DMM Revision: New Option for Pallet Placards Bearing Intelligent Mail Container Barcodes

On March 2, 2009, the Postal Service™ revised *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 708.6.6 to provide a new option to mailers preparing pallets, or other approved containers, with pallet placards bearing Intelligent Mail® container barcodes. Current standards require that pallet placards prepared in the 8 inch by 11 inch format be affixed to the outside of any shrinkwrap or plastic by a self-adhesive or other adhesive means.

The revised standard permits, until November 29, 2009, pallet placards prepared in the 8 inch by 11 inch format and bearing Intelligent Mail barcodes to be affixed beneath shrinkwrap or plastic. Mailers must affix placards so as to not obscure any required element of the placards and so that the placards remain secure throughout USPS® processing. Mailers are reminded that placards prepared in

the 4 inch by 7 inch optional format must continue to be affixed to the outside of any shrinkwrap or plastic by a self-adhesive or other adhesive means.

Beginning November 29, 2009, all placards bearing Intelligent Mail container barcodes must be affixed by self-adhesive or other adhesive means to the outside of the shrinkwrap or plastic, as described in DMM 708.6.6.5.

These revisions were incorporated into the March 2, 2009, update of the online DMM available via Postal Explorer® at <http://pe.usps.com> and will be included in the next printed version of the DMM.

IMM Revision: Revised PS Form 2976-A, Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note — CP 72

Effective April 6, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) parts 123 and 324 to reflect changes to PS Form 2976-A, *Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note — CP 72*. The newly revised PS Form 2976-A has an edition date of January 2009. An image of Copy 1 of the revised form appears on page [6](#) in this issue of the *Postal Bulletin*.

Summary of Changes

Listed below is a summary of the changes to PS Form 2976-A:

- For customer convenience, the revised form includes a tear-off Instructions page. In the previous edition, the instructions were included on the back of the Sender's copy along with the Parcel Indemnity Statement and Privacy Act Statement.
- The Instructions page is updated with the following information:
 - a) Additional guidance on parcel indemnity coverage.
 - b) The current Filing Claims Statement.
 - c) The current Privacy Act Statement.
- The revised form is reformatted to include color changes to the font and to provide more clearly defined spacing for written information, which will

assist the user in entering information and will enable the Postal Service to efficiently capture data for electronic data entry of customs information.

Use of Previous and Revised Customs Forms

Upon receipt, mailers may immediately begin using the revised form. Postmasters should encourage customers to use the revised PS Form 2976-A as soon as possible. For ease of use, mailers also have the option of completing and printing Customs declarations electronically at <https://webapps.usps.com/customsforms>.

Availability of Forms

The revised PS Form 2976-A is available at the Material Distribution Center (MDC). To ensure that sufficient forms are available, Post Office™ facilities should order no more than a 2-month supply.

Use the eBay on-catalog requisition system to order PS Form 2976-A from the MDC by searching for items using the PSIN or PSN listed below (without the dashes). If your office does not have access to eBay, you may order using touch-tone order entry (TTOE): Call 800-273-1509.

- i. In block (7), note any restrictions that pertain to block 12.
- j. In block (8), enter the total gross weight in pounds and ounces.
- k. In block (9), enter the total value of all items in U.S. dollars.
- l. In block (10), provide disposal instructions in the event that the package cannot be delivered. Check the appropriate box to indicate whether the package is to be returned, treated as abandoned, or forwarded to an alternate address. Undeliverable packages returned to the sender are, upon delivery, subject to collection of return postage and any other charges assessed by the foreign postal authorities. If you are unwilling to pay return postage, check the box “Treat as Abandoned.”
- m. In block (11), enter the applicable Exemption or Exclusion Legend, Proof of Filing Citation, or AES Downtime Citation.
- n. In block (12), provide details if the contents are subject to quarantine (plant, food products, etc.).
- o. In block (13), sign and date the form. The sender's signature certifies that all entries are correct and that the item contains no dangerous article prohibited by postal or other regulations.
- p. In blocks (14), (15), (16), (17), (18), and (19), enter the applicable number if the item requires a sender's customs reference or importer's reference, or if the item is accompanied by a license, certificate, or invoice.
- q. In blocks (20) and (21) — which are for commercial items only (i.e., goods exported/imported in the course of a business transaction whether or not they are sold for money or exchanged) — enter, if known, the HS tariff number (which is the six-digit number based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System developed by the World Customs Organization) and the country of origin (which is the country where the goods originated — i.e., where the goods were produced, manufactured, or assembled).
- r. Affix PS Form 2976-A according to the class of mail, as follows:
 - (1) For a Priority Mail International parcel, with the exception of the flat-rate envelope and small flat-rate box, allow the Postal Service employee to

complete PS Form 2976-A as described in 123.722, place the form set inside PS Form 2976-E (plastic envelope), and affix it to the address side of the package.

- (2) For a Priority Mail International flat-rate envelope or small flat-rate box or a First-Class Mail International item valued at \$400 or more, or if you do not want to list the contents on the outside wrapper, affix the upper portion only of PS Form 2976 (green label) (cut on the dotted line and discard the lower portion) to the address side of the package, complete PS Form 2976-A, and enclose the form set inside the package.

Notice 180, Lobby Recycling Postcard

Postmasters participating in the Post Office Box Lobby Recycling Program must make sure that each PO Box customer is notified about the program using Notice 180, which is now available at the Material Distribution Center (MDC). The success of the lobby recycling program depends upon customer awareness.

Notice 180 invites PO Box customers to recycle their mail in specially designed recycling containers that the Postal Service™ recently deployed to 2,000 Post Offices having PO Box lobbies nationwide. These secure containers carry the message, “Read, Respond, Recycle Your Mail.” Notice 180 also emphasizes the importance of recycling mail through the community’s recycling program, since some customers will take their mail home with them rather than recycle it in the Post Office™ lobby.

The Postal Service can make significant reductions in its solid waste disposal costs if customers recycle their mail after they have finished with it. By offering customers the opportunity to recycle their mail right in the lobby, USPS® can also play an important role in meeting customers’ environmental expectations.

Service Talk: Cyber Security Reminders

As we all become increasingly computer literate and get used to various ways to access the Internet anytime from virtually anywhere, we have to also become more aware of how we store the vast amounts of personal and business information in databases at our fingertips. Organizations such as the Postal Service™ are prime targets for persons who would steal this information. By establishing good basic security habits, you can prevent a compromise of sensitive personal and business information caused by (or resulting from) a cyber intrusion.

Authorized and Limited Personal Use of Information Technology

- Use Postal Service technology for business purposes. The technology that you use at work is primarily for the authorized business of the Postal Service. It's there to help you do your job.
- Limit personal use of desktop and laptop computers, e-mail, and Internet access. To protect yourself and the Postal Service, you should consult the acceptable use policy and discuss this use with your supervisor. A clear understanding of the limitations on this privilege can help you avoid unnecessary problems.
- Do not install your own software or any product from an outside vendor on a Postal Service system without permission from Information Technology.

Password Protection

- Keep your password secret and choose passwords that are very hard to guess. Make sure each password is at least eight characters in length and includes upper and lowercase letters and numbers. You also may use special characters such as "&," "#," and "\$." Avoid simple English words, proper names, or personal data, such as birthdays, addresses, or telephone numbers.
- When you leave your desktop or laptop unattended, use the password-protected screensaver or log off the network.
- Change your password immediately if you think it has been compromised, and telephone or e-mail the Postal Service Computer Incident Response Team by calling 866-USPSCIRT (866-877-7247) or by sending an e-mail to USPSCIRT@usps.gov.

E-mail

- Do not open messages or attachments sent to you by strangers. E-mail can easily and quietly spread viruses and cause other problems to our computer network.
- Do not initiate or forward e-mail chain letters, messages that contain possible hoaxes, advertising, jokes, or other non-business messages.
- Do not preview "spam" messages and do not click the "unsubscribe" within spam messages. Just delete them entirely. You may also put the sender into your junk mail file.

Safe Handling of Information Resources

- Do not leave restricted, personal, or sensitive hardcopy information in public areas.
- Backup your work regularly to protect it from loss, and ensure that the backup is stored securely.
- If a sensitive data file must be removed from Postal Service premises, first obtain approval from your manager before removing the paper or electronic data. Secure the electronic data per an approved encryption method. For instructions on encrypting sensitive files, visit the Information Security Awareness page at <http://ITWebShare.usps.gov>.

- At Post Offices.
- At Automated Postal Centers[®] (APCs[®]).
- Through third-party insurance providers (i.e., Endicia, Stamps.com).

Benefits for customers filing their claim(s) online include the following:

- Easy access to upload evidence (.jpg or .pdf) to substantiate their claim.
- Claim status checks.
- Viewable claim history of other claims filed online.
- Immediate transfer of claims to USPS Accounting Services for claim resolution and adjudication.
- Customer support 7 days per week, 7 A.M.–11 P.M. EST by e-mail at icustomer@usps.com.

After signing in to USPS.com[®], customers will need to provide:

- Their insurance article number.
- Their transaction number (for Click-N-Ship claims) or the auction number (for eBay claims).
- Proof of value (all claims) and a description of the damage (damaged claims/missing content only).
- Claim description and details for a lost or damaged claim. Customers may receive a letter notifying them to bring their damaged article and packaging to the Post Office[™].

Revised PS Form 1000, Domestic or International Claim

To streamline and synchronize claim procedures, we are implementing a new claim form, which may be used for both domestic and international claims. The new PS Form 1000, *Domestic or International Claim*, will replace all previous versions of PS Form 1000 and PS Form 2855, *Claim for Indemnity — International Registered Mail, Insured, Ordinary Parcel and Express Mail*, which are now obsolete. The Post Office employee section has been eliminated on PS Form 1000. Customers will be able to submit the claim form by mail directly to Accounting Services in St. Louis. PS Form 1000 will be a one-ply form. It will be available from the Material Distribution Center (MDC). We will publish ordering information in a future *Postal Bulletin*. It will also be available online on Blue and www.usps.com (see copy of form on pages [13–14](#)).

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

Exceptions: All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

On April 9, 2009, in Chicago, Illinois, the Postal Service™ will issue a 61-cent, *Richard Wright* commemorative stamp in one design in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 113000). Designed by Carl T. Herrman of Carlsbad, California, the stamp goes on sale nationwide April 9, 2009.

With this 25th stamp in the *Literary Arts* series, the U.S. Postal Service® honors author Richard Wright (1909–1960). Best remembered for his controversial 1940 novel, *Native Son*, and 1945 autobiography, *Black Boy*, Wright drew on a wide range of literary traditions, including protest writing and detective fiction, to craft unflinching portrayals of racism in American society.

The stamp artwork by Kadir Nelson, San Diego, California, features a portrait of Richard Wright in front of snow-swept tenements on the South Side of Chicago, a scene that recalls the setting of *Native Son*. Nelson's portrait of Wright was based on a circa 1945 photograph.

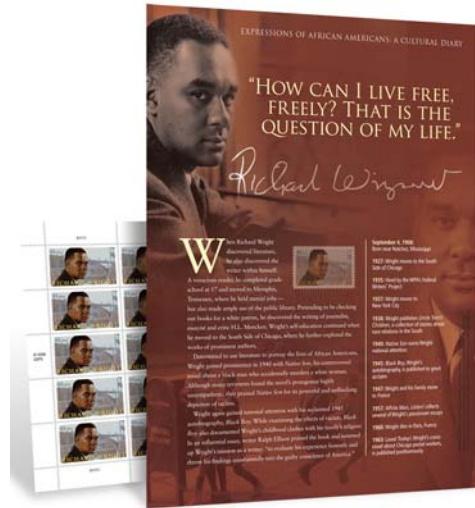

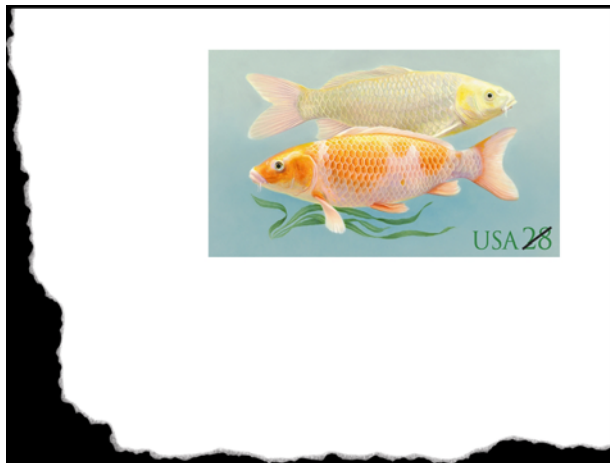

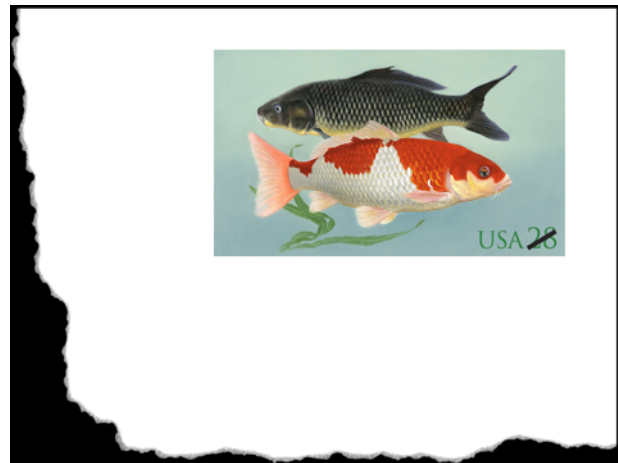

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of those postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of non-specified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

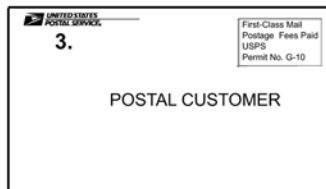
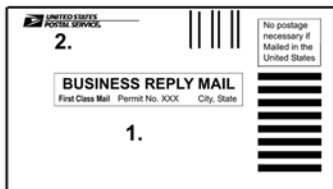
