

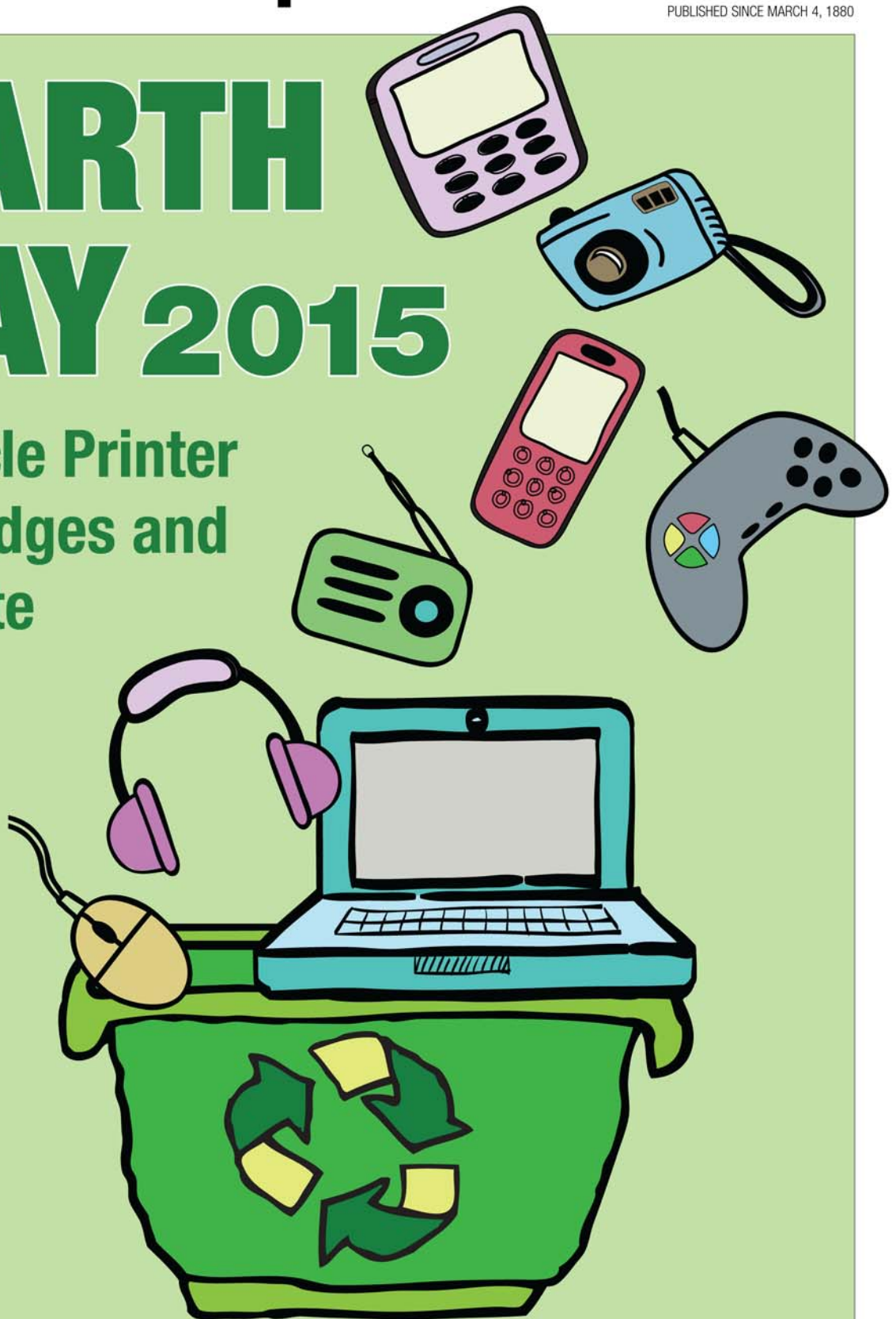

Go Green — Celebrate Earth Day by Recycling eWaste

Earth Day 2015 is a good time to re-emphasize our corporate-wide commitment to the reduction of electronic waste (eWaste) and refresh our national campaign to increase awareness of eWaste recycling among Postal Service™ employees and federal agencies. In this issue of the *Postal Bulletin*, we feature a wide range of articles and tips on recycling eWaste in the office as well as employee recycling solutions for personal electronic devices through the USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program. Many people may not realize that electronics is one of the fastest growing waste streams in the world, and only a small fraction of this waste is recycled. Electronics contain some of the most hazardous wastes generated in the workplace and in our homes. Electronic equipment, such as cell phones, contain a range of toxic metals like lead, cadmium, and mercury, which can have significant adverse effects on groundwater quality when thrown away.

In 2012, the Postal Service joined the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Federal Green Challenge with the objective of recycling 50% of all our solid waste by the year 2015. Electronic waste represents 2% of the total waste stream in America and nearly that same percentage within the Postal Service. We are well into FY 2015, and if we recycle all of our electronic waste, we will meet our Federal Green Challenge goal and divert these wastes from landfills.

This issue of the *Postal Bulletin* provides instructions on taking advantage of the Topeka MDC electronic recycling program and promotes an innovative Postal Service program that allows you to safely and properly dispose of your personal electronic waste items such as cell phones and laptops through the USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program. The Federal Recycling Program generates revenue for both the Postal Service (at zero cost to Postal Service employees) and Federal customers, and we encourage you to share this information with your employees. Another recycling initiative that is being rolled out over the next few years is the National Recycling Operation, whereby our existing transportation network is used to backhaul mixed paper from postal facilities to plants and hubs where it is consolidated and sold to recyclers, adding to postal revenues and reducing landfill disposal costs.

We also urge you to become familiar with the wide range of sustainability initiatives available through our Lean Green Teams. Earth Day may happen once a year, but our sustainability practices should become part of the fabric of our working lives. Go green, and celebrate Earth Day 2015 by recycling your eWaste.

Federal Recycling for America's Future

Last year, the U.S. Postal Service® launched an innovative new program to assist federal agencies to recycle on a national level. The USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program allows customer agencies and their employees (including USPS® employees) to repurpose and recycle qualified end-of-life products free of charge.



The USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program makes recycling easy enough for every federal location to participate:

"The USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program does not require federal agencies to replace any of their existing recycling programs. It can easily supplement recycling programs already in place, said Tom Day, chief sustainability officer for the U.S. Postal Service."

The USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program is free (no shipping or disposition costs) to every federal agency.

The program provides solutions in two ways:

- A recycling program for federal agencies on a national level for *government* equipment, such as ink jet and toner cartridges and small electronics shipped via USPS from a government location.
- A recycling program for federal agency employees on a national level for disposal of their *personal* property, such as ink jet and toner cartridges and small electronics shipped via USPS from the employee's home.

In each of the two categories above, the employee follows a simple process to access a customized website (<http://blueearth.usps.gov>), input the required information, print a label, seal the items in a nondescript box provided by the agency or employee, and submit the parcel to a mail carrier through current standard mailing procedures.

Green Teams as Change Agents for Waste and Cost Reduction

Lean Green Teams are continuing forward in FY 2015 to get their facilities signed up on the Green Initiative Tracking Tool (GITT). On the GITT, teams are selecting easy low- and no-cost projects to reduce wasted facility energy, vehicle fuel, water, and spending on office supplies. A main priority of Lean Green Teams this year is to work on diverting solid waste from landfills to recycling in order to reduce disposal costs and build revenue. USPS® efforts in the National Recycling Operation have resulted in a positive impact to the bottom line of tens of millions of dollars in each of the past few years. But there is still a lot of opportunity to get involved in reducing waste and cost, boosting revenue, and making the USPS a more sustainable place to work. Every little bit makes a difference, especially when you multiply even the smallest savings by over 31,000 facilities and 210,000 vehicles.

This year, we have more options to help Lean Green Teams save money and generate revenue for the USPS, including helping to divert USPS eWaste to the Topeka Asset Recovery Center and promoting awareness and usage of the USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program.

Lean Green Teams can also work with supervisors to deploy Notice 890-A on all dumpsters and compactors at Postal facilities. Notice 890-A is intended to remind employees and custodians that electronic waste must never be disposed of in landfills.

National Recycling Operation: A Five-Year Strategy for Paper Recycling

The Postal Service™ has launched a National Recycling Operation, which will institute a standardized mixed paper backhaul recycling program in postal facilities over five years.

Recycling can no longer be considered an optional part of postal business operations. In many places, it's now required by law. This initiative is not just "the right thing to do" — it is also a viable solution to present financial challenges:

- The National Recycling Operation could generate millions in combined savings and revenue. Additionally, it could double current postal recycling rates.
- Backhaul recycling uses reverse logistics in which Post Offices™ transport their mixed paper recyclables, such as undeliverable Standard Mail®, on existing transportation trips to a servicing hub.

- In 2014, the Postal Service expanded recycling of mixed paper, which generated important revenue and waste disposal savings. Increased recycling through the National Recycling Operation can expand on the efforts to generate more revenue as well as further increase savings by reducing waste disposal costs.
- During the staged rollout, hub facilities will receive new equipment and employees will receive training to implement the necessary steps.

How to Recycle Postal Service Facility eWaste and Ink/Toner Cartridges

What is Electronic Waste (eWaste)?

The term "eWaste" is broadly defined as obsolete, surplus, or broken electrical or electronic devices, but may include a variety of equipment (see the Recyclable Postal Service eWaste list). Improper disposal of eWaste could be harmful to human health and the environment as it generally contains heavy metals such as lead, cadmium, and mercury.





What is the USPS Doing About Our eWaste?

Similarly, the USPS continues to upgrade its information technology platform with the concurrent challenge of realignment, consolidation, and downsizing of our mail-processing network. As a result, USPS generation of eWaste will substantially increase over the next several years. USPS Supply Management entered into an innovative revenue sharing contract in 2011 with Asset LifeCycle, LLC at our Topeka Material Distribution Center, to promote the collection, reuse, recycling, and disposal of our electronic equipment.

Our selected vendor, Asset Life Cycle, is a third-party certified “responsible recycler” in R2 and eStewardship, along with being a Postal Inspection Service-certified secure site. Third-party certifications ensure best management practices and offer a way to assess the environmental, worker health, and security practices of entities managing our used electronics.

What Can You Do?

- **ACE Hardware and Equipment.** Contact your local IT office to get accountability, collection, and shipping procedures for shipping ACE hardware and equipment to the Topeka Material Distribution Center.
- **Processing and Distributions Centers.** Follow MMO 04212, which provides instructions for shipping eWaste to the Topeka Material Distribution Center. Click the link for instructions: http://blue.usps.gov/sustainability/electronic_stewardship.htm.
- **Post Offices.** Contact your local IT office for information about recycling ACE-related hardware and equipment. Other eWastes (see the Recyclable

Postal Service eWaste list) may be shipped directly to the Topeka Material Distribution Center.

- **Electronic Security-Related Equipment.** Contact your local Postal Inspection Service Field Office for more information about recycling security-related equipment.

Make sure your office is recycling its eWaste to ensure these items are generating revenue, rather than being placed in the trash. To take advantage of this nationwide eWaste recycling program, go to the sustainability website and download the instructions for sending your obsolete or non-functioning equipment to the Topeka Material Distribution Center. Recycle Empty Toner and Inkjet Cartridges

The USPS BlueEarth® Federal Recycling Program is the Postal Service's resource for the recycling of all empty toner and inkjet cartridges. We are trying to increase participation in every District and in every office. Please help

us to spread the word to all that use a printer in your facilities. Go to <http://blueearth.usps.gov> instead of using the enclosed UPS label when returning your used cartridges.

Employees can securely and easily recycle toner and all types of inkjet cartridges by visiting the program website at <http://BlueEarth.usps.gov>.

The steps are simple:

- Click on "Get Started Today," then choose agency assets and United States Postal Service® from the drop down menu.
- Fill out and submit the online form.
- Print the prepaid label, pack the empty cartridges in a box, and mail it.

DO NOT photocopy the labels. A new label must be generated for each shipment.

DMM Revision: Clarification of Content Eligibility for Standard Mail Marketing Parcels

Effective April 16, 2015, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* part 243 to reaffirm basic eligibility standards for Standard Mail® Marketing Parcels.

Specifically, Standard Mail Marketing Parcels were designed for mailers to send non-requested items or samples to potential customers. Our intent was to build a low-cost prospecting vehicle; therefore, the Postal Service built in factors to minimize handling costs. One factor, the alternative addressing format, was required so that the current resident became the recipient of the mailpiece if the named addressee moved from that address. This avoided extra delivery and forwarding costs. Another factor was the specification of size restrictions, including the requirement that pieces needed to be similar in shape and weight if sent in a single mailing.

Building upon the original intent, and to keep this product a viable and cost-effective promotional vehicle, we are adding stronger language to the DMM on content eligibility and address format for Standard Mail Marketing Parcels. This includes clarification that all Standard Mail Marketing Parcels (regular and nonprofit) must bear an alternate addressing format and cannot be used for “fulfillment purposes” (i.e. the sending of items specifically purchased or requested by the customer of a mailer). The one exception to this rule is if the customer of a mailer elects to receive certain samples in connection with the purchase of an item; then, those samples may be sent separately from the purchased item as a Standard Mail Marketing Parcel. Moreover, the alternate address format must be on the same line as the addressee's name, or on the address line directly above or below the addressee's name as identified in DMM 602.3.4.

***Noncash tangible awards, valued at \$75 or more, and all cash equivalent and gift certificate awards must be reported in eAwards as income received so that (a) appropriate payroll deductions can be made from the recipient's normal pay, and (b) the award amount may be grossed up, if necessary. The reporting of these items in eAwards should occur in the same pay period the award is presented to the recipient. Reporting *must* take place in the same calendar year to avoid tax reporting discrepancies.

A Noncareer Gift Certificate Award consists of a gift certificate not greater than \$100 in value purchased locally in accordance with Postal Service and local purchasing rules and regulations. Eligible employees may receive up to \$500 in gift certificate awards in a fiscal year.

The Noncareer Gift Certificate Award, regardless of dollar value, is considered taxable income. Noncareer Gift Certificates valued at \$50 or more are grossed up for tax purposes. (See 491.34 for more information on the tax impact of awards and grossing up for tax purposes.)

A Noncareer Gift Certificate Award may be presented along with a letter of appreciation on official Postal Service letterhead in an official service award folder.

***All Noncareer Gift Certificate Awards are reported in eAwards as income received so that the appropriate payroll deductions can be made from the recipient's pay. The reporting of these items in eAwards should occur in the same pay period the award is presented to the recipient.

Reporting must take place in the same calendar year to avoid tax reporting discrepancies.

[Revise the text of 497.25 to read as follows:]

Noncash tangible items valued at \$75 or more must be reported in eAwards as a Contest Award. All gift certificates, regardless of value, must be reported in eAwards using the appropriate Gift Certificate award. (See 491.3 for more information on noncash tangible and gift certificate awards.)

497.35 Processing

[Revise the text of 497.35 to read as follows:]

Noncash tangible items valued at \$75 or more must be reported in eAwards as a Safety Award. All gift certificates, regardless of value, must be reported in eAwards using the appropriate Gift Certificate award. (See 491.3 for information on noncash tangible and gift certificate awards.)

Handbooks

Handbook EL-312 Revision: Assignment, Reassignment, and Promotion

Effective April 2, 2015, the Postal Service™ is revising Handbook EL-312, *Employment and Placement*, sections 716.2 through 717.3 to update policy for Temporary Promotions and Promotions to Temporary Positions:

- The heading for 716.2 is revised from Temporary Promotion to Temporary Promotion and Promotion to a Temporary Position.
- Text was added to 716.2 to better define a temporary promotion and to add a description of a promotion to a temporary position.

- The text of 716.21 is revised with minor editorial changes and to state that vacancy announcements must clearly indicate that the appointment will not exceed a stated period. Also, a reference to part 743 was added.
- 716.22 is revised to state that a temporary promotion may be made for a limited period, usually two years or less, and to clarify that if the assignment continues after the initial period expires, the employee may continue to serve but it must be determined whether

the situation is still temporary. In addition, items a through e were revised:

- Item a now states that the assignment may not exceed one year without the approval of the area vice president (or functional officer for a headquarters position) and refers the reader to section 716.145 when travel is involved;
- Item b is replaced with new text that says the action is documented on PS Form 50, *Personnel Action*;
- Item c is reworded slightly to state that the assignment may be terminated at any time based on the needs of the Postal Service; and
- New item e states that placement in the assignment does not make the employee ineligible to compete for the vacancy if the position is posted.
- The heading for 716.23 is revised from Preappointment Statement to Conditions of the Temporary Promotion.
- 716.23 is revised to state that an employee selected for a temporary promotion will be required to sign an agreement covering the terms of the temporary promotion. New items a through f outline items that are to be addressed in such an agreement.
- 717.1a concerning bargaining positions is revised with minor editorial changes.
- 717.1b concerning nonbargaining positions is revised with a new sentence that states that an employee with a disability who desires reassignment to a nonbargaining position should work through the appropriate Reasonable Accommodation Committee at the district, area, or headquarters level. In addition, minor editorial changes and a new reference to section 743.11 were added.
- 717.1c is revised with minor editorial changes.
- 717.3 is revised with minor editorial changes.
- 717.32 is revised to use the word “exempted” instead of “excepted.”
- Item a contains a minor editorial change.
- Item b replaces the reference to present or former nonbargaining employees with the word current and changes the reference to another section in the handbook from “73-75” to “74.”
- Item c is revised with minor editorial changes.
- New section 717.4 is added to address nonbargaining employee changes to a lower level and the procedure an employee with a disability who seeks noncompetitive change to a lower level to a nonbargaining position, as a reasonable accommodation must use.

- Previous section 717.4 is renumbered 717.5.
- 717.51 (formerly 717.41) is revised to delete a sentence requiring placing notation of a selection pending an effective date to be placed into an employee’s official personnel folder.
- Previous section 717.42 is renumbered 717.52.
- Previous section 717.421 is renumbered 717.521.
- The heading for 717.522 (formerly 717.422) is changed from “EAS” to “Nonbargaining Positions,” and similar revisions are made in the text. This section is further revised with updates to describe current procedures used by employees to apply for a nonbargaining position.

716 Positions Filled Temporarily

* * * * *

[Revise the title and text of 716.2 to read as follows:]

716.2 Temporary Promotion and Promotion to a Temporary Position

Temporary promotion to a nonbargaining position which has no time limitation is limited to situations where it is impractical to fill a higher-level position by other temporary means. Such situations include, but are not limited to (a) long-term absence of the incumbent or (b) a need to defer the permanent filling of a vacant position for a lengthy period of time.

Promotion to a temporary nonbargaining position is limited to situations where the position is authorized for a specific limited duration to serve a temporary or transitional need.

In this section, “temporary promotion” refers to both temporary promotions to a nonbargaining position and promotion to a temporary nonbargaining position.

716.21 Selection Procedures

[Revise the text of 716.21 to read as follows:]

Competitive procedures are used to fill a position through a temporary promotion. The vacancy announcement must clearly indicate that the appointment will not exceed a stated period. When the position is filled permanently, competitive or noncompetitive procedures may be used

(see 743). An employee who has served in a position through competitive temporary promotion is eligible to re compete, regardless of the duration of the temporary promotion.

716.22 Appointment Duration

[Revise the text of 716.22 to read as follows:]

A temporary promotion may be made for a limited period, usually two years or less, depending upon need. If the employee's services are still needed in the assignment after the initial period expires, the employee may continue to serve, but it must be determined whether the situation is still temporary or whether the position should be filled permanently. A temporary promotion:

- a. May not exceed one year without approval of the area vice president (or functional officer for a headquarters position). See 716.145 when travel is involved;
- b. Is documented on a PS Form 50, *Personnel Action*;
- c. Terminates on a specified date, unless extended;
- d. May be terminated at any time based on the needs of the Postal Service; and
- e. Does not make the employee ineligible to compete for the vacancy if the position is posted.

[Revise the title and text of 716.23 to read as follows:]

716.23 Conditions of the Temporary Promotion

Applicants for temporary promotion must be informed of the conditions of the placement, including the expected duration. An employee selected for a temporary promotion will be required to sign an agreement covering the terms of the temporary promotion. The purpose of the agreement will be to avoid any misunderstanding as to the conditions of the temporary promotion. The agreement must state that by accepting promotion to the temporary position, the position becomes the employee's position of record, and must also address:

- a. The effect on the employee's salary during the temporary promotion;
- b. Relocation benefits, if any;
- c. Security clearance requirements, if applicable;
- d. The employee's ability to apply for other positions including lateral reassignment at the grade of the position to which temporarily promoted;
- e. Reassignment to a comparable nonbargaining position at the end of the temporary promotion; and
- f. That if prior to the termination of the temporary promotion the competitive area where the position is located undergoes a RIF, the employee's rights are

determined based on that position, not under the agreement he or she signed.

717 Positions Filled Permanently

717.1 Reassignment

* * * * *

[Revise the text of items a, b, and c to read as follows:]

- a. *Reassignment to a bargaining position.* General policies and procedures governing reassignments to bargaining positions are contained in the applicable collective bargaining agreement. (See 72, Bargaining Positions, and 76, Bargaining Position Qualification Standards, for detailed policies and procedures.)
- b. *Reassignment to a nonbargaining position.* Management may reassign nonbargaining employees noncompetitively (see 743.11). Employees with saved grade may be considered noncompetitively for positions up to the level of their former position or at any intervening level. Employees who desire reassignment may also apply in the same way as employees who desire promotion consideration. Additionally, an employee with a disability who desires reassignment should work through the appropriate Reasonable Accommodation Committee at the district, area, or headquarters level.
- c. *Mutual exchanges.* Career bargaining employees may exchange positions at the same level, if the exchange is approved by management at the installations involved, subject to the provisions of the applicable collective bargaining agreement. An exchange of positions does not necessarily mean that the employees involved take over the duty assignments of the positions.

* * * * *

717.3 Promotion

[Revise the text of 717.3 to read as follows:]

A promotion is the permanent assignment with or without relocation of an employee to an established position with a higher level than the employee's previous position, or to an established position with a higher than equivalent level in another schedule (see ELM 413, Promotion to Nonbargaining Unit Positions). Restrictions on the promotion, or recommendation for promotion, of immediate relatives of nonbargaining employees are set forth in Chapter 5. The following policies apply to promotion:

- a. *Promotion to a bargaining position.* General principles governing promotions to bargaining positions are contained in the applicable collective bargaining agreement (see 72, Bargaining Positions).

- b. *Promotion to a nonbargaining position.* General policies and procedures governing promotions to nonbargaining positions are contained in ELM 350, Assignment, Reassignment, and Promotion. (See 73-75 of this handbook for specific policies.)

* * * * *

717.32 Exceptions to Competitive Procedures

[Revise the text of 717.32 to read as follows:]

The following promotion actions are exempted from competitive promotion procedures:

- a. Promotion of an incumbent to a position reclassified at a higher level without significant change in duties and responsibilities.
- b. Promotion and assignment of current nonbargaining employees to higher-level nonbargaining positions under the specific conditions described in 74. This includes employees with retreat rights, those previously reduced in level, or those serving with saved grade.
- c. Promotion of an employee who satisfactorily completes an approved training program that specifically provides for promotion, if: (1) the employee was selected for the program under competitive procedures; and (2) the fact that selection could lead to promotion was made known to potential candidates for the program.

[Add new section 717.4 to read as follows:]

717.4 Change to Lower Level

Management may approve a nonbargaining employee's voluntary request for change to a vacant nonbargaining position at a lower grade consistent with section 743.11 and *Employee and Labor Relations Manual*, section 354.23(f). An employee with a disability who desires noncompetitive change to a lower level nonbargaining position should work through the appropriate Reasonable Accommodation Committee at the district, area, or headquarters level.

[Renumber current 717.4 as new 717.5 to read as follows:]

717.5 Absent Employees

[Renumber current section 717.41 as new 717.51 and revise the text to read as follows:]

717.51 Not on Active Military Duty

Employees on extended leave including leave without pay will also be considered provided they are otherwise eligible and have applied for promotion. If the employee is selected for promotion, the personnel action is processed upon return to postal duty. The date placed on the personnel action is the date the promotion would have occurred had the employee not been absent.

[Renumber current 717.42 as new 717.52 to read as follows:]

717.52 On Active Military Duty

[Renumber current 717.421 as new 717.521 to read as follows:]

717.521 Bidding on Positions

* * * * *

[Renumber current 717.422 as new 717.522 and revise the title and text of 717.522 to read as follows:]

717.522 Nonbargaining Positions

Nonbargaining and bargaining employees on military duty who are interested in being considered for nonbargaining positions are required to submit to Human Resources personnel a completed Candidate Profile for vacancies in desired positions and locations. Human Resources personnel will treat the Profile as if it were an application when there is a vacancy in the desired position and location. The application is considered in accordance with the area of consideration noted on the announcement. Applications resulting in a nonselection are reconsidered for other vacancies as they occur in the desired position and location, until the applicant has been successfully selected. Applications from employees who are on active duty with the uniformed services are to be accepted at any time for subsequent consideration when an appropriate vacancy is announced.

Nonbargaining employees on active military duty may also request reassignments to lateral or lower level positions in accordance with the nonbargaining selection policy. Selected individuals are to be placed in the new position with the appropriate pay level by initiating a personnel action while in the leave without pay (LWOP) status.

An audit trail of the selection activity must be established and retained by Human Resources. Upon return from active military service, the responsibility for submitting bids or applications for nonbargaining positions reverts to the employee.

Publication 75, Mover's Guide, News

As of April 1, 2015, recycle any old copies of Publication 75, *Mover's Guide*. All Post Offices™ should have received the new April – June 2015 issue of Publication 75 by March 31, 2015. Similar to last quarter's shipment, the total quantity of *Mover's Guide* copies sent to your facility may have been reduced. In an effort to reduce waste and account for more customers submitting change-of-address orders online, fewer *Mover's Guide* copies are needed. There are several things you can do to conserve as well:

- Make sure customers are aware that USPS.com® is the most convenient, safe, and secure way for customers to submit a change-of-address order.
- Encourage carriers to take Internet Change of Address (ICOA) message cards on their routes instead of *Mover's Guide* copies.
- Give *Mover's Guide* copies out to *moving* customers only.

Important Reminders and Alerts

Alert: The Postal Service™ offers the *Mover's Guide* as a service to our customers to assist them with forwarding mail to new addresses. Remember, provide only one *Mover's Guide* per mover unless the visitor asks for more. In that event, provide no more than three. The Postal Service has determined that this number is sufficient for customers who use the *Mover's Guide* to submit a Change of Address Order relating to a move.

Reminders:

- Copies of *Mover's Guide* must be kept behind the counter *ONLY*, not in inner or outer lobbies or on clerk counters.
- Customers unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at www.usps.com should be given a complete, unopened copy of *Mover's Guide*.

- Limit of one *Mover's Guide* per customer. Upon request, up to three can be provided.
- *Mover's Guide* is printed and distributed four times a year.

Shipment Information and Inventory Management

Offices will continue to receive copies of *Mover's Guide* in one or two shipments. The first shipments should have arrived by the end of March. The second shipments will arrive 3 to 5 weeks later.

- Boxes with PINK stickers are the first shipment for this print run.
- Boxes with YELLOW stickers are the second and final shipment for this print run.

To track your office's shipment information, go to http://blue.usps.gov/purchase/operations/ops_downloads.htm and click *Mover's Guide* (Pub 75) Distribution for April – June 2015. ICOA Message Card Information

If your Post Office has an ICOA message card display, replenishment cards and updated banners will be mailed with your *Mover's Guide* shipments. DO NOT THROW AWAY THE DISPLAY OR ICOA MESSAGE CARDS. THEY DO NOT EXPIRE. The display is REQUIRED to be in the lobby and it must have the ICOA message cards in it at all times.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

A2. APO/FPO/DPO addresses shall not include a city and/or country name.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976 or, if the customer prefers, PS Form 2976-A) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as official mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in PUB 52, Sec 431. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in PUB 52, Sec 431.3 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those available under PUB 52, Sec 421, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:

- Maximum length 12 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
- Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 pounds, regardless of class.

V. Priority Mail Express Military Service (PMEMS) not available from any origin.

V1. USPS Tracking is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Freely Associated States (FAS) Restrictions

Effective March 19, 2015, the mailing restrictions for Freely Associated States will be listed in the Pull-Out section of the *Postal Bulletin* and updated periodically.

Mail addressed to freely associated states is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. On May 9, 2015, in Irvine, CA, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *Special Olympics World Games* First-Class Mail® Forever® stamp, in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 472800).

The stamp will go on sale nationwide May 9, 2015.

This year, the U.S. Postal Service celebrates the 2015 Special Olympics World Games, the flagship event of the Special Olympics movement. The Games will be held in Los Angeles from July 25 to August 2. It will be the first time the Special Olympics World Summer Games have been held in the United States since 1999. The stamp features the 2015 Special Olympics World Games Los Angeles logo, showcasing the colors of flags from participating countries. "The logo's celebratory figure represents the courage, determination, and joy of our athletes," says Patrick McClenahan, president and chief executive officer of the 2015 Games. "Placing the iconic image inside the circle represents acceptance and inclusion of people with

intellectual disabilities." The words "Special Olympics World Games Los Angeles 2015" and "Forever/USA" appear on the stamp; its colored background begins as a light orange at the top of the stamp then darkens as it moves toward the bottom. The title of the pane "Special Olympics World Games" appears in two shades of orange on a white background. Art director Greg Breeding designed the stamp.

Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches horizontally by 2 inches vertically. Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1.

The Postal Service™ must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services four weeks before the event using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announcement/Report*. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in *italics* under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

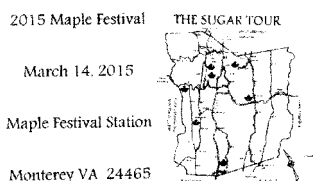
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first-day-of-issue city. The first-day-of-issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first-day-of-issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.
