DMM Revision: Mailing of Cigarettes and Smokeless Tobacco Products to APO/FPO/DPO Destination Addresses

Effective August 27, 2010, we revised *Mailing Standards* of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM[®]) 503.9 and 601.11 to permit the mailing of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco to APO/FPO/DPO destination addresses via Express Mail[®] Military Service or Priority Mail[®] service with Delivery Confirmation[™] service. This change will be integrated into the online version of the DMM on October 4, 2010.

In response to inquiries from customers, USPS® has identified alternative mailing options for mailpieces containing cigarettes and smokeless tobacco sent as gifts between individual adults to APO/FPO/DPO addresses. These changes to our standards were made to accommodate the needs of military families that ship to APO/FPO/DPO destination addresses to which Express Mail service in not offered. With these changes, mailings of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco will be permitted to APO/FPO/DPO addresses when using Priority Mail service with Delivery Confirmation service, when not otherwise restricted in accordance with the requirements of the host country.

In conjunction with these revisions, we are also clarifying the product description for Delivery Confirmation service when used with products sent to APO/FPO/DPO addresses. Specifically, DMM 503.9.2.1 is clarified to specify that for APO/FPO/DPO shipments, Delivery Confirmation service may not always provide the mailer with online information regarding the date and time of an event scan.

a. Be entered as Express Mail with Hold for Pickup service (waiver of signature and pickup services not permitted); unless shipped to APO/FPO/DPO addresses under 11.6.4.

11.6.3 Delivery

Delivery under the certain individuals exception is made under the following conditions:

[Revise text in items a and c as follows:]

a. The recipient receiving or signing for the article must be an adult of at least the minimum age for the legal sale or purchase of tobacco products at the place of delivery.

c. For Express Mail articles, once age is established, the recipient must sign PS Form 3849 in the appropriate signature block.

[Add new item 11.6.4 as follows:]

11.6.4 Tobacco Product Shipments to APO/FPO/DPO Destination Addresses

Shipments of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco may not be sent to APO/FPO/DPO destination addresses to which the mailing of tobacco is restricted (see 703.2.3.1). To the extent cigarettes or smokeless tobacco are permitted to be mailed to APO/FPO/DPO destination addresses, such

mailings under the certain individuals exception must comply with all of the requirements of 11.6, with the exception that mailings may be entered as either Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) or Priority Mail service with Delivery Confirmation service. Regardless of the service elected, the mailing must bear the full name and mailing address of the sender and recipient.

IMM Revision: Exchange Office for IPA and ISAL Service to Bermuda and Mauritius

Effective November 1, 2010, the Postal ServiceTM is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM[®]) Exhibits 292.452 and 293.452 to update the exchange office name for International Priority AirmailTM (IPA[®]) and International Surface Air Lift[®] (ISAL[®]) items sent to Bermuda and Mauritius.

Periodically, the Postal Service receives such requests from foreign posts to facilitate operational needs. In this case, these foreign posts requested that these updates be implemented as soon as possible. However, in order to provide mailers the time needed to make necessary logistic and software changes, we are not requiring this change from mailers until November 1, 2010. Nonetheless, in order to expedite delivery, mailers may implement these changes immediately.

Effective immediately, postal retail units with IRT and eMOVES reporting technologies are to follow the closeout procedures for Post Office™ box and caller service transactions outlined in Handbook F-101, section 6-6.4.1.

6-6.4 Unit Closeout Procedures

6-6.4.1 eMOVES and IRT Units

[Revise text to read as follows:]

The closeout employee provides the following documents to the Post Office box section for updating box holder information in WebBATS on a daily basis:

 PS Form 1412. The closeout person reviews and compares PS Form 1412 entries with support documents.

- Support Documents (PS Form 1538, PS Form 3533, IRT/eMOVES system-generated unit 3544 for PO boxes/caller fees, and PS Form 3544). These are then submitted to the PO box clerk to be entered into the WebBats system.
- 3. WebBATS PO Box/Caller Service Receipt. After all PO box/caller service activities are entered into Web-BATS, print a WebBATS PO Box/Caller Service Receipt by Date report for the business day. The report will consist of the following:
 - a. A list of PO box numbers or caller numbers with the amounts.
 - b. The subtotal of all amounts posted for each AIC (115, 158, 166, 167, and 535).
- 4. WebBATS Report. The PO box clerk validates the WebBATS report with the copies of PS Forms 3533 and 3544, initials the report and supporting documents, and submits them back to the originating closeout person or supervisor to be filed locally.

Internet change-of-address (ICOA) transactions provide customers with the most convenient, safe, and secure way to change their address. Furthermore, ICOA transactions reduce processing time, improve address accuracy, and generate revenue for the Postal Service™.
- Advise customers to take an ICOA Message Card to reinforce the online change-of-address message.

 Customers unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at www.usps.com should be given a complete, unopened Mover's Guide.

Revised Publication 542, Understanding the Private Express Statutes

The revised edition of Publication 542, *Understanding* the *Private Express Statutes*, is available on both the internal and external websites.

Publication 542 (May 2010) describes changes resulting from the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act of 2006 (Public Law 109-435). It also reflects the amendment of Title 39, *Code of Federal Regulations*, parts 310 and 320 (39 CFR 310 and 320) to correct the addresses for inquiries and other correspondence regarding the enforcement of the Private Express Statutes, as published in a final rule in the *Federal Register* (75 *Federal Register* 12123, March 15, 2010).

Household Diary Study

The Postal Service's Household Diary Study (HDS), conducted since 1987, provides information about the contents of the mail sent and received by our customers in U.S. households. The Postal Service™ uses this information to help understand why and how customers use the mail. The results are used to:

- Forecast mail volume.
- Plan marketing strategies.
- Provide information for rate-setting purposes.

The HDS is administered at Headquarters by the Office of Demand Forecasting and Analysis, Finance. NuStats, the HDS survey research firm contractor since July 1999, conducts the interviews and collects and analyzes the HDS data throughout the year.

HDS is a two-stage survey. Stage 1 is the Household Interview. NuStats sends an advance letter, signed by the postmaster general, to a representative sample of U.S. households. This letter emphasizes the importance of the HDS and asks for participation. Sample households are contacted either by telephone or in person and asked about the mail they send and receive, their adoption and use of various communications' technologies, their attitudes about mail service in general, and information relating to their household and personal demographics. Respondent households are recruited to participate in HDS Stage 2.

Stage 2 is the Mail Diary. NuStats asks households that agree to participate in Stage 2 to record information about the mail they send and receive for a 7-day period from Monday to Sunday. Information recorded includes number of mailpieces received and sent, industry mail source, mail

characteristics, and attitudes regarding mail received. As an incentive for HDS Stage 2 participation, households are offered the options of receiving \$30 or a roll of 100 First-Class Mail[®] stamps.

Customers who participate in Stage 2 of the HDS can expect to receive their incentive about 2 months after they return the diary packet to NuStats.

Data gathered in both HDS stages is available in a final report, *The Household Diary Study — Mail Use and Attitudes*. The report is published in hard copy and an electronic file. Order forms for the latest HDS report may be obtained via the Postal Service Internet at www.usps.com/householddiary.

Paper Payroll Savings Bond Program To Be Discontinued; Electronic Payroll Savings Available Through TreasuryDirect

The United States Department of the Treasury (Treasury) has announced that it will stop issuing paper savings bonds through federal agency, including USPS[®], savings plans as of September 30, 2010.

The Treasury currently offers TreasuryDirect, a secured web-based system to invest in savings bonds and other Treasury securities. It allows you a convenient way to purchase, manage, and redeem electronic (paperless) savings

bonds along with Treasury marketable securities (bills, notes, bonds, and TIPS) online 24/7.

If you want to purchase Treasury securities through a payroll deduction, you will need to first establish a TreasuryDirect account and then establish an allotment via PostalEase. In order to complete Treasury's online application, you will need the following items on hand:

 Your Social Security number (taxpayer identification number).

- Your driver's license number or state ID and expiration date.
- Your bank or credit union routing number and account number of the checking or savings account you would like to use.
- A valid e-mail address.
- A web browser that supports Treasury's technical requirements.

Once established, you will be provided bank account information that you will need to create an allotment (subject to maximum allotment restrictions) through PostalEase.

2010 Combined Federal Campaign Guidelines

Schedule and Responsibilities

Each fall, the U.S. Postal Service[®] joins other federal agencies in the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC). In accordance with Office of Personnel Management (OPM) regulations, the campaign runs for a 6-week period between September 1 and December 15, as established by the local Federal Coordinating Committee.

Vice presidents of area Operations have campaign responsibility. Area offices must ensure that campaign information is disseminated to all offices under their jurisdiction.

Publication 530, Combined Federal Campaign Operational Guidelines, October 1994, explains how to carry out a successful campaign; revises position titles, facility locations, and dates of campaign; and is available on the Postal Service™ PolicyNet website:

Final Report

At the end of each campaign, Eagan Accounting Services prepares a report from the Postal Payroll System of CFC con-

tributions through payroll deductions (as of pay period 02-11) as the annual report of national CFC contributions. Each performance cluster manager receives a copy.

Express Mail Open and Distribute Service Changes

Effective January 2011, Publication 91, Confirmation Services Technical Guide, will be revised to include requirements for Express Mail[®] Open and Distribute Service. This is an advance notice of the changes that will become effective in January 2011.

Express Mail Open and Distribute is a premium service that allows mailers to expedite the movement of shipments of any class or subclass of mail between the acceptance unit and domestic postal facilities using Express Mail service. Customers must place mailpiece contents into an approved USPS® container (sack or USPS-supplied tray box), affix the Express Mail Open and Distribute address label barcode to the container, and present the container to the Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU) or authorized acceptance location before the critical acceptance time for Express Mail items. The contents of the Express Mail Open and Distribute container may include any products or class of mail, except Express Mail items. Postage is paid based on the weight and zone for the contents of the Express Mail Open and Distribute container. Once received at the destination facility, the container address label barcode is scanned and the enclosed mail is processed appropriately for the mail class.

The following requirements must be met to use Express Mail Open and Distribute service:

- 1. For each container, mailers will affix a barcoded address label. All address labels will contain the human-readable text above the barcode of "USPS Scan on Arrival", affixed to either a yellow Tag 267 for containers destined to mail processing facilities (NDC and SCF) or a blue Tag 257 for destination delivery units (DDUs). Alternatively, an Express Mail Flat Rate Envelope with a blue Label 257S can be used for destination delivery units or an Open and Distribute tray box can be used for both processing facilities and DDUs.
- The mailers will send an electronic file, consistent with the rules outlined in the latest version of Publication 91, which includes the label number for the Express Mail Open and Distribute container.

- 3. The mailers will present the container with the affixed address label barcode and tag to the BMEU or authorized USPS acceptance facility with a prepared PS Form 3152-E, Express Mail Manifesting Certification. PS Form 3152-E will contain a barcode representing the electronic file number used in the Header Record of the electronic file.
- 4. After contents and postage of each Express Mail Open and Distribute container are verified, the barcode on PS Form 3152-E will be scanned as accepted by the BMEU or authorized acceptance location.
- Express Mail Open and Distribute labels that are addressed to:
 - An SCF must reflect the 3-digit ZIP CodeTM.
 - An NDC must reflect the 5-digit ZIP Code.
 - A DDU must reflect the complete address, including the ZIP+4[®] code.
- 6. Customers may use one of the options listed below.

Option 1. Use of Standard 13-Digit Barcoded Labels

Express Mail Open and Distribute customers using option 1 must do the following:

- Use a valid 13-digit barcoded label containing a prefix of "DB" in either the USS 128 or Code 39 barcode symbology.
- Obtain a label range from the National Customer Service Center upon certification.
- Prepare and present mail according to specifications outlined in Publication 97, Express Mail Manifesting Technical Guide.
- Use version 1.3 file format and may use electronic file type '3' (Express Mail Manifest Using EMCA) or 'E' (PC Postage Vendors).
- Include the Destination Rate Indicator that represents the destination location:
 - B = Destination Network Distribution Center (DNDC).

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service $^{\text{TM}}$ money order:

- 1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
- 2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration form is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise) addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. PS Form 2976 is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces, and PS Form 2976-A is required for items weighing 16 ounces or more. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). When the surface area of the address side of the mailpiece is not large enough to contain a PS Form 2976-A, the smaller PS Form 2976 may be substituted (e.g., the Priority Mail Small Flat Rate Box). The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.1c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

- 11. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{I2.}}$ This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.
 - J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.11.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:

- Maximum length 12 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
- Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

 $\mbox{\bf U2.}$ Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

PVDS Destination

When receiving a drop shipment, the destination office must confirm that the documentation is complete, is accurate, and matches the drop shipment so that USPS® receives proper payment for each mailing.

Remember the 3 R's when receiving plant-verified drop shipment (PVDS) loads at the destination site:

Review PS Form 8125, Plant-Verified Drop Shipment (PVDS) Verification and Clearance:

- Verify that the load arrived at the correct destination.
- Confirm all critical fields are complete and unaltered.

Receive the Load:

- Compare container counts on PS Forms 8125 to actual containers on the truck.
- Complete the Destination Entry Post Office section.
- Scan the postal barcode in the lower right corner of PS Form 8125, if present.

Record Irregularities:

 Record all drop shipment irregularities on PS Form 8125, in Facility Access and Shipment Tracking (FAST), and in Electronic Mail Improvement Reporting (eMIR).

PVDS Origin

Accurately checking and accepting mail throughout the business mail acceptance process is a key component of Sarbanes-Oxley Act (SOX) compliance. You can do your part by following these key processes when accepting plant-verified drop shipment (PVDS) mail:

- At a business mail entry unit (BMEU), follow the Job Aid for accepting PVDS mail.
- At a detached mail unit (DMU), use the DMU PVDS standard operating procedures (SOP).
- Conduct these key steps following the applicable SOP:
 - 1. Validate the postage statements against the PS Forms 8125 at the origin site. Ensure the discounts claimed and the piece counts match.
 - Confirm that the container labels and container counts are accurate and match the physical mail presented.
 - Sign and round stamp PS Form 8125 to document the review unless the form contains an authorized legend.
 - 4. In DMUs where Special Postage Payment Systems (SPPS) agreements authorized by Business Mailer Support exist, ensure acceptance personnel follow the procedures identified in the agreement.
- For non-PVDS mail, such as Expedited Plant Loads, compare the postage statement to PS Form 8017, Expedited Plant-Load Shipment Clearance, and the physical mail. Sign and round stamp to show evidence of the review.

DMU Plant-Load Loading and Securing of USPS Vehicles or USPS Contracted Vehicles

Ensuring the mail is accounted for and secure prevents unpaid mail from entering the mailstream. You can do your part by following these key processes.

When loading mail onto USPS® vehicles or USPS contracted vehicles at a detached mail unit (DMU):

- Confirm that the mail is verified and cleared for dispatch.
- Observe all mail being loaded onto USPS vehicles or USPS contracted vehicles.
- Secure a contractor's vehicle using a numbered seal (0817-A) and twisted wire seals. Complete PS Form 5111-R and PS Form 5398-A.
- Secure a Postal Vehicle Service (PVS) vehicle using a cargo compartment door lock or numbered seal. Complete PS Form 5111-R.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail[®] postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4[®] Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.





How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service[™] will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept handpainted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

Stamps by Mail — Brochure Ordering Information

This article publishes the Stamps by Mail® (SBM) print run cutoff schedule for fiscal year (FY) 11. Each date has a designation whether it is for the year-round (YR) brochure or the holiday (HOL) brochure. The remaining FY 11 print cycle cut-off date is as follows:

- September 24, 2010 (HOL).
- November 5, 2010 (Price Change).
- January 14, 2011 (YR).
- April 8, 2011 (YR).
- May 20, 2011 (YR).
- June 24, 2011 (YR).
- August 19, 2011 (HOL).

Starting with the June 25, 2010, print cycle, the Englishonly brochures have been replaced with bilingual (English and Spanish) brochures. All orders received from SBM sites by June 25 and thereafter will be provided bilingual brochures. There is no change in the price.

To order brochures, submit PS Form 3227-O, Stamps by Mail Brochure Order Form (January 2009), to Cyril-Scott Company:

You can find this form at http://blue.usps.gov; click Forms, and then select the form by number. A copy of this form appears on page 47 in this Postal Bulletin.

The cost per unit of 500 is \$12.51. This cost includes overprinting the address of the fulfillment office placing the order. You may pay for orders (under \$10,000) with local IMPAC credit cards, checks, or money orders. However, Cyril-Scott Company cannot process the order until it receives payment. Local eBuy procedures may also apply (refer to local procurement procedures). Cyril-Scott Company must receive orders placed by mail by close of business the day of the print run cut-off date listed here. Orders received after the cut-off date will be processed the next print run date.

All local Post Offices[™] and centralized sites should follow the ordering instructions contained within this article and utilize local funds.

For Orders Exceeding \$10,000

Use eBuy to process both centralized and decentralized brochure orders that exceed \$10,000.00. In the Purchasing

Method field, select "Route Req to Supply Mgmt," then in the After Approval Route field, select "Eastern Services CMC (Memphis, TN)." Include completed PS Form 3227-O with imprint information with the eBuy order.

Note: These approved eBuy orders must be received by Supply Management at least 10 days prior to a published run cut-off date to be included in that run.

Cyril-Scott Company will deliver orders within 35 calendar days after printing. Printing begins 1 week after the deadline date, and actual receipt of the order will depend on the ultimate destination and the corresponding delivery service standard. You should save copies of all orders placed at your local Post Office until the order has been received. Ensure procedures are in effect locally for proper verification of receipt.

Supply Management

eBuy2 Yearly Purchases of Five-Gallon Bottled Drinking Water Services From Nestle and DS Waters for Fiscal Year 2011

All sites purchasing yearly 5-gallon bottled water service from Nestle (marketed as Arrowhead, Calistoga, Deer Park, Ice Mountain, Ozarka, Poland Spring, or Zephyrhills), or from DS Waters (marketed as Alhambra, Belmont, Crystal Springs, Hinckley Springs, Kentwood Springs, Sierra Springs, or Sparkletts) are required to reorder yearly via eBuy2 "on-catalog" and are requested to process their requisitions for fiscal year (FY) 2011 before October 1, 2010.

All requisitions must to be processed and approved prior to October 15, 2010, to avoid a lapse in service. Processing of requisitions is required during this period because the supplier needs to have your FY 2011 on-catalog requisition in the eBuy2 system in order to invoice your FEDSTRIP.

(1) There are some sites that cannot receive service directly from Nestle or DS Waters. These sites are authorized to purchase "off-catalog" as long as Nestle or DS Waters have stated they will not service those specific locations. (2) This service is not for "emergency" national disaster-type bottled water purchases. For all "emergency" bottled water requirements, refer to Material Logistics Bulletin (MLB) MLB-CO-07-001, Amendment to the MLB for Water and Ice to American Water, Ice and Logistics.
