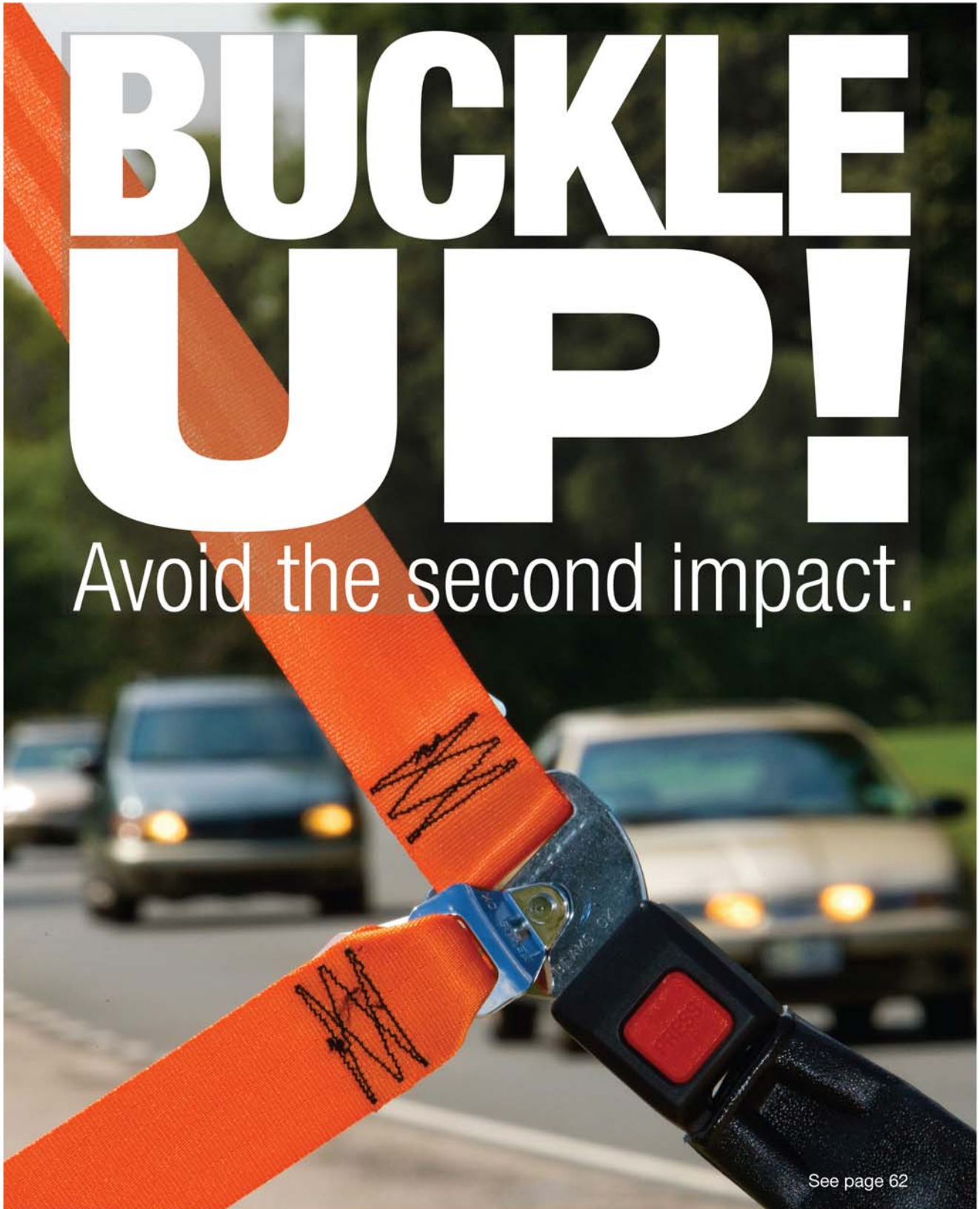

DMM Revision: Change in Intelligent Mail Barcode Requirements for Qualified Business Reply Mail and Permit Reply Mail

Effective September 8, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 507.9.3.1, 507.9.9, 507.10.3.6, and 708.4.3.1 to revise the timeline and mailing standards to postpone the Intelligent Mail® barcode (IMb) requirement for qualified Business Reply Mail® (QBRM) and permit reply mail (PRM) pieces until May 2011.

In a *Federal Register* final rule (73 FR 49333–46348) published on August 21, 2008, the Postal Service™ included a requirement for IMbs for qualified QBRM letters and cards and PRM pieces to be effective in May 2010. Revising the timeline is consistent with the IMb requirement for automation letters, flats, and other BRM pieces.

- f. Bears the correct Intelligent Mail barcode (required in May 2011) or POSTNET barcode (until May 2011) that corresponds to the unique ZIP+4 code in the address on each piece distributed. The barcode must be correctly prepared under 9.9 and 708.4.0.

9.9 Additional Standards for Letter-Size and Flat-Size BRM

[Revise the introductory text of 9.9 to change the effective date of the IMb requirement to May 2011 as follows:]

In addition to the format standards in 9.8, letter-size BRM enclosed in automation mailings and all QBRM must be barcoded with a ZIP+4 POSTNET barcode (only until May 2011) or an Intelligent Mail barcode. Intelligent Mail barcodes on all BRM must contain the barcode ID, service type ID, and correct ZIP+4 routing code, as specified under 708.4.3. All BRM letters must bear Intelligent Mail barcodes (with a USPS-assigned Mailer ID, except when using origin OneCode Confirm under 503.13.3.2) effective May 2011.

10.3.6 Delivery Address

[Revise text to change the required date for IMb to May 2011 as follows:]

The complete address (including the permit holder's name, delivery address, city, state, and ZIP+4 code) must be printed on the piece. PRM pieces must bear a delivery point POSTNET barcode (until May 2011) or Intelligent Mail barcode (required in May 2011). Effective May 2011, PRM pieces must bear Intelligent Mail barcodes (under 708.4.3) with delivery point routing codes and USPS-assigned Mailer IDs.

4.3 Intelligent Mail Barcodes

Intelligent Mail barcodes must include the Mailer ID in the Mailer Identifier field.***

DMM Revision: Labeling List Changes

Effective August 3, 2009, we revised Labeling List(s) L001, L007, L009, L201, and L606 of the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* to reflect changes in mail processing operations. Mailers are encouraged to label according to these revised lists immediately, but must comply by October 15, 2009.

Along with the operational changes currently taking place, all Bulk Mail Centers (BMCs) will be renamed Network Distribution Centers (NDCs). All BMC-related materials and correspondence will be updated to reflect the name change. The following labeling lists are affected by this change:

L600 Standard Mail and Package Services

[Revise the heading and the introductory paragraph of L601 to reflect the mail processing operation change by renaming BMC to NDC as follows:]

L601 Network Distribution Centers (NDCs)

L601 describes the service area by individual 3-digit ZIP Code prefix for sorting mail to NDC destinations. Use this list for:

- a. Standard Mail parcels and NFMs except ASF mail (other than mail for the Buffalo ASF service area) prepared and claimed at DBMC prices. Parcels and NFMs for the Buffalo ASF service area prepared and claimed at DBMC prices must be sorted to the Pittsburgh NDC.
- b. Standard Mail bundles, letter trays, or sacks on pallets.
- c. Bound Printed Matter machinable parcels except ASF mail (other than mail for the Buffalo ASF service area) prepared and claimed at DBMC prices. Machinable parcels for the Buffalo ASF service area prepared and claimed at DBMC prices must be sorted to the Pittsburgh NDC.
- d. Bound Printed Matter bundles or sacks on pallets.
- e. Parcel Post except for ASF mail (other than mail for the Buffalo ASF service area) prepared and claimed at DBMC prices and nonmachinable BMC Presort or OBMC Presort mail. Machinable parcels for the Buffalo ASF service area prepared and claimed at DBMC prices must be sorted to the Pittsburgh NDC. Nonmachinable parcels for the Buffalo ASF service area claimed at DBMC prices may be sorted to the Pittsburgh NDC if bedloaded and presented with machinable parcels.
- f. Presorted Media Mail and Presorted Library Mail to NDC destinations.

For labeling, mixed BMC sacks and pallets, mailers must add "MXD" before the Column B information of the NDC serving the 3-digit ZIP Code prefix of the Post Office at which the mail is entered.

[Revise the second footnote in the L601 to reflect the mail processing operation change by renaming BMC to NDC as follows:]

IMM Revision: Mailing Standards Reorganization for Global Express Guaranteed, Express Mail International, Priority Mail International, and First-Class Mail International Services

Effective September 8, 2009, the Postal Service™ is reorganizing *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) subchapters 210, 220, 230, and 240 to enhance clarity and to improve ease-of-use.

This reorganization for Global Express Guaranteed®, Express Mail International®, Priority Mail International™, and First-Class Mail International™ services will increase customers' ability to find information in the IMM. It also closely aligns with our recent reorganizations for International Priority Airmail™ service (part 292) and International Surface Air Lift® service (part 293), in which we organized these mail classifications by the following topics:

- a. Description and physical characteristics.

- b. Prices and postage payment methods.
- c. Mail preparation.
- d. Mail entry and deposit.

There are no substantive changes with these revisions; however, editorial changes are made throughout for clarity and consistency.

IMM Revision: International Business Reply Service — Updates

Effective October 5, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) section 382.6 to provide updates to our format standards for mailers who use International Business Reply Service (IBRS).

Consistent with the article titled “DMM Revision: New Barcode Placement Standards for Automation Letters” in *Postal Bulletin* 22264 (7-30-09, page 6), we are revising IMM standards for IBRS mailpieces to increase the upper limit of the allowable vertical placement for a POSTNET™ or an Intelligent Mail® barcode placed in the lower right corner of IBRS mailpieces to 1/2 inch from the bottom of the mailpiece. This new standard will provide an additional 1/16 inch of vertical clearance for mailers choosing to print a barcode in the lower right corner.

In addition, we are making minor changes to the format requirements in section 382.6 and are updating Exhibit 382.6 accordingly. These additional changes include the following:

1. Consistent with DMM 202.5.1, the barcode clear zone is defined by the area that extends 5/8 of an inch from the bottom and 4-3/4 inches from the right

edge of the mailpiece. Previously, we identified this area as 5/8 of an inch from the bottom and 4-1/2 inches from the right edge of the mailpiece.

2. Also, consistent with DMM 202.5.1, when the barcode is printed in the lower right corner of the mailpiece, the leftmost bar must be between 3-1/2 inches and 4-1/4 inches from the right edge of the mailpiece. Previously, we identified this area as between 3-1/4 inches and 4-1/4 inches from the right edge of the mailpiece (we had noted the area only in Exhibit 382.6, but we are also codifying this in section 382.63).
3. For ease-of-use and clarity, we are adding other identifiers to the image in Exhibit 382.6.

IMM Revision: Global Express Guaranteed Participating 3-Digit ZIP Codes — Update

Effective October 5, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) Exhibit 215.1 to reflect that we are introducing Global Express Guaranteed® (GXG®) service in Hawaii to certain Post Office™ facilities in the 968 3-digit ZIP™ Code service area.

POM and Handbook F-101 Revision: Replacement of PS Form 1096 With PS Form 3544 for Retail Window Service Transactions

Effective immediately, the *Postal Operations Manual* (POM) and Handbook F-101, *Field Accounting Procedures*, are revised to discontinue the use of PS Form 1096, *Receipt*, for retail window service transactions. PS Form 3544, *USPS Receipt for Money or Services*, is now used for retail window service transactions. **Exception:** PSIN# 13 (Routing Slip) replaces PS Form 1096 when issuing temporary cash receipts for local emergency purchases.

However, rural carriers will continue to use PS Form 1096 according to procedures stated in Handbook PO-603, *Rural Carrier Duties and Responsibilities*. A revision to PS Form 1096 is forthcoming, which will restrict usage to rural carrier and highway contract route (HCR) transactions only. Prior to availability of revised PS Forms 1096, issue the current version to rural carriers and HCRs only.

The online version of PS Form 1096 will be removed from the Postal Forms webpage; all replenishment orders must be made through the Material Distribution Center (MDC).

Postal retail units (PRUs) must ensure all PS Forms 1096 are removed from the retail window area and manual PS Forms 3544 (7/04 edition) are on hand to provide customers with manual receipts when electronic receipts are not available. POS and IRT units must have books of PS Forms 3544 on hand to provide customer receipts in the event of a system failure or power outage.

PRUs issue PS Forms 3544 in sequential number order, which provides required financial controls for manual customer receipts created outside electronic USPS® reporting systems (POS and IRT). For proper verification of receipts, only issue receipts from one book of PS Forms 3544 at a time. (Do not issue a receipt from a new book of PS Forms 3544 until the last receipt issued from the book is currently in use). See subchapter 3.7 in Handbook F-101 for using and controlling accountable receipts.

eMOVES units will continue to use PS Form 3544 to support PS Form 1412 entries, per current policy. Additionally, eMOVES units will issue PS Form 3544 as customer receipts for purchases when receipts are requested by the customer.

After the money order is issued to the carrier, annotate on PS Form 3544 that the money order was issued and include the date. In all other

respects, money order procedures for highway contract route carriers are the same as for rural carriers.

Handbook F-101 Revision: Updates to Support POS ONE Software Release 38.0 (Enhancements to POS Closeout and Financial Differences)

Effective immediately, Handbook F-101 is revised to support POS ONE Software Release 38.0. New functionality for software release 38.0 for point-of-service (POS) transactions will provide messaging during the retail associate (RA) and unit-close workflows to enhance procedures for closing out the day's business and verifying the PS Form 1412 and the supporting documentation that accompanies it.

Release 38.0 workflows for financial adjustments are being revised to increase financial control, reduce accounting inconsistencies, and ensure timely clearance. This new functionality will generate a reference number when creating a financial difference (AIC 247 or AIC 647). The reference number will be used for reporting and tracking the financial adjustment and will be required when clearing a financial adjustment. All clearing entries are linked directly to the original financial adjustment. New messaging will be displayed at "Start of Day" to inform RAs when a financial adjustment memorandum is assigned to them for clearance.

Postal retail units (PRUs) using the POS system will no longer be required to complete a manual record (log) of financial differences (AIC 247/647 activities). POS will generate a Financial Differences History — Unit Report to use as supporting documentation and to monitor expenses created or cleared locally via AIC 247 or AIC 647. PRUs must maintain a file with documentation/reports for all AIC 247/647 expenses (financial differences) created locally or issued by Accounting Services.

For AIC 247/647 expenses issued by Accounting Services, the following reports (or any combination) can be used as a detailed record and is approved supporting documentation:

- FPR Net Financial Differences (AIC 247/647) — Line Detail Report in the ADM.
- Narrowcast Report.

Note: For expenses not cleared (offset), annotate the reports with a reason.

The following options will be available in the Front Office for financial adjustments:

- Creating a financial adjustment (AIC 247 or AIC 647) with a reference number.
- Creating a cash transfer to another employee.
- Clearing a financial adjustment with a reference number.
- Entering a financial adjustment to offset an expense issued by Accounting Services (no reference number).

- Voiding a financial adjustment (AIC 247 or AIC 647).

The POS system will automatically create a reference number and a reason code for financial adjustment items when they are created from:

- Recovered transactions.
- Deposit adjustments created on the unit PS Form 1412 for a clerk deposit.
- Refunds of money orders or Sure Money that cannot be completed due to insufficient funds.

When a financial adjustment assigned to a retail associate (RA) is not cleared or reassigned by the end of the accountability session, the reference number, AIC, and amount will be printed on the bottom section of the RA's final PS Form 1412.

Electronic signature is an R-38 enhancement that replaces the required employee signature for PS Form 1412 certification with an electronic signature tied to the employee's logon ID. Employees are no longer required to sign the PS Form 1412.

Oracle Projects Implementation — New Capital Asset Transfer Process

The current process for capitalizing mail processing equipment for Engineering programs was replaced by a new module of the Oracle eBusiness financial suite, Oracle Projects, on August 4. Following the initial implementation of the new module in Engineering, the plan is to implement Oracle Projects solutions for the other functional organizations that require it.

Oracle Projects functionality enables the tracking of assets at a facility level ("location"). In support of this new functionality, PS Form 7340, *Property Transfer Request*, has been modified to include a Facility ID. The revised PS Form 7340 must be retained as support for all asset trans-

fers in the future. The transfers themselves will continue to be made via the Property and Equipment Accounting System (PEAS); a field for Facility IDs has been added to PEAS to enable location tracking.

Household Diary Study

The Postal Service's Household Diary Study (HDS), conducted since 1987, provides information about the contents of the mail sent and received by our customers in U.S. households. The Postal Service™ uses this information to help understand why and how customers use the mail. The results are used to:

- Forecast mail volume.
- Plan marketing strategies.
- Provide information for rate-setting purposes.

The HDS is administered at Headquarters by the Office of Demand Forecasting and Analysis, Finance. NuStats, the HDS survey research firm contractor since July 1999, conducts the interviews and collects and analyzes the HDS data throughout the year.

HDS is a two-stage survey. Stage 1 is the Household Interview. NuStats sends an advance letter, signed by the postmaster general, to a representative sample of U.S. households. This letter emphasizes the importance of the HDS and asks for participation. Sample households are contacted either by telephone or in person and asked about the mail they send and receive, their adoption and use of various communications' technologies, their attitudes about mail service in general, and information relating to their household and personal demographics. Respondent households are recruited to participate in HDS Stage 2.

Stage 2 is the Mail Diary. NuStats asks households that agree to participate in Stage 2 to record information about the mail they send and receive for a 7-day period from Monday to Sunday. Information recorded includes number

of mailpieces received and sent, industry mail source, mail characteristics, and attitudes regarding mail received. As an incentive for HDS Stage 2 participation, households are offered the options of receiving \$30 or a roll of 100 First-Class Mail® stamps.

Customers who participate in Stage 2 of the HDS can expect to receive their incentive about 2 months after they return the diary packet to NuStats.

Data gathered in both HDS stages is available in a final report, *The Household Diary Study — Mail Use and Attitudes*. The report is published in hard copy and an electronic file. Order forms for the latest HDS report may be obtained via the Postal Service Internet at www.usps.com/householddiary.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPO/DPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

Exceptions: All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.1c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Displaying the U.S. Flag and the POW-MIA Flag

U.S. Flag at Half-Staff

How to Display

Displaying the U.S. flag at *half-staff* means lowering the flag to half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.

Specific Dates

Display the U.S. flag at half-staff on the following days each year:

- May 15: Peace Officers Memorial Day (see note 1 below).
- Last Monday in May: Memorial Day Observed (see note 2 below).
- December 7: National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.

Note 1: When May 15, which is the date for Peace Officers Memorial Day, falls on the third Saturday in May, which is the date for Armed Forces Day, display the U.S. flag in the full-staff position, *not* at half-staff.

Note 2: On the last Monday in May, when Memorial Day is observed, display the flag at half-staff from sunrise, or the hour at which you raise it, until noon, and then hoist it to the peak of the staff, until the time of closing or no later than sunset.



POW-MIA Flag

How to Display

In relation to the U.S. flag, display the POW-MIA flag (and any other flag) as follows:

- If displayed on the same flagstaff, place it below the U.S. flag.
- If displayed on a separate flagstaff, place it at the same level or lower. If displayed at the same level, place it on the U.S. flag's left.

When flying the U.S. flag at half-staff, fly the POW-MIA flag (and any other flags) at half-staff also.



Specific Dates

Display the POW-MIA flag on the following days each year:

- Armed Forces Day: Third Saturday in May.
- Memorial Day: Last Monday in May.
- Flag Day: June 14.
- Independence Day: July 4.
- National POW-MIA Recognition Day: Third Friday in September.
- Veterans Day: November 11.

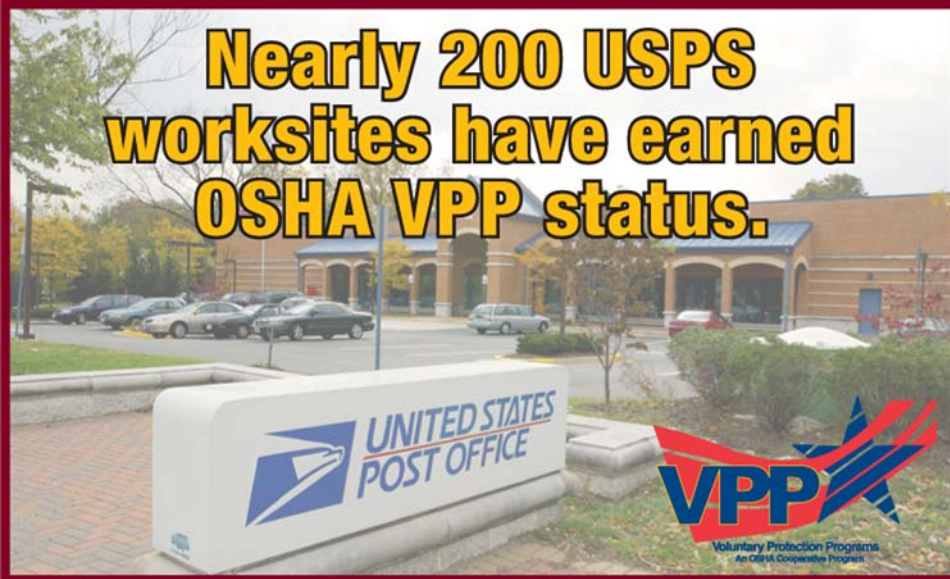
If any of these days fall on a nonbusiness day, display the POW-MIA flag on the last business day before the designated day.

Offices that are currently not participating in this program should expect to receive information and instructions on upcoming participation in this program on or before August 31, 2009.
- The *Mover's Guide* is printed and distributed three times per year — December (for January use), April (for May use), and August (for September use).
- Offices will receive *Mover's Guide* copies in one or two shipments. The first shipment arrived in mid-August. The second shipments will arrive 4 to 6 weeks later. Shipments will be sent in quantities of 25, 100, and 300. - Your facility may receive *Mover's Guide* copies addressed to other offices. If so, check the labels and forward the *Mover's Guide* copies as necessary.

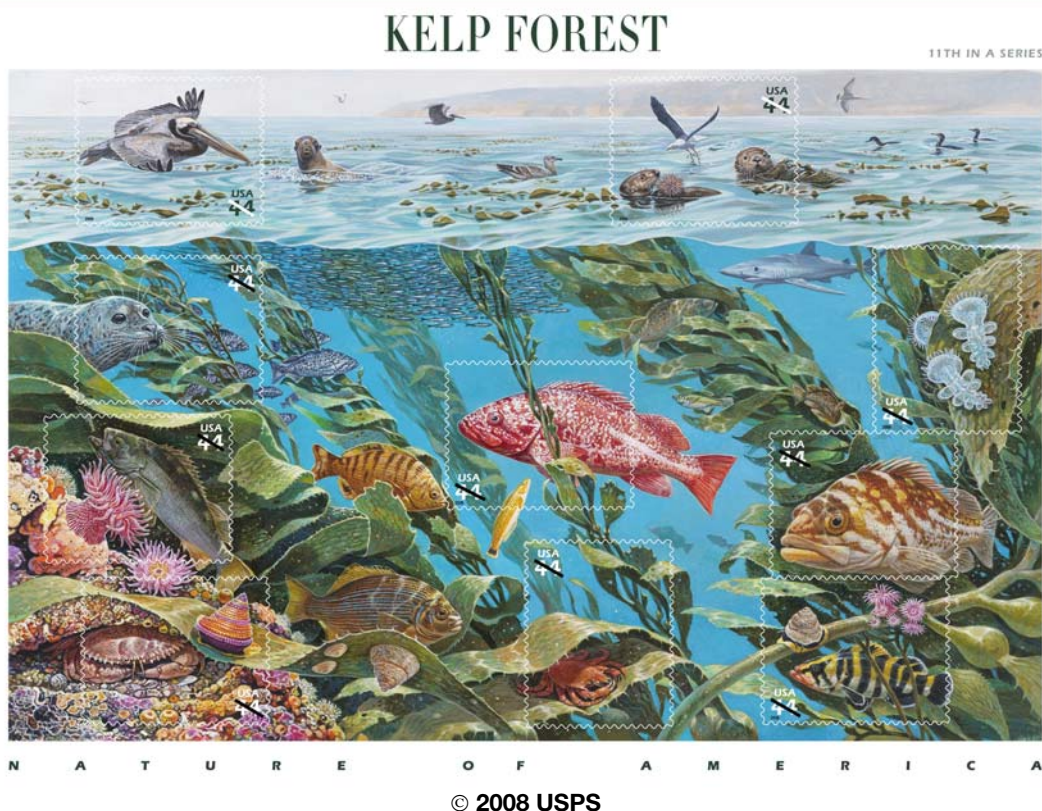

Stamp Announcement 09-45: Nature of America: Kelp Forest



On October 1, 2009, in Monterey, California, the Postal Service™ will issue 44-cent *Nature of America: Kelp Forest* commemorative stamps in ten designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 10 (Item 464000) and a \$8.95 Premium Stamped Postal Card Booklet of 10 (Item 896900). Designed by Ethel Kessler, Bethesda, Maryland, the stamps go on sale nationwide October 1, 2009.

This 2009 *Nature of America* issuance features a kelp forest off the central California coast. This is the 11th stamp pane in an educational series focusing on the beauty and complexity of major plants and animal communities in the United States. To illustrate the biodiversity of a kelp forest, artist John D. Dawson, Hilo, Hawaii, depicted more than 27 different species in his colorful acrylic painting.

Previous issuances in the *Nature of America* series were Sonoran Desert (1999), Pacific Coast Rain Forest (2000), Great Plains Prairie (2001), Longleaf Pine Forest (2002), Arctic Tundra (2003), Pacific Coral Reef (2004), Northeast Deciduous Forest (2005), Southern Florida Wetlands (2006), Alpine Tundra (2007), and Great Lakes Dunes (2008).

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in *italics* under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

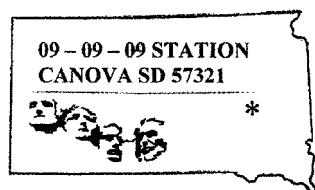
People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

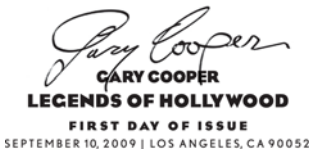

New Requirements for Conducting Audits and Entering Retail Products into POS ONE

Effective Fiscal Year (FY) 2010, all Post Offices™ receiving retail products for resale in retail lobbies will be required to enter these items into POS ONE upon receipt. Retail products referred to are categorized as mail-related merchandise and stamp-imaged merchandise. The purpose behind this strategy is to create an inventory system that will streamline the current ordering process and provide automatic replenishment directly to your office.

The week of September 7th, all POS ONE units are required to perform audits on all remaining photostamp kits and 5 lb. and 10 lb. scales to establish a baseline inventory by following the step-by-step instructions provided here. Negative reports are required.

The audit for September 2009 is due by close of business Friday 9-11-09. Five existing retail items must be counted and entered into POS ONE.

POS ONE Count/Audit Instructions for All OLRP Items

1. Log on to POS ONE.
2. Select *Inventory Options*.
3. Select *Count Inventory & Cash*.
4. Select *Start New Count*.
5. Select *Unit Inventories*.
6. Select *Retail Products*.
7. Select *All OLRP Items*.
8. Select *Counter #1 and Counter #2*.
9. Select *Continue*. The screen will say, "Please wait", then, "A new count has been successfully initiated".
10. Select *Continue*. **Note:** Two (2) sets of Inventory Count Sheets will automatically print.
11. Select *Resume/Finish Selected Count*.
12. The entire product list prepopulates on screen.
13. Select *Saleable Count*. The cursor will move down the page as you enter quantities.
14. Select *Continue* when the audit is complete.
15. Enter Counter (Individual Remarks) (if any).

16. Select *Continue*.

17. Select *Accept*. **Note:** Cash/Stamp Credit Count Report "Count Summary" will automatically print.

18. Select *Continue* to proceed with exiting POS back office.

Quarterly audits will be required on all retail products beginning in FY 10.

To better manage and track on-hand inventory, guidelines will require all new retail products (mail-related merchandise and stamp-imaged merchandise) be entered in POS ONE on receipt by following the step-by-step instructions provided here.

Entering Inventory Into POS ONE

The stamp stock custodian is responsible for entering inventory. First make sure your office has scanned in the Delivery Confirmation™ number on the shipping carton.

1. Log on to POS ONE.
2. Select *Non-retail roles*.
3. Select *Back office*.
4. Select *Inventory options*.
5. Select *Inventory transfers*.
6. Select *Receive stock*.
7. Select *Receive shipment not listed*.
8. At the look-up menu, scan/enter item number.
9. Select *Enter* (to create item list).
10. Select *Continue* (after all item numbers are entered), enter all quantities for each item received.
11. Select *Continue*.
12. Select Location *External Vendor*.
13. Enter *Shipment Number* (this is your order number on the packing slip).
14. At the "Source Location ID", enter the company who sent you the shipment.
15. If information is all correct, select *Accept this shipment*. (Your screen will say "Received stock from external vendor has been successfully completed".)
16. Select *Continue*.
17. After entering this invoice (or packing slip information), print the report from POS ONE back office "Received from External Vendor".

You have now completed your retail merchandise receiving process.

Standard operating procedures will be forwarded to all retail offices accompanied by a retail stand-up talk explaining the benefits of this retail strategy.

Additionally, guidelines for required audits and maintaining inventory of all retail merchandise will be included in the next printing of Handbook PO-209, *Retail Operations Handbook*.

- August 20, 2010 (HOL).

The cost per unit of 500 is \$12.51. This cost includes overprinting the address of the fulfillment office placing the order. You may pay for orders (under \$10,000) with local IMPAC credit cards, checks, or money orders. However, Cyril-Scott Company cannot process the order until it receives payment. Local eBuy procedures may also apply (refer to local procurement procedures). Cyril-Scott Company must receive orders placed by mail by close of

business the day of the print run cut-off date listed here. Orders received after the cut-off date will be processed the next print run date.

All local Post Offices™ and centralized sites should follow the ordering instructions contained within this article and utilize local funds.

For Orders Exceeding 10,000

Use eBuy to process both centralized and decentralized brochure orders that exceed \$10,000.00. In the Purchasing Method field, select "Route Req to Supply Mgmt", then in the After Approval Route field, select "Eastern Services CMC (Memphis, TN)". Include completed PS Form 3227-O with imprint information with the eBuy order.

Note: These approved eBuy orders must be received by Supply Management at least 10 days prior to a published run cut-off date to be included in that run.

Cyril-Scott Company will deliver orders within 35 calendar days after printing. Printing begins 1 week after the deadline date, and actual receipt of the order will depend on the ultimate destination and the corresponding delivery service standard. You should save copies of all orders placed at your local Post Office until the order has been received. Ensure procedures are in effect locally for proper verification of receipt.

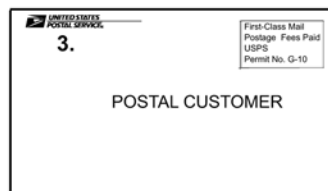
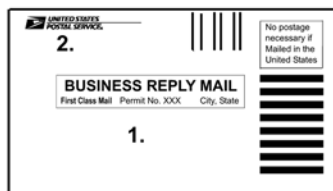

Safety

Buckle Up for Safety — It's a Simple Choice

Did you know that motor vehicle accidents are the leading cause of work fatalities? Most off-the-job accidental deaths involve motor vehicles, too.

Buckling up often means the difference between death and minor injury in a traffic accident.

When an injury-producing traffic accident occurs, there are actually two collisions. The first is the collision between the vehicle and whatever it hits, such as another vehicle or a utility pole. The second collision, or second impact, occurs inside the vehicle, when the occupant strikes the interior of the vehicle or another object inside. Injuries occur during this second collision, which happens less than a second after the first collision.

Even if you can't prevent the first collision, you can save yourself from injuries in the second. A belt and shoulder harness spread the force of the crash throughout your body, reducing or eliminating the impact.

Belts also keep you inside the vehicle. Doors often open in a collision, and the occupants can be thrown from the vehicle. The chances of dying are 25 times greater when the occupant is thrown from the vehicle.

Buckling up is the law, and is required by postal policy¹. The conscious and personal choice to click the buckle is the one you make every time you get in your vehicle. It's the right choice for your safety and the well-being of your loved ones. Buckle up for safety! Buckle up for your family!

Supply Management

eBuy Purchases of Bottled Drinking Water Services From Nestle and DS Waters for Fiscal Year 2010

All sites purchasing yearly bottled water service from Nestle, marketed as Arrowhead, Calistoga, Deer Park, Ice Mountain, Ozarka, Poland Spring, or Zephyrhills, or from DS Waters, marketed as Alhambra, Belmont, Crystal Springs, Hinckley Springs, Kentwood Springs, Sierra Springs, or Sparletts via eBuy on-catalog purchase are requested to process their requisitions for fiscal year (FY) 2010 before October 1, 2009. All requisitions need to be processed and approved prior to October 15, 2009, to avoid a lapse in service. Processing of requisitions is required during this period because the supplier needs to have your FY 2010 on-catalog requisition in the eBuy system in order to invoice your FEDSTRIP.

Note: There are some sites that cannot receive service directly from Nestle or DS Waters. These sites are authorized to purchase off-catalog as long as Nestle or DS Waters have stated they will not service their locations.

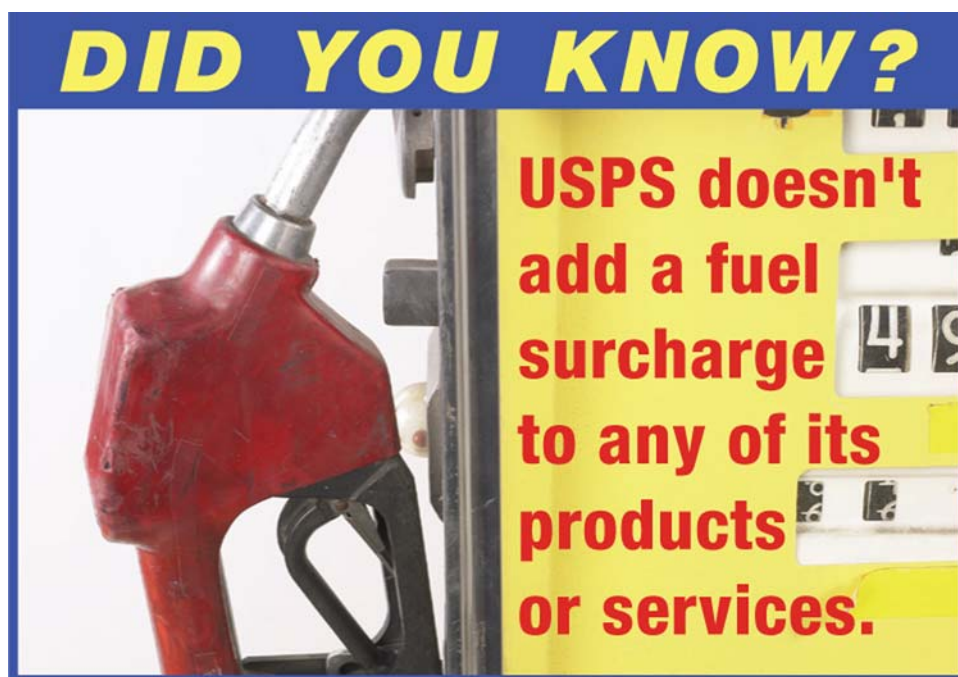
If your site sent a successfully processed eBuy requisition to the supplier last year, you can use this requisition to re-order. By re-ordering, you are copying last year's requisition, which will be assigned a new "R" number. Ensure quantities and units of measure are correct on the new requisition prior to sending for approvals.
