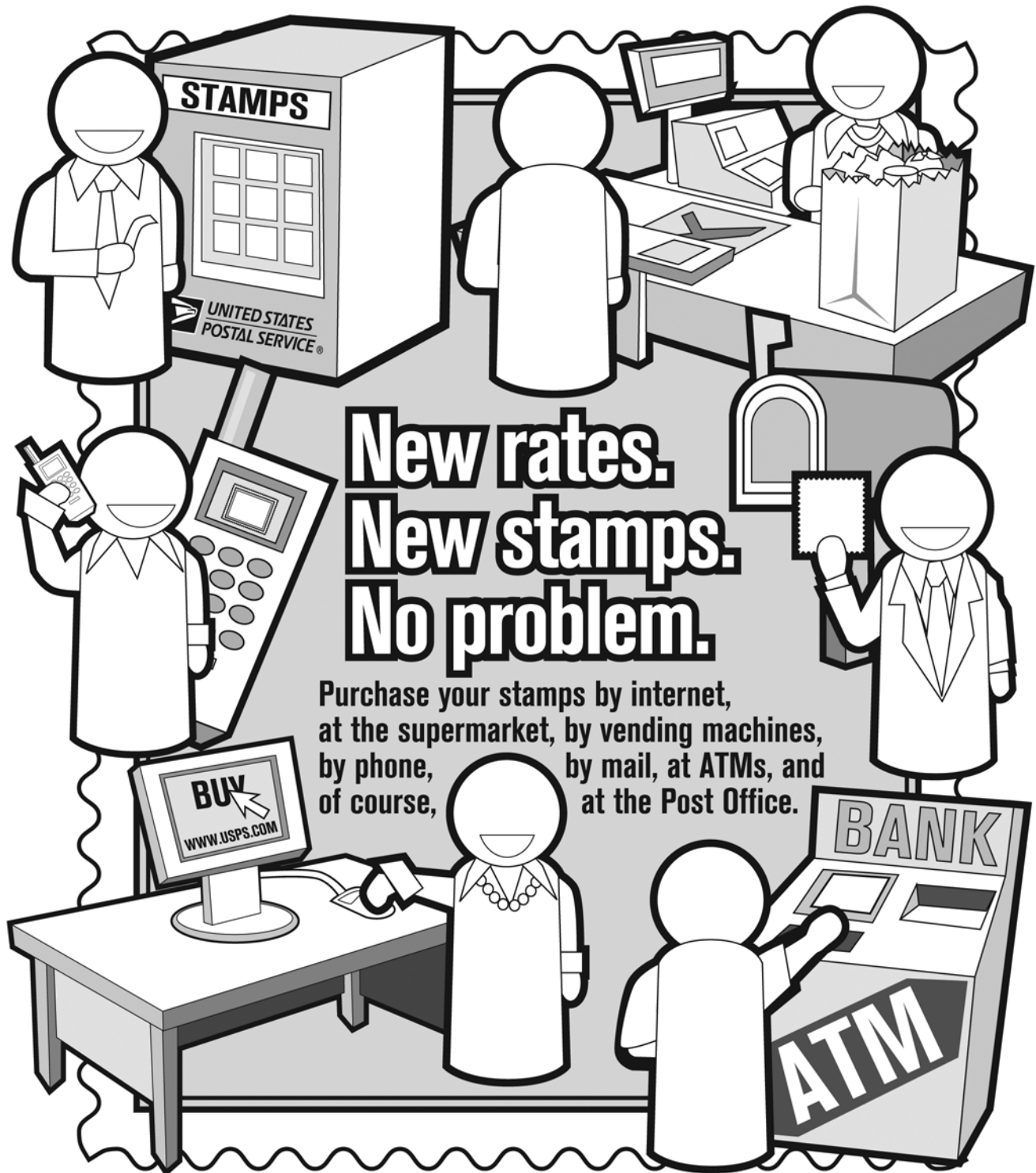

GUIDELINES

Obtaining and Evaluating Information Technology Hardware and Software Products for a Trial Period

Effective June 27, 2002, anyone wishing to test and evaluate hardware or software (both free and purchased) must follow the guidelines set forth in MI AS-840-2002-6, *Obtaining and Evaluating Information Technology Hardware and Software Products for a Trial Period*. The MI replaces MI AS-840-88-12, *Free Trial Loans of ADP Hardware and/or Software*. Among other things, the MI explains what steps you should take before you make a request to evaluate hardware or software and how to request approval once you've completed those steps.

For example:

- Before you request approval to evaluate hardware or software:
 - Research the need for the product.
 - Ensure the test period will not exceed 180 days.
 - Ensure there will be no obligation to purchase the product following the evaluation period.
 - Ensure that only test data is used in the evaluation.
 - Ensure the product is 508 compliant.
 - Ensure the product meets Postal Service security requirements.
- To request approval to evaluate hardware or software:
 - Prepare a statement explaining the reasons for evaluation.
 - Prepare PS Form 7381, *Requisition for Supplies, Services and Equipment*, for both purchased and free products.
 - For free products, prepare a PS Form 2629, *Free Trial Test Agreement* (see sample on page 4).
 - Submit the completed form(s) and all supporting documents to:

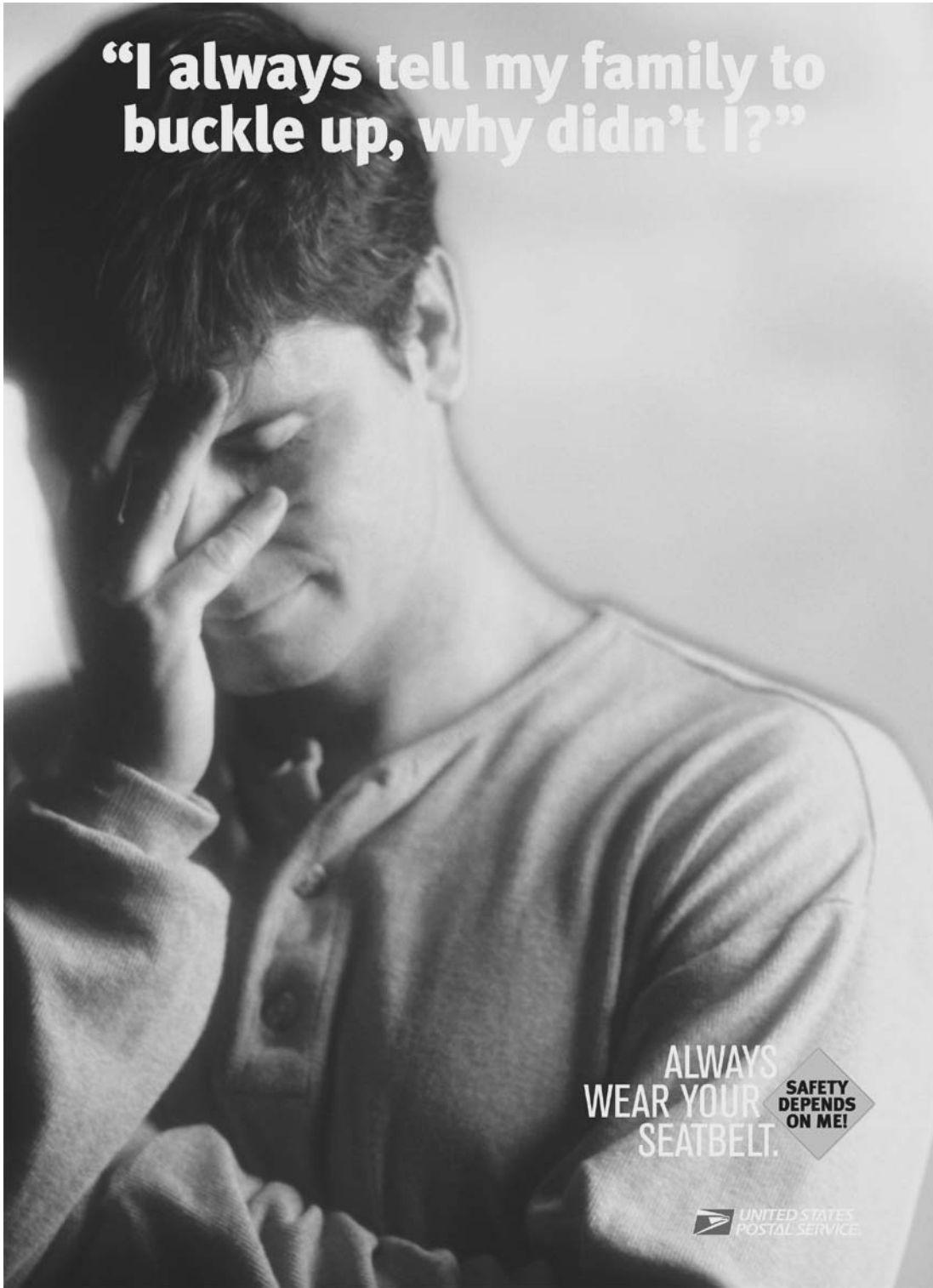

DMM REVISION

Parcel Select ZIP Code Addition

Effective June 27, 2002, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E751 Exhibit 6.0 is revised to add a ZIP Code. To qualify for destination sectional center facility (DSCF) rates on pallets for this ZIP Code, the mail must now be deposited at the bulk mail center (BMC) as indicated below.

DMM REVISION

Barcode Requirements for Delivery Confirmation and Signature Confirmation Services

Effective June 27, 2002, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) C850 is revised to amend the barcode requirements for Delivery Confirmation™ and Signature Confirmation™ labels. The word “ZIP” must be added to these labels no later than December 31, 2002, as specified below. “ZIP” is used as an internal identifier to process loop mail.

[Revise 1.4b(5) to read as follows:]

- (5) In addition to the human-readable requirements in S918, S919, and Publication 91, the word “ZIP” must be printed on the barcode label. One of the following two options must be incorporated: (a) The word “ZIP” must be printed to the left of the barcode in 12-point or larger sans serif type. A clear zone between the end of the word “ZIP” and the beginning of the barcode must be maintained. The clear zone must be no less than 10 times the average narrow bar or space element width and no more than 1/2 inch to the left of the barcode. A clear zone of 0.25 inch is recommended. (b) The word “ZIP” must be printed above the barcode and left-justified with a hyphen to separate text (e.g., “ZIP – USPS DELIVERY CONFIRMATION”).

Overseas Military Mail

Mail addressed to or from military post offices overseas is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. The APO/FPO table below outlines these conditions by APO/FPO ZIP Codes through the use of footnoted mailing restrictions codes (see the Restrictions page following the table).

Acceptance clerks should use the table with the integrated retail terminal (IRT) or POS ONE terminal to determine which APO/FPO ZIP Codes are active and

which conditions of mailing apply. **Acceptance clerks may contact the Military Postal Service Agency with any questions regarding APO/FPO ZIP Codes, toll free, at 800-810-6098, Monday–Friday, 0730–1630.**

For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, all acceptance clerks must refer to the local hardcopy EMMS directory.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C024.1.1C. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail items and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O818-A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

After consulting with union representatives of affected employees at the Post Office, if the postmaster decides a tie is to be worn with the convertible collared summer shirt, the tie is worn by all affected employees at that Post Office. However, if the decision is that a tie need not be worn, individual employees who desire to wear the tie may do so even though the majority are without ties.

ICM UPDATES

International Customized Mail

We have combined ICM updates into one *Postal Bulletin* article to save space and paper. Four ICM updates appear here.

On May 30, 2002, the Postal Service entered into an International Customized Mail (ICM) Service Agreement with a qualifying mailer. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 294, the Postal Service now makes public the following information concerning the Agreement:

- a. **Term:** May 30, 2002, through May 31, 2005.
- b. **Type of mail:** *International Priority Airmail Service* (IPA), *International Surface Air Lift Service* (ISAL), and *Global Bulk Economy Service* (GBE). Every item must conform to the mailing requirements set forth in the IMM for Qualifying Mail.
- c. **Destination countries:** Worldwide.
- d. **Service provided by the Postal Service:** The Postal Service has agreed to:
 1. Furnish the Mailer with the postal equipment and postal supplies required for the use of Qualifying Mail.
 2. Provide the Mailer with the preparation requirements for Qualifying Mail and any training necessary to prepare ICM Mail in conformity with the requirements for Qualifying Mail.
 3. Arrange with carriers to transport Qualifying Mail to international destinations for delivery by the appropriate authority.
- e. **Minimum volume commitments:** The Mailer has agreed to tender to the Postal Service mail intended for delivery outside the United States that generates at least \$25 million in actual postage in each year beginning on the effective date of this Agreement and ending on each anniversary of this date for the duration of the Agreement.
- f. **Worksharing:** The Mailer has agreed to:
 1. Tender at least ninety-nine (99) percent of IPA Qualifying Mail in drop shipments to the appropriate locations specified in IMM 292.153.
 2. Tender at least ninety-nine (99) percent of ISAL Qualifying Mail in drop shipments to the appropriate locations specified in IMM 293.32.
 3. Tender no more than one (1) percent of IPA and ISAL Qualifying Mail to other postal facilities at the national rate or full service rate as appropriate.

4. Drop-ship GBE Qualifying Mail at the New Jersey International and Bulk Mail Center.
 5. Provide the Postal Service with notification of intent to drop ship Qualifying Mail at a specific International Service Center (ISC) 2 weeks before the initial shipment to that ISC.
 6. Provide the Postal Service with notification of new dedicated permit numbers 2 weeks in advance of using the new dedicated permit numbers.
 7. Provide the Postal Service with projections of mailings to include the intended date of mailing, weight, and volume of the mailings.
 8. Pay postage to the Postal Service for GBE using an exclusive permit imprint number.
 9. Pay postage to the Postal Service for ICM Qualifying Mail using dedicated permit imprints.
- g. **Rates:** The Mailer has agreed to pay postage for:
1. GBE at rates discounted sixteen (16.0) percent off the base rates contained in Exhibit 1.

STAMP ANNOUNCEMENT 02-23

Jefferson Memorial Priority Mail Stamp

The Postal Service will issue a \$3.85 *Jefferson Memorial* Priority Mail® stamp (Item 112100) in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 on July 30, 2002, in Washington, DC. The stamp, designed by Derry Noyes, Washington, DC, and photographed by Carol Highsmith, Takoma Park, Maryland, goes on sale nationwide July 30, 2002.

Dedicated April 13, 1943, on the 200th anniversary of Thomas Jefferson's birth, this picturesque landmark is located on the south side of the Tidal Basin in Washington, DC. In 1934, Congress established the Thomas Jefferson Memorial Commission to plan, design, and construct a memorial to the nation's third president. The memorial's design is a circular domed structure based on the Pantheon in Rome. In 1819, Jefferson used the Pantheon as inspiration for his design of the rotunda at the University of Virginia.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

The U.S. Capitol is a stunning example of neoclassical architecture and an enduring symbol of democracy and the American people. President George Washington laid the building's cornerstone in 1793. Effective August 10, 2002, the Postal Service will discontinue standard international postal money orders, both incoming and outgoing (see *International Mail Manual* 371.2a). The *Authorization To Issue International Money Order* (ATI) form set will be discontinued. This does not affect the sale of direct money orders (Form MP 1) issued to those countries with whom we have agreements.

August 9, 2002, is the last day that standard international postal money orders using the ATI may be sold.

New Mandatory Contract for Temporary Personnel Services

Supply Management, in concert with Human Resources, recently awarded a nationwide contract for temporary personnel services to Manpower. The contract is for 2 years with three 1-year renewal options. Under this contract, Manpower will provide full-time and part-time temporary staff for 33 labor and skill categories, including clerical, administrative, paraprofessional, technical, and light industrial. Postal Service employees must use Manpower to fill all temporary positions except casual labor positions (i.e., casual carriers, mail handlers, and casual clerks).

In fiscal year 2002, we anticipate that the Manpower contract will save the Postal Service \$547,200. Additionally, we have negotiated savings of \$361,600 over 24 months (the base period of the contract). The contract also includes an option to use eBay, which could result in further savings.

Area Human Resources offices will receive a list of the 33 labor and skill categories and a letter outlining the policies and procedures that Postal Service staff must follow when contracting for Headquarters and Headquarters field temporary services. We will issue policies and procedures for filling temporary casual labor positions in the near future.
