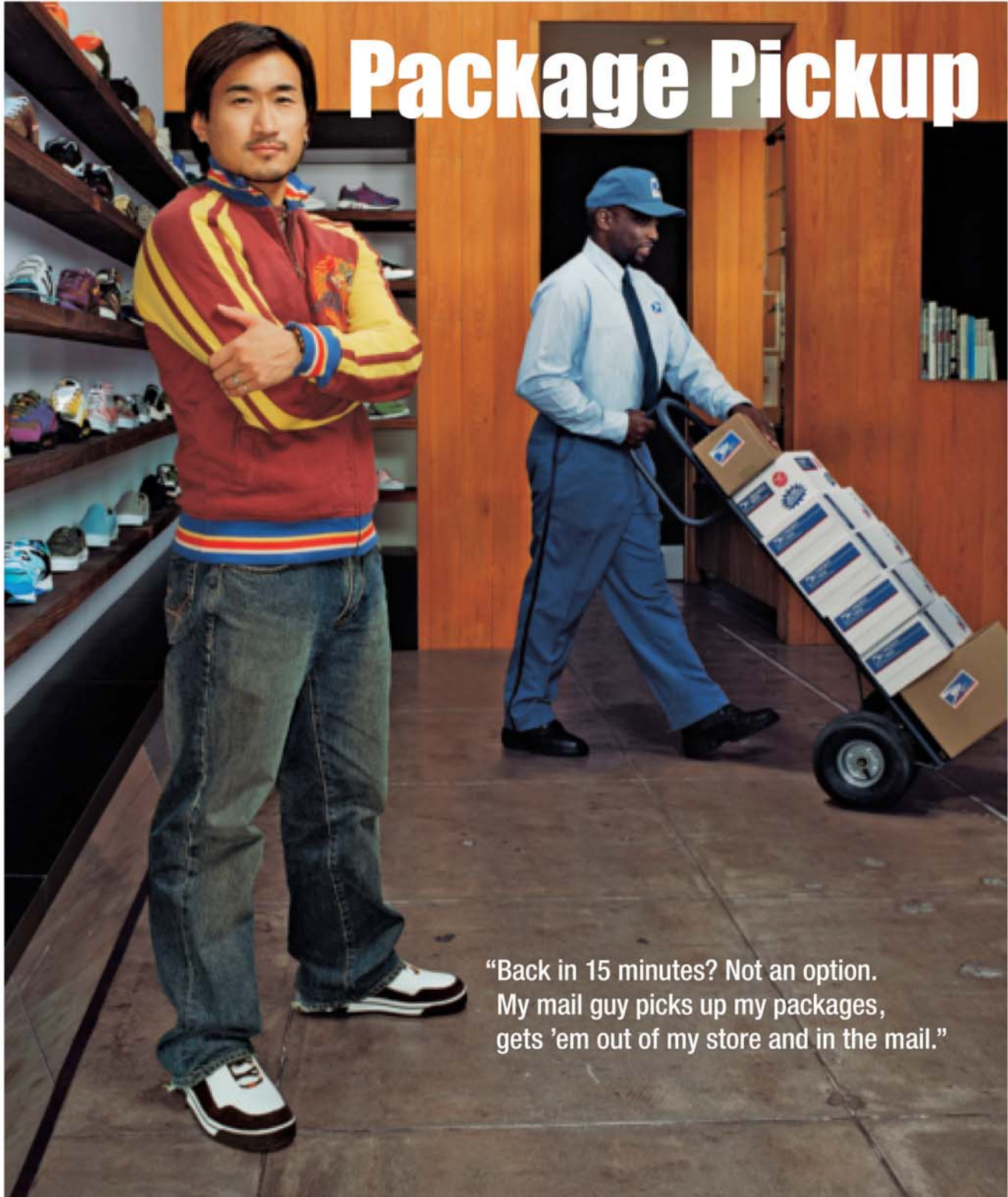

Survey shows record-setting improvements in Remittance Mail

Time is money, a simple equation with significant implications for USPS and remittance mailers. Now, according to the results of an independent study, USPS is providing record-setting service to this important customer group.

Phoenix-Hecht, a leading financial services research firm, reports that service performance for Remittance Mail improved by 1.2 nationwide workhours since last year and by 6 hours over the last decade. A “nationwide workhour” is a measurement of time for non-local mail to reach its destination.

USPS awards seven air transport contracts

The Postal Service has awarded air transportation contracts to seven passenger airlines effective Sept. 30, 2006 — American Airlines, American Trans Air, Continental Airlines, JetBlue Airways, Midwest Airlines, Sun Country Airlines and US Airways. The agreements contain on-time delivery requirements and performance standards established in 2003 as part of the Postal Service’s previous 3-year commercial air contract.

USPS Network Operations Vice President Tony Pajunas said the contracts contain tracking provisions so USPS can account for a customer’s mail the entire time it is in the air transportation system. The airlines are required to scan mail at three key points — when they take possession from the Postal Service or when mail is loaded onto a flight, during transfers to connecting flights and when mail is delivered to the Postal Service after the flight’s arrival.

The 5-year contracts cover domestic transport of Express Mail and First-Class Mail items, and Priority Mail items originating from designated Transportation Security Administration sites.

August financial results released — Net deficiency of \$1.5 billion posted after escrow allocation

USPS revenues for August were \$6.3 billion, or \$143 million over plan, and 6.6 percent more than August 2005. Expenses for the month were \$6.3 billion, or \$223 million over plan, and 6.9 percent more than same period last year (SPLY). The net loss was \$38 million before the escrow allocation. The net deficiency in August after the escrow allocation was \$288 million.

Year-to-date (YTD), revenue through August was 0.8 percent, or \$507 million higher than plan, and 4.2 percent above SPLY. Expenses through August were 0.8 percent, or \$535 million higher than plan, and \$2.9 billion above SPLY.

YTD, the net income before the escrow allocation is \$1.3 billion. A YTD net deficiency of \$1.5 billion exists after the escrow allocation.

Seatbelts did their job for one letter carrier

Orchard Park, NY, Letter Carrier John Marasco recently learned a life-saving lesson — seatbelts do indeed save lives.

Marasco was behind the wheel of his long-life vehicle (LLV) with his seatbelt attached when a car backing out of a driveway hit him. The LLV rolled over. But Marasco emerged with no serious injuries.

Officer in Charge Keith Krempa believes that Marasco's experience will have a greater impact on his fellow carriers than the usual motor safety lectures. "There's a reason the Postal Service is so adamant about carriers buckling up when in their vehicles," Krempa said. "But getting a first-hand account from a co-worker puts policy in a proper perspective."

New EEO hotline available

A new hotline number for filing an Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) claim has been established — 1-888-EEO-USPS. If you've been discriminated against because of age, race, sex, color, national origin, religion, physical or mental disability, or retaliation for previous EEO activity, you can file an EEO claim. Deaf and hard-of-hearing people can call 800-877-8339 (Federal Relay Service) to begin filing a claim.

When you call the hotline, an interactive voice response system will collect pre-complaint information such as your name, address, finance number, Social Security number and telephone number. A counseling packet will be mailed to you. Complete the enclosed forms and mail them to the address indicated. When the EEO office receives your packet, your request for counseling will be assigned to an EEO specialist for processing.

This is part of the EEO program improvements implemented in fiscal year 2004 when all EEO investigations were centralized. The hotline will take advantage of proven technology and move the Postal Service further along in its efforts to be a model federal employer. Response time will improve and employees will have more convenient access to the EEO process.

Second hydrogen fuel vehicle added to USPS fleet

USPS will station in California.

USPS is extending for 1 year an agreement with General Motors (GM) to test hydrogen fuel vehicles.

The Postal Service has been testing one vehicle in Washington, DC. Now, GM has provided a second hydrogen fuel cell-powered vehicle that

USPS has reported good results with the vehicle it has been operating over the past 2 years. Postal Service engineers say the minivan has held up well to the rigors of stop-and-go driving and dramatic shifts in weather.

A vehicle powered by hydrogen fuel cells emits just pure water and is twice as energy efficient as an internal combustion engine.

HANDBOOK REVISION

Handbook AS-353, Guide to Privacy and the Freedom of Information Act

Records originating from any other USPS systems of records, which may be duplicated in or incorporated into this system, may also be disclosed with all personally identifiable information redacted.

Section 707.11.5 of the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®), authorizes the general public to mail copies of Periodicals publications at the applicable single-piece First-Class Mail®, Priority Mail®, or Package Services rate. As a clarification, we are adding similar standards to the Retail and Discount sections of the DMM for Bound Printed Matter and Parcel Post® items. Our clarification is effective October 12, 2006.

DMM REVISION

Destination Sectional Center Facility Mail Entered at Bulk Mail Centers

Due to the small volumes of Package Services parcels entered at destination sectional center facilities (DSCFs), we no longer need mailers to enter pallets of parcels for certain ZIP Codes™ at bulk mail centers instead of SCFs. Therefore, we are removing the restrictions in sections 456.2.7 and 466.4.1 of the Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®). This change will allow mailers to enter pallets for all ZIP Codes to the designated SCF under Labeling List L005.

In addition, the exhibits that describe the “delivery facility for the exceptions to the majority of the city carriers rule” and the “delivery facilities different from those in the Drop Shipment Product” are now contained within the Drop Ship Product. Accordingly, we have modified our standards to direct mailers to the Drop Ship Product to obtain the most up-to-date information.

The DSCF rate is not available for palletized mail for facilities that are unable to handle palletized mailings. Refer to the Drop Shipment Product available from the National Customer Support Center (NCSC) (see 608.8.1) to

determine if the facility serving the 5-digit destination can handle pallets.

c. A destination delivery unit (DDU) is a facility that delivers to the addresses appearing on the deposited pieces in a destination entry rate Parcel Post mailing. Refer to the Drop Shipment Product maintained by the National Customer Support Center (NCSC) (see 608.8.1 for address) to determine the location of a 5-digit delivery facility. Use L606 only for mailings prepared using the optional 5-digit scheme sort.

- a. For DSCF rates, be part of a mailing of parcels sorted to 5-digit scheme or 5-digit destinations and deposited at a designated SCF under L005. Nonmachinable

parcels sorted to 3-digit ZIP Code prefixes and claimed at a DSCF rate must be entered at the designated SCF under L005. Mailers must not prepare mail on pallets or pallet boxes for the DSCF rate if the 5-digit delivery facility is unable to handle pallets. Refer to the Drop Shipment Product maintained by the National Customer Support Center (NCSC) (see 608.8.1) to determine which 5-digit delivery facilities can handle pallets or pallet boxes. When the Drop Shipment Product shows that mail for a single 5-digit ZIP Code area is delivered out of more than one postal facility, use the facility where the majority of city carrier routes are located to determine if the delivery facility can handle pallets.

- b. For DDU rates, be part of a Parcel Select mailing deposited at a designated DDU facility that delivers parcels to the addresses appearing on the pieces. There is no required minimum number of pieces that must be deposited for the DDU rate and no specific preparation requirements; however, the pieces must be part of a mailing of at least 50 Parcel Select rate pieces and must be prepared by 5-digit scheme (optional) and 5-digit sorts. To determine the location for entry of 5-digit scheme sorted pieces, use Column B of L606. To determine the location for entry of 5-digit sorted pieces or whether a 5-digit delivery facility can handle pallets (or pallet boxes), refer to the Drop Shipment Product maintained by the National Customer Support Center (NCSC) (see 608.8.1). When the Drop Shipment Product shows that mail for a single 5-digit ZIP Code area is delivered out of more than one postal facility, use the facility from which the majority of city carrier routes are delivered as the facility at which the DDU mail must be entered. The Drop Shipment Product identifies the 5-digit ZIP Codes that are exceptions to the “majority of city carriers rule” or other facilities where parcels are normally dropped. If a mailer transports mail to a DDU facility that cannot handle pallets, the driver must unload the pallets into containers as specified by the delivery unit.

The Drop Shipment Product identifies the 5-digit ZIP Codes that are exceptions to the “majority of city carriers rule” or other facilities where parcels are normally dropped. If a mailer transports mail to a DDU facility that cannot handle pallets, the driver must unload the pallets into containers as specified by the delivery unit.

Labeling List Changes

Effective October 12, 2006, we are revising Labeling Lists L001, L002, L003, L007, L011, L201, and L606 of the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* to reflect changes in mail processing operations. Mailers are encouraged to label according to these revised lists immediately, but *must* comply with these changes no later than December 24, 2006.

Election Campaigns — Hatch Act and Other Requirements

Hatch Act Requirements for Postal Service Employees

The Hatch Act affects some political activities, including off-duty activities, for Postal Service™ employees. The Office of Special Counsel, which investigates possible Hatch Act violations, has prepared examples of permitted and prohibited activities for federal, including Postal Service, employees:

Postal Service employees may:

- Be candidates for public office in nonpartisan elections.
- Register and vote as they choose.
- Assist in voter registration drives.
- Express opinions about candidates and issues.
- Contribute money to political organizations.
- Attend political fundraising functions.
- Attend and be active at political rallies and meetings.
- Join and be an active member of a political party or club.
- Sign nominating petitions.
- Campaign for or against referendum questions, constitutional amendments, and municipal ordinances.
- Campaign for or against candidates in partisan elections.
- Make campaign speeches for candidates in partisan elections.
- Distribute campaign literature in partisan elections.
- Hold office in political clubs or parties.

But, Postal Service employees may not:

- Be candidates for public office in partisan elections.
- Use their official authority or influence to interfere with an election.
- Collect political contributions unless both individuals are members of the same federal labor organization or employee organization and the one solicited is not a subordinate employee.
- Knowingly solicit or discourage the political activity of any person who has business before the agency.
- Engage in political activity while on duty.
- Engage in political activity in any government office.
- Engage in political activity while wearing an official uniform.
- Engage in political activity while using a government vehicle.

- Solicit political contributions from the general public.
- Wear political buttons on duty.

Campaigning on Postal Service Premises

Postal Service regulations (see *Postal Operations Manual* 124.54; 39 CFR 232.1; and Poster 7, *Rules and Regulations Governing Conduct on Postal Property*) prohibit campaigning for election to public office on leased or owned Postal Service property. Tell individuals who ask about the availability of Postal Service property for such purposes about the prohibition, and give them a copy of the regulations. The following points will help you interpret and apply the regulations:

- The focus of the regulations is to identify activities that are “prohibited.” Activities that are not prohibited by any of the regulations are permitted. For example, in the context of political campaigning, informational leafletting would be permitted, so long as the information in the leaflet itself is not political campaigning and the leafletting was carried out in a way that does not disrupt Postal Service business.
- Campaigning for election to public office is prohibited on Postal Service property, even if the candidate is independent of any political party.
- The regulations do not prohibit all activities related to political issues. For example, distributing literature pertaining to a referendum or ballot measure is permitted. The regulations do prohibit, however, the solicitation of signatures on petitions, polls, and surveys.
- The regulations prohibit depositing posters or literature on Postal Service property, obstructing entrances, any activity that tends to impede or disturb the public in transacting Postal Service business, the sale of goods, and the solicitation of contributions on Postal Service property.
- The regulations cover activity only on Postal Service premises. Activity outside Postal Service property, even if it affects our premises, is not governed by our regulations.

REVISED FORM

Revised PS Form 1608, Emergency Salary Authorization

Effective October 1, 2006, Post Offices™ and postal retail units must begin using the August 2006 edition of PS Form 1608, *Emergency Salary Authorization* (see page 19 of this *Postal Bulletin*). Previous editions are obsolete and must be disposed of properly.

When to Use PS Form 1608

Use the revised PS Form 1608 only for issuing emergency salary to an employee that did not receive a scheduled payroll check. Make sure that an emergency salary is not issued before the date of the scheduled date of the payroll check.

Note: Do not use the revised PS Form 1608 for employee payroll adjustments. If an employee receives a payroll check that is less than amount due, use the appropriate form: PS Form 2240, *Pay, Leave, or Other Hours Pay Adjustment Report*; PS Form 2240-R, *Rural Pay or Leave Adjustment Request for PS Form 1314*; or PS Form 2240-RA, *Rural Pay or Leave Adjustment Request for PS Form 1314-A*.

How to Issue Emergency Salary

Supervisor

The supervisor follows these steps:

1. Refers to the payroll register for the amount to be issued. Do not issue emergency salary if a net-to-bank is validated in the payroll register.
2. Completes PS Form 1608 (August 2006 version).
3. Issues the authorized PS Form 1608 to the employee.

Employee

The employee signs and submits the completed and authorized PS Form 1608 to a Post Office or postal retail unit.

Postal Retail Unit

The retail associate at the postal retail unit follows these steps:

1. Issues a no-fee postal money order (AIC 100 and AIC 101 with offset to AIC 586) for the authorized amount to the employee.

2. Annotates the money order serial number on PS Form 1608.
3. Records the amount issued into AIC 754, Authorized Emergency Salary Issued, in his/her PS Form 1412, *Daily Financial Report*.
4. Provides system-generated or PS Form 3544, *USPS Receipt for Money or Services*, to the employee together with the no-fee money order.
5. Attaches the money order receipt and a copy of system-generated or PS Form 3544 to the PS Form 1608 and files locally.
6. Does not send PS Form 1608 to the Scanning and Imaging Center (SIC).

REMINDER

Federal Taxation Percentages for Supplemental Wages

Postal Service™ employees are reminded that the percentages used to tax supplemental wages are different from the normal taxation percentages. As information, supplemental wages include, but are not limited to, the following: prizes, awards, back-pay awards, severance pay, and reimbursements for moving expenses. The American Jobs Creation Act of 2004 and Section 31.3402(g)-1 of Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regulations created a temporary two-tiered taxation rate for supplemental wages that was effective as of January 1, 2005. However, these regulations have now been finalized.

The final regulations provide for taxation of supplemental wages up to a total of \$1 million within a calendar year at a mandatory withholding rate of 25 percent. The final regulations also provide for a mandatory withholding rate of 35 percent for any supplemental wages paid in excess of \$1 million within a calendar year. These rates will remain in effect until Congress and the IRS change the taxation percentages.

Revised Segmented Inventory Accountability Sales Calculation for POS Sites

Effective October 12, 2006, the calculation of Segmented Inventory Accountability (SIA) sales for POS sites is revised as follows:

Subtract the following account identifier codes (AICs) from AIC 852, Total Sales:

- AIC 096, Vending Equipment Postage Sales.
- AIC 095, Stamps on Consignment Replenishment Sales.

- AIC 094, Stamps by Mail, Internet, and Phone.
- AIC 086, Precancelled Stamps.

The formula is as follows:

$$\text{SIA Sales} = \text{AIC 852} - 096 - 095 - 094 - 086$$

IMM REVISION

International Mail — International Customized Mail Changes

Effective October 12, 2006, we are revising *International Mail Manual* (IMM®) 297.2 to reflect a change in the qualification standards for International Customized Mail (ICM).

[Revise items a and b to read as follows:]

- a. Paying at least \$2 million in international letter-post postage (excluding Global Priority Mail) to the Postal Service.
- b. Tendering at least 600 pieces of international non-letter-post mail to the Postal Service, or paying at least \$12,000 in international non-letter-post postage to the Postal Service.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.

- There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

over 42" to 44"	24" girth
over 44" to 46"	20" girth
over 46" to 48"	16" girth

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

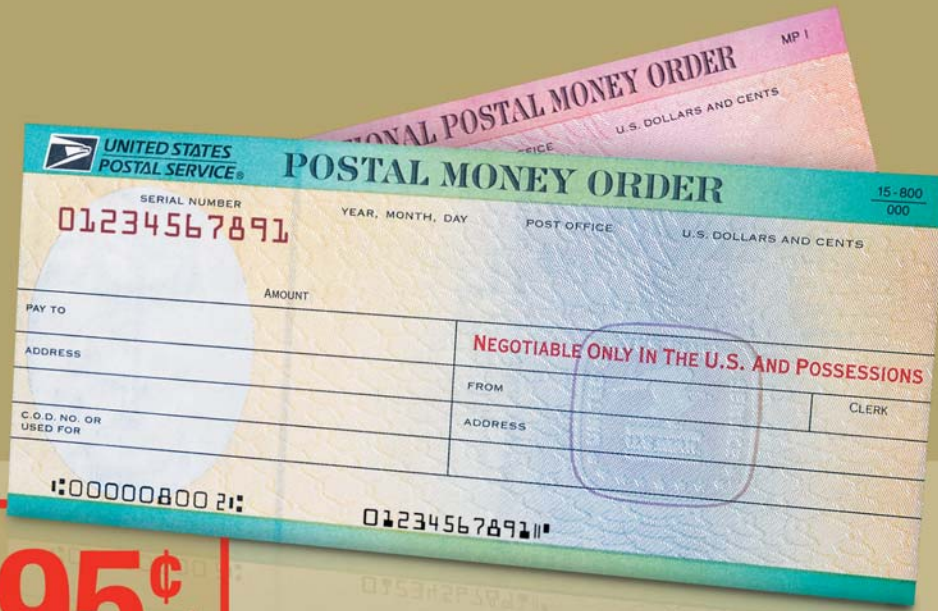
Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those postmarks that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the postmark, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

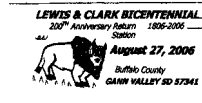
Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP+4 code).

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

Political Campaign Mail Season Is Winding Down

The Postal Service™ is responsible for providing information to assist in the knowledgeable preparation and deposit of political campaign mailings, as well as for the proper acceptance, processing, delivery, and recording of these mailings. In addition to this article, see “POM Revision: Political Campaign Mail Processing Procedures,” in *Postal Bulletin* 22186 (8-3-06, pages 17–21).

The American electorate votes on numerous political offices and issues each year. This year includes elections for one-third of the U.S. Senate and all members of the House of Representatives. In addition, there are also state, county, and local offices and referenda measures. The general election is Tuesday, November 7. This can be a hectic time for political candidates, campaign committees, and committees of political parties.

Mailings are created by individual candidates, their campaign organizations, and local, state, and national committees of political parties. Campaign organizations planning to prepare their own mailings using volunteers need to determine if their campaign workers and volunteers have recent mail preparation experience. Local Post Offices™ need to be ready to answer any questions and provide assistance.

Mailing Assistance

Committees of political parties, candidates, and the candidates' campaign organizations will be contacting Post Office(s) where they hold mailing permits, or plan to apply for a mailing permit, to obtain information on mail preparation standards, procedures, and each Post Office's hours (and days) of business mail acceptance. Verify the status of mailing permits and nonprofit authorizations, if applicable, as well as information on eligible rates. Provide mailers with current First-Class Mail® and Standard Mail® rates and direct them to Postal Explorer® at <http://pe.usps.com>, and have them click *Ratefold* (Notice 123).

When asked, Post Offices can review proper preparation, makeup, and handling of mailings; explain the use, and associated costs, of ancillary service endorsements; and advise of any restrictions as to what may and may not be mailed as Standard Mail and what may be mailed at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates (see Nonprofit Standard Mail Eligibility and Rates, pages 55–56).

Mail Service Providers

Political campaign workers and staff may be unfamiliar with current mailing standards and how the Postal Service processes and delivers the mail, resulting in unrealistic plans. Getting the assistance of a mailing professional (e.g., letter shop, presort bureau, etc.) before printing (and making commitments) may provide insights about preferred mailpiece designs and characteristics, optimum addressing and automation features, and ideal mailing schedules to enable timely delivery.

Letter shops and presort bureaus specialize in preparing mailings for customers. Some of these businesses can take care of the entire mail preparation process, from printing to entering the mailings. These businesses can be found by doing a Web search or by checking the local phone book under “letter shops,” “mailing services,” or “printing.” Mail service providers assist with the following:

- Obtaining an address list.
- Designing and printing mailpieces.
- Sorting mailpieces.
- Possibly reducing postage.
- Entering mailings.

Additional Reminders for Political Mailers

Discount mailings are subject to specific volume, marking, and preparation requirements and must be entered at a business mail entry unit of the Post Office where the permit is held and the annual mailing fee paid.

- Mailpieces paid with precanceled stamps must bear a complete domestic return address.
- Postage statements can be obtained from the local Post Office, as well as online at <http://pe.usps.com>; click *Business Forms*.
- First-Class Mail that cannot be delivered as addressed is forwardable and returnable, as appropriate. Standard Mail (including Nonprofit Standard Mail) that cannot be delivered as addressed is disposed of at the delivery office unless the mailpiece bears an appropriate ancillary service endorsement (e.g., “return service requested”). Explain the ancillary service endorsement options available and their associated cost to mailers. Mailings bearing an ancillary service endorsement must have a return address located in the upper left corner of the address side of the mailpiece.
- Standard Mail may receive deferred handling, and delivery time cannot be assured.

Political Campaign Mailings

Any material mailed at First-Class Mail or Standard Mail rates for political campaign purposes is classified as a

“political campaign mailing” if mailed by any of the following:

- A registered political candidate.
- A campaign committee.
- A committee of a political party.

An individual or organization recognized as such by the appropriate government (national, state, local) election control authority is considered to be a registered political candidate or party.

Using Tag 57 with Political Campaign Mailings

First-Class Mail and Standard Mail items entered by a registered political candidate, campaign committee, or committee of a political party can be identified by using Tag 57, *Political Campaign Mailings*, on the mailing containers. Use of Tag 57 with eligible campaign mailings is optional.



For mailings prepared in trays and strapped, mailers can affix Tag 57 with a wire twist tie to the strap at the end of the tray that bears the tray label. If the Post Office permits letter trays to be tendered without strapping, Tag 57 can be affixed to the tray with a rubber band double-looped through the handhold of the tray at the end that bears the tray label. For flat-size mailings (prepared in sacks), affix Tag 57 to the strap or label holder — depending on the type of sack used.

Mailings made by organizations other than those listed above, promoting or endorsing political candidates, referendums, and so forth, are not classified as political campaign mailings, and may not use Tag 57.

Nonprofit Standard Mail Eligibility and Rates

Section 3626(e) of Title 39, U.S. Code, permits certain Standard Mail material to be mailed by a qualified political committee at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates. The following political committees may be authorized to mail at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates:

- A national or state committee of a political party.
- The Democratic Congressional or Senatorial Campaign Committee.

- The National Republican Congressional or Senatorial Committee.

A “national” (or “state”) committee is the organization that, by virtue of the bylaws of a political party, is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the political party at the national (or state) level.

Only the above named political parties and committees, which have received authorization from the Postal Service for the location where they enter mailings, may mail eligible materials at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates. Except for mailings deposited under plant-verified drop shipment (PVDS), a separate authorization is required at each Post Office where mailings are entered.

A qualifying political committee may mail election-related materials (e.g., candidate endorsements, sample ballots, etc.) at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates if the materials are exclusively that of the qualifying political committee. Qualified political committees may not make cooperative mailings at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates involving material mailed on behalf of, or produced for, individual candidates or political organizations that do not qualify. Such cooperative mailings must be paid at First-Class Mail or Standard Mail rates.

The following are examples of political committee mailings that do not qualify for Nonprofit Standard Mail rates:

- Material identified as having been paid for by the campaign committee of, or treasurer of, an individual candidate.
- Flyers, brochures, or other printed material prepared or printed by a political candidate or his or her campaign organization.
- A mailing for which postage is paid for by a political candidate or his or her campaign organization.
- A mailing made on behalf of a candidate in return for a contribution to the qualifying political committee.

Political organizations and committees other than the qualified political committees defined above are ineligible to mail at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates. Political party committees organized at the county or local level are not eligible to mail at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates. These restrictions, however, do not prohibit a state committee of a political party from endorsing and supporting local candi-

dates, as long as the campaign materials to be mailed at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates are the state committee’s own and the committee pays the postage with no reimbursement from the candidates or other committees supporting those candidates.

Identification

All mailings at Nonprofit Standard Mail rates must identify the qualified political committee. The name and address of the authorized qualified political committee must appear either on the outside of the mailpiece or in a prominent location on the material being mailed. If the mailpiece bears any name and return address, it must be that of the authorized qualified political committee. For mailpieces paid with precanceled stamps, the name and address of the authorized qualified political committee must appear as the return address on the mailpiece.

Additional Information and Guidance

In addition to rate information and postage statements, Postal Explorer lets you view the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual; current container labeling lists; Quick Service Guides; related publications; and rate calculators. In addition, you have access to:

- *An Introduction to Mailing for Businesses and Organizations*.
- Business Mail 101 — a tool for beginning or infrequent mailers.
- Standard Mail Eligibility Decision Tree and related Customer Support Rulings.

Setting Clocks for Standard Time

Managers must ensure that before opening for business on Monday, October 30, 2006, the clocks in all integrated retail terminals (IRTs) and debit/credit card terminals under their control are set *back* (in most locations) 1 hour to reflect the change to Standard Time. Facilities with Saturday night operations should reset the time as soon as possible after the 2 A.M. start time, Sunday, October 29, 2006.

The correct system time in IRTs is critical since their internal clocks are used to verify Express Mail® and Global Express Guaranteed™ acceptance times and service commitments. The IRT system time is also printed on customer receipts and employee reports. It is very important that the debit/credit card terminal clocks be set to the correct day, date, and time as this will help reduce the possibility of accepting an expired debit/credit card.

Integrated Retail Terminals (IRTs)

On the UNISYS III Supervisor Disk, select menu item 11, Set System Date and Time, from the Control menu, and perform the following steps:

1. Observe that the date appears.
2. Press the ENTER key to accept the current date. The time appears.
3. Press the CE key to clear the time.
4. Enter correct Standard Time in military format (Examples: 8 A.M. = 0800, 1:30 P.M. = 1330).
5. Press the ENTER key to save the corrected time. The Control menu appears.
6. Observe that the corrected time is displayed in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Tranz 380 Debit/Credit Card Terminals

For Tranz 380 debit/credit card terminals, follow these steps:

Display	Action
U.S. Postal Service	Press the (*) key and the (3) key at the same time. (If you are having trouble, simply hold the (*) key and tap the (3) key.)
Diagnostics	Press ALPHA key.
Year	Key in the current year (4 digits). Press ENTER key.
Month	Key in a number (1–12) for current month. Press ENTER key.
Date	Key in a number (1–31) for current date. Press ENTER key.
Display	Action

Hour	Key in a number (1–24) for current hour. Press ENTER key.
Minutes	Key in number of minutes (0–59). Press ENTER key.
Seconds	Key in number of seconds or press ENTER key to bypass.

You must make an entry for each selection, even if the display is correct.

Note: The date and time of Tranz 380s located in Europe should be set to Eastern (New York) time. The date and time of Tranz 380s located in the Pacific should be set to Pacific (San Francisco) Time.

Displaying the Clock and Calendar

To verify the existing date and time of the clock in the terminal, follow these steps:

Display	Action
U.S. Postal Service	Press ENTER key.
Function	Press the (4) key.
Day, Date, Time	
Exit	Press CLEAR key.

Retail Consolidation Unit (RCU)

The time for the RCU/CONA will be updated automatically by the San Mateo Host Computing Service Center. However, all RCU operators should validate the correct time and date when they log on to the RCU on Monday, October 30, 2006, and notify System Services if the time and date are incorrect.

Mobile Data Collection Devices (MDCDs)

The Delivery Confirmation™ handheld scanners will automatically change to Standard Time. No manual changes are necessary.

Intelligent Mail Devices (IMDs)

The new handheld imager will automatically change to Standard Time. No manual changes are necessary.

IBM and NCR POS ONE Terminals

The IBM and NCR POS ONE terminals will automatically change to Standard Time. No manual changes are necessary.

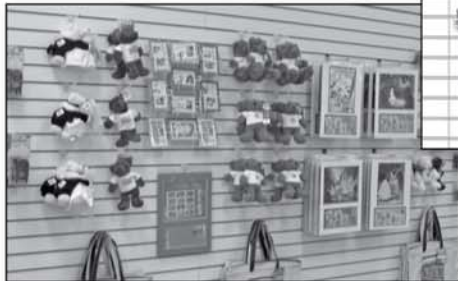

Keep the Traffic Moving

During the busy season, your Post Office™ can greatly reduce wait times in line by following some of the simple steps outlined here:

1. Make sure that your vending machines and the Automated Postal Center® (APC®) kiosks are fully stocked.
2. Remind customers that they can perform debit or credit card transactions at the APC kiosk.
3. Empty the parcel drops frequently.
4. Keep your ReadyPost® and complimentary shipping supply displays well stocked at all times.
5. Make sure the product identifiers for the vending machines are in their proper places to let customers know which stamps are available. Visit http://eagmnsg10d/VFO/vfo_2006RateCase_MachineProductIdentifiers.html if you need to print product identifiers.

Something to consider during this time of year is to have someone in the lobby to direct traffic and answer customer questions. Keep in mind that this is not mandatory, but this person can help customers by directing them to the vending machine and the APC kiosk. Customers will appreciate the heads up and you'll have more time to concentrate on selling higher revenue-generating products such as Express Mail® service and Priority Mail® service.

Your Holiday POP kit will be arriving by the end of October. Make sure all the POP signage is up on November 1.

New Touch Tone Order Entry System Upgrade and Telephone Number

Effective September 29, 2006, there are new changes to the touch tone order entry (TTOE) system. The new TTOE system will be consolidated with the St. Louis Accounting Service Center Call Center and will use up-to-date universal telecommunications standards and system fault tolerance and will improve service and simplify support.

Due to this upgrade, callers must use a new number to order materials: 800-273-1509. In addition, callers will now use the "pound" (#) key instead of the "star" (*) key to complete data input entries.

Note: Continue to use 800-332-0317 for emergency orders, order status, item information, and customer service assistance. The telephone number change is only for standard orders placed through TTOE. If you are a registered TTOE user you do not need to register to use the new system.
