

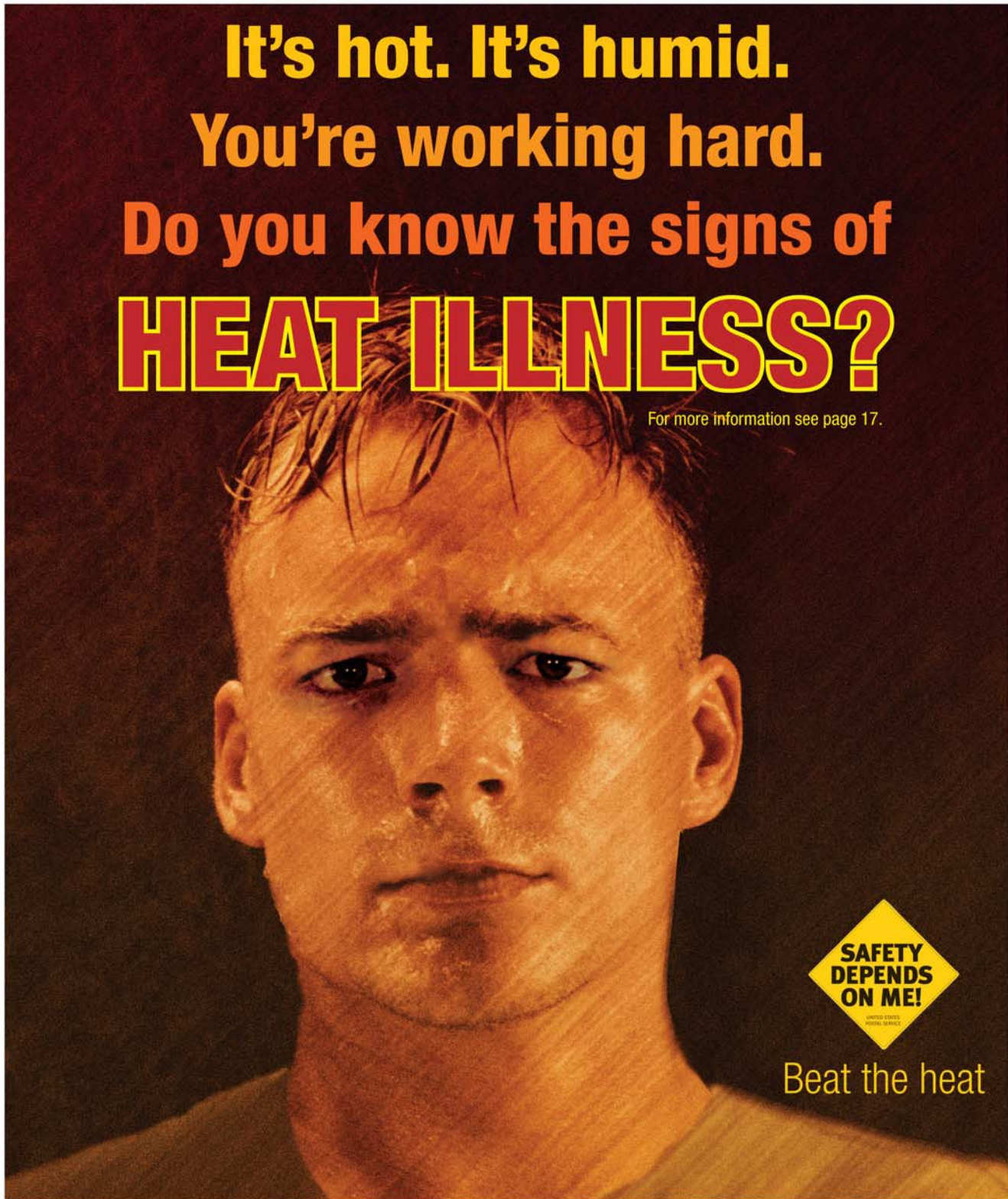

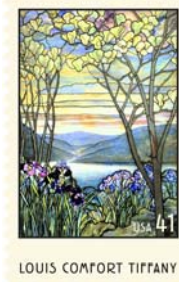

Do you know the signs of heat illness?

It's hot. It's humid. You and your co-workers are working hard. One of you could be suffering from heat exhaustion or heat stroke. Be aware of the symptoms of heat illness and the actions you should take.

The symptoms of *heat exhaustion* include headaches, dizziness, lightheadedness, weakness, mood changes, irritability, confusion, nausea, fainting, decreased or dark-colored urine and pale, clammy skin. Take steps to cool yourself or the victim off by moving to a cool, shaded area, drinking cool water and loosening or removing heavy clothing.

The symptoms of *heat stroke* include those listed above plus dry, pale skin with no sweating, hot skin that looks sunburned, seizures and the inability to revive from an unconscious state. If you think it's a heat stroke, call 911 immediately, and cool yourself or the victim off.

The best way to prevent heat illness is to drink plenty of fluids.

USPS to re-issue Purple Heart stamp in August

The Postal Service is issuing the *Purple Heart* stamp at the First-Class Mail price of 41 cents. The stamp goes on sale in August.

This is the third issue of the *Purple Heart* definitive postage stamp, which was first issued May 30, 2003, in Mount Vernon, VA. The second issuance was May 26, 2006, during the 75th anniversary of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

The stamp image features a photograph by Ira Wexler of one of two Purple Hearts awarded to James Loftus Fowler of Alexandria, VA. A Lt. Col. in the U.S. Marines, Fowler was serving as a battalion commander when he received the Purple Heart in 1968, following action close to the Ben Hai River in Vietnam.

The Postal Service showcased its new rates and shipping solutions for thousands of eBay entrepreneurs attending *eBay Live! 2007*, held last month at the Boston, MA, Convention and Exhibition Center.



Several workshops taught attendees about the changes to domestic rates and international mail. They also learned about PayPal MultiOrder Shipping Solution — USPS' solution to eBay success. It allows customers to manage all eBay and PayPal shipments in one place, print multiple Postal Service domestic shipping labels with one click, and link shipments to the newly launched Shipment Confirmation Acceptance Notice (SCAN). SCAN forms contain Intelligent Mail barcodes that hold information on all shipping labels and packages in the same shipment.

Mobile security: Mail screening hits the road



The United States Postal Inspection Service is taking its act on the road.

The new Mobile Mail Screening Station (MMSS) is a self-sufficient screening station that can detect chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive threats. The inaugural assignment for MMSS was the Global Initiative to Combat Nuclear Terrorism Conference held in Miami.

The Technical Services Division of the Postal Inspection Service designed the vehicle and wrote the specifications. The 53-foot custom tractor and trailer contains eight functional areas designed to accommodate existing and future technology. The facility requires a staff of five to eight people.

Beacons that beckon: USPS commemorates historic lighthouses

The Postal Service is recognizing five historic Pacific lighthouses with new commemorative stamps — featuring Hawaii's Diamond Head Light, Five Finger Islands Light in Alaska, Grays Harbor Light in Washington, Oregon's Umpqua River Light and St. George Reef Light in California.

The first-day-of-issue ceremony was held at the Westport, WA, Maritime Museum, which owns and operates the Grays Harbor Light under the 2004 National Historic Lighthouse Preservation Act.

DMM Revision: Postal Service Precancellation Handstamps and Electroplates Discontinued

Effective July 5, 2007, we are discontinuing use of the few remaining Postal Service™ precancellation handstamps and precancellation electroplates. Once used to precancel limited quantities of postage stamps, these devices no longer have a functional purpose in the Postal Service. Post Offices™, stations, and branches must discontinue the use of these devices and destroy them locally to ensure that they are no longer usable.

We will update 604.3.0 of *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* with the following revisions.

3.0 Precanceled Stamps

3.1 General Information

3.1.1 Definition

[Revise 3.1.1 as follows:]

Precanceling is the cancellation of adhesive postage, stamped envelopes, or stamped cards before mailing. Precanceling may be done by the mailer under a postal permit, or mailers may purchase precanceled stamps bearing a rate category from the USPS.

3.3 Precancellation of Stamps by USPS

[Delete 3.3.1, Stamps Precanceled by USPS. Renumber 3.3.2 as new 3.3. Revise the first sentence as follows:]

Precanceled stamps are preprinted with a rate category as the precancellation method.***

DMM Revision: Preparing AADC Letter Trays on SCF Pallets

Effective July 5, 2007, the Postal Service™ is providing an option for mailers to place automation area distribution center (AADC) trays of Periodicals and Standard Mail letters on Sectional Center Facility (SCF) pallets. This option is available when the 3-digit ZIP Code™ on the AADC tray is within the SCF's service area. Pieces in the AADC trays would be eligible for destination bulk mail center (DBMC) entry rates, but not DSCF rates.

We will incorporate these changes in 246.3.0, 705.8.0, and 707.28.2 of *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* as noted below. We encourage mailers to make the related changes to their mailings as soon as possible.

3.2 Eligibility

[Revise 3.2 to add SCF deposit and restructure as follows:]

Pieces in a mailing that meet the standards in 2.0 and 3.0 are eligible for DBMC rates when they meet all of the following conditions:

- a. The pieces are deposited at a BMC, ASF, or SCF under 3.3.
- b. The pieces are addressed for delivery to one of the 3-digit ZIP Codes served by the BMC or ASF where deposited (see Exhibit 3.1).
- c. The pieces are properly placed in a tray or pallet that is labeled to the BMC or ASF where deposited, or labeled to a postal facility within the service area of that BMC or ASF (see Exhibit 3.1).

3.3 Eligibility for ADC or AADC Mailpieces

[Revise 3.3 as follows:]

All pieces in an ADC sack or tray or AADC tray are eligible for DBMC rates if the ADC or AADC facility ZIP Code (in Line 1 of the container label) is within the service area of the BMC or ASF at which the sack or tray is deposited as shown in Exhibit 3.1. All pieces in a palletized ADC bundle are eligible for DBMC rates if the bundle is labeled to an ADC facility (determined by using the "Label To" ZIP Code in Column B of 004) within the service area of the BMC or ASF at which the pallet is deposited as shown in Exhibit 3.1. All pieces in an AADC tray properly placed on an SCF pallet under 705.8.10.2 are eligible for DBMC rates when the 3-digit ZIP Code on the tray label is within that SCF's service area according to L005.

DMM Revision: Customs Forms for Priority Mail To or From ZIP Codes Beginning “969” and ZIP Code 96799

Effective June 8, 2007, we revised *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to require customs declarations on all Priority Mail pieces weighing 16 ounces or more sent to or from ZIP Codes beginning with the prefix 969 and to or from ZIP Code 96799. As clarification, the affected “969” ZIP Codes are 96910 through 96940, and 96950 through 96952.

Customers must affix PS Form 2976-A, *Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note – CP72*, to these mailpieces. If PS Form 2976-A will not fit on the address side of the mailpiece, the customer must affix PS Form 2976, *Customs Declaration CN22 – Sender’s Declaration*.

2.4 Customs Forms Required

Regardless of contents, all Priority Mail weighing 16 ounces or more sent from the United States to ZIP Codes 96910–40, 96950–52, and 96799, and all Priority Mail sent from these ZIP Codes to the United States, must bear customs Form 2976-A. If Form 2976-A will not fit on the address side of the mailpiece, Form 2976 must be used. This mail must be presented to an employee at a post office, to a letter carrier when using Click-N-Ship with Carrier Pickup, or to a Postal Service employee designated by the postmaster.

DMM Revision: New Option to Update Mailing Lists for Automation Mailings

Effective July 5, 2007, we are revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to allow mailers to use a new process, Direct Delivery Point Validation or “DirectDPV,” as a valid coding method to qualify address lists for use in automation rate mailings.

The Postal Service™, in cooperation with the mailing industry, developed this new method to provide mailers an additional alternative to the current processes available to update mailers’ electronic mailing lists for automation rate mailings. Other methods for obtaining delivery point or ZIP+4® codes are by using the Coding Accuracy Support System (CASS)™-certified address matching software with components DPV™ and LACSLink™; CASS-certified Z4CHANGE process; NCOALink™; or DSF2™ process.

Similar to Z4CHANGE, DirectDPV™ has the distinctive feature of reducing frequency and increasing the speed with which address records are processed, minimizing expensive and time-consuming computer processing. CASS-certified address matching software using DirectDPV will quickly and efficiently identify delivery points

within a mailer’s list that have undergone changes and require updating.

Beginning with 2007–2008 Cycle L, CASS-certified address matching software with DPV™ and LACSLink™ will assign a ZIP+4 code to an address record only when the primary address number is DPV confirmed. DirectDPV is a database table with five years of data that will indicate when delivery point changes occur.

DirectDPV will help many mailers by eliminating the need to reprocess their entire address list each time address updating is performed. This new process identifies only those records where changes have occurred so only address records that require updating need to be reprocessed for matching and coding.

Mailers who take advantage of DirectDPV must comply with the following requirements: First, address lists must be completely reprocessed using any of the approved matching and coding methods noted above, except the Z4CHANGE process. This complete processing of the address lists need to be performed only once a year thereafter. Then on a semi-annual basis, the address lists, using only addresses that have been delivery point

barcoded, are processed against the DirectDPV product to identify only those records that have changed within the past 6 months.

Addresses identified through DirectDPV as having changed, and new addresses that were not previously coded with a CASS Cycle L-compliant software product, become the only records that must be reprocessed through CASS-certified address matching software to obtain the current ZIP+4 code or delivery point code.

Mailers must develop, buy, or lease software to access the DirectDPV file. As with address matching software used to qualify mail for postage discounts, DirectDPV access software must pass Postal Service certification before the software may be used on address lists for automation mailings. Mailers using a vendor's certified DirectDPV product without modification are automatically certified.

3.0 Coding Accuracy Support System (CASS)

3.1 Basic Information

3.1.3 Methods

[Revise 3.1.3 to include DirectDPV as follows:]

Delivery point or ZIP+4 coding may be obtained by using the CASS-certified DPC address matching software with components DPV and LACS^{Link}; CASS-certified Z4CHANGE process; CASS-certified DirectDPV process; NCOA^{Link}; or DSF² process.

3.3 Date of Address Matching and Coding

3.3.1 Update Standards

[Revise the first sentence in 3.3.1 to include DirectDPV as follows:]

Unless Z4CHANGE or DirectDPV is used, all automation and carrier route mailings bearing addresses coded by any AIS product must be coded with current CASS-certified software and the current USPS database.***

[Add new 3.3.3, DirectDPV List Matching, as follows:]

3.3.3 DirectDPV List Matching

When using DirectDPV to match and code address lists for automation rate mailings:

- a. The entire address list must first be matched and ZIP+4 coded with Cycle L (or later) CASS-certified software and the current USPS ZIP+4 product.
- b. Every 180 days after the initial matching, the address list must be processed through DirectDPV using Cycle L (or later) CASS-certified address matching software to identify changed records since the last update.
- c. If an address record was previously ZIP+4 coded and that ZIP+4 code is not in DirectDPV, it does not need to be run through CASS-certified address matching software until the annual run. Address records identified as changed through DirectDPV that have a valid converted 11-digit record require additional processing. These records can either be reconstructed using the 11-digit code provided or reprocessed through CASS-certified software. Address records identified as changed through DirectDPV that have a zero 11-digit code must then be matched and coded using Cycle L (or later) CASS-certified address matching software and the current USPS ZIP+4 product.
- d. The entire address list must be processed once a year using current CASS-certified address matching software and the current USPS ZIP+4 product.

3.6 CASS Certification

3.6.1 Testing Arrangements

[Revise 3.6.1 as follows:]

To obtain information on standards and arrange for testing of carrier route, ZIP+4, or delivery point address matching software, contact the National Customer Support Center by calling 1-800-238-3150, or by writing to the CASS Certification Department, National Customer Support Center (see 608.8.0 for address).

3.6.4 Certification Standards

[Revise 3.6.4 as follows:]

To be CASS-certified:

- a. Delivery point code address matching software/hardware must correctly ZIP+4 code the addresses in the Stage II file or test deck with an accuracy rate determined by the CASS Certification Department and must correctly append the additional two digits of the delivery point code (plus a check digit) to the Stage II file or test deck with 100% accuracy.
- b. A 2-digit utility (separate or stand-alone address matching software that appends only the correct 2-digit DP9019C information) must use the standardized address information returned by DPC address matching software when determining the correct delivery point code. A 2-digit utility must assign the

2-digit delivery point code (plus a check digit) to the addresses in the Stage II file with 100% accuracy.

- c. Address matching software used to assign 5-digit ZIP Codes and carrier route codes must assign the appropriate codes to the Stage II file with an accuracy rate determined by the CASS Certification Department.

Appendix E, Ordering Safe Driver Testing and Training Materials

This section describes how to order instructional materials associated with the Safe Driver Program, including materials for testing, classroom instruction, and the Defensive Driver Course.

Introduction

Instructional materials associated with the Safe Driver Program are available through the Material Distribution Center (MDC). The Postal Employee Development Center (PEDC) is responsible for ordering materials as needed, but other functions, such as Safety, can also order materials.

Depending on the course, the instructional materials include printed matter, videos, CDs, posters, and forms that are used in training.

For any course with a qualifying exam, only certified District examiners are authorized to order selection and testing materials.

Instructions for Ordering

Testing Materials: Exams 804 and 806

A Driver Safety Instructor (DSI) certified by the National Test Administration Center (NTAC) must request forms and other materials from NTAC through the District examination administrators. The DSI should maintain a 6-month supply of materials.

Defensive Driving Course Materials

Order the National Safety Council's Defensive Driving Course materials from MDC. Use the following numbers:

Equipment Maintenance Allowance Schedule for Rural Routes

Rural Carriers

In accordance with provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.3 of the Rural Carrier National Agreement, effective July 7, 2007 (pay period 15-07), the equipment maintenance allowance (EMA) will increase from 48.0 cents per mile to 53.0 cents per mile. The EMA is 53.0 cents per mile, or a minimum of \$21.20 per day, whichever is greater.

Auxiliary Rural Carriers, Rural Carrier Reliefs, Rural Carrier Associates, Rural Carrier Part-Time Flexibles, and Auxiliary Assistance

Employees providing auxiliary assistance or serving auxiliary routes under provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.5, receive an EMA of 53.0 cents per mile or \$5.90 per hour, whichever is greater. This EMA should not exceed the amount provided in the special equipment maintenance allowance for the route stops and miles.

Safety Talk: Do You Know the Signs of Heat Illness?

It's hot. It's humid. You're working hard. You — or one of your coworkers — could be suffering from heat exhaustion or heat stroke. Be aware of the symptoms of heat illness and the actions you should take.

Heat Exhaustion

The symptoms of heat exhaustion include:

- Headaches.
- Dizziness or lightheadedness.
- Weakness.
- Mood changes, irritability, confusion or the inability to think clearly.
- Nausea and vomiting.
- Decreased or dark-colored urine.
- Fainting.
- Pale, clammy skin.

Act Immediately! If not treated, heat exhaustion can advance to heat stroke or death.

- Move the victim to a cool, shaded area. Don't leave the person alone.
- If symptoms include dizziness or lightheadedness, lay the victim on his or her back and raise legs 6 to 8 inches.
- If symptoms include nausea or vomiting, lay the victim on his or her side.
- Loosen and remove any heavy clothing.
- Give the person cool water to drink — about a cup every 15 minutes — unless he or she is nauseous or vomiting.
- Fan the victim and spray with a cool mist of water or apply a wet cloth to skin.
- Call 911 for emergency help if the person does not feel better in a few minutes.

Heat Stroke — A Medical Emergency

The symptoms of heat stroke include:

- Dry, pale skin with no sweating.
- Hot, red skin that looks sunburned.
- Mood changes, irritability, confusion or the inability to think clearly.
- Seizures.
- Inability to revive from an unconscious state.

Call 911 immediately for emergency help. Then:

- Move the victim to a cool, shaded area. Don't leave the person alone.
- Lay the victim on his or her back.
- If the victim is having seizures, move any nearby objects away.
- If symptoms include nausea or vomiting, lay the victim on his or her side.
- Loosen and remove any heavy clothing.
- Give the person cool water to drink — about a cup every 15 minutes — unless he or she is nauseous or vomiting.
- Fan the victim and spray with a cool mist of water or wipe the victim with a wet cloth or cover with a wet sheet.
- Place ice packs under the armpits and groin area.

Prevent Heat Illness

The best way to prevent heat illness: Drink plenty of fluids.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976–A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use – Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976–A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only First-Class Mail letters, Periodicals, and Standard Mail items are authorized.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

On August 4, 2007, in Clayton, New York, the Postal Service™ will issue 41-cent, Vintage Mahogany Speedboats commemorative stamps in four designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 12 (Item 461800). Designed by Carl T. Herrman of Carlsbad, California, the stamps go on sale nationwide August 4, 2007.

The stamps feature photographs of speedboats made by four major manufacturers — a 1915 Hutchinson Brothers Launch, a 1931 Gar Wood triple cockpit runabout, a 1939 Hacker-Craft, and a 1954 Chris-Craft Racing Runabout.

How to Order First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, or at The Postal Store® Web site at www.usps.com/shop, or by calling 800-STAMP-24. Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) will receive approximately 35 to 40 percent of their full standard automatic distribution quantity for a PSA sheet stamp. Distributions are rounded up to the nearest master carton size (24,000 stamps).

Initial Supply to Post Offices

SDOs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to Post Offices of one-fourth their full standard automatic distribution quantity using PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition/*

Stamp Return. SDOs must not distribute stamps to Post Offices before July 27, 2007.

Additional Supply

Post Offices requiring additional stamps must requisition Item 461800 from their designated SDO using PS Form 17. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate accountable paper depository (APD) using PS Form 17.

On August 9, 2007, in Portland, Oregon, the Postal Service™ will issue a 41-cent, *Louis Comfort Tiffany* commemorative stamp in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) double-sided booklet of 20 (Item

676900). Designed by Derry Noyes of Washington, DC, the stamp goes on sale nationwide August 9, 2007.

For this seventh issuance in the *American Treasures* stamp series, art director Derry Noyes of Washington, DC, chose the image of a memorial window designed by Louis Comfort Tiffany (American, 1848–1933). The window is *Magnolias and Irises*, ca. 1908, made by Tiffany Studios (1902–1938). The leaded Favrile-glass window, 60-1/4 x 42 in. (153 x 106.7 cm), was presented to the Metropolitan Museum of Art in 1981 as an anonymous gift in memory of Mr. and Mrs. A. B. Frank. (Photograph (c) 1981, the Metropolitan Museum of Art.)

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, and at The Postal Store® Web site at www.usps.com/shop.

Customers may submit #6 or #10 covers constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service™ recommends 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free envelopes, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. There is a minimum of 10 covers at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. You may submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. Two test envelopes must be included. For covers with graphics or lettering, please note the maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. The Postal Service reserves the right not to accept

hand painted and other cachets that are not compatible with our digital color postmark. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of non-specified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked within 60 days of the first day of issue date.

They should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to the following address:
