### New postal law: A message from the postmaster general

The postal legislation signed into law by President Bush on Dec. 20 will benefit both residential and business customers by ensuring predictable price increases tied to the rate of inflation.

The new law, called the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act, is the first major change to the Postal Service since 1971.

The law directs the Department of the Treasury to resume the obligation for military pensions for postal employees, taking the financial burden off the Postal Service. That means our Civil Service and Federal Retirement System obligations are now fully funded. It also abolishes a federally mandated escrow requirement directing that money to pre-fund retiree health benefits. So by 2017, our retiree health benefits will essentially be fully funded. During the next decade, these changes will free the Postal Service of future legacy costs, putting us on firm financial footing for the future.

For our customers, the new law means universal service will be preserved at affordable rates. For mailers it will provide rate predictability, allowing them to plan their budgets more accurately. And for employees it ensures your health and retirement benefits are fully funded.

The new law also divides our products into two broad categories: market-dominant and competitive. Market-dominant products include First-Class Mail, Standard Mail and Periodicals. Future rate increases for these products will be tied to the Consumer Price Index. Competitive products, such as Priority Mail and Express Mail, will enjoy greater pricing flexibility.

The law also reconstitutes the existing Postal Rate Commission (PRC) into a regulatory body with greater authority and responsibility. The PRC has 18 months to develop regulations for both market-dominant and competitive products. The Postal Service is allowed to file one last rate case under the current rule, not later than Dec. 20, 2007. And the current rate case will proceed as scheduled.

The new law comes at a time when we are strong and stable — and it will enable us to build on our successes. Most of the changes are down the road. But one thing won't change — our fundamental commitment to delivering the mail and improving service to the American people.

### Employees fight record snow to deliver Christmas cheer



Boulder, CO, Letter Carrier Dave Hayden navigated through impassable streets, and found mailboxes buried by snow, to make his appointed rounds.

It was supposed to be the biggest mail delivery day of the year. Instead, a different kind of delivery came — a major winter storm deposited up to 4 feet of snow in Colorado and Wyoming in less than 24 hours. The snow crippled transportation, closing airports and interstates.

Mail operations were not immune from the ravages of the storm. Trucks weren't able to bring the mail to processing centers to be sorted. And unplowed streets that were choked with abandoned vehicles made many deliveries impossible.

But once the storm passed, thousands of employees worked together to deliver an estimated 3 million cards and letters and 300,000 parcels before Christmas.

Stories about employees' efforts were reported in hundreds of newspapers, television and radio stories across the nation.

### The holiday spirit begins at work: Rochester employees remember their own

Somewhere in Iraq, six servicemen were overwhelmed by the generosity of employees at the Rochester, NY, Processing and Distribution Center.

Two of the servicemen are employed at the Rochester facility. The four others are family

members of Rochester employees.



Mail handler James Watts and Ergonomic Risk Reduction Process and Voluntary Protection Program Coordinator Mary Hutteman organized the gift drive. Working from a list of requests the troops provided, employees at the facility were more than happy to play Santa Claus.

Rochester employees collected 18 boxes containing snacks, stationery, personal hygiene items and duct tape. The tape, used with a strip of gauze, makes a great waterproof Band-Aid.

## Still the king

The *Associated Press*, *Concorde Monitor* and other media outlets report that this year's *Wonders of America* stamp set climbed to second place in the most popular stamps, but Elvis is still the king.

Some 124.1 million of the 1993 *Elvis Presley* stamps were saved by Americans, according to an annual survey of 10,000 households to determine which stamps are most popular. Rising into second spot was the *Wonders of America* set, with 87.5 million stamps saved.

"Stamp collecting continues as one of the world's most popular educational hobbies that the entire family can enjoy," said Postmaster General Jack Potter.

## USPS team to look at asset management

Supply chain management changed how the Postal Service administered contracts — leveraging the size and strength of our organization to get the best deals on a variety of products and services.

Asset management integration is going to do the same thing for managing USPS physical assets.

The program is still in the developmental stage. A recent meeting was held in Washington, DC, and included representatives from Government Relations, Supply Management, Marketing, Information Technology, Finance and Human Resources. Their goal — define and implement the best solutions for effectively managing the Postal Service's many physical assets.

## History in the making: Mail History Tracking System debuts

Delivery point sequencing (DPS) revolutionized the way the Postal Service processes letter mail by sorting it into a carrier's line of travel. But even with the best of systems, errors occasionally occur.

Sometimes it's human error, where a mail processing clerk sweeps the mail incorrectly. Other times, it's machine

error — where the machine has calculated an incorrect ZIP Code. And, less-than-optimal machine performance affects the quality of the sort.

Because letter carriers don't discover these errors until they're out on the street, service is impacted.

But thanks to the Mail History Tracking System (MHTS), a new Web-based application, the Postal Service can tell if there are errors and, if so, exactly where in each tray the missorted, missequenced and missent letters are located. Within one hour after completing the DPS second pass — the final sortation for DPS mail — MHTS can produce a report that lets maintenance, processing operations and delivery units know the number of errors, if any, and where they are in each letter carrier's tray.

## Voter registrar gives Bay-Valley and San Francisco Districts a "thumbs up"

During the campaign season, USPS and the office of the Registrar of Voters (ROV) in Santa Clara County, CA, worked hard to make sure registered voters received their election mailings in plenty of time to become informed and participate in November's polls. After the election, the county's ROV took time to thank the Postal Service — Bay-Valley and San Francisco Districts — for its role in getting the vote out.

In a letter to USPS, Al Salcedo, the ROV's coordinator for the Election Materials Processing Division, praised Postal Service officials in the California county.

The Santa Clara County ROV generated 1.5 million pieces of mail directly related to the General Election of 2006, including sample ballots, absentee ballots and Voter Information Guides.



USPS scores with grid-iron-related promotion

College football zealots from Boston to Berkeley participated this past season in a five-game USPS promotion for the NetPost CardStore and Customized Postage products. The Postal Service distributed more than 18,000 promotional pieces on the two products to fans who visited the USPS display during the five-game run.

## Flags at Half-Staff

Due to the death of former President Gerald Ford, the U.S. flag and Postal Service™ flag will be displayed at half-staff through Jan. 25, 2007. Half-staff display applies to all Post Offices™, branches, stations, terminals, garages, and postal facilities — including leased and rented premises. Displaying the flag at *half-staff* means lowering the flag to half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff. The flag must first be hoisted to the peak of the staff and then slowly lowered to half-staff. When the flag is lowered

for the day, it must be raised again to the peak and then lowered slowly before being stored for the night. When the flag is displayed at half-staff during a period of mourning, it must be so displayed on all days included in such period (*Administrative Support Manual 472.132*).

### DMM REVISION

#### Labeling Single-Piece Rate Pieces Presented With Presort Mailings

Effective January 4, 2007, we are revising 235.5.1.2 in the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to provide labeling instructions for single-piece-rated First-Class Mail® letters presented as part of a presorted mailing.

##### 5.1.2 Single-Piece Rate Pieces Presented With Presort Mailings

[Revise 5.1.2 to add new labeling instructions for single-piece rate pieces as follows:]

Regardless of postage payment method, mailers may present single-piece rate First-Class Mail with pieces claimed at automation or presort rates, and report all pieces on the same postage statement, if:

- a. The mailer physically separates the single-piece rate pieces from the automation and presort pieces.

- b. The single-piece rate pieces bear no rate marking or are marked “First-Class” or “Single-Piece” (“SNGLP”) if not affixed with full single-piece rate postage. See 202.3.0, *Placement and Content of Mail Markings*.
- c. The mailer affixes additional postage to the single-piece rate pieces to yield the correct amount on each piece, or (if prepared with a corrective rate marking) the mailer pays all additional postage at the time of mailing.
- d. The mailer prepares single-piece rate mailpieces in trays labeled as follows:
  1. Line 1: Use L201; for mail originating in ZIP Code areas in Column A, use “MXD” followed by city, state, and 3-digit ZIP Code prefix in Column C (use “MXD” instead of “OMX” in the destination line and ignore Column B).
  2. Line 2: FCM SNGLP WKG.
  3. Line 3: office of mailing or mailer information.

## RURAL CARRIERS

### Equipment Maintenance Allowance Schedule for Rural Routes

#### Rural Carriers

In accordance with provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.3 of the Rural Carrier National Agreement, effective January 6, 2007 (pay period 04-07), the equipment maintenance allowance (EMA) will decrease from 52.5 cents per mile to 48.0 cents per mile. The EMA is 48.0 cents per mile, or a minimum of \$19.20 per day, whichever is greater.

#### Auxiliary Rural Carriers, Rural Carrier Reliefs, Rural Carrier Associates, Rural Carrier Part-Time Flexibles, and Auxiliary Assistance

Employees providing auxiliary assistance or serving auxiliary routes under provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.5,

receive an EMA of 48.0 cents per mile or \$5.40 per hour, whichever is greater. This EMA should not exceed the amount provided in the special equipment maintenance allowance for the route stops and miles.

#### EMA Rate Schedule

The EMA rate schedule on pages 9–10 supersedes all previously published EMA schedules for employees receiving EMA.

HANDBOOK F-15 REVISION

## Travel and Relocation

Effective January 1, 2007, Handbook F-15, *Travel and Relocation*, is revised to reflect reimbursement rates for travel and relocation. These rates also apply to bargaining unit relocation benefits under Handbook F-12, *Relocation Policy*.

#### A-1.2 Reimbursement for Postal Service Supervisors

[Revise A-1.2 to read as follows:]

Postal Service supervisors (see 5-5.2.1.2) will be reimbursed at the rate of \$6.00 per day or 48.5 cents per mile, whichever is greater, when a privately owned vehicle is used. Do not use the eTravel system when claiming the \$6.00 daily rate, because the excess of the daily rate over the actual mileage is taxable as compensation to the claimant. You should claim the \$6.00 daily rate by submitting PS Form 1164-A, *Claim for Reimbursement for Postal Supervisors*, to the Scanning and Imaging Center.

Odometer readings are not required on the respective claim forms; the integrity of the claim is the responsibility of the traveler. However, should the approving official have reason to question the claim, the claimant must provide evidence that supports the claim of distance traveled.

**NOTICE****eTravel Upgrade — Prepare Now**

The eTravel system will be upgraded on January 29, 2007. You will not be able to submit travel vouchers after January 29 in the current version. However, the current version of eTravel will remain open for several months for approvals and maintenance of vouchers created in the old version.

eTravel uses a commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) product that has not had any significant changes in more than 6 years. Recently, the vendor issued a new version that replaces the one currently in use. The Postal Service™ is implementing the eTravel upgrade because it has a number of advantages:

- Groups in the upgrade have group-specific business rules.
- The upgrade has a Web-based user interface with screen helpers and tool tips.
- The need to download the windows applet file has been eliminated, which is a big benefit to those with non-ACE computers.
- It is vendor supported. (The vendor has dropped support of the old version.)

Please prepare for the eTravel upgrade by following these three basic steps:

1. Check your e-mail address in the current version of eTravel. If it's not accurate, correct it as necessary. Information on the upgrade will be forwarded to you via your e-mail account.
2. Go to the Travel Help Web site at *http://blue.usps.gov/travelhelp/* and take the online tutorials — required before first-time use of the new version — and review the Quickstart guides. Answers to your questions about the eTravel upgrade are available under the site's frequently asked questions (FAQs).
3. Submit your final eTravel expense report and accompanying receipts in the current eTravel system by the close of business, January 26. If you recently completed a trip and all your charge card transactions aren't in the current eTravel system by then, don't worry — just wait until after January 29 to enter and submit your travel expense report in the upgraded system. Any unused card transactions from December 2006 and January 2007 will be available there.

## International Mail — Conversion Rates Between U.S. Dollars and Special Drawing Right (SDR) Values, and Indemnity Limits for Ordinary Parcel Post

Effective January 1, 2007, *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) 324.22 and Exhibit 324.22 are revised to reflect a change in the conversion rates between U.S. dollars and special drawing right (SDR) values. Also, Exhibit 281.3 is revised to reflect a change in ordinary parcel post indemnity limits, which are based on SDR values. Furthermore, the Individual Country Listing for each applicable country is revised to reflect a change in the ordinary parcel post indemnity limits.

Postal Service™ retail employees use the information about SDR values when an insured parcel is presented for mailing. Employees must write the insured amount, stated in terms of both U.S. dollars and SDR values, in the designated blocks on PS Form 2976-A, *Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note — CP 72*.

\$1 U.S. = 0.6860 SDR

1 SDR = \$1.46 U.S. (\$1.4577 U.S.)

- c. Enter the insured number, insured amount, and SDR equivalent on PS Form 2976-A, *Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note CP — 72*.

## Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
  - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
  - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.

- There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

over 42" to 44" . . . . .	24" girth
over 44" to 46" . . . . .	20" girth
over 46" to 48" . . . . .	16" girth

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

## Redeeming International Reply Coupons

Effective January 1, 2007, we are revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) 372 and Publication 51, *International Postal Rates and Fees*, to reflect current procedures in our redemption policy for international reply coupons (IRCs).

**Note:** This policy change is only for IRCs issued by foreign postal administrations — U.S.-origin coupons are not affected. U.S.-origin IRCs are distinguishable from foreign-origin IRCs because they bear the legend “Amérique (Etats-Unis)” on the front side.

As of January 1, 2007, customers are no longer able to redeem the following foreign-origin IRCs at U.S. Post Offices™:

- IRCs issued before 2002.
- IRCs bearing an expiration date of December 31, 2006.

The pre-2002 IRCs are approximately 2.5 inches by 4 inches and do not have a barcode on the back, whereas the current version of the IRCs printed by the Universal Postal

Union is approximately 3.75 inches by 6 inches and can be distinguished by the barcode on the back.

IRCs with the 12-31-06 expiration date bear the following language on the front side: “A échanger jusqu’au 31.12.2006.” IRCs currently offered for sale by the Postal Service™ and foreign postal administrations do not expire until December 31, 2009.

Retail associates should advise customers to return pre-2002 IRCs and IRCs with the 12-31-06 expiration date to their correspondents in the country of issue for redemption through the postal administration that issued the coupon.

Starting below are images of the front and back of the pre-2002 IRC, of the IRC with the 12-31-06 expiration date, and of the current IRC.

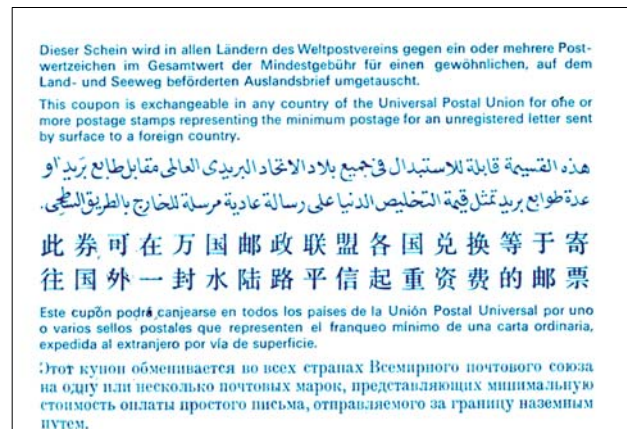

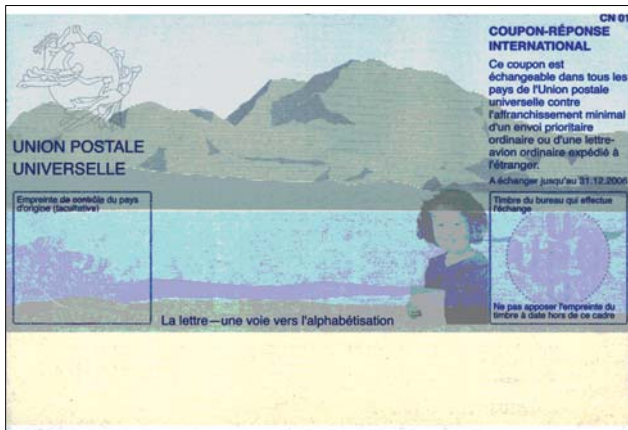

### With Love and Kisses 2007 Love Stamp

Due to licensing agreements, for the *With Love and Kisses* 2007 love stamp, only the second-day postmark shown here is permitted.



Post Office™ facilities planning events are prohibited from designing their own pictorial postmark. The field is not allowed to create new artwork that incorporates the shape of a Hershey's Kisses chocolate or the words "Hershey's" or "kisses." The word "station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design because the station will be a temporary station.

### Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those postmarks that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the postmark, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP+4 code).

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

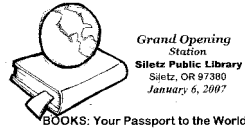

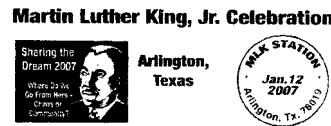

#### Catalog Address Change and Request Card

- Attached to PS Form 3575, *Change-of-Address Order*, is the Catalog Address Change and Request Card, which movers can fill out to let catalogers know where they are moving.
- The Catalog Address Change and Request Card must be detached from the change-of-address (COA) form and from the catalog description card.
- The Catalog Address Change and Request Card and the COA form should be mailed separately. This is important for change-of-address processing.

#### PS Form 3576, Address Notification Cards

- PS Form 3576, *Address Notification Cards*, is no longer included inside the *Mover's Guide* envelope.
- Post Offices™ that need *Address Notification Cards* must order them from the Material Distribution Center (MDC).
- To order up to 200 *Address Notification Cards*, call the MDC and use touch tone order entry (TTOE): Call 800-273-1509.

*Note:* You must be registered to use TTOE. To register, call 800-332-0317, option 1, extension 2925, and follow the prompts to leave a message. (Wait 48 hours after registering before placing your first order.)

### Reduce Travel Costs by Using Trip Manager

Effective November 1, 2006, the transaction fee for Postal Service™ employees booking air travel online via Trip Manager was reduced from \$9.50 to \$8.50 because of increased usage of the online booking tool. The transaction fee for call-in reservations is \$19.

In August and September, more than 70 percent of Postal Service employees booked air travel through Trip Manager for the first time since the inception of the contract. In April 2002, the Postal Service awarded a national travel services management contract to Omega World Travel, which incorporated Trip Manager, an online self-booking tool for travel. All Postal Service employees are required to use Trip Manager when making official travel

plans, including those travelers using a centrally billed account (CBA). The commodity management travel team recently made the changes necessary for CBA travelers to use Trip Manager.
