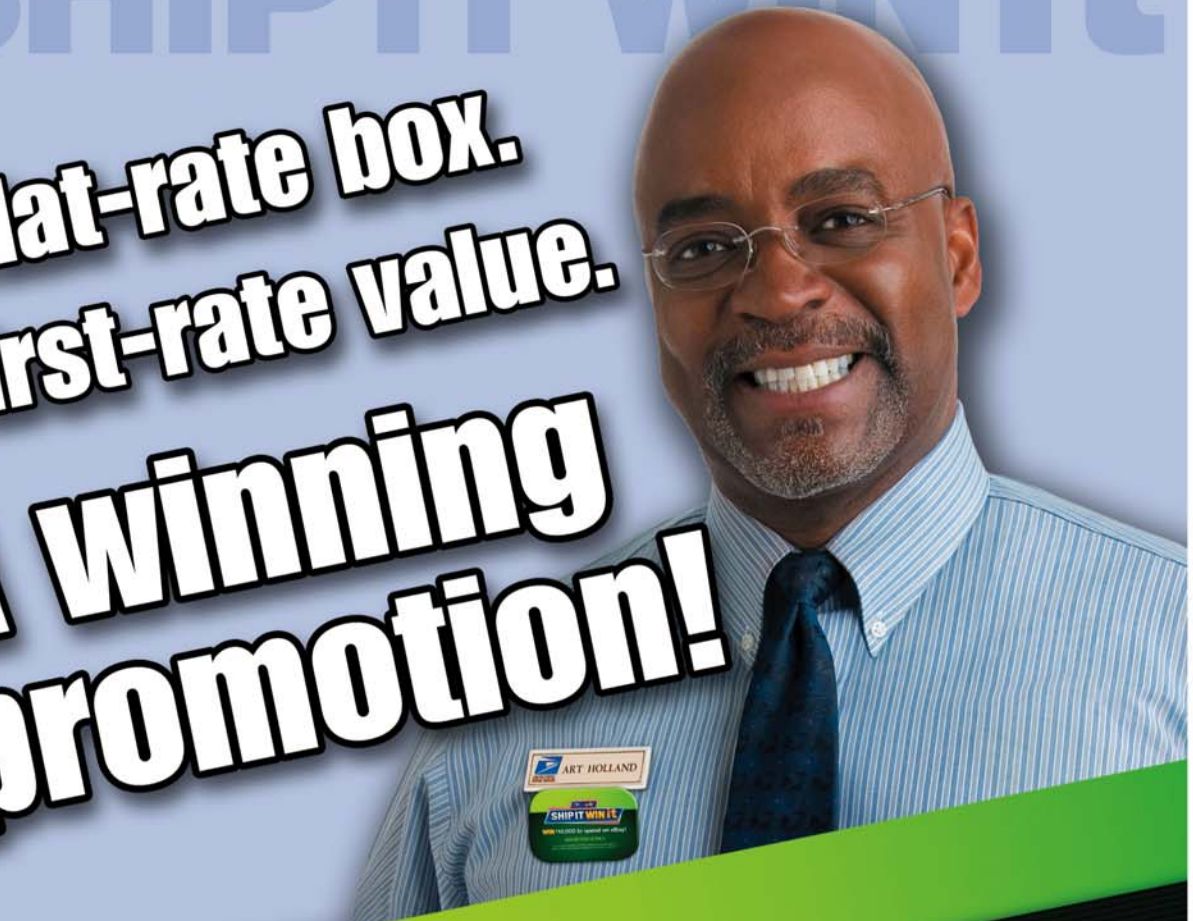

It’s estimated that on average the shoe box will ship for between \$4.05 and \$6.05 coast to coast.

A bountiful reception: Letter carrier holds wedding reception at local food bank

Walnut Creek, CA, Letter Carrier Margie Louise Garcia and Brentwood Post Office Clerk Geary Lee Baria tied the knot at the Contra Costa Food Bank in Concord, CA, recently.

Her wedding invitations — specially designed small brown paper bags — reminded people to bring food for the hungry. Food donations from the wedding guests totaled 1,252

pounds — enough to feed 1,100 people, according to food bank staff.

Garcia has been the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) food drive coordinator for the Walnut Creek Post Office for the past five years. She saw her wedding as a perfect opportunity to kick off the annual NALC Food Drive this May.

On May 13, communities rallied around their Post Offices to help stock local food banks for the coming months. Letter carriers across the country collected food donations along their routes and returned to their offices where clerks, mail handlers, custodians, supervisors and volunteers helped sort and separate everything for local food banks — and tractor-trailer operators helped transport it from there.

This was the 14th year for the drive, which has collected nearly 700 million pounds of food.

Rising costs are behind price adjustment filing: Mail still a bargain, price changes at or below inflation

Like most Americans, you’re probably feeling the pinch at the fuel pump — and when you pay your household heat

and electric bills. Not to mention ever-increasing health care costs.

It's the same for the Postal Service. That's why we've filed for price adjustments to take effect next year, including a 3-cent increase in the price of a First-Class Mail stamp. Price changes will vary for other postal products and services. But even with adjustments, the U.S. Mail is still a great bargain.

Postmaster General Jack Potter noted the price of a First-Class Mail stamp has increased at rates lower than or equal to inflation since today's Postal Service began operations in 1971 — while the cost of gasoline has doubled since the last USPS operational rate adjustment in 2002.

While other delivery services have responded to growing costs with fuel and other surcharges along with annual rate increases, USPS doesn't have the same flexibility as other businesses. The price you see is the price you pay, without extra fees tacked on.

The estimated cost of the proposed price adjustments for the average household is well below \$6 annually, about 50 cents a month.

5-Star Customer Service Awards announced



Retail Associate Judy Hamel and her co-workers know customer service is important — the Wakefield Post Office has won the 5-Star Customer Service Award for the second straight time.

Eight performance clusters and 571 Post Offices earned recognition for their quarter 2 customer service efforts.

Six clusters — Boston, Capital, Northern New Jersey, Northern Virginia, Massachusetts and Southeast New England — and more than 300 Post Offices are repeat winners. Two

clusters — Long Island and Maine — are first-time winners.

Under the 5-Star program, clusters and offices are rated on a combination of residential and small business Customer Satisfaction Measurement (CSM) survey questions — clerk information, clerk efficiency, delivery accuracy, delivery time of day and Mystery Shopper wait-time-in-line score. If a Post Office doesn't have a Mystery Shopper score, CSM-residential/small business wait-time-in-line scores are used.

Winning clusters receive a crystal star. Winning Post Offices receive a door cling and employees in those offices receive lapel pins.

named in his memory.

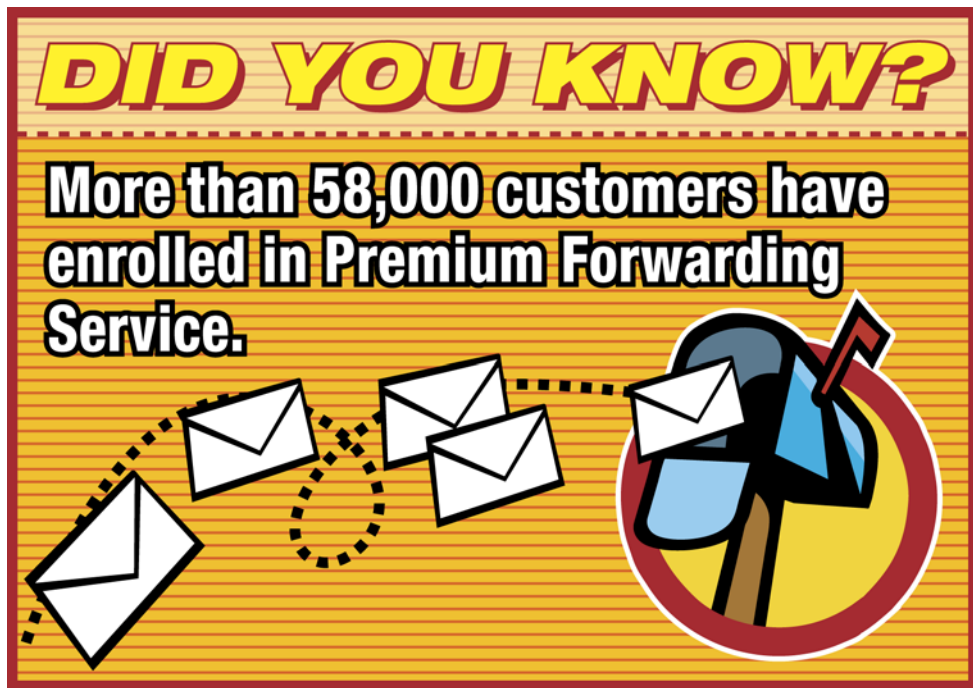

ELM REVISION

Occupational Safety and Health Programs

Effective June 1, 2006, the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), 810, 820, 850, and the Appendix are revised to reflect changes in Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) regulations and Postal Service™ policies. Many of the revisions are not significant: these include changes in section titles and organization names as well as improvements in grammar or style. Other changes are due to new or revised federal requirements. Many changes incorporate new technology, such as the Safety Toolkit, an online resource used to manage safety programs.

Because these parts of the ELM are completely revised, we are publishing a summary of the revisions in this article.

Summary of Changes to the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM)

810, Occupational Safety and Health Program, is revised to add (1) the Voluntary Protection Program process and other innovative safety activities; (2) Accident

Reduction Plan (ARP) responsibilities; (3) district support for Facility Safety Coordinators (FSCs); (4) FSC use of the Safety Toolkit; (5) reference to PS 8214, *Certificate of OSHA, Safety, and Environmental Records Transfer*; and (6) revised safety training, including Aviation Mail Security training.

820, Reports and Investigations, Program Evaluations, and Inspections, is revised to (1) remove language related to “overlapping Postal Service and OSHA requirements” and Human Resources Information System (HRIS) accident reporting; (2) include new language on OSHA reporting requirements and postal accident reporting systems; (3) update accident analysis requirements; (4) clarify procedures for reporting serious accidents and reporting to OSHA; (5) clarify procedures for cooperation with OSHA investigations; (6) discuss how to use the *Safety Toolkit* to prepare ARPs and Hazard Abatement Plans and conduct inspections and other activities; (7) add labor-agreement language on “regular staff meetings” in smaller facilities; and (8) clarify language on OSHA inspections and citations.

850, Emergency Action Plans and Fire Prevention and Control, is revised to add information about (1) revised OSHA emergency standards; (2) Homeland Security requirements; (3) the Office of Emergency Preparedness; (4) “incidental releases” of hazardous materials; (5) shelter-in-place planning; (6) using volunteers in emergency evacuation teams; and (7) alarm requirements for audible and visible signals.

Appendix, Records Control Schedules, Introduction and Safety (32–43), are revised to reflect changes in records management and retention requirements and to correct references.

ELM REVISION

Equivalent Grades Chart

Effective May 25, 2006, *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), Exhibit 418.1, Equivalent Grades, is revised to delete the column regarding rate schedule code (RSC) S, Postal Career Executive Service (PCES) Executives. This change is made because a PCES level 01 has been deemed not equivalent to an Executive and Administrative Schedule (EAS) (RSC E) level 26.

The chart describes how different grades are related between pay schedules. The human resources computer system [Complement Management System (CMS) or Human Capital Enterprise System (HCES)] is programmed with this information to generate the appropriate nature of action (NOA) code on PS Form 50, *Notification of Personnel Action*, when an employee is approved for reassignment into a new pay schedule.

418.1 Equivalent Grades

When an employee is reassigned, reduced in grade, promoted, or otherwise permanently or temporarily changed to a position in another salary schedule, see Exhibit 418.1 for grades that are equivalent for pay purposes. This chart determines the appropriate nature of action (NOA) triggered when processing a PS Form 50, *Notification of Personnel Action*. Special salary handling during an involuntary reduction in grade involving bargaining unit employees is performed in accordance with the applicable collective bargaining agreement.

Lateral reassignment to an equivalent grade.

Promotion.

Reduction in grade (change to lower level).

The number of lines on the chart between the old grade and the new grade is considered to be the number of grades changed for the purpose of calculating promotions or reductions in grade.

Response to Hazardous Materials Releases

Management Instruction (MI) EL-810-2006-3, *Response to Hazardous Materials Releases*, is now available. This MI is effective immediately and obsoletes MI EL-810-96-1. The MI has been aligned with policy and procedures on suspicious mail and unknown powders or substances and Inspection Service Dangerous Mail Investigation procedures. The concept of “incidental” versus “emergency” releases and the appropriate response to each are stated more clearly. The term “spill and leak” is retained, but to align with OSHA regulatory language, the MI uses the term “releases” more often. The new MI also documents organizational changes, additional training courses, and updated references to regulations (including Aviation Mail Security policies).

REVISED FORM

PS Form 1013, Transportation Ticketing Authorization

PS Form 1013, *Transportation Ticketing Authorization*, May 2006, has been revised. The changes to the form are as follows:

- The Social Security number (SSN) was replaced with the employee identification number (EIN). This change will protect the Postal Service™ traveler’s privacy and allow for online booking using centrally billed cards. The EIN will replace the SSN on PS Form 1013 for travel after June 18, 2006.
- A field was added to identify the purpose of travel. Nonbargaining travelers are not allowed to use the centrally billed travel card unless their individually billed card enrollment form has been recently sent to the card provider and card activation is not possible before the travel date. In addition to the purpose, nonbargaining travelers must provide the date their individually billed travel card enrollment was sent to the card provider.
- The Sub-Location Code was replaced with HQ/Area/District. The office issuing the ticket must complete the name of the facility issuing the ticket. The name

of the facility helps the booking agent charge the correct centrally billed account.

Starting on June 4, 2006, Facility Access and Shipment Tracking (FAST) will become the owner of the ZIP content identifier number (CIN) file and CIN List file via a new sub-system of FAST. This sub-system, the Drop Entry Point System (DEPS), in conjunction with the other files of the Drop Ship Product (DSP), will provide the information necessary to identify drop entry points required for desired discounts.

FAST will also store the remaining three DSP files. USPS® will no longer provide the DSP via CD subscription; rather, you will access FAST at <https://fast.usps.com> and download these files for free:

- Address File — USPS facility address and telephone information.
- Supplemental Site File — Dock information, processing hours, and directions to the drop ship facilities.

- Parcel File — Facility information that identifies the drop ship facility for ZIP Codes™ split by carrier route based on the majority of city carriers rule for parcels.
- ZIP CIN File — ZIP Codes, carrier routes, CIN, drop ship carrier sequence barcode sorter (CSBCS) discount codes, and drop site key for additional discounts; soon to be the new DEPS mail direction file.

The Postal Service™ will issue a 39-cent *Judy Garland* commemorative stamp in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 459400) on June 10, 2006, in Zankel Hall at Carnegie Hall in New York, New York. The stamp, designed by Ethel Kessler of Bethesda, Maryland, goes on sale nationwide June 11, 2006.

With this 12th stamp in the *Legends of Hollywood* series, the U.S. Postal Service® honors Judy Garland, considered by many to be one of the greatest entertainers of the 20th century.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail items and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Displaying the U.S. Flag and the POW-MIA Flag

U.S. Flag at Half-Staff

How to Display

Displaying the U.S. flag at *half-staff* means lowering the flag to half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.



Specific Dates

Display the U.S. flag at half-staff on the following days each year:

- May 15: Peace Officers Memorial Day (see note 1 below).
- Last Monday in May: Memorial Day Observed (see note 2 below).
- December 7: National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.

Note 1: When May 15, which is the date for Peace Officers Memorial Day, falls on the third Saturday in May, which is the date for Armed Forces Day, display the U.S. flag in the full-staff position, *not* at half-staff.

Note 2: On the last Monday in May, when Memorial Day is observed, display the flag at half-staff from sunrise, or the hour at which you raise it, until 12 noon, and then hoist it to the peak of the staff, until the time of closing or no later than sunset.

POW-MIA Flag

How to Display

In relation to the U.S. flag, display the POW-MIA flag (and any other flag) as follows:

- If displayed on the same flagstaff, place it below the U.S. flag.
- If displayed on a separate flagstaff, place it at the same level or lower. If displayed at the same level, place it on the U.S. flag's left.

When flying the U.S. flag at half-staff, fly the POW-MIA flag (and any other flags) at half-staff also.



Specific Dates

Display the POW-MIA flag on the following days each year:

- Armed Forces Day: Third Saturday in May.
- Memorial Day: Last Monday in May.
- Flag Day: June 14.
- Independence Day: July 4.
- National POW-MIA Recognition Day: Third Friday in September.
- Veterans Day: November 11.

If any of these days fall on a nonbusiness day, display the POW-MIA flag on the last business day before the designated day.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the postmark, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Vending Machines Removed From Service

Effective immediately, PSM 53C-MOD (Model Code 119) and PSM 53D (Model Code 118) vending machines in non-sales or non-training locations are to be removed from service (MRS) so parts can be used to repair machines still in use in sales locations.

The coin hopper installed in the PSM 53 series (53, 53B, 53C, all obsolete) and in the two current models, PSM 53C-MOD and PSM 53D, is no longer available. In order to keep PSM 53C-MOD and PSM 53D machines currently being used in sales locations operational, all 53 series models in warehouses must be disassembled and the parts sent to the Material Distribution Center (MDC). If either of these models is removed from service, it can **not** be redeployed. The parts must be “harvested” for use in active sales models.

Because of the urgent need for these parts, Headquarters (HQ) is asking self-service postal center (SSPC) technicians to remove certain parts from the obsolete machines and current MRS models in warehouses in their vending territories. The Field Maintenance office will have to harvest parts from machines in warehouses in areas not serviced by an SSPC technician.

The following parts (all 53 series) must be harvested:

- NSN 3550-01-000-6532, Module, Master.
- NSN 3550-01-000-6533, Module, Slave.

- NSN 3550-01-000-7121, Coin Acceptor.
- NSN 3550-01-000-8980, Coin Changer.
- NSN 3660-02-000-7120, Coin Changer.
- NSN 3550-03-000-1857, Chassis Assy, w/Harness.
- NSN 5999-01-000-0537, PCB Assy, Program.

For 53C-MOD and 53D only, harvest NSN 3550-04-000-6935, Bill Validators.

Return the parts to the MDC using the Return Authorization Process. You will receive credits for certain returned parts. (See the article “How to Return Vending Machine Parts” below).

After warehoused machines have been cannibalized, the manager in charge must notify the district Retail offices so they can deactivate the machines in their Web VARS warehouses. The districts must then e-mail Deborah Gyaki at deborah.gyaki@usps.gov that the machines have been deactivated so HQ can delete them from Web VARS.

Any remaining parts and the machine housing must be disposed of locally by the district material management specialist. Recycling is recommended.

How to Return Vending Machine Parts

For used parts from existing equipment, return the reusable or repairable parts removed from machines to the Material Distribution Center (MDC) via the Central Repair Facility (CRF) NRFI Return Process for Returning Repairable Items. For information on the return process, go to <http://www.mtsc.usps.gov>, enter “MMO-026-01” in the Search box, select “Only Bulletins-MMO” from the drop-down box, then click *Submit*. For more current return instructions, go to the CRF Web site at <http://crf.usps.gov>; click on *Main Directory*, then *ERP Frequently Asked Questions*, then *Click here to view the SOP*.

Note: Pay particular attention to item #13, which states: “Check the ‘Do not generate a one-for-one replacement’ box if you do **not** want TMDC to automatically send a

replacement for the item being returned. This option will be available only if the item is coded as a one-for-one item.”

For new parts currently in stock at warehouses, return them to the MDC using the Web-based return authorization system available to all sites with Intranet access. With your browser open, type in *emdims-webra*. Enter your FEDSTRIP number and the PSN of the items to be returned. 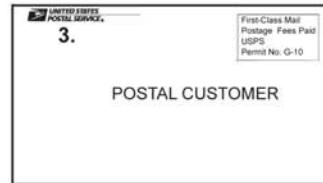
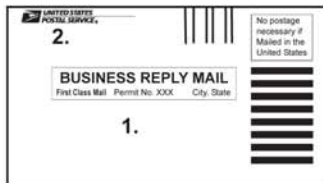

New Payment Process for Highway Contract Route Suppliers

Effective May 1, 2006, the Postal Service™ begins a new payment process to automatically pay its nearly 12,000 box delivery and transportation Highway Contract Route (HCR) suppliers. As a result, most of the manual data entry performed at the St. Louis Accounting Service Center (ASC) is eliminated. Instead of every 28 days, all suppliers will now be paid on the last business day of the month. Therefore, the first monthly payment will be made on Wednesday, May 31, 2006. A payment calendar is available at the Distribution Networks Contracting Offices and online at http://blue.usps.gov/purchase/_xls/tnp_pay_calendars.xls.

Effective June 1, 2006, on the first day of each month, administrative officials must certify all exceptional service performed during the previous month. Any exceptional service that has not yet been certified for the month of May must be certified and submitted to the ASC on June 1.

All exceptional contract service performed by HCR suppliers will be paid on a monthly basis via PS Form 5429, *Certification of Exceptional Contract Service Performed*. A revised PS Form 5429 should be available by the end of June 2006. Until that time, the current form can be used

and the obligation period should indicate the month and fiscal year. The actual pay month should be spelled out when recorded (e.g., January, February, March).

Effective May 1, the ASC is accepting new service codes, as follows:

- L = Late Slips
- C = Christmas
- P = Plant Load
- X = Automation Processing
- T = Terrorism
- N = Natural Disaster

These service codes will be listed on the revised PS Form 5429. Only the Distribution Networks Contracting Office (DNCO) can authorize an administrative official to use the Late Slips code (L). The DNCO will notify administrative officials when the Late Slips certification is authorized.
