

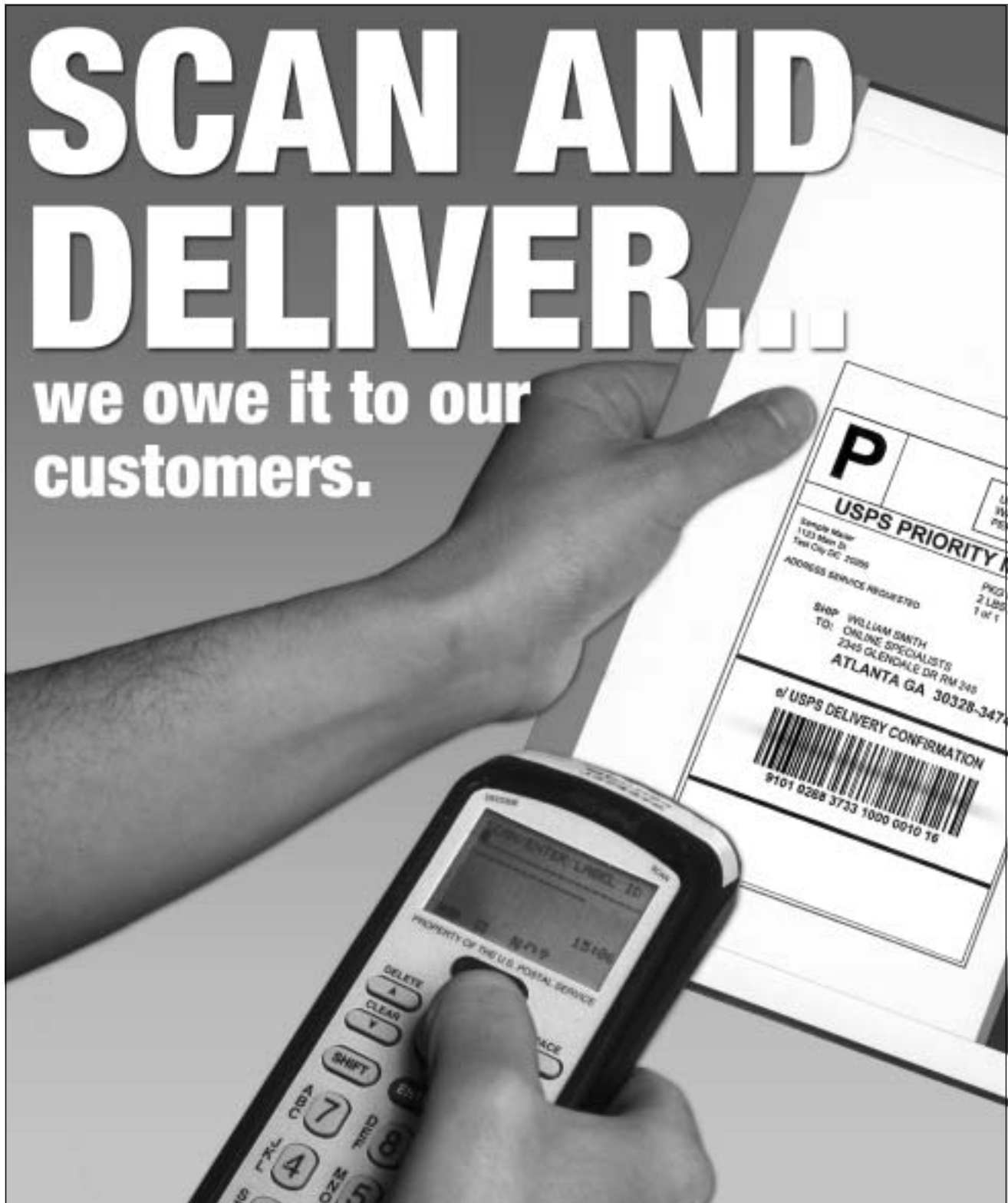

3-4 Standard Formats for Date and Time

3-4.1 Standard Format for Date — General

The Postal Service standard format for expressing calendar (and ordinal) dates for external date data exchange and internal date manipulations, calculations, and storage is MM/DD/YYYY. This format is based on the Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) Publication 4-1 for external date data exchange.

Two-digit year representations may be used where there is a need to conserve space and no potential for confusion (e.g., computer screens, forms, or reports).

3-4.2 Standard Formats for Date and Time Fields That Identify Changes to Data in Information Systems

Postal Service policy requires that each table in every database contain fields that automatically identify the date and time of the last change to the row. (See section 3-6 for policy). To conform to this policy, date and time must follow the format CCYYMMDDhhmmss, where:

- CC = first two digits of the calendar year.
- YY = last two digits of the calendar year.
- MM = month of the year.
- DD = day of the month.
- hh = hour of the day.
- mm = minute of the hour.
- ss = seconds of the minute.

Note: This requirement can be satisfied in Oracle and DB2 databases by specifying the DATE field type.

3-6 Identification of Date and Time of Changes to Data in Information Systems

3.6.1 Description

Information systems that include data fields that record the date and time that changes to data occur must follow a standard date and time format. This is to avoid the need for additional steps to process and verify data manually before it is forwarded to target databases or data marts.

3-6.2 Applicability

This requirement applies to all information systems designed, developed, replaced, purchased, or maintained by the Postal Service or by a company or an external group under contract with the Postal Service.

Exception: If a database was in operation before December 16, 2002, it may be brought into compliance when it is redesigned or replaced.

3.6.3 Use of Alternate Methods and Contact Information

The Enterprise Architecture and Standards organization in IT is responsible for approving or disapproving any exception to this policy, including use of alternate methods.

Ensuring Standardization of the Postal Service Computing Infrastructure

With the rollout of the Advanced Computing Environment (ACE) initiative, Information Technology (IT) is replacing all outdated computers in the Postal Service computing infrastructure with state-of-the-art, standardized equipment that will help make the computing environment more efficient and effective. IT is both deploying and funding the non-mail-processing core infrastructure hardware and software that will become the new standard for the enterprise.

The key objectives of this initiative are as follows:

- To upgrade, standardize, simplify, and centralize the Postal Service computing infrastructure components to better support the Postal Service's business needs.
- To realize substantial cost savings.

To achieve these objectives, we must ensure that the Postal Service is conducting its business using the ACE components that we are deploying — and *only* those components. This means that you must do the following:

- Remove computers that are being replaced from the infrastructure and do not redeploy them. Ongoing software, maintenance, and support costs for those outdated units far exceed the cost of the hardware. This outdated hardware additionally compromises the integrity of the standardized environment.

- Do not locally purchase desktop computers, laptops, flat-screen monitors, and servers — those purchases are no longer permitted. The exception to this is application-specific hardware and software that will continue to be funded by specific projects and must still conform to Postal Service standards.
- Coordinate local purchases of software or software licenses with your local IT representative to ensure the software is supported and approved.

TRACK & CONFIRM

Checking Delivery Status Online Is Made Easier

Starting on June 3, 2003, customers will find it even easier to check the delivery status of a mailpiece at the Track & Confirm site at www.usps.com.

At the Track & Confirm site, the customer can enter a label number and immediately receive a response. If the response indicates that there has been a delivery or delivery-related event, the customer may choose from two e-mail options:

- Have the Postal Service e-mail the current status of the shipment to as many as three e-mail addresses.
- Have the Postal Service e-mail future scan event information as it arrives to as many as three e-mail addresses.

In both options, the e-mail addresses may be the customer's own or those of other parties.

If the customer selects the e-mail update option, the Postal Service will generate future e-mails based on delivery or delivery-related events. The Postal Service will keep the update request open for 2 weeks.

Options for Obtaining Delivery Status of Certified Mail and Registered Mail Items

Effective May 20, 2003, customers can call 800-222-1811 to obtain the delivery status of their Certified Mail and Registered Mail items. The following revisions to the *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) reflect the inclusion of the "800" number and clarify the current options available to customers for retrieving the delivery status.

We will incorporate these revisions into the printed version of DMM 58 and into the monthly update of the online DMM available via Postal Explorer at <http://pe.usps.gov>.

NOTICE

Clarification of the Nonmachinable Surcharge for Shrubs and Trees

Each spring, people ask us questions about the mailability of shrubs and trees.

Nursery stock such as shrubs and trees completely enclosed in boxes or cartons are considered machinable. The required dimensions for machinable parcels, as described in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) C050.4, are as follows:

- Minimum 6 inches, maximum 34 inches in length.
- Minimum 3 inches, maximum 17 inches in height.
- Minimum ¼ inch, maximum 17 inches in thickness.
- Minimum 6 ounces, maximum 35 pounds in weight.

Shrubs and trees that are placed in plastic, vinyl, or paper bags (sealed or unsealed) are nonmachinable. Items that are nonmachinable have characteristics (such as inadequate packaging) that could result in damage to the contents, other parcels, or Postal Service machinery if mechanical sortation is used. These items require more costly manual sortation and therefore must be assessed the applicable nonmachinable surcharge. NEW FORM

PS Form 6014, Certification of Move Update Compliance

PS Form 6014, *Certification of Move Update Compliance*, was recently developed for use by third-party mailing agents, such as presort bureaus or letter shops, to ensure compliance with move update standards, which are noted in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E130.3 and E140.1. To qualify for First-Class Mail® service discounted rates, mailers must use an approved address-updating method to ensure that the addresses on the mailpieces are updated within 180 days of the date that the mailer submits the pieces to the Postal Service.

PS Form 6014 serves two purposes:

1. It advises the mailing agents' clients of the move update requirements.
2. It places the responsibility for meeting the move update requirements on the client, who accepts responsibility by signing the form. This protects the third-party agent in the event that the Postal Service must assess a revenue deficiency for noncompliance with the move update requirements.

The third-party agent retains the signed forms — the agent does *not* submit the forms to the Postal Service.

Overseas Military Mail

Mail addressed to military post offices overseas is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. The APO/FPO table below outlines these conditions by APO/FPO ZIP Codes through the use of footnoted mailing restrictions codes (see the Restrictions page following the table).

Acceptance clerks should use the table with the integrated retail terminal (IRT) or POS ONE terminal to determine which APO/FPO ZIP Codes are active and

which conditions of mailing apply. **Acceptance clerks may contact the Military Postal Service Agency with any questions regarding APO/FPO ZIP Codes, toll free, at 800-810-6098, Monday–Friday, 0730–1630.**

For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, all acceptance clerks must refer to the local hardcopy EMMS directory.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C024.1.1C. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM C024.2.0 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

42"	72" length and girth combined
over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth
	Maximum length 48"

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail items and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Employees

REMINDER

Federal Regulations on Soliciting and Fundraising

Federal regulations, including the Standards of Ethical Conduct and the Combined Federal Campaign rules, prohibit Postal Service employees from soliciting funds on Postal Service property, *except* in connection with the annual Combined Federal Campaign, or as an authorized activity of an official Postal Service employee recreation and benefit organization. Otherwise, while on duty, in uniform, or on Postal Service property, employees may not request donations for charitable causes, or sell or take orders for candy, cookies, cosmetics, gift wrap, pizza, or any other merchandise or service, regardless of whether the solicitation is for profit or for the benefit of a charitable organization.

Employees may engage in fundraising *only* while off-the-clock and off Postal Service premises, subject to the following broad restrictions:

- An employee may not target a solicitation to subordinates, even if the solicitation is conducted in his or her personal capacity.

- An employee may not solicit funds from persons who have interests that may be affected by the Postal Service (e.g., vendors, contractors, mailing industry associations, customers).
- An employee may not use or permit the use of his or her official title, position, or authority to promote any fundraising effort or non-Postal Service business activity.
- An employee may not use Postal Service property or equipment, such as copiers, fax machines, e-mail, or telephones, in connection with soliciting charitable donations or conducting any kind of commercial activity.

ICM UPDATES

International Customized Mail

We have combined ICM updates into one *Postal Bulletin* article to save space and paper. 9 ICM updates appear here.

On April 29, 2003, the Postal Service entered into an International Customized Mail (ICM) Service Agreement with a Qualifying Mailer. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 297.4, the Postal Service now makes public the following information concerning the Agreement:

- a. **Term:** May 13, 2003, through May 12, 2004.
- b. **Type of mail:** Global Express Mail™ (EMS). Every item must conform to the mailing requirements set forth in the IMM for EMS.
- c. **Destination countries:** Worldwide.
- d. **Service provided by the Postal Service:** The Postal Service has agreed to transport EMS to international destinations for delivery by the appropriate authorities.
- e. **Minimum volume commitments:** The Mailer has agreed to meet an annualized minimum commitment of 600 pieces of EMS.

On April 29, 2003, the Postal Service amended an International Customized Mail (ICM) Service Agreement dated May 31, 2002. The Agreement was published on page 17 of *Postal Bulletin* 22079 (6-27-02). The Amendment modifies the term of the Agreement. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 297.4, the Postal Service previously announced entering into an International Customized Mail Service Agreement with this qualifying mailer and now makes public the following information regarding this Amendment:

 - 7. Pay for any requested harmonization at a rate of \$250 per hour.
 - 8. Pay fees for the return of EMS items and Airmail Parcel Post items receiving Customs Pre-Payment, whether refused by an addressee or undeliverable, at the fees listed in Exhibit 1.
- g. Rates:** The Mailer has agreed to pay postage for Qualifying Mail according to the rate charts in Exhibit 2.

On April 24, 2003, the Postal Service amended an International Customized Mail (ICM) Service Agreement dated November 15, 2001. The Agreement was published on page 27 of *Postal Bulletin* 22068 (1-24-02). The Amendment modifies the rates for Rest of World Labeling. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 297.4, the Postal Service previously announced entering into an International Customized Mail Service Agreement with this Qualifying Mailer and now makes public the following information regarding this Amendment:

- a. **Term:** November 15, 2001, through October 31, 2003.
- b. **Type of mail:** *All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force.*
- c. **Destination countries:** *All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force.*
- d. **Service provided by the Postal Service:** *All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force.*
- e. **Minimum volume commitments:** *All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force.*
- f. **Worksharing:** *All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in force.*
- g. **Rates:** The Mailer will pay postage for all Qualifying Mail according to the rate charts in Exhibit 1.

The Postal Service will issue the nondenominated (25-cent value) *American Eagle* Presorted First-Class Mail® stamps in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) coil of 10,000 (Item 782100) on June 26, 2003, in Santa Clara, California. The stamps, designed by Tom Engeman, Brunswick, Maryland, go on sale nationwide June 27, 2003.

These Presorted First-Class Mail coil stamps feature an artistic rendering of a detail of the Great Seal of the United States. In his 1782 design, Charles Thomson, secretary of the Continental Congress, gave prominence to the American bald eagle. This majestic raptor, a native of North America, became a symbol of freedom as well as the emblem of our country. The designs for the stamps feature the head and outstretched right wing of the American bald eagle and a portion of the shield is on its breast, with the tip of the olive branch held in its right talon. The coil has 10 versions of the eagle — in gold, green, blue, red, and gray — that appear against a background of a contrasting color.

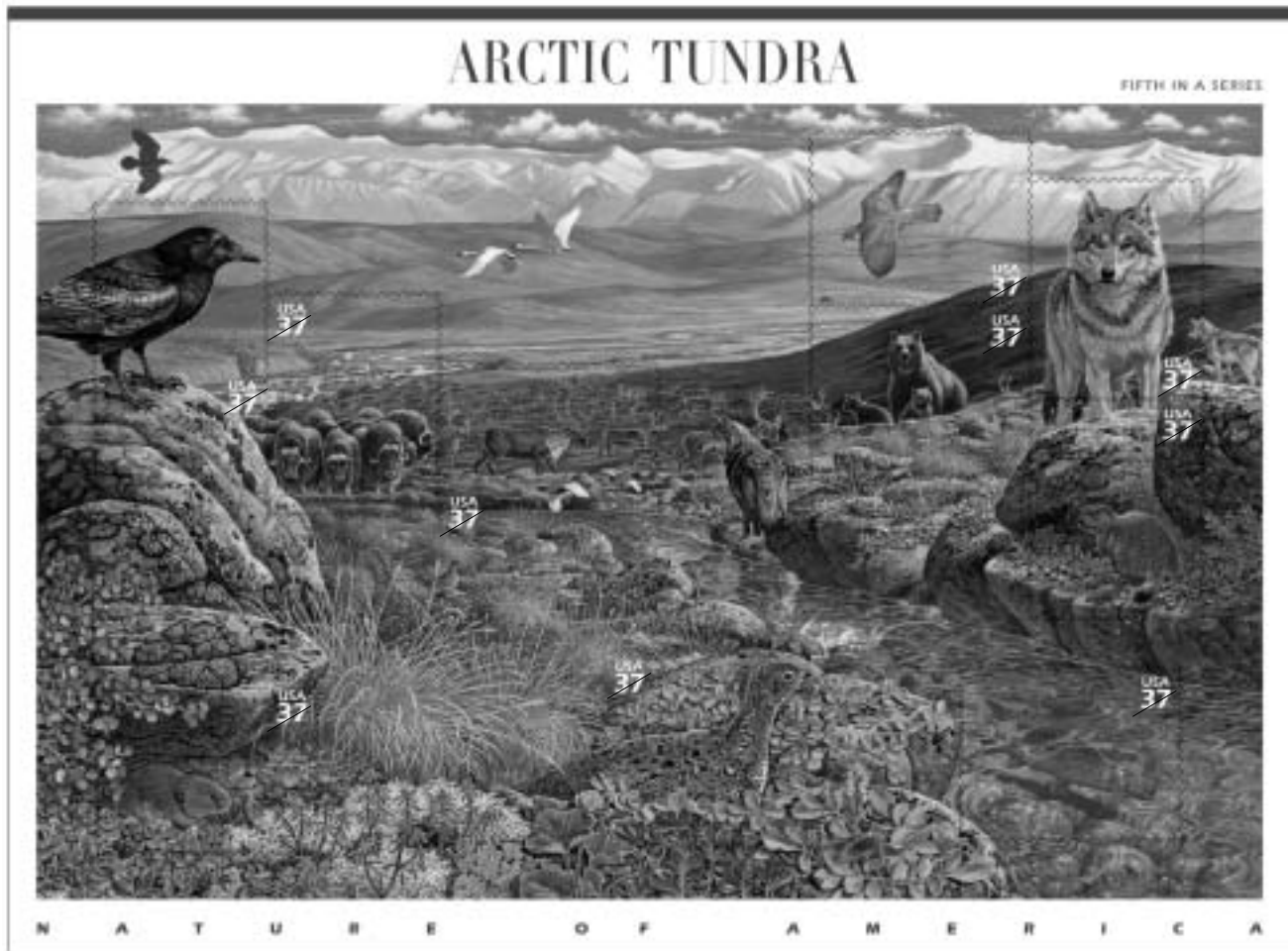

Arctic Tundra Stamps

The Postal Service will issue a souvenir sheet of the 37-cent *Arctic Tundra* stamps (Item 454500) on July 3, 2003, in Fairbanks, Alaska. The stamps, designed by Ethel Kessler, Bethesda, Maryland, and illustrated by John D. Dawson, Hilo, Hawaii, go on sale nationwide July 4, 2003. The souvenir sheet may not be split, and the stamps may not be sold individually.

The *Arctic Tundra* stamps are the fourth in an educational series designed to promote appreciation of North America's major plant and animal communities. The previous issuances in the *Nature of America* series were the *Sonoran Desert* (1999), *Pacific Coast Rain Forest* (2000), *Great Plains Prairie* (2001), and *Longleaf Pine Forest* (2002).

Coldest of the North American ecosystems, the Arctic tundra is a vast treeless region stretching across northern Alaska and Canada. There the soil is permanently frozen

except for the surface layer, thawed by the summer sun, where plants take root. The frozen soil, or permafrost, keeps the surface layer moist by preventing water from seeping deeply into the ground. Summer days in the Arctic are long, but the growing season is short. Arctic plants have adapted to survive the cold and wind. Most grow close to the ground, many are evergreen, and all are frost hardy. Although there are no trees on the tundra, other plants flourish there: shrubs and herbs (nonwoody plants), sedges and grasses, lichens, and mosses.

The Arctic tundra provides habitat for diverse fauna, including mammals, birds, insects, and fish. Large mammals such as the musk ox, grizzly bear, and gray wolf are tundra inhabitants. The tundra serves as the calving grounds for caribou and also provides nesting sites for many species of migratory birds.

The stamp pane depicts an autumn tundra scene in the northern foothills of the majestic Brooks Range in Alaska. A description of the Arctic tundra and a numbered key to the artwork appear on the back of the pane, along with a corresponding list of common and scientific names for the 24 species.

Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamps

The \$15 *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamp for the 2003–2004 season goes on sale at Post Offices nationwide July 1, 2003, and is valid through June 30, 2004. The Department of the Interior will formally issue the stamp at the National Postal Museum in Washington, DC, on July 1, 2003.

The *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamp will be issued in two formats — the traditional gummed pane of 20 stamps (Item 332700) and a self-adhesive single stamp (Item 333000). The stamp in the self-adhesive version is the same size as in the gummed version and can be peeled from its carrier sheet. The carrier sheet is the size of U.S. paper currency and fits easily in cash drawers. *Postmasters should order enough of Items 332700 and 333000 to meet the expected demand for this item by stamp collectors, conservationists, and hunters.*

Distribution*Post Offices*

To allow postmasters to order the 2003–2004 *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamps in quantities approximating customer demand, there is no minimum ordering quantity for either format. Postmasters should review their previous year's sales records to determine the appropriate number of the 2003–2004 stamps to requisition.

Postmasters must immediately send a separate PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition/Stamp Return*, to their stamp distribution offices (SDOs) for enough *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamps to last until February 29, 2004. Post Offices served by stamp service centers must follow their established ordering guidelines.

If the initial stamp supply is exhausted before February 29, 2004, postmasters must requisition additional quantities. Retail units with authorized philatelic centers should order both formats and have them available to meet philatelic demand. All postmasters and station managers must ensure that *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamps are available to meet public demand.

Stamp Distribution Offices

SDOs will receive automatic distributions of both Item 332700 and Item 333000, *Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation* stamps. Automatic distributions to SDOs are scheduled to begin May 1, 2003, and complete May 29, 2003. SDOs must not distribute stamps to Post Offices before June 23, 2003.

SDOs requiring additional gummed stamps (Item 332700) or additional self-adhesive stamps (Item 333000) must requisition them from the designated accountable paper depository using PS Form 17.

Hunting Regulations Pamphlets

The Department of the Interior does not automatically distribute pamphlets on hunting regulations because migratory game bird laws vary by state. Direct all inquiries about hunting regulations to the state fish and wildlife agency or state department of natural resources. Do not forward to the federal U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary Post Office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*





All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for cancellation may not include


postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.


Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for cancellation, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

The New Color of Money

The Bureau of Engraving and Printing (BEP), Department of the Treasury, unveiled the 2004 design for the new \$20 bill on May 13, 2003. It will be released into circulation sometime in September of this year. The new bill includes increased security features to deter counterfeiting and added background colors. You can obtain more information from the BEP on their Web site at www.moneyfactory.com/newmoney.

The latest currency changes will require a reprofiling of the vending machine bill acceptors to accept the new bills in addition to all previous bills already in circulation. Self Service and Access Management is preparing for this reprofile and will be forwarding information and schedules as soon as vendors have their processes complete. We anticipate this effort beginning before the first week of July.

*REMINDER***Securing Registry/Accountable Cages**

All postmasters and Postal Service employees are responsible for following current policies and procedures concerning registry/accountable cages.

Review Handbook DM-901, *Registered Mail*, and pay particular attention to section 72, Protection, which outlines the requirements concerning registry mail activities.

Use PS Form 1625, *Record of Entry-Registry Section*, to keep a daily record of all employees working in the registry cage.

*REMINDER***Key Accountability**

Postmasters must keep an accurate inventory of all building keys and signed receipts for all assigned keys. Use PS Form 1628, *Individual Key Record*, to obtain signed receipts when keys are assigned.

You must conduct semiannual physical inventories on all building keys. Pay particular attention to master keys, exterior entrance keys, and special keys such as those for the registry cages, stamped envelope rooms, and employee record rooms.

EBUY UPDATE

Forwarding Off-Catalog Requisitions to Supply Management

Since 2001, the approval and routing of "on-catalog" purchases have been done through eBuy, the Postal Service's web-based, self-service requisitioning process. Effective January 11, 2003, those with access to the Postal Service Intranet are required to enter "off-catalog" requisitions into eBuy as well. This process will replace the requirement to complete and print hard copies of PS Form 7381, *Requisition for Supplies, Services, or Equipment*.

eBuy users can choose to electronically route off-catalog requisitions to category management centers (CMCs) and purchasing service centers (PSCs) by one of two methods: either via ad hoc approval or by e-mail. Either method will reduce manual transactions and move the Supply Management organization toward the corporate goal of establishing a paperless requisition process.

To obtain documents outlining the two methods for off-catalog requisition routing, go to <http://blue.usps.gov/purchase> and click the "e-Req" icon (which soon will be available). **Please note that it is important for you to read all of the documents in order to fully understand the off-catalog requisition routing process.**

You should contact your district or area eBuy representative to receive a logon ID and password. If you have access to the Postal Service Intranet, you can obtain a list of your district or area eBuy representatives as follows:

From Internet Explorer (version 5.0 or higher), go to the blue page at <http://blue.usps.gov> and type "ebuy" in the address line and then hit the Return key. (The direct URL is <http://ebuy.usps/jsp.gov/co/Login.jsp>; note that this URL is case sensitive). Once at the eBuy Welcome page, click *Administrative Points of Contact*.

If you do not have access to the Intranet, you should continue processing your requisitions as you have been, per your individual office procedures using Form 7381, *Requisition for Supplies, Services, or Equipment*.

POW-MIA Flags



We're in the annual cycle of displaying the POW-MIA flag at Postal Service facilities on the following 6 specific days:

- Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May
- Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
- Flag Day, June 14
- Independence Day, July 4
- National POW-MIA Recognition Day, the third Friday in September
- Veterans Day, November 11

Note: If any of these days fall on a nonbusiness day, Postal Service facilities are required to display the POW-MIA flag on the last business day before the designated day.

The flag and its display at our facilities honor the sacrifices made by members of the armed forces held as prisoners of war or missing in action. Use the information below to order POW-MIA flags.

Ordering Instructions

In compliance with the law requiring the display of POW-MIA flags, the Material Distribution Center offers the following sizes of flags, which it orders from the General Services Administration.

Order a POW-MIA flag based on the size of your United States flag.

Note: You must be registered to use TTOE. To register, call 800-332-0317, Option 1, extension 2925, and follow the prompts to leave a message (wait 48 hours after registering before placing your first order).
- **E-mail:** Complete PS Form 7380, *MDC Supply Requisition* (manually or using F3Fill), and send it as an attachment to the e-mail address *MDC, Customer Service* or to *mcustome@email.usps.gov*.
