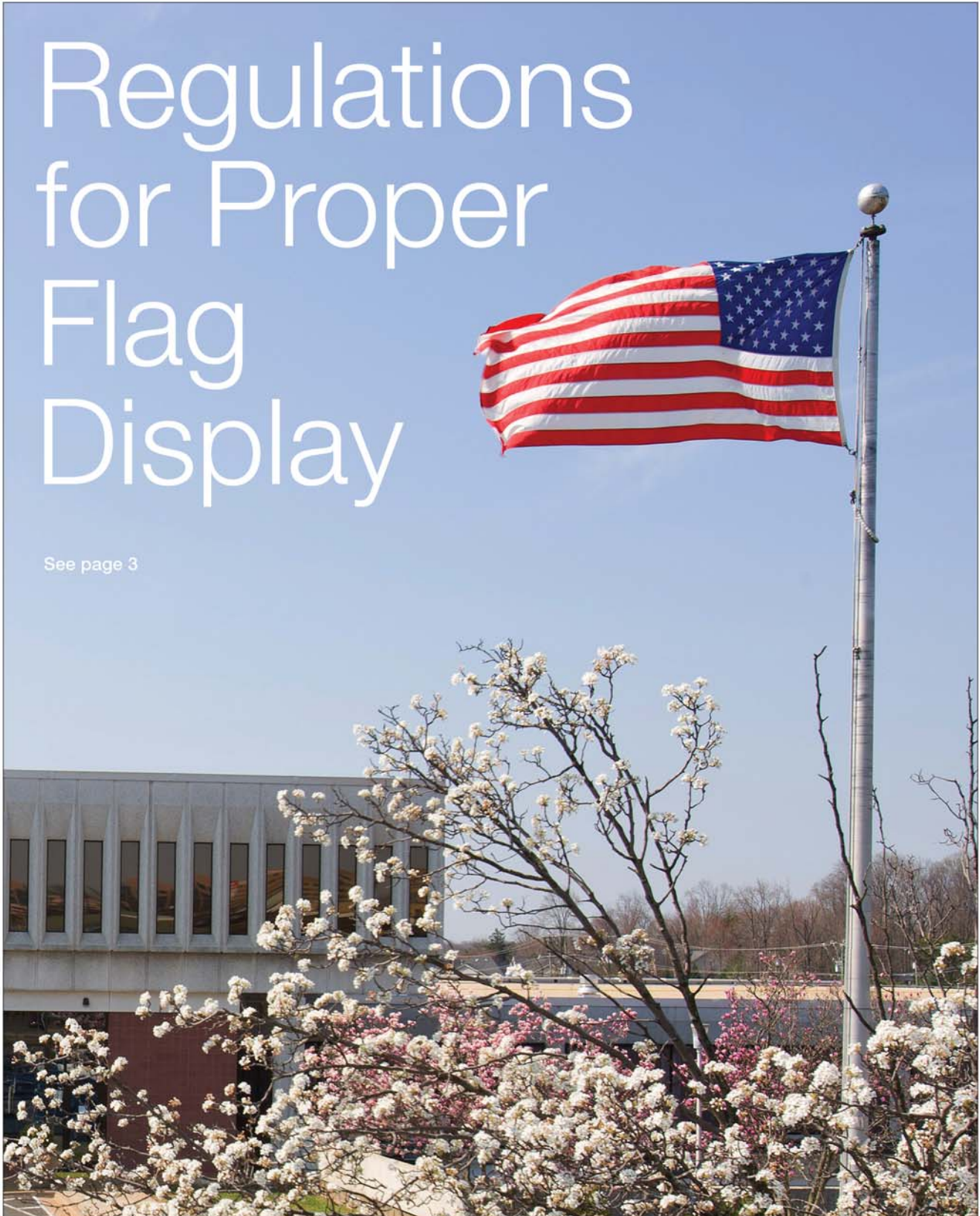

Cover Story

Regulations for Proper Flag Display

The regulations for the proper display of flags are contained in Part 47 of the *Administrative Support Manual* (ASM). Sections of this part of the manual are reprinted here so that Postmasters can ensure that the American flag, the Postal Service™ flag, and the MIA-POW f47 flag are displayed properly. 47 Flags

471 Flags at Postal Facilities

471.1 Which May Be Displayed

Except as governed by host facilities as noted in 472.21, the only flags to be displayed at postal facilities are the flag of the United States of America, the Postal Service flag, the POW-MIA flag, and, when authorized by the vice president of Corporate Communications, flags directly related to the programs, missions, and activities of the United States Postal Service. Flags of states, commonwealths, or local governments must not be displayed.

471.2 Relative Placement

471.21 When Displayed on Flagstaffs

Other flags are flown below the U.S. flag if displayed on the same flagstaff and at the same level or lower if displayed on a separate flagstaff. When the U.S. flag is flown at half-staff, all other flags are to be at half-staff.

471.22 When Displayed on Speaker's Platform

When the United States flag and the Postal Service flag are displayed on a speaker's platform in an auditorium, the United States flag must occupy the position of honor and be placed at the speaker's right as the speaker faces the audience, with the Postal Service flag at the speaker's left.

472 U.S. Flag Display

472.1 Regulations for Proper Display

472.11 Placement

If the flag of the United States is not flown from a vertical flagstaff, the following regulations apply:

- a. When the flag is displayed from a staff projecting horizontally or at an angle from the window sill, balcony, or front of a building, the union of the flag (blue field

and stars) must be placed at the peak of the staff unless the flag is at half-staff.

- b. When the flag is suspended over a sidewalk from a rope extending from a building to a pole at the edge of the sidewalk, the flag must be hoisted out, union first, from the building.
- c. When the flag is displayed otherwise than by being flown from a staff, it must be displayed flat, whether indoors or out, or so suspended that its folds fall as free as though the flag were staffed.

472.12 Respect

No disrespect may be shown to the flag of the United States of America. It must never:

- a. Be dipped to any person or thing.
- b. Be displayed with the union down save as a signal of dire distress.
- c. Be used as drapery of any sort whatsoever; never festooned, drawn back, nor up in folds, but always allowed to fall free.
- d. Touch anything beneath it, such as the ground, the floor, water, or merchandise.
- e. Be fastened, displayed, used, or stored in such a manner as will permit it to be easily torn, soiled, or damaged in any way.
- f. Be used as a covering for a ceiling.
- g. Have placed upon it, nor on any part of it, nor attached to it any mark, insignia, letter, word, figure, design, picture, or drawing of any nature.
- h. Be used as a receptacle for receiving, holding, carrying, or delivering anything.

472.13 Raising and Lowering

472.131 Full Staff

As soon after sunrise as practicable, the flag must be hoisted briskly to the peak of the staff. Care must be taken that it not touch the ground. The flag must always be displayed with the union (blue field) at the peak of the staff (unless the flag is at half-staff). No later than sunset, the flag must be lowered ceremoniously and not allowed to touch the ground. It must be folded or rolled carefully and stored where it will not be soiled or otherwise damaged. If the flag is wet when taken down, it must be carefully spread out and allowed to dry thoroughly before being stored.

472.132 Half-Staff

Displaying the flag at half-staff means lowering the flag to half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff. The flag must first be hoisted to the peak of the staff and

then slowly lowered to half-staff. When the flag is lowered for the day, it must be raised again to the peak and then lowered slowly before being stored for the night. When the flag is displayed at half-staff during a period of mourning, it must be so displayed on all days included in such period.

472.14 Bad Weather

During severe weather when it is probable that the flag will be damaged, it should not be flown.

472.2 Postal Display

472.21 Where Displayed

The flag of the United States must be displayed on stationary flagstaffs at all Post Offices, branches, stations, terminals, garages, and postal facilities, including leased and rented premises. If the Post Office unit is located in a facility operated by the General Services Administration, that agency's regulations on the display of the flag govern. If the Post Office unit is located on a military reservation, the military regulations on the display of the flag on the reservation govern.

472.22 When Displayed

When employees are on duty in a postal facility, the flag must be displayed except in severe weather as noted in

472.14. It is raised as soon after sunrise as practicable and lowered at the time of closing or no later than sunset.

472.23 When Displayed Half-Staff

472.231 Specific Days

When the flag is being displayed, it must be flown at half-staff (see 472.132) on the following dates:

May 15	Peace Officers Memorial Day (see note 1 below)
Last Monday in May	Memorial Day Observed (see note 2 below)
December 7	National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

Note 1: When May 15, which is the date for Peace Officers Memorial Day, falls on the third Saturday in May, which is the date for Armed Forces Day, the Postal Service follows the regulations in the United States Code (36 U.S.C. 175) and flies the U.S. flag in the full-staff position, *not* at half-staff.

Note 2: On the last Monday in May, when Memorial Day is observed, the flag must be flown at half-staff from sunrise, or the hour at which it is raised, *until 12 noon*, and then hoisted to the peak of the staff, where it must be flown until the time of closing or no later than sunset.

472.232 Deaths of Prominent Persons

When the flag is being displayed, it must be flown at half-staff on the death of any person as indicated in Exhibit 472.232.

Exhibit 472.232 Half-Staff Display on Death of a Prominent Person

On Death Of:	Flag Displayed Half-Staff:	On All Federal Buildings In:
President or former President	For 30 days from date of death.	District of Columbia; throughout the U.S., and its territories and possessions
Vice President, U.S. Chief Justice or retired Chief Justice, or Speaker of the House of Representatives	For 10 days from date of death.	
Associate Justice of Supreme Court, Cabinet member, Former Vice President, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Majority Leader of House, or Minority Leader of House,	From date of death until interment.	Metropolitan area of District of Columbia; the state, congressional district, territory, or commonwealth
U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, or Delegate	On date of death and following day.	
Resident Commissioner from Commonwealth of Puerto Rico	From date of death until interment.	Commonwealth of Puerto Rico
Governor of a state, territory, or possession	From date of death until interment.	The state, territory, or possession
Prominent local citizen	From date of death until immediately after funeral.	Locally
Other official, former official, or foreign dignitary	The flag is displayed half-staff under orders or instructions issued by or at the direction of the President, or according to recognized customs or practices not inconsistent with law.	

472.233 Other Occasions

Other occasions on which the flag may be displayed at half-staff include the following:

- a. On days proclaimed by the president of the United States.
- b. The heads of government departments and agencies may direct that the flag be flown at half-staff on buildings, grounds, etc., under their jurisdiction on occasions other than those specified which they consider proper. The vice president of Corporate Relations notifies area, district, and plant managers by either broadcast fax or electronic mail of such an order. They, in turn, notify the heads of all postal facilities reporting to them.
- c. The flag may be displayed at half-staff on days when funerals of returned war dead are being held locally, when the flags on municipal, county, or state buildings and business establishments generally are being displayed in that manner.

* * * * *

475 Postal Service Flag Display

475.1 Authorized Use

The Postal Service flag is authorized for use as follows:

- a. On or in front of Postal Service installations.
- b. At Postal Service ceremonies.
- c. At conferences in which the Postal Service is participating (including display in Postal Service conference rooms).
- d. At governmental or public appearances of Postal Service officers and/or executives.
- e. In the offices of Postal Service officers.
- f. By all Postal Service vice presidents of Area Operations, district managers, and all field units reporting directly to Headquarters.
- g. On the approval of a vice president, when judged to be in the best interest of the Postal Service.
- h. As otherwise authorized by the Postmaster General or designee.

475.2 Display Regulations

The Postal Service flag is displayed only in conjunction with the United States flag. The same regulations for proper display of the United States flag described in 471 and 472 must also be followed when displaying the Postal Service flag.

476 POW-MIA Flag Display

476.1 Policy

The Defense Authorization Act, Public Law 105-85, section 1082, requires that postal facilities display the POW-MIA flag on six specified days each year:

Armed Forces Day	Third Saturday in May
Memorial Day	Last Monday in May
Flag Day	June 14
Independence Day	July 4
National POW-MIA Recognition Day	Third Friday in September
Veterans Day	November 11

Note: If any of these days fall on a non-business day, postal facilities are required to display the POW-MIA flag on the last business day before the designated day.

476.2 Display

476.21 Description

The POW-MIA flag that may be flown at postal facilities is the National League of Families POW-MIA flag that is recognized officially and designated by Public Law 101-355, section 2.

476.22 Regulations

The POW-MIA flag must be displayed in a manner designed to ensure visibility to the public.

476.23 Placement with the United States Flag

No other flag should be placed above or, if on the same level, to the right of United States flag.

DMM Revision: Mandatory Use of Customs Declaration PS Form 2976-B on APO/FPO/DPO Priority Mail Express

Effective July 13, 2015, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 703.2.3.6* to make mandatory the use of PS Form 2976-B, *Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form*, on Priority Mail Express® items requiring a customs form for APO/FPO/DPO addresses. This is part of an ongoing effort to improve efficiency and our customers' retail experience by requiring only one form, which combines the mailing label and customs form.

We are simultaneously revising sections 123.1 and 123.6 of the International Mail Manual (IMM®) to incorporate these changes; see separate article titled "IMM Revision: Preparation Requirements for Priority Mail Express International Shipments" in this issue of the *Postal Bulletin*.

2.3.6 Customs Declarations

[Revise the first sentence of 2.3.6 to read as follows:]

Customs declaration PS Form 2976, PS Form 2976-A, or PS Form 2976-B must be applied to mailpieces sent to APO, FPO, and DPO addresses as required in the "Overseas Military/Diplomatic Mail" section of the *Postal Bulletin*.***

2.3.7 Customs Declarations – Required Usage

[Revise 2.3.7 in its entirety to read as follows:]

Customs declarations forms required for use to or from APO/FPO/DPO addresses are as follows:

- a. Except as provided in 2.3.8, mailpieces addressed to or from an APO, FPO, or DPO location must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B, *Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form*, if mailed using Priority Mail Express service.
- b. Other than as provided in a) above and in 2.3.8, mailpieces addressed to or from an APO, FPO, or DPO location must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976, *Customs Declaration – CN22* or, if the customer prefers, a PS Form 2976-A, *Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note – CP 72*, if:
 1. The mailpiece weighs 16 ounces or more (regardless of its contents, value, shape, or mail class [other than Priority Mail Express, which requires a PS Form 2976-B]).
 2. The mailpiece contains goods (regardless of weight, shape, or mail class [other than Priority Mail Express, which requires a PS Form 2976-B]).

IMM Revision: Preparation Requirements for Priority Mail Express International Shipments

Effective July 13, 2015, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) sections 123.1, 123.3, 123.6, 123.7, 222.5, 224.1, 224.2, and 922.3, and all Individual Country Listings (ICLs) for countries that accept Priority Mail Express International® service to reflect updated mail preparation requirements for Priority Mail Express International shipments.

In the article titled “IMM Revision: Preparation Requirements for Priority Mail Express International Shipments” in *Postal Bulletin* 22375 (10-31-13, pages 17–19), we incorporated mailing standards for PS Form 2976-B, *Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form*, and announced that Label 11-B, *Express Mail Post Office to Addressee*, would no longer be effective for Priority Mail Express International shipments. Continuing the work begun in that article, we are now making PS Form 2976-B mandatory for all Priority Mail Express International shipments that require a customs form, and we are revising the following IMM standards accordingly.

Also, as part of an ongoing effort to improve efficiency and the customer experience at retail, we are making PS Form 2976-B mandatory for all Priority Mail Express shipments that require a customs form to and from APO/FPO/DPO addresses. As noted in the article titled “DMM Revision: Customs Declaration Form PS Form 2976-B Mandatory for Use on APO/FPO/DPO Priority Mail Express” in this issue of the *Postal Bulletin*, we are simultaneously revising section 703.2.3 of *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) to incorporate these changes.

123.1 USPS-Produced Customs Declaration Forms

123.11 General

As required under 123.6, only three customs declaration forms are used for international mail:

[Revise item c to read as follows (adding a reference to Priority Mail Express to APO/FPO/DPO destinations):]

- c. PS Form 2976-B, *Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form*. **Note:** For international mail, PS Form 2976-B is used only for Priority Mail Express International items. However, as noted in DMM 703.2.3, PS Form 2976-B is also used with Priority Mail Express items sent to APO/FPO/DPO destinations.

123.3 Privately Printed Forms

123.31 Authorization

[In the introductory paragraph, revise the second sentence to read as follows (adding a reference to PS Form 2976-B):]

If authorized, a mailer may privately print PS Forms 2976, 2976-A, and 2976-B as specified in the Customs Form Certification Checklist, which is available by clicking on the link to that checklist at the Web site noted in 123.31b.

[Revise the final paragraph to read as follows (adding a reference to PS Form 2976-B):]

Upon receipt of the request, the NCSC will send the mailer an application and specifications for preparing PS Forms 2976, 2976-A, and/or 2976-B.

123.6 Required Usage

123.61 Conditions

The following conditions apply to customs forms for international mail items:

[Revise the first sentence of item c to read as follows (adding a reference to Priority Mail Express to APO/FPO/DPO destinations):]

- c. Regardless of any listing in Exhibit 123.61, items containing articles that require an export license (see 532) must always bear PS Form 2976-A or PS Form 2976-B — note that, for international mail, PS Form 2976-B is used only for Priority Mail Express International items, but as noted in DMM 703.2.3, PS Form 2976-B is also used with Priority Mail Express items sent to APO/FPO/DPO destinations.***

123.72 PS Form 2976-A, Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note — CP 72**123.721 Sender's Preparation of PS Form 2976-A**

[Revise the introductory paragraph to read as follows, and delete Exhibits 123.721a, 123.721b, and 123.721c:]

[Redesignate current 123.73 as new 123.74, and insert new 123.73 to read as follows:]

123.73 PS Form 2976-B, Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form**123.731 Sender's Preparation of PS Form 2976-B**

An image of PS Form 2976-B, *Priority Mail Express International Shipping Label and Customs Form*, is available at <http://about.usps.com/forms/ps2976b.pdf>. Before mailing, the sender must fulfill any nonpostal export requirements described in Chapter 5 and do the following:

- Enter both the sender's and addressee's full name and full address in the blocks provided. Provide the

sender's and addressee's telephone/fax number or email address.

- In block (1), enter, if applicable, a USPS corporate account (USPSCA) number, federal agency account number, or Postal Service account number for payment by account.
- In block (2), check all applicable boxes to indicate whether the package contains a gift, documents, commercial samples, or other items. Check the box for "Dangerous Goods" if the shipment contains mailable dangerous goods.
- In block (3), enter the applicable Automated Export System (AES) Internal Transaction Number (ITN), an AES Exemption, or if applicable, an AES Downtime Citation. One of these codes must appear in the "AES/ITN Exemption" block before the Postal Service will accept a package for mailing.
- In block (4), provide a detailed description, in English, of each article. General descriptions such as "food," "medicine," "gifts," or "clothing" are not acceptable. In addition to the English text, a translation in another language is permitted. If there is insufficient space on the form to list all contents, use a second form (and additional forms, if necessary) to continue listing the contents, and indicate on the first form that the contents are continued on one or more subsequent forms. When using this option, ensure that the barcodes on the subsequent forms are totally obliterated to avoid multiple barcodes being assigned to the package. Place all subsequent forms listing the contents into PS Form 2976-E, *Customs Declaration Envelope — CP 91* (plastic envelope).
- In blocks (5), (6), and (7), enter the quantity, net weight (in pounds and ounces), and value (in U.S. dollars) of each article.
- In block (8), enter, if known, the 6-digit Harmonized Tariff Schedule number, which is based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System developed by the World Customs Organization.

- h. In block (9), enter, if known, the “Country of Origin,” which is the country where the goods were produced/manufactured or assembled.
 - i. In block (10), enter the total weight (in pounds and ounces) of the package, including packaging (the total weight is used to calculate postage), and enter the total value in U.S. dollars.
 - j. In block (11), sign and date the form. Your signature certifies that all entries are correct and that the item(s) being mailed contain no undeclared dangerous, prohibited, or restricted contents per United States Postal Service, customs, or destination country regulations.
 - k. In blocks (12) and (13), enter the applicable number if the item requires a Sender’s Customs Reference or Importer’s Reference.
 - l. In blocks (14), (15), and (16), enter the License Number, Certificate Number, and/or Invoice Number, if applicable.
 - m. Insert the completed form and all other required documents, such as a commercial invoice or additional subsequent forms, into PS Form 2976-E (plastic envelope). Affix PS Form 2976-E to the address side of the package. Do not fold the form set or wrap it around the package.
 - n. Present the item for mailing and allow the Postal Service employee to complete PS Form 2976-B as described in 123.732.
- d. If the sender purchases additional insurance against loss, damage, or missing contents, the acceptance employee records the insured amount in U.S. dollars on PS Form 2976-B in the space provided.
 - e. If the sender did not already fill out this information in an online application, weigh the parcel, enter the weight, insured amount, and insurance fee (if applicable — see 222.71 and 222.72), originating facility ZIP Code, postage, total postage/fees, date and time received, and scheduled delivery date in the shaded area provided in the upper-right corner of the form.
 - f. Round stamp the form in the appropriate place on each copy (copies 1–5).
 - g. Remove the Post Office copy (Copy 4) and tell the sender that the Postal Service will retain this document for 30 days as a record of mailing. Remove the Sender’s copy (Copy 5) and give it to the mailer.
 - h. Round stamp any uncanceled stamps, and if postage is paid by meter, round stamp the front of the piece near the meter postage.
 - i. Review the IMM individual country listing for destination-specific mailing restrictions, prohibitions, and observations that apply to all mail classes unless otherwise noted.
 - j. Enter into the Customs and Border Protection Manifest (CBPMAN) application all data the sender has provided on PS Form 2976-B. The data that the sender provided on the declaration must match what is entered into CBPMAN at the Point of Sale or ACE terminal.

123.732 Preparation by Acceptance Employee of PS Form 2976-B

The acceptance employee must do the following when accepting PS Form 2976-B from the sender:

- a. Verify that the sender has entered the information on the form required in 123.731 and has signed and dated the declaration.
- b. Instruct the sender to complete any incomplete portions of the forms. Remind the sender that failure to complete the form properly can delay delivery of the item or inconvenience the sender and addressee. Moreover, a false, misleading, or incomplete declaration can result in the seizure or return of the item and/or criminal or civil penalties. The Postal Service assumes no responsibility for the accuracy of information that the sender enters on PS Form 2976-B.
- c. To comply with U.S. Census Bureau requirements, it is the sender’s responsibility to ensure that an appropriate AES ITN, AES Exemption, or AES Downtime Citation is displayed on PS Form 2976-B. If this information is not entered, remind the sender that he or she may be subject to civil and criminal penalties for noncompliance.

Note: When using the CBPMAN Bypass option, enter the data from PS Form 2976-B into CBPMAN using POS ONE or an ACE computer by close of business that same day, which is considered to be 2 a.m. Eastern time (11 p.m. Pacific time).

- k. After acceptance, place each item in the appropriate working pouch for forwarding to the international exchange office authorized to dispatch Priority Mail Express International shipments to that destination. (See Handbook T-5, *International Mail Operations*.)

Note: Consistent with 225.12, the sender must present any item bearing a handwritten PS Form 2976-B to an employee at a Post Office retail service counter.

123.74 PS Form 2976-E, Customs Declaration Envelope — CP 91

Publications

Publication 75, Mover’s Guide, News

As of July 1, 2015, recycle any old copies of Publication 75, *Mover’s Guide*. All Post Offices™ should receive the new July–September 2015 issue of Publication 75 by June 30, 2015. Similar to last quarter’s shipment, the total quantity of *Mover’s Guide* copies sent to your facility may have been reduced. In an effort to reduce waste and account for more customers submitting change-of-address orders online, fewer *Mover’s Guide* copies are needed. There are several things you can do to conserve as well:

- Make sure customers are aware that <http://www.usps.com> is the most convenient, safe, and secure way for customers to submit a change-of-address order.
- Encourage carriers to take ICOA message cards on their routes instead of *Mover’s Guide* copies.
- Give *Mover’s Guide* copies out to *moving* customers only.

Important Reminders and Alerts

Alert: The Postal Service™ offers the *Mover’s Guide* as a service to our customers to assist them with forwarding

mail to new addresses. Remember, provide only one *Mover’s Guide* per mover unless the visitor asks for more. In that event, provide no more than three. The Postal Service has determined that this number is sufficient for customers who use the *Mover’s Guide* to submit a Change of Address Order relating to a move.

Reminders:

- Copies of *Mover’s Guide* must be kept behind the counter *ONLY*, not in inner or outer lobbies or on clerk counters.
- Customers unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at www.usps.com should be given a complete, unopened copy of *Mover’s Guide*.
- Limit of one *Mover’s Guide* per customer. Upon request, up to three can be provided.
- *Mover’s Guide* is printed and distributed four times a year.

Shipment Information and Inventory Management

Offices will continue to receive copies of *Mover's Guide* in one or two shipments. The first shipments should arrive by the end of June. The second shipments will arrive 3 to 5 weeks later.

- Boxes with BLUE stickers are the first shipment for this print run.
- Boxes with ORANGE stickers are the second and final shipment for this print run.

To track your office's shipment information, go to http://blue.usps.gov/purchase/operations/ops_downloads.htm and click *Mover's Guide* (Pub 75) Distribution for July–September 2015. ICOA Message Card Information

If your Post Office has an ICOA message card display, replenishment cards and updated banners will be mailed with your *Mover's Guide* shipments. DO NOT THROW AWAY THE DISPLAY OR ICOA MESSAGE CARDS. THEY DO NOT EXPIRE. The display is REQUIRED to be in the lobby and it must have the ICOA message cards in it at all times.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

A2. APO/FPO/DPO addresses shall not include a city and/or country name.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976 or, if the customer prefers, PS Form 2976-A) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as official mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in PUB 52, Sec. 431. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in PUB 52, Sec. 431.3 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under PUB 52, Sec. 421, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:

- Maximum length 12 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
- Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 pounds, regardless of class.

V. Priority Mail Express Military Service (PMEMS) not available from any origin.

V1. USPS Tracking is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Displaying the U.S. Flag and the POW-MIA Flag

U.S. Flag at Half-Staff

How to Display

Displaying the U.S. flag at *half-staff* means lowering the flag to half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.

Specific Dates

Display the U.S. flag at half-staff on the following days each year:

- May 15: Peace Officers Memorial Day (see note 1 below).
- Last Monday in May: Memorial Day Observed (see note 2 below).
- December 7: National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.



Note 1: When May 15, which is the date for Peace Officers Memorial Day, falls on the third Saturday in May, which is the date for Armed Forces Day, display the U.S. flag in the full-staff position, *not* at half-staff.

Note 2: On the last Monday in May, when Memorial Day is observed, display the flag at half-staff from sunrise, or the hour at which you raise it, until noon, and then hoist it to the peak of the staff, until the time of closing or no later than sunset.

POW-MIA Flag

How to Display

In relation to the U.S. flag, display the POW-MIA flag (and any other flag) as follows:

- If displayed on the same flagstaff, place it below the U.S. flag.
- If displayed on a separate flagstaff, place it at the same level or lower. If displayed at the same level, place it on the U.S. flag's left.

When flying the U.S. flag at half-staff, fly the POW-MIA flag (and any other flags) at half-staff also.

Specific Dates

Display the POW-MIA flag on the following days each year:

- Armed Forces Day: Third Saturday in May.
- Memorial Day: Last Monday in May.
- Flag Day: June 14.
- Independence Day: July 4.
- National POW-MIA Recognition Day: Third Friday in September.
- Veterans Day: November 11.

If any of these days fall on a nonbusiness day, display the POW-MIA flag on the last business day before the designated day.

Freely Associated States

Mail addressed to freely associated states is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. The FAS table below outlines these conditions as listed by each affected FAS ZIP Code™ through the use of footnoted mailing restrictions codes (see the [Restrictions](#) following the table). For additional information on available extra services for FAS destinations, see *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)*, part 503.

The G Fund is managed internally by the Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board. Assets of the F, C, S, and I Funds are managed externally. The Board currently has contracts with BlackRock Institutional Trust Company, N.A., to manage the F, C, S, and I Fund assets. The F, C, S, and I Funds invest in commingled trust funds, in which the assets of tax-deferred employee benefit plans are combined and invested together. The F, C, S, and I Funds and the BlackRock funds are passively managed index funds.

Future performance of the funds will vary and may be significantly different from the returns shown above. See the *Summary of the Thrift Savings Plan* for detailed information about the funds and their investment risks. The monthly returns of the TSP Funds represent net earnings for the month after deduction of accrued administrative expenses and, except for the G Fund, after deduction of trading costs and accrued investment management fees as well. The returns for the four indexes shown do not include any of these deductions.

with an early concept developed by former art director Richard Sheaff, Antonio Alcalá art directed these stamps. **Michael Doret was the designer and artist.**

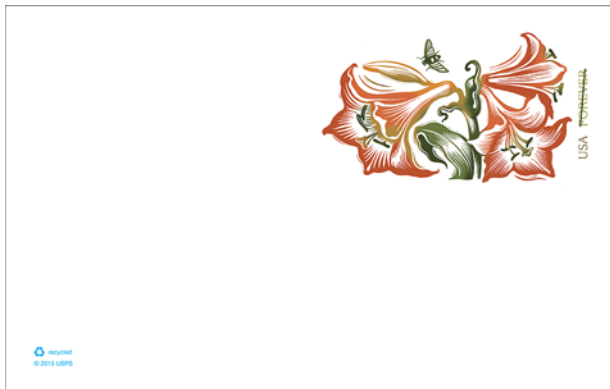

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it To Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first-day-of-issue city. The first-day-of-issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There

is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through

the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first-day-of-issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.
