Winter Safety

Working outside during winter presents special challenges for employees who are exposed to cold temperatures and hazardous conditions.

Prolonged exposure to cold temperatures can cause your body to lose heat faster than it's able to produce it, which puts employees at risk of hypothermia or frostbite. Frostbite occurs when skin is exposed to extreme cold for long periods and the skin and underlying tissue freeze. The fingers, toes, and feet are most commonly affected, but other extremities including the nose, ears, and the cheeks can also develop frostbite.

At the first sign of frostbite, get out of the cold. Unless absolutely necessary, do not walk on frostbitten feet or toes. Don't rub the frostbitten area because it will increase tissue damage. Warm the affected area using body heat or

by immersing in warm water; avoid using a heating pad, heat lamp, or the heat of a stove, fireplace, or radiator for warming because direct heat can burn tissue that's already damaged. Drink warm drinks to replace lost fluid. In case of severe frostbite, seek medical attention.

Snow and icy conditions increase the occurrences of slips, trips, and falls resulting in pain and lost productivity due to injuries. Proper footwear is essential for safe walking on slippery surfaces. To prevent slips, trips, and falls, wear grippers (ice cleats), walk with care, take short steps, and only finger mail when it is safe to do so. Take extra precautions when entering and exiting your vehicle — use handrails on steps, and wait for vehicles to stop completely on snow or ice-covered roadways before crossing the street.

Always remember, "Safety Depends on Me."

2016 Tax Information: Form W-2 Wage and Tax Statement; Form 1099

General Form W-2 Information

If an employee has earnings from more than one state or locality, a separate Form W-2 (See pages [11-12](#)) will be issued for each.

Form W-2, *Wage and Tax Statement*, for 2016 will be mailed to all employees except those employees who, through the *PostalEASE* “W-2” module, elected not to receive mailed copies of Forms W-2 in lieu of official, electronic Forms W-2. The *PostalEASE* “W-2” module makes online viewing and/or printing of Forms W-2 for any of the last seven years available to all employees.

The format of the 2016 Form W-2 remains unchanged from the 2015 version.

An employee may be able to take the Earned Income Credit (EIC) for 2016, if he or she meets qualifying requirements. Details are printed in the “Notice to Employee” section of the Form W-2. An employee may also qualify for a state EIC credit. Employees should visit applicable state taxing authority websites to determine eligibility.

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act created the “Additional Medicare Tax” effective January 1, 2013. All wages and other compensation that are subject to regular Medicare tax in excess of \$200,000 are subject to an additional Medicare tax of 0.9%. All Medicare tax withheld is reported in Box 6 of the Form W-2.

General Questions

Source of Reported Wages

The Wages and Other Compensation amount reported in Box 1 of Form W-2 is derived from year-to-date (YTD) totals reflected on the employee's Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) Earnings Statement, plus several other totals from the Form W-2. The employee's Earnings Statement (YTD) amounts and the Reconciliation Formula calculation specific to the

employee are printed on the employee's Form W-2 (top left section of the page). In addition, employees can access this information via *PostalEASE* (W-2 module).

Flexible Spending Accounts (FSA): Dependent Care (DC) and Health Care (HC)

- Employee contributions to an FSA for dependent care are reported in Box 10 (Dependent Care Benefits). Per the Reconciliation Formula, FSA contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).
- Employee contributions to an FSA for health care are not reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, FSA contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) earnings statement year-to-date amount to determine your total Health Care FSA contributions made in 2016.

Thrift Savings Plan (TSP)

- Employee TSP traditional contributions including TSP Catch-up (employees 50 years old and older) are reported in Box 12 (letter code "D").
- Per the Reconciliation Formula, traditional TSP contributions (Box 12, letter code "D") are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).
- TSP Roth contributions including TSP Catch-Up are reported in Box 12 (letter code "AA"). TSP Roth contributions do not reduce gross pay; they are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). Roth contributions (letter code "AA") are reported for your information only.

Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB)

- FEHB premiums are considered pretax unless the employee declined the pretax benefit. Payroll deductions for pretax FEHB premium payments are no longer reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for pretax FEHB premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) earnings statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pretax FEHB premium payments made in 2016.
- The Cost of Employer-Sponsored Health Coverage (employer costs plus employee pretax or post-tax cost) is reported in Box 12 (letter code "DD"). Reporting is required by the Affordable Care Act but is reported for informational purposes only.

Health Savings Accounts (HSA)

Employee HSA contributions are reported in Box 12 (letter code "W"). Per the Reconciliation Formula, employee HSA contributions (Box 12) are subtracted from gross pay and are not included Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP)

FEDVIP premiums are considered pretax. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for pretax FEDVIP premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) earnings statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pretax FEDVIP premium payments made in 2016.

USPS HB (previously known as USPS NCE HB)

- USPS® HB premiums are considered post-tax, unless the employee opts for pretax deductions. Post-tax premiums are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).
- For those employees who elected pretax premiums, these pretax premium payments are not reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for pretax USPS HB premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) earnings statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pretax USPS HB premium payments made in 2016.
- The Cost of Employer-Sponsored Health Coverage (employer share plus employee pretax or post-tax share) is reported in Box 12 (letter code "DD"). Reporting is required by the Affordable Care Act, but such reporting is for informational purposes only.
Note: For Benefit Year 2016, the USPS employer share for USPS HB is \$125 per pay period. However, the total employer cost per pay period is the \$125 plus any HB premium shortage (shortage = employee share minus what the employee actually paid) for the pay period.

Example:

- USPS HB Self Only Plan has a cost of \$160.00 per pay period (reported in Box 12, Code DD).
- Employer share is \$125.00.
- Employee share is up to \$35.00, but employee pays only \$10.00 because of insufficient gross).
- Shortage is \$25.00.

Total Employer Cost is \$150.00 (\$125.00 Employer Share plus \$25.00 Shortage).

Commuter Program

Employee contributions for the Commuter Program are considered pretax for 2016 up to the IRS \$255 monthly limit (annually \$3,110) for public transportation and/or the IRS \$255 monthly limit (annually \$3,110) for parking. Per the Reconciliation Formula, employee pretax commuter contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2016 (or the last pay period in pay status 2016) earnings statement year-to-date amount to determine your total Commuter Program contributions made in 2016. Any commuting contributions elected over the IRS limits are considered post-tax. Post-tax contributions do not reduce gross pay; they are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Relocation Payments

Qualified relocation (excludable) reimbursements paid directly to an employee are reported in Box 12 (letter code "P"). Per the Reconciliation Formula, Relocation Gross is added to gross pay while Relocation Excludable (Box 12) is subtracted from gross pay. The net difference between Relocation Gross and Relocation Excludable is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See the statements issued to you by the Postal Service's Relocation Management Firm (Brookfield), if you need additional information.

Employee Business Expense (EBE)

Equipment maintenance allowance (EMA), carrier drive-out, vehicle hire, and supervisor vehicle usage are considered employee expenses paid by the U.S. Postal Service®. The nontaxable (not the total) EBE amount is reported in Box 12 (letter code "L"). If there is a taxable amount, it is reported in Box 14 (Other). Per the Reconciliation Formula, taxable vehicle (Box 14) is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Imputed Life Insurance

- Imputed Income Life Insurance is reported in Box 12 (letter code "C"). The IRS requires (see IRS Publication 15-B) employers to report as income the employer cost of Group Term Life Insurance in excess of \$50,000.
- Per the Reconciliation Formula, Imputed Income Life Insurance (Box 12) is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Locality Pay, LEAP, AUO

Per the Reconciliation Formula, Locality Pay, LEAP (Law Enforcement Availability Pay), and AUO (Administratively Uncontrollable Overtime) are added to gross pay and are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

GEO Pay

Per the Reconciliation Formula, GEO Pay is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Military Differential Payments

Military Differential Payments are reported in Box 14 (Other) and are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). Differential payments made to an individual while on active duty for more than 30 days are not subject to Social Security and Medicare taxes. Differential payments made to an individual while on active duty for 30 days or less are subject to Social Security and Medicare taxes.

State/Territory Taxable Wages

The amount in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.) will equal Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation) with the following exceptions:

- Hawaii includes territorial cost-of-living allowance (TCOLA) in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.).
- California does not allow income deferral for Health Savings Accounts (HSAs).
- Mississippi does not allow income deferral for commuter program public transportation and parking.
- New Jersey allows no income deferral. Therefore, there is no income deferral for TSP, FSA DC, FSA HC, HB, HSA, FEDVIP, and Commuter Program (Public Transportation and Parking).
- Pennsylvania does not allow income deferral for TSP, FSA Dependant Care, and Commuter Program (Public Transportation and Parking). But, on the other hand, Pennsylvania does not require the addition of Imputed Income Life Insurance to state gross pay.
- Puerto Rico does not allow income deferral for employee FSA DC, FSA HC, HB, HSA, FEDVIP, and Commuter Program (Public Transportation and Parking) contributions.

Local Taxable Wages

The following statements do not take into account taxable wage limits that exist for certain localities. For those localities, amounts in Box 18 (Local wages, tips, etc.) will not exceed local taxable wage limits.

The amount in Box 18 (Local wages, tips, etc.) will equal gross pay with the following exceptions:

- New York City, NY; St. Louis, MO; and MI Locals (Battle Creek, Detroit, Flint, Grand Rapids, Lansing, Pontiac, and Saginaw): Local taxable wages are the same as the federal taxable wages reported in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).
- Kansas City, MO: Local taxable wages equals federal taxable wages plus HSA.

- OH Locals (Akron, Brecksville, Brook Park, Canton, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, Dayton, Fairview Park, Heath, Kettering, Mansfield, Newark, Oberlin, Sharonville, Springfield, Toledo, Whitehall, and Youngstown): Local taxable wages equals federal taxable wages plus TSP and minus Life Insurance Imputed Income.
- With the exception of Philadelphia and Pittsburgh, PA Locals (Bethlehem, Erie, Greene, Hanover, Harrisburg, Horsham, Lancaster, Middletown, Reading, Scranton, Sunbury/Gregg, Tinicum, Warminster, Wilkes-Barre, and York) are the same as the PA taxable wages reported in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.).

Obtaining Duplicate Forms W-2 for Tax Years 2010 to the Present

PostalEASE

Employees may use the *PostalEASE* "W-2" module to view and/or print official, electronic copies of their Forms W-2 for any of the last seven years, including the most recent W-2 year.

Except for an approximate six-week period (mid-December through late January), an employee may also exercise the option to have mailed to his or her home address reprinted copies of any of the seven most recent Tax Year Form(s) W-2. Requests are processed weekly (daily during March and April). Employees should allow two weeks to receive the W-2 reprint(s) by mail to the address of record. In mid to late January 2017, Tax Year 2016 will be loaded to the *PostalEASE* W-2 module. At the same time, Tax Year 2009 will be removed from the W-2 module.

PostalEASE Interactive Voice Response (IVR)

USPS employees now have the option to request a duplicate Form W-2 reprint by telephone using the *PostalEASE* automated Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system.

Employees can access *PostalEASE* from the USPS Employee Service Line at 877-477-3273:

- For *PostalEASE*, press or say 1.
- Press or say 8-digit Employee Identification Number.
- Press or say 4-digit USPS Pin.
- For Payroll Options, press 2.
- For W-2 Reprints, press 3.

If you disagree with the Form W-2 tax information provided and you want the tax statement to be reviewed and corrected if wrong, you must submit your request in writing.

Even if you do not have to file a tax return, you may be eligible for a refund if box 2 shows an amount or if you are eligible for any credit. **Earned income credit (EIC).** You may be able to take the EIC for 2016 if your adjusted gross income (AGI) is less than a certain amount. The amount of the credit is based on income and family size. Workers without children could qualify for a smaller credit. You and any qualifying children must have valid social security numbers (SSNs). You cannot take the EIC if your investment income is more than the specified amount for 2016 or if income is earned for services provided while you were an inmate at a penal institution. For 2016 income limits and more information, visit www.irs.gov/efc. Also see Pub. 595, Earned Income Credit. **Any EIC that is more than your tax liability is refunded to you, but only if you file a tax return.**

Clergy and religious workers. If you are not subject to social security and Medicare taxes, see Pub. 517, Social Security and Other Information for Members of the Clergy and Religious Workers.

Corrections. If your name, SSN, or address is incorrect, correct Copies B, C, and 2 and ask your employer to correct your employment record. Be sure to ask the employer to file Form W-2c, Corrected Wage and Tax Statement, with the Social Security Administration (SSA) to correct any name, SSN, or money amount error reported to the SSA on Form W-2. Be sure to get your copies of Form W-2c from your employer for all corrections made so you may file them with your tax return. If your name and SSN are correct but are not the same as shown on your social security card, you should ask for a new card that displays your correct name at any SSA office or by calling 1-800-772-1213. You also may visit the SSA at www.socialsecurity.gov.

Cost of employer-sponsored health coverage (if such cost is provided by the employer). The reporting in box 12, using code DD, of the cost of employer-sponsored health coverage is for your information only. The amount reported with code DD is not taxable.

Credit for excess taxes. If you had more than one employer in 2016 and more than \$7,347 in social security and/or Tier 1 railroad retirement (RRTA) taxes were withheld, you may be able to claim a credit for the excess against your federal income tax. If you had more than one railroad employer and more than \$4,321.50 in Tier 2 RRTA tax was withheld, you also may be able to claim a credit. See your Form 1040 or Form 1040A instructions and Pub. 505, Tax Withholding and Estimated Tax.

Box 8. This amount is not included in boxes 1, 3, 5, or 7. For information on how to report tips on your tax return, see your Form 1040 instructions.

You must file Form 4137, Social Security and Medicare Tax on Unreported Tip Income, with your income tax return to report at least the allocated tip amount unless you can prove that you received a smaller amount. If you have records that show the actual amount of tips you received, report that amount even if it is more or less than the allocated tips. On Form 4137 you will calculate the social security and Medicare tax owed on the allocated tips shown on your Form(s) W-2 that you must report as income and on other tips you did not report to your employer. By filing Form 4137, your social security tips will be credited to your social security record (used to figure your benefits). **Box 10.** This amount includes the total dependent care benefits that your employer paid to you or incurred on your behalf (including amounts from a section 125 (cafeteria) plan). Any amount over \$5,000 is also included in box 1. Complete Form 2441, Child and Dependent Care Expenses, to compute any taxable and nontaxable amounts.

Box 11. This amount is (a) reported in box 1 if it is a distribution made to you from a nonqualified deferred compensation or nongovernmental section 457(b) plan or (b) included in box 3 and/or 5 if it is a prior year deferral under a nonqualified or section 457(b) plan that became taxable for social security and Medicare taxes this year because there is no longer a substantial risk of forfeiture of your right to the deferred amount. This box should not be used if you had a deferral and a distribution in the same calendar year. If you made or deferral and received a distribution in the same calendar year, and you are or will be age 62 by the end of the calendar year, your employer should file Form SSA-131, Employer Report of Special Wage Payments, with the Social Security Administration and give you a copy.

Box 12. The following list explains the codes shown in box 12. You may need this information to complete your tax return. Elective deferrals (codes D, E, F, and S) and designated Roth contributions (codes AA, BB, and EE) under all plans are generally limited to a total of \$18,000 (\$12,500 if you only have SIMPLE plans; \$21,000 for section 403(b) plans if you qualify for the 15-year rule explained in Pub. 571). Deferrals under code G are limited to \$18,000. Deferrals under code H are limited to \$7,000.

However, if you were at least age 50 in 2016, your employer may have allowed an additional deferral of up to \$5,000 (\$3,000 for section 401(k)(11) and 408(p) SIMPLE plans). This additional deferral amount is not subject to the overall limit on elective deferrals. For code G, the limit on elective deferrals may be higher for the last 3 years before you reach retirement age. Contact your plan administrator for more information. Equipment Maintenance Allowance Schedule for Rural Routes

Rural Carriers

In accordance with the provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.3, of Handbook EL-902, *Agreement between the United States Postal Service and the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association*, effective January 7, 2016 (pay period 02-17), the equipment maintenance allowance (EMA) will increase to 65.5 cents per mile. The EMA is 65.5 cents per mile, or a minimum of \$26.20 per day, whichever is greater.

Auxiliary Rural Carriers, Rural Carrier Reliefs, Rural Carrier Associates, Rural Carrier Part-Time Flexibles, and Auxiliary Assistance

Employees providing auxiliary assistance or serving auxiliary routes under provisions of Article 9, Section 2.J.5, receive an EMA of 65.5 cents per mile or \$7.15 per hour,

whichever is greater. This EMA should not exceed the amount provided in the special equipment maintenance allowance for the route stops and miles.

Form W-4 Completion for Employees Claiming Exempt Status for 2017

Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regulations permit employees who anticipate no federal tax liability for 2017 to claim total exemption from federal tax withholding provided they owed no federal taxes for 2016. These regulations also require a new Form W-4, *Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate*, be submitted every calendar year by employees claiming an exempt status. However, because of *PostalEASE*, these employees no longer have to file a hard copy Form W-4.

Employees may meet IRS filing requirements for exempt Forms W-4 by either logging onto *PostalEASE* at <http://lite-blue.usps.gov> or by calling *PostalEASE* toll-free at 877-477-3273, option 1. Follow the Form W-4 instructions provided by *PostalEASE*, and your form will be updated for calendar year 2017. If you need to contact the HR Shared Service Center (HRSSC) in Greensboro about this matter, call 877-477-3273, menu option 5, and then request Benefits when prompted. To reach the HRSSC using TTY, call 866-260-7507.

Any employee currently in an exempt status who does not submit a new Form W-4 claiming a continuation of the exempt status will be converted to a taxable status, effective Pay Period (PP) 04-2017. For the exempt status to remain effective into 2017, updated Form W-4 information must be entered into *PostalEASE* no later than Wednesday, February 15, 2017, 3:00 P.M. Central Time. However, to ensure a seamless continuation of the exempt status for

2017, employees are encouraged to update their W-4 information no later than a day or two in advance of the February 15 cut-off.

Note: An employee currently in an exempt status may file for exemption after February 15, the *PostalEASE* cut-off date; however, in that instance, the employee's exempt status will not be continuous from 2016 to 2017. Depending on the day of the pay period in which W-4 information is entered into *PostalEASE*, the 2017 exempt status is effective the pay period of entry or the pay period following entry.

Any employee who claimed exempt status for 2016 and who does not submit a new Form W-4 will have federal taxes withheld at the rate normally applicable to an employee claiming "Single" with "0" allowances. Employees with an exempt status (as of PP 26-2016) will receive printed messages on their earnings statements during PP 02-2017, PP 03-2017, and PP 04-2017 reminding them that a new Form W-4 is required.

Reminders

- All administrative and managerial employees are prohibited from providing any tax advice to employees about the completion of Form W-4.
- Sending information about exempt Form W-4 to Eagan Accounting Services is no longer required.

Maintain Up-To-Date Withholding Information in *PostalEASE*

As a Postal Service[™] employee, you are personally responsible for ensuring correct federal, state, and local taxes are deducted from your pay.

Upon submission of your federal and state tax returns, you are urged to review your federal and state tax withholdings, particularly if you owed a significant amount of money or were due a large refund. If you are someone who counts on a big tax refund by a certain date to make a major purchase or to pay a financial obligation, you need to know more tax returns are facing additional review as the IRS and state tax administrators continue to strengthen identity theft and refund fraud protections.

In addition, a recent tax law requires the IRS to hold the refund for any tax return claiming either the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or Additional Child Tax Credit (ACTC) until February 15. By law, the IRS must hold the entire refund, not just the portion related to the EITC or ACTC. Thus, a refund may be delayed.

You are also encouraged to review your federal and state tax withholdings whenever any of the following scenarios take place:

- A change in marital status or a change in your number of dependents.
- A change in the anticipated amount of itemized deductions or tax credits for the next tax year.
- A new hire default to a "Single" marital status and zero withholding allowances.
- A PS Form 50, *Notification of Personnel Action*, that included a "state" change to assigned duty station finance with a subsequent default of a "Single" marital status and zero withholding allowances.
- A failure to update your *PostalEASE* Federal W-4 and/or State Tax Payroll modules, if you wished to deviate from the default settings.

Taking a closer look at the taxes being withheld can help ensure the right amount is withheld. A taxpayer with a big refund can reduce the refund amount and boost take-home pay by claiming additional withholding allowances. Anyone with a big balance due can have additional tax withheld.

The IRS offers several online resources to help taxpayers bring taxes withheld closer to what is owed. These resources are available anytime on www.irs.gov. They include:

- IRS Withholding Calculator — Online tool that helps determine the correct amount of tax to withhold.
- IRS Publication 505 — Tax Withholding and Estimated Tax.
- Tax Withholding — Complete information on withholding, estimated taxes, FAQs, and more.

If you are subject to federal, state, and/or local taxes and the correct deductions are not being withheld from your pay, you should take immediate action to ensure appropriate tax withholdings.

To Update Federal and/or State Tax Withholdings

- Complete the federal Form W-4, *Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate*, and/or the state equivalent of the federal Form W-4. (For example, to update Minnesota tax withholdings, complete Form W-4MN, *Minnesota Withholding Allowance/Exemption Certificate*). Complete the federal Form W-4, if your state does not have its own state equivalent of the federal Form W-4.

- Go to the *LiteBlue* home page (www.lite-blue.usps.gov) to access the *PostalEASE* App.
- Update your Federal W-4 Payroll Module and/or your State Tax Payroll Module.
- If you do not have access to a computer and/or the Internet, forward your completed form(s) to:

Note: It is to your advantage to complete the paper form prior to your *PostalEASE* update, as the paper form comes with helpful instructions for complex state withholding selections.

Information Security

Watch Yourself: How to Avoid, Identify, and Report Identity Theft

Identity theft is one of the scariest forms of cyberattacks. The thought of a hacker gaining enough information to hijack your personal identity — meaning they can make purchases and access your devices — causes a wave of fear for most. Learn how to avoid this fear by following the proper ways to handle threats regarding identity theft.

1. **Avoid:** To protect yourself against identity theft, make sure to use strong, unique passwords that are at least 15 characters in length. You should also monitor your financial accounts for unauthorized charges and be discreet when posting personal information on the Internet.
2. **Identify:** While there are many clues that could indicate a thief has stolen your identity, several of the most common ones have been listed below:
 - You see unauthorized withdrawals from your bank account;
 - You do not receive your bills or other mail; or
 - You receive medical bills for services you did not undergo.

3. **Report:** If you suspect your identity has been compromised, be sure to contact the agencies or companies that oversee your stolen credentials. Although personal breaches should not be reported to the Postal Service™, incidents that relate to your Postal accounts should be reported immediately to the CyberSecurity Operations Center (CSOC) by emailing CyberSafe@usps.gov.

Hackers use a variety of techniques to execute fraudulent activities, but identity theft is one of the most personal, severe ways. To protect against identity theft, make sure that you know how to properly avoid, identify, and report potential cyber threats and other suspicious activity.

Stamp Announcement 17-05: Dorothy Height Stamp



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On February 1, 2017, in Washington, DC, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *Dorothy Height* stamp (Forever® priced at 49 cents), in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 474300).

The stamp will go on sale nationwide February 1, 2017.

The 40th stamp in the *Black Heritage* series honors Dorothy Height (1912–2010), the tireless activist who dedicated her life to fighting for racial and gender equality. Although she rarely gained the recognition granted her male contemporaries, she became one of the most influential civil rights leaders of the 20th century. The stamp features artist Thomas Blackshear II's gouache and acrylics on board portrait of Height. The painting is based on a photograph shot in 2009 by Lateef Mangum. Art director Derry Noyes designed the stamp.

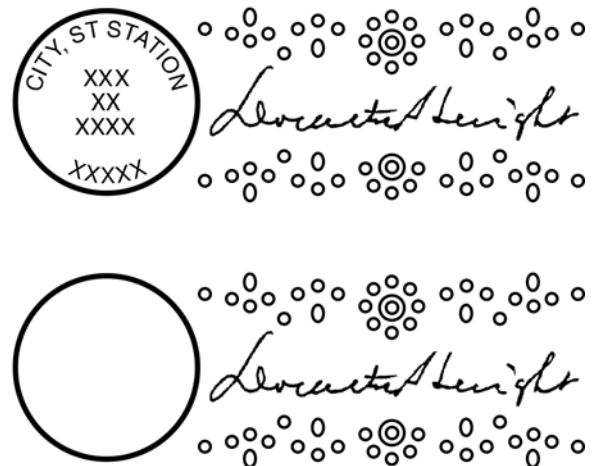
Availability to Post Offices: Item 474300, Dorothy Height (Forever priced at 49 cents) Commemorative PSA Pane of 20 Stamps

Stamp Fulfillment Services will make an automatic push distribution to Post Offices™ of a quantity to cover approximately 30 days of sales. Distribution quantities for the automatic push distribution are available by logging on to SFS Web at <https://sfsweb.usps.gov>. Post Offices may begin ordering stamps on the FDOI through SFS Web. However, offices should check the website noted above to determine the amount they will receive on their automatic push distribution.

Special Dedication Postmarks

Only the following pictorial postmark is permitted for the *Dorothy Height* stamp. The word "Station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design, because it will be a temporary station.

Guidelines for Finalizing Dorothy Height Stamp Pictorial Postmark Art



To finalize the *Dorothy Height* stamp pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state, and ZIP Code™ of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches horizontally by 2 inches vertically. Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1.

The Postal Service™ must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services four weeks before the event using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announcement/Report*. Invalid USPS Corporate Account Numbers

This listing should be provided to Contract Postal Units and used by acceptance clerks in non-POS locations without intranet access to validate a USPS Corporate Account (USPSCA) number online. For all other locations, online USPSCA validation is preferred. The online validation process is outlined in the USPSCA Validation SOP on the Retail webpage. This list supersedes all previous notices,

which must be recycled. Acceptance clerks must not accept Priority Mail Express™ shipments bearing an invalid USPSCA number in the “Payment by Account” or “Agreement Number” section of the label or form.

Note: The first 6 digits of a 9-digit Custom Designed Service and Next Day Pickup Agreement make up the Corporate Account Number.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

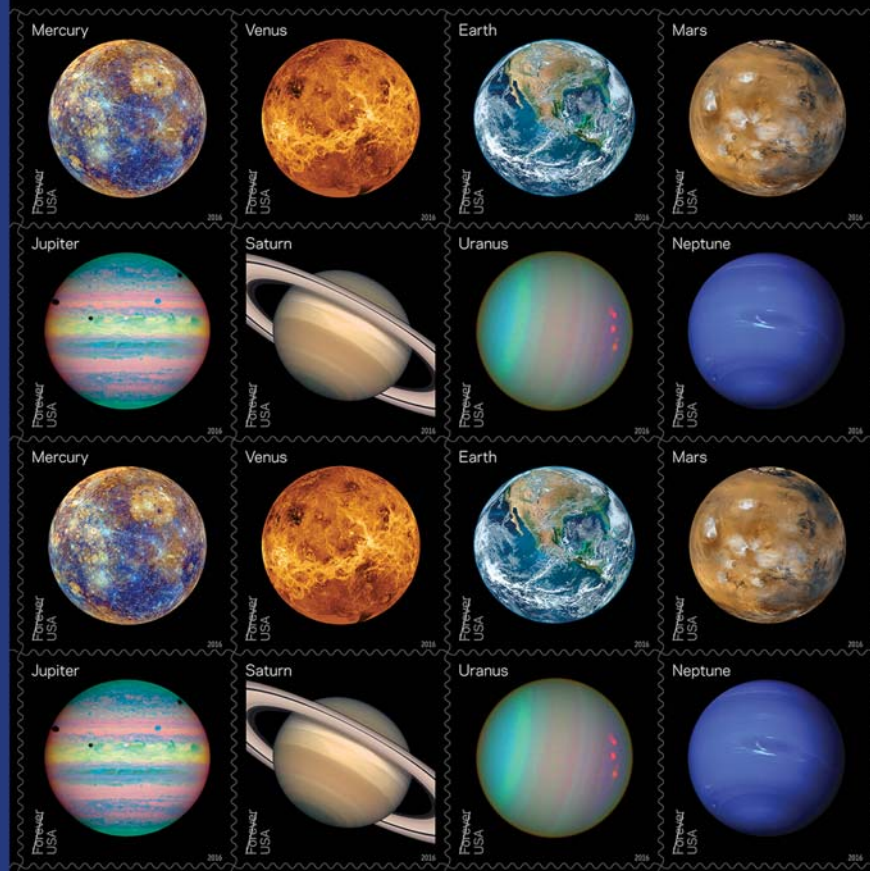

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals, including in their raw, unmanufactured state, are prohibited. Official Mail shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Reserved for future use.

A2. Reserved for future use.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976, PS Form 2976-A, or PS Form 2976-B) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from an MPO or DPO ZIP Code. If mailed using Priority Mail Express service, mailpieces requiring a customs form that are addressed to or from an MPO or DPO location must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., nonnegotiable documents). The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an MPO except for those MPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- If mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Reserved for future use.

I2. Reserved for future use.

I3. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 27 inches.
- Maximum width 14 inches.
- Maximum height 14 inches.

J. Standard Post and Parcel Select parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Reserved for future use.

L. All Official Mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, live animals, and live plants are prohibited.

N. Registered Mail service is prohibited.

O. Reserved for future use.

P. Official Mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under Publication 52, Part 421, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

V1. Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on *USPS.com*. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.

W. Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Cremated remains are prohibited.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No 0817E or 0818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in *italics* under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail®.

All postmark requests should go to the first-day-of-issue city. The first-day-of-issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first-day-of-issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.
