Judy Garland honored on commemorative stamp

Fans of Judy Garland saw their dreams come true at Carnegie Hall, with the dedication of a postage stamp in her honor.

Garland's daughter Lorna Luft spoke at the ceremony. "Of all the honors accorded to my mother during her life and afterwards, this recognition ranks as one of the greatest," said Luft. "I can't think of a better place to unveil the stamp than at Carnegie Hall, site of her greatest performance."

Garland performed "Judy" at Carnegie Hall in 1961. The recording of her performance topped sales lists for 13 weeks and earned her five Grammy Awards.

April financial results released

USPS revenues of \$5.88 billion for April were \$58 million, or 1%, over plan and \$115 million, or 2%, more than April 2005. Expenses were virtually on plan, producing a net income of \$103 million before the monthly escrow allocation of \$250 million. After the escrow allocation, our financial position for April shifts to a net deficiency of \$147 million.

Total mail volume in April was 1.9% less than last year. Mail volumes in all major mail categories were below April 2005 levels. April 2006 had 25 delivery days and 20 business weekdays, while April 2005 had 26 delivery days and 21 business weekdays.

Year-to-date, net income before escrow allocation is \$1.66 billion, or \$186 million, over plan. Year-to-date, the net deficiency after escrow allocation is \$89 million.

Surface Visibility helps keep us on track

Surface Visibility allows the Postal Service to track individual handling units — trays, tubs and sacks — from origin to destination, by using a series of barcode scans.

It's like the old "the knee bone's connected to the thigh bone" song. Each scan builds on previous scans to help us track the mail. And since the scans are cross-referenced, the Surface Visibility system will let you know if you're trying to put a tray, sack or tub into a container where it doesn't belong. Or a container in the wrong trailer.

Surface Visibility — brought to USPS by Network Operations Management and Information Technology. It's changing the way we dispatch mail. Motor vehicle accident numbers hit the skids

The Postal Service is driving its accident rate down, literally. Motor vehicle accidents (MVAs) through April are down significantly compared with the same period last year. Five areas have reduced their MVAs. The top three are: Capital

Metro, down 10.2 percent; Eastern Area, down 9.5 percent; and Great Lakes Area, down 7.2 percent.

Safety training is obviously paying off. The number of MVA repeaters (drivers with three or more prior MVAs at the time of their last MVA) is down 32. For the fiscal year, 336 of our MVAs involved drivers with three or more prior MVAs. Not only are the accident repeaters driving safer, we're all driving smarter as well. The number of U-turn MVAs is down 27 and the number of Postal Service drivers failing to yield right-of-way in an MVA is down 74.

And we did all of this while adding 3.2 million miles to our total mileage. Outstanding!

Response and recovery contracts awarded



Decontamination services, demonstrated here by a volunteer employee during a biohazard alert test at the Dulles, VA, Processing and Distribution Center, are available through two vendors under a new USPS contract.

As part of our priority to protect employees, customers, operations and the mail, the Postal Service has awarded contracts to two vendors to supply response and recovery services during severe weather, disasters and other incidents of national significance that affect daily operations at USPS facilities.

Through the Office of Emergency Preparedness, and Supply Management, contracts were awarded to The Louis

Berger Group and Weston Solutions. The companies will provide response and recovery support such as debris and tree cleanup after hurricanes or tornados, identification and containment of potentially hazardous materials or situations and facility decontamination.

These contracts will be available on eBay by the end of August. Before then, facilities that need response and recovery services may place orders through Supply Management's Environmental and Maintenance, Repairs and Operations Center. DMM REVISION

Labeling Changes for Standard Mail Nonmachinable Letters, Periodicals Presort Letters, and Bound Printed Matter Irregular Parcels

Effective August 3, 2006, we are revising chapters 245, 465, 707, and 708 of the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to change the labeling standards for mixed area distribution center (ADC) trays of Standard Mail® nonmachinable letters and Periodicals presorted letters, and for mixed ADC sacks of Bound Printed Matter irregular parcels. The new standards will result in more efficient mail processing because we will handle outgoing working mail at consolidated facilities.

Mailers are encouraged to label according to these standards beginning August 3, but *must* comply with these changes no later than October 15, 2006.

PS Form 8165, Mail Fraud Report

PS Form 8165, *Mail Fraud Report*, may be completed by consumers who believe they have been victims of mail fraud and returned to their local Post Office™ for forwarding to the U.S. Postal Inspection Service. Because Postal Inspectors base mail fraud investigations on the number, substance, and pattern of complaints received by consumers against a person or organization, it is important that PS Forms 8165 be processed timely and accurately.

Currently, some Post Offices send PS Forms 8165 directly to their local Inspection Service offices and others forward the forms to the Inspection Service's Criminal Investigations Service Center, which handles the processing of all mail fraud complaints.

ELM REVISION

Essential Features of Leave Without Pay

Effective June 22, 2006, *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), 514.1, Essential Features (formerly Definitions), is revised to emphasize the essential features of leave without pay (LWOP) and to clarify that employees exempt from the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) must take LWOP in 1-day increments except when they are taking leave protected under the Family and Medical Leave Act.

514 Leave Without Pay

[Revise 514.1 to read as follows:]

514.1 Essential Features

Essential features of leave without pay (LWOP) are as follows:

- LWOP is an authorized absence from duty in a non-pay status.
- LWOP may be granted upon the employee's request and covers only those hours that the employee would normally work or for which the employee would normally be paid. FLSA-exempt employees must take LWOP in 1-day increments except when they are

taking leave protected under the Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA).

- LWOP is different from AWOL (absent without leave), which is a nonpay status due to a determination that no kind of leave can be granted either because (1) the employee did not obtain advance authorization, or (2) the employee's request for leave was denied.

SAFETY TIPS

Fourth of July and Summer Safety

“Ladies and gentlemen, start your engines.”

Not so fast, shipmates! Before you turn the key, always remember: “Safety first.”

Summer fun in the sun is in full swing, and strong emphasis on your safety is vital. Postal Service™ employees and their families will continue to drive great distances for work and to visit their families and friends. Swimming, boating, off-road driving, barbecuing, and fireworks are popular activities for the Fourth of July holiday. Whatever your plans, vigorously pursue and adopt a risk management plan before you get underway for the holiday celebration.

Exercise forethought and common sense when engaging in any activity. To meet the challenge of this Fourth of July holiday, keep in mind some safety hints to minimize risks and avoid death and injury:

- *Driving:* Here are some tips for highway trips:
 - If you are highway bound, make sure your vehicle is in excellent operating condition. Always carry a roadside emergency and first aid kit. Remember to bring extra water, especially in hot climates.
 - Put on a safety belt the first thing when you get in a car — it takes only 3 seconds. Putting on a safety belt is a simple habit and can make all the difference between walking away from a crash and being carried off on a stretcher.
 - Keep children safe. The back seat is the safest place for children to ride. All children must be protected with the correct safety equipment.
 - Don’t speed. Speeding reduces your ability to steer safely around curves or objects in the road.

You never know what's around that next corner — a deer, stalled car, or pedestrian in the roadway.

- Most importantly, don't drink and drive — and equally important, don't get into a vehicle with a driver who has been drinking.
- *Swimming:* Use common sense; swim where life-guards are present. They are trained to identify hazards and help you if you get into trouble. Never dive unless you know the depth of the water and what obstacles are below. Don't let a bad decision leave you paralyzed for life.
- *Boating:* Take a boating course, file a float plan, never exceed the boat's maximum capacity, wear a personal flotation device, keep an eye on the weather, and save the alcohol for later.
- *Off-road driving:* Get training before operating a vehicle or an all-terrain vehicle off-road. Start out slowly. Know your route so you can alter speed and be especially cautious in areas with limited visibility or poor road conditions. Maintain proper speed and wear personal protective equipment.
- *Barbecue safety:* Follow the manufacturer's instructions for lighting and extinguishing gas grills. There is

a right way and a wrong way. Postal Service employees and their families have been severely burned when gas buildups have caused explosions.

- *Fireworks:* The best advice: leave them to the professionals. If fireworks are legal in your area and you decide to light off a few, use caution! Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Careless use of fireworks can cause serious injury or death.
- *Heat:* When the heat is on, it may be harder to work safely. Drink water often. Dress lightly and choose fabrics that let moisture and heat escape. When possible, take breaks, move to a cooler area, or periodically change to lighter work.

Think before you act. Basic precautions for prevention of mishaps — while in the home, on the waterways, on the ball field, on the highway, and at work — will make this Fourth of July and summer a safe and happy one, and one which you will live to talk about.

Publication 342, USPS Anti-Money Laundering Program

We have issued Publication 342, *USPS Anti-Money Laundering Program*, which provides customers with information about the Postal Service's anti-money laundering compliance program and tips on making money order and Sure Money® transactions faster and easier. Household Diary Study

The Postal Service's Household Diary Study (HDS), conducted since 1987, provides information about the contents of the mail sent and received by U.S. households. The Postal Service™ uses this information to help understand why and how customers use the mail. The results are used to:

- Forecast mail volume.
- Plan marketing strategies.
- Provide information for rate-setting purposes.

The HDS is administered at Headquarters by the Office of Demand Forecasting and Economic Analysis, Finance. NuStats, the HDS survey research firm contractor since July 1999, conducts the interviews and collects and analyzes the HDS data throughout the year.

HDS is a two-stage survey. Stage 1 is the Household Interview. NuStats sends an advance letter, signed by the postmaster general, to a representative sample of U.S. households. This letter emphasizes the importance of the HDS and asks for participation. These sample households are contacted either by telephone or in person and asked about the mail they send and receive, their adoption and use of various communications' technologies, their attitudes about mail service in general, and information relating to their household and personal demographics. Those respondent households are recruited to participate in HDS Stage 2.

Stage 2 is the Mail Diary. NuStats asks households that agree to participate in Stage 2 to record information about the mail they send and receive for a 7-day period from Monday to Sunday. Information recorded includes number

of mailpieces received and sent, industry mail source, mail characteristics, and attitudes regarding mail received. As an incentive for HDS Stage 2 participation, households are offered the options of receiving \$30 or a roll of 100 First-Class Mail® stamps.

Customers who participate in Stage 2 of the HDS can expect to receive their incentive about 2 months after they return the diary packet to NuStats.

Data gathered in both HDS stages is available in a final report, *The Household Diary Study — Mail Use and Attitudes*. The report is published in hard copy and a free electronic file. 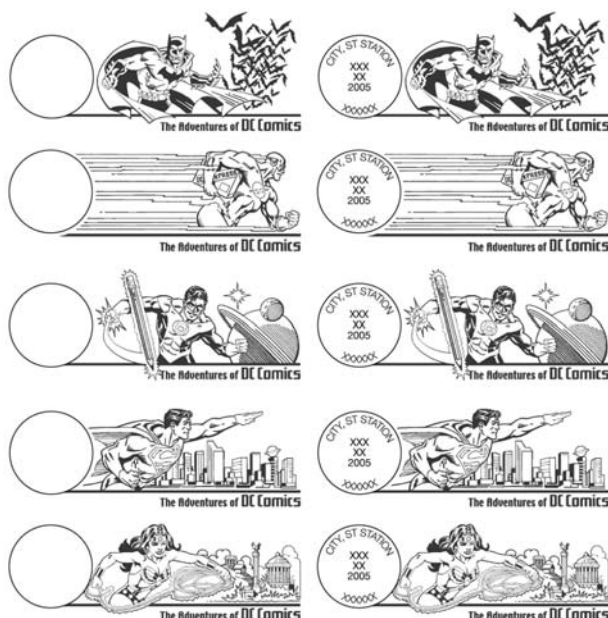

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail items and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No 0817E or 0818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

OPM has no connection with, nor responsibility for, any other life insurance product, whether or not it is represented as "supplemental" to the FEGLI Program.

- ***Aren't connected to FEGLI or the MetLife unit processing claims for deceased employees.***

The FEGLI Program does not use sales agents or telephone solicitations of any kind. No one from the FEGLI Program or OFEGLI will ever contact employees at their worksite (or at home) in person or by phone to sell life insurance. If agents are trying to sell life insurance to employees, they are most assuredly *not* connected with the FEGLI Program.

Premiums for FEGLI coverage are withheld from employees' salaries. FEGLI premiums are not withheld through voluntary allotments. A request from a life insurance company to set up a voluntary allotment from an employee's pay means that the life insurance product is not connected in any way with the FEGLI Program.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those postmarks that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the postmark, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

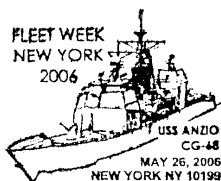
Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP+4 code).

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

*INSTALLATION HEADS/MAOs***Semiannual Review of Capital Records**

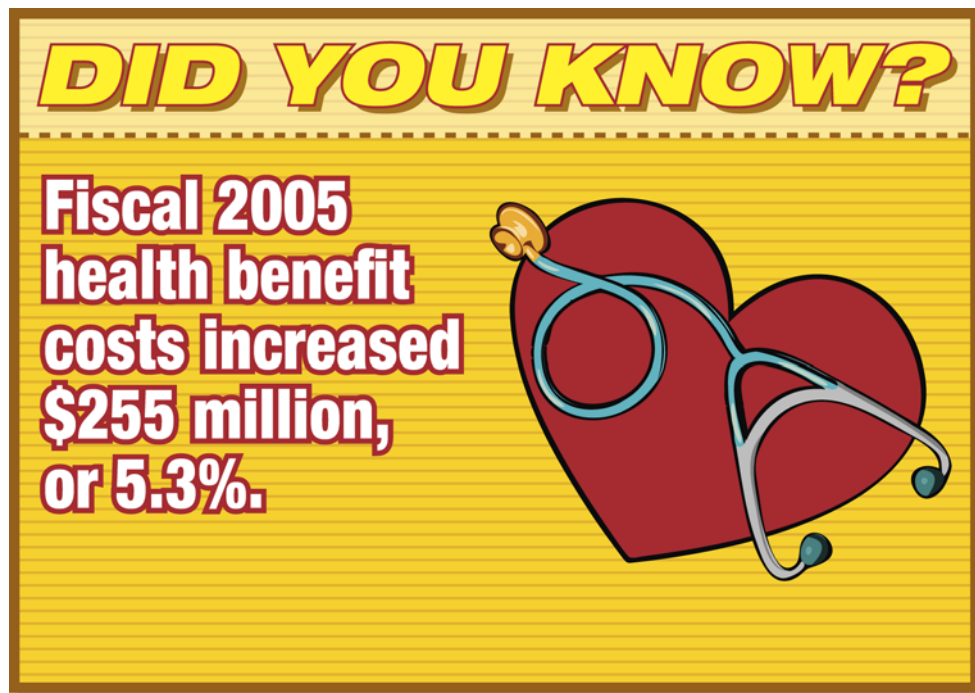
Handbook AS-701, *Material Management*, Section 541.28, Internal Reviews, contains procedures for conducting a semiannual review of capital records. The procedures require either the installation head or material accountability officer (MAO) to conduct a semiannual internal review and an evaluation of the status of property records and files.

If you are an installation head or MAO, you must complete the review and evaluation process by following these steps:

- Meet with delegated MAO assistants (if you have them) and discuss the material accountability background of the installation.

- Review the local standard operating procedures.
- Randomly select and inventory 10 percent of capital items and 10 percent of sensitive items.
- Review files and records to verify that they are being maintained in accordance with procedures outlined in Handbook AS-701, Chapter 5, Asset Accountability.
- Review the past six property changes for the month to ensure they have been properly verified.
