DMM Reminder: Priority Mail Commercial Plus Cubic Markings

The Postal Service™ would like to remind customers of the markings required for Priority Mail® Commercial Plus® cubic mail prices. Priority Mail Commercial Plus cubic mail has two subcategories, which are cubic mailpieces, and soft pack and padded envelopes.

Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®), sections 202.3.4.1 and 202.3.4.2, provide the marking requirements and placement for cubic mailpieces with regard to the postage payment method. DMM section 202.3.4.1, Price Marking — Postage Evidencing Systems, states that a cubic mailpiece using postage evidencing systems must be marked “Priority Mail” and bear the applicable marking that reflects the correct price tier printed on the piece or produced as part of the postage indicia (e.g., Cubic .10, Cubic .20). DMM section 202.3.4.2, Price Marking — Permit Imprint, states that a cubic mailpiece using a permit imprint must also be marked “Priority Mail,” and bear the “cubic” marking (i.e.,

“Cubic,” or “CUBIC,” or “cubic”). In both cases, the marking may be placed directly above, directly below, or to the left of the postage.

DMM section 202.3.4.3, Soft Pack and Padded Envelope Markings, states that regardless of the postage payment method used, soft pack and padded envelopes must be marked “Priority Mail” and bear the applicable marking that reflects the correct price tier (e.g., Cubic .10, Cubic .20), along with the dimensions (length and width) of the original packaging. The price tier and dimensions of the original packaging markings may be placed directly above, directly below, or to the left of the postage.

Priority Mail pieces that do not bear a complete cubic price marking, as stated in DMM 202.3.4, are subject to the applicable weight and zone prices. Additional information can be found in DMM sections 202.3.4 and 223.1.4, which are available on the Postal Explorer® website at pe.usps.com.

Fiscal Year 2018 Closing Guidance: Message from the Controller

Thank you for your efforts to control expenses during fiscal year (FY) 2018. It is important that we carry this effort through to the end of the fiscal year by controlling discretionary activity. This does not mean curtailing business, but it does mean making prudent choices by deferring or eliminating noncritical activity, and purchasing goods or services throughout the year, rather than at the end of the fiscal year, simply because there are available budget funds. Please encourage your contractors to bill us in a timely manner for goods received and services rendered, or inform us of any billing delays so we can recognize the expense before the end of the fiscal year.

The following instructions will assist you, when appropriate, in helping the Postal Service™ close its financial books in a timely and efficient manner.

I. Instructions for Fiscal Year 2018 Closing

We request that all organizations limit their expense and capital expenditures, particularly for Postal Service support equipment, to essential needs. Accordingly, all vice presidents should review discretionary spending to ensure the Postal Service attains its financial target for this fiscal year.

The instruction and reporting dates in this *Postal Bulletin* supplement procedures followed during the normal monthly or quarterly reporting schedule.

II. Fiscal Year

The Postal Service prepares its annual reports on a government FY basis, which comprises 365 days (366 in leap years), always ending on September 30.

III. End of Year Processing Activities and Timelines, Requisitions, and Contract Actions

To ensure timely processing, submit purchase requests, expense and capital requisitions, requests for contract awards, and contract modifications for FY 2018 to Supply Management for processing as follows:

Requisitions for Contract Actions (IT Hardware, Services, Software, and Telecom)

For FY 2018, submit expense requisitions and requests for contract actions to Supply Management before

August 1, 2018. Any requests received after this date may not be processed for award and delivery by September 30.

Requisitions for Contract Actions (Other than IT and Telecom)

For FY 2018, submit expense requisitions and requests for contract actions to Supply Management before August 31, 2018. Any requests received after this date may not be processed for award and delivery by September 30.

Requisitions for Contract Actions (Capital Purchases)

For FY 2018, submit capital requisitions and requests for contract actions by the same dates as above for expense, although Supply Management will accept requisitions through September 7, 2018. Any requests received after this date may not be processed for award by September 30.

Requisitions for FY 2019 Contract Actions

For FY 2019, submit expense and capital requisition requests for contract actions that require a start date before October 1, 2018, to Supply Management before August 21, 2018. Any requests received after this date may not be processed for award by the required start date.

FY Processing of Funds

Accounting Services, San Mateo, will process against the appropriate fiscal year funds based on contract or modification issuance in accordance with the table shown here:

For requisitions received...	Funds are processed as follows...

On or after September 1, 2018 (Expense) or September 7, 2018 (Capital)	For contracts or modifications issued after September 30, Accounting Services, San Mateo, will process against FY 2019 funds.

IV. Payments and Accruals for Year-End Closing FY 2018

Payments

Submit appropriate receiving reports or certified invoices for goods and services (received by September 30) to Accounting Services, San Mateo, no later than Monday, October 1, 2018.

1. Expedite processing of receiving reports and certified invoices, as these documents are used to charge expense to the proper FY.
2. Additionally, review contracts to ensure sufficient funds are available by Friday, August 24, to process invoices.
3. Supply Management will process all requisitions for the issuance of contracts against FY 2018 funds according to the following priorities:

- Priority 1 — Capital commitment requisitions.
- Priority 2 — Expense commitment requisitions.

Accruals

We will process monthly accruals for Headquarters (HQ) expense as normal and as communicated to the Executive Leadership Team (ELT) and their budget coordinators.

Note: Any unusual or non-recurring expense must be communicated to the ELT budget coordinators as a possible adjustment to the normal ELT accrual.

1. All HQ accruals will occur at the ELT or VP finance level.
2. Certified invoices for goods and services received by September 30 must be received by Accounting Services, San Mateo, no later than Monday, October 1. All invoices not received by San Mateo by October 1 will be processed in October 2018, and paid in FY 2019.
3. If goods or services have been received as of September 30, 2018, but the vendor invoice has not been received, or if received, has not been approved and submitted to the Accounting Services Center for payment, these expenses will need to be accrued. Please contact your respective Budget Coordinator to complete the accrual.

Stamp Announcement 18-30: Hot Wheels Stamps

On September 29, 2018, in Fort Worth, TX, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *Hot Wheels* stamps (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in 10 designs, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive pane of 20 stamps (Item 569000). The stamps will go on sale nationwide September 29, 2018, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue. **The *Hot Wheels* pane of 20 stamps may not be split and the stamps may not be sold individually.**

This issuance celebrates Hot Wheels®, the iconic die-cast cars that for the last 50 years have ignited the imaginations of generations of children around the world. Arranged in diagonal rows, the 20 stamps showcase photographer Len Rizzi's images of 10 Hot Wheels cars — two of each design — speeding along a bright orange track. Each stamp features the name of the vehicle shown as follows:

- First row, left to right: Purple Passion, Rocket-Bye-Baby, Rigor Motor, Rodger Dodger, and Mach Speeder.
- Second row, left to right: Twin Mill, Bone Shaker, HW 40, Deora II, and Sharkruiser.

The iconic, curvy Hot Wheels logo appears in the top right corner of the pane. The back of the pane displays the Hot Wheels 50th anniversary logo. William J. Gicker served as art director. Greg Breeding designed the stamps and was the typographer.

Special Dedication Postmarks

Only the following pictorial postmark is permitted for *Hot Wheels* stamps. The word "Station" or the abbreviation "STA" is required somewhere in the design, because it will be a temporary station. **Use of any image other than the following special pictorial image is prohibited.**

Guidelines for Finalizing Hot Wheels Stamps Pictorial Postmark Art



To finalize the *Hot Wheels* stamps pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state, and ZIP Code™ of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches (horizontally) by 2 inches (vertically). Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1.

The Postal Service™ must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services 4 weeks before the event.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™ or at The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop. They must affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark up to a quantity of 50. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. All orders must be postmarked by January 29, 2019.

How to Order First-Day Covers

The Postal Service also offers first-day covers for new stamp issues and Postal Service stationery items postmarked with the official first-day-of-issue cancellation. Each item has an individual catalog number and is offered in the *USA Philatelic* publication and online at usps.com/shop. Customers may register to receive a free *USA Philatelic* publication online at usps.com/philatelic.

Locally produced items are not authorized. Only merchandise that has been approved and assigned an item number by Headquarters Retail Marketing may be produced and sold.

Stamp Announcement 18-31: “Madonna and Child” by Bachiacca Stamp

On October 3, 2018, in Santa Fe, NM, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the “*Madonna and Child*” by Bachiacca stamp (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive booklet of 20 stamps (Item 682200). The stamp will go on sale nationwide October 3, 2018, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

This Christmas stamp features a detail of *Madonna and Child*, an oil-and-gold-on-panel painting by Italian Renaissance artist Francesco d’Ubertino Verdi (1494–1557), known as Bachiacca. Dating from the early 1520s, the painting is part of the Jack and Belle Linsky Collection at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York City. William J. Gicker served as art director for this stamp, and Greg Breeding was the designer.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Reserved for future use.

S. Synthetic cannabinoids used to stimulate the central nervous system commonly known as "synthetic marijuana," "K2," or "Spice" are prohibited.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

Stamp Announcement 18-32: Kwanzaa 2018 Stamp

On October 10, 2018, in Raleigh, NC, the U.S. Postal Service® will issue the *Kwanzaa 2018* stamp (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive pane of 20 stamps (Item 565800). The stamp will go on sale nationwide October 10, 2018, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

With this new stamp, the Postal Service™ continues its tradition of celebrating Kwanzaa. The annual holiday, which takes place over 7 days from December 26 to January 1, brings family, community, and culture together for many African Americans. The stamp depicts a small family adorned in a mixture of western and traditional clothing, paying tribute to the holiday's focus on the contemporary African-American experience while also drawing on African roots. They are gathered around a kinara (candleholder), the warm light from the seven candles illuminating their faces. Several other important Kwanzaa symbols sit on the table. Artist Floyd Cooper used a method he calls "oil erasure" — covering an illustrated board in oil paint and then erasing layers of paint to reveal his images — to create this design of familial love and connection. Art director Derry Noyes designed the stamp.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

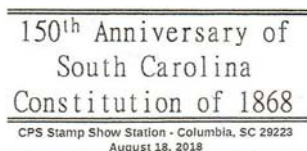

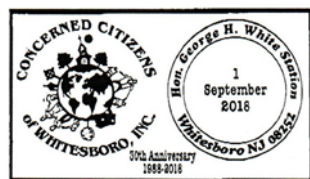

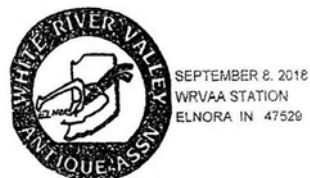

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches high by 4 inches long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

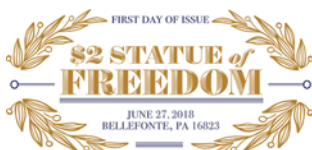

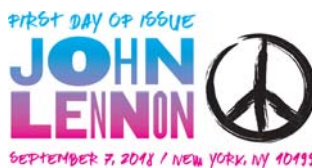
