Recent incidents where nonmailable hazardous materials were inducted into the mail stream serve as a sobering reminder that these types of mailpieces continue to pose a real threat.

To bring renewed awareness to these preventable situations, the Postal Service is again designating November as “HAZMAT Awareness Month.” During November, the Postal Service will distribute targeted communications that reinforce current HAZMAT policies and procedures (see page [4](#)).

As our peak season begins, and we anticipate increased mail volume along with its potential risks, there is even more reason to be diligent. I know I can count on Postal Service employees to support this effort, and I thank you in advance for emphasizing to your teams the importance of their adherence to current HAZMAT policies and procedures.

IS YOUR PACKAGE SAFE TO MAIL?

You could be mailing hazardous materials and not even know it.



Did you know that many common household items are dangerous to ship and are not permitted in the mail?

Even items that are permitted in the mail can present a hazard if improperly packaged, due to vibration, temperature changes, and variations in atmospheric pressure.

USPS® is committed to keeping your mail safe. Log on and see if the item you wish to mail is permitted and learn more about how to prepare this type of mail safely.

WARNING: Persons who knowingly mail items or materials that are dangerous or injurious to life, health, or property in violation of 39 U.S.C. 3018 may be liable for a civil penalty of at least \$250, but not more than \$100,000 for each violation; the costs of any cleanup associated with each violation; and damages.

DMM Revision: Hold Mail Service Standards Modification

Effective January 26, 2020, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®), sections 508.11.3.1 and 508.11.3.3, to modify the standards for customers to change or cancel their Hold Mail service request.

In the article titled “DMM Revision: Hold Mail Service,” published in *Postal Bulletin* 22531 (10-24-19, pages 11-13), the Postal Service announced that it is revising Chapter 508 to add new section 508.11.0, “Hold Mail Service.” The new section includes sections 508.11.3.1, “Change or Cancel a Request Submitted Online,” and 508.11.3.3, “Change or Cancel a Request Submitted to the Customer Care Center.”

The Postal Service is revising these sections to include the standard that customers who have a Hold Mail confirmation number from an online or Customer Care Center Hold Mail service request have the option to change or cancel the request either online or through the Customer Care Center, regardless of how they originally made the request.

Although the Postal Service will not publish these revisions in the DMM until January 26, 2020, the standards are effective immediately.

DMM Revision: Mail Entry and Payment Technology Organization Structural Changes

Effective January 26, 2020, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) in several sections to reflect the new Mail Entry and Payment Technology (MEPT) organization structure.

On August 31, 2019, the Postal Service announced changes within its MEPT structure. The changes are designed to better serve the organization and its commercial customers. As a result of the structural changes, the Postal Service is updating applicable DMM sections with new MEPT department and position titles. The Postal Service is also revising section 608.8.0, “USPS Contact Information,” with new MEPT office address information.

Title-related revisions include replacing:

- “Manager, Business Mailer Support,” with “director, Business Acceptance Solutions.”
- “Manager of Payment Technology” with “director, Commercial Payment.”

- “Business Manager Acceptance” with “director, Commercial Acceptance.”

Department-related revisions primarily include replacing “Business Mailer Support” with “Business Acceptance Solutions.”

In addition, the Postal Service will update applicable sections of the Quick Service Guides and Customer Support Rulings to reflect the MEPT organizational structural changes.

The Postal Service will incorporate these revisions into the January 26, 2020, edition of the online DMM, which is available via Postal Explorer® at pe.usps.com. Although the Postal Service will not publish these revisions in the DMM until January 26, 2020, the standards are effective immediately.

IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

Effective November 21, 2019, the Postal Service™ is revising the Individual Country Listing for United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (UK) in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) to note a change to the Prohibitions section.

This revision rescinds a previous revision published in the article titled “IMM Revision: Individual Country Listing for United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland” in *Postal Bulletin* 22531 (10-24-19, page 13). That article noted the removal of an entry beginning with “Switchblade knives” and adding an entry beginning with “Knives and blades.”

This recension is based on a formal request that Royal Mail Group made through the Universal Postal Union via *International Bureau Circular* 173, dated November 4, 2019, noting the UK legislation’s postponement of the Offensive Weapons Act 2019 related to knives and blades (which was to be effective November 1, 2019) and reinstating the previous prohibition about knives.

Handbook AS-805-H Revision: Cloud Security

Effective November 2019, the Postal Service™ revised Handbook AS-805-H, *Cloud Security*, to update policy and procedure with regard to cloud providers.

Handbook AS-805-H, *Cloud Security*

6 Cloud Technology Security Requirements

* * * * *

6-1 Cloud Providers and Security

[Revise the text of 6-1 to read as follows:]

The following must apply to cloud providers:

- a. A FedRAMP Authorization to operate is mandatory for Postal Service Platform as a Service (PaaS) and Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS) cloud deployments and service models at the low-, moderate-, and high-impact levels, as determined by CISO.

The Postal Service does not participate in the FedRAMP Initial (Sponsored) Authority to Operate process and does not offer sponsorship.

While the Postal Service does not require a FedRAMP Authorization for Software as a Service (SaaS) environments, FedRAMP Authorization is required on the foundational layer/hosting environment, also referred to as the Platform as a Service (PaaS) and Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS). Notwithstanding an entity’s FedRAMP Authorization status, the Postal Service has its own internal Certification and Accreditation (C&A) processes and policies for all systems, which are in accordance with Handbook AS-805, *Information Security* and Handbook AS-805-H, *Cloud Security*. Accordingly, the Postal Service must certify and accredit all cloud solutions for use by the Postal Service regardless of FedRAMP Authorization status. The Postal Service may consider potential suppliers’ FedRAMP Packages in its certification and accreditation process.

All cloud solutions must demonstrate the ability to meet USPS security requirements.

- b. Cloud providers must comply with FISMA Moderate and/or High Authorization and Accreditation security controls and processes.
- c. Cloud providers must comply with the current version of the *Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standard (DSS)* and the *Information Supplement: PCI*

DSS Cloud Computing Guidelines if that functionality is provided within a Private Cloud.

8-4 Information Security Contract Requirements

[Revise the introduction and first two sets of bullets of 8-4 to read as follows:]

The contract must address the Assessment and Authorization (A&A) Package requirements for a SaaS Non-FedRAMP Authorized Cloud. That this requirement is specifically for a SaaS environment that is not FedRAMP Authorized. If the SaaS is FedRAMP Authorized, then we collect the below documents from the *Max.gov* website.

The Cloud Service Provider (CSP) must provide at a minimum the following A&A documents:

- a. FedRAMP ID of the IaaS hosting environment.
- b. System Security Plan (SSP).
- c. Control Implementation Summary (CIS).
- d. Plan of Action and Milestone (POA&M).
- e. Incident Response Plan (IRP).
 - (1) The SaaS CSP will inherit this from the IaaS hosting environment but should also have its own IRP to cover the investigation of the SaaS.
 - (2) Configuration Management Plan (CMP).
- f. Contingency Plan (CP).
- g. The SaaS CSP will inherit this from the IaaS hosting environment but should also have its own CP to cover the recovery of the SaaS.
- h. Inventory.
- i. Software list.
- j. Penetration Testing Report web-facing applications.
- k. Vulnerability Scan Report.
- i. Privacy Impact Analysis (PIA)/Privacy Threshold Assessment (PTA).

Cybersecurity Awareness Fair Brings Industry and Academia to USPS Headquarters

The Corporate Information Security Office recently hosted its fourth annual Cybersecurity Awareness Fair, titled “Welcome to the New Cyber Frontier.” Three prominent cybersecurity leaders spoke at the event:

- Jen Fox (from Dominos);
- Nick Merrill (from University of California, Berkeley); and
- Jim Meehan (from Verizon).

The speakers engaged attendees with cybersecurity insights from their respective industries. For anyone unable to attend in person, visit blue.usps.gov/cyber to view each presentation and a video from the event.

These experts shared tips that could help prevent cyber attacks. They are as easy as A-B-C(R):

- **Always** be aware of when you share organizational and personal information. Poor cybersecurity behaviors, such as sharing passwords or discussing sensitive information in public, can leave individuals and the Postal Service™ vulnerable to cyberattacks.
- **Be** on your guard and proceed with caution. Cyber criminals rely on the fact that humans have a natural

desire to trust others. If something seems suspicious, report it.

- **Careful!** Cyber criminals prey on human emotions to manipulate or trick users into sharing valuable information.
- **Report** any suspected incident:
 - By clicking the “Report to CyberSafe” button in your Outlook toolbar,
 - By emailing CyberSafe@usps.gov, or
 - By calling 866-877-7247.

Remember, these tips are not only relevant to your work environment — they can also protect your home and family.

FY 2020 CyberSafe Training Now Available for Contractors

Protecting employee, customer, and supplier data is a priority for the United States Postal Service®. By taking these courses, USPS® contractors learn how to safeguard critical data and prevent cyber threats to the Postal Service.™

Three required CyberSafe Training courses are now available for USPS contractors:

- **CyberSafe Fundamentals, Part I and Part II.** Provides the fundamental skills and knowledge needed to adhere to cybersecurity practices and policy for the protection of USPS electronic data.
- **CyberSafe 201: Data Protection.** Provides best practices for handling sensitive and sensitive-enhanced information to keep USPS electronic data secure.

The deadline for course completion is **January 7, 2020**.

Contractors who do not meet the January 7 deadline will be subject to limited ACE system access until all courses are completed. These courses were designed for all Postal Service employees and contractors as part of a mandatory, annual training program to protect USPS data.

Military Mail

To send packages to loved ones serving in the military abroad, the Postal Service offers a discounted price of \$18.45 on its largest Priority Mail Flat Rate® box. The price includes a \$1.50 per box discount for mail sent to APO/FPO/DPO destinations worldwide.

Priority Mail Flat Rate boxes are available at no cost at local Post Offices or customers can order them online at usps.com/freeboxes. Customers may print postage, labels, and customs forms online anytime using Click-N-Ship® at usps.com/ship.

To ensure timely delivery of holiday wishes by December 25, 2019, the Postal Service recommends that you send cards and packages to military APO/FPO/DPO addresses overseas no later than the mailing dates listed in the table* (see page 12).

It is available for USPS Retail Ground items not exceeding 30 pounds in weight or 60 inches in length and girth combined. The customer must pay the applicable PAL fee in addition to the regular surface price for each addressed piece sent by PAL service.
3. Customers pay for SAM parcels at USPS Retail Ground prices with maximum weight and size limits of 15 pounds and 60 inches in length and girth combined. SAM parcels are first transported domestically by surface and then to overseas destinations by air on a space-available basis.

Military Care Kit

The Postal Service has created a free Military Care Kit based on the items most frequently requested by military families. The kit contains:

1. Two Priority Mail APO/FPO/DPO Flat Rate boxes,
2. Two Priority Mail Medium Flat Rate boxes,
3. Priority Mail tape,
4. Priority Mail address labels, and
5. Appropriate customs forms.

To order the kit, call 800-610-8734. You can find guidelines for packing, addressing, and shipping items to U.S. troops at usps.com/ship/apo-fpo-dpo.htm. To order flat rate boxes featuring the "America Supports You" logo, go to usps.com/freeboxes.

Addressing the Package

Use the following directions to properly address your military mail package:

- Write out the service member's full name.
- Include the unit and APO/FPO/DPO address with the 9-digit ZIP Code™ (if one is assigned).

For example:

- Do not write the country name where the service member is stationed in the address.

- Include a return address.
- Inside the box, include the service member's name and address as well as the sender's name and address on an index card in case the shipping label gets damaged in transit.

Busiest Mailing and Delivery Days

Our busiest time is now 2 weeks before Christmas. Starting the week of December 9, customer traffic is expected to increase. The Postal Service predicts that the week of December 16–22 will be the busiest mailing, shipping, and delivery week for the holidays.

Skip the Trip and Ship Online

The Postal Service anticipates December 16 will be the busiest day online with more than 8.5 million customers predicted to visit usps.com for help shipping that special holiday gift. And usps.com is always open.

The Click-N-Ship feature (usps.com) and other online services allow customers to order free Priority Mail boxes*, print shipping labels, purchase postage, and even request free next-day Package Pickup**.

* Boxes are delivered in the U.S. with regular mail usually within 7 to 10 business days. Exclusions apply. For details and to order, visit store.usps.com/store.

** For details on availability, visit tools.usps.com/schedule-pickup-steps.htm.

New Stamped Package Rule

There have been some changes made to how you can ship packages this year. For safety reasons, as of October 1, the Postal Service no longer accepts stamped packages that are more than one-half inch thick and/or weigh more than 10 ounces into blue collection boxes, building mail chutes, or Post Office mail slots. For clarity, stamped packages are those using individual stamps as postage. This restriction also applies to all other mailpieces, apart from packages, using individual stamps as postage that are more than one-half inch thick and/or weigh more than 10 ounces.

Instead, you must go to a retail counter or use the self-service kiosk to purchase a postage label. If you opt to use the kiosk to buy a postage label, you can drop your package in the package slots, not the mail slots, at a Post Office. If a prohibited package or mailpiece is found in a collection box, mail chute, or lobby mail slot, it will be returned to sender with a Customer Return Label attached explaining the restrictions and reason for return.

Click-N-Ship customers are unaffected by this change.

Other 2019 Updates

- We will offer an expanded package delivery window — delivery in the morning, afternoon, early evening, and on Sundays where volume warrants.
- We have expanded our capacity by adding new equipment:
 - 20 automated package bundle sorters with more than 400 additional separations.
 - 16 universal sorters.
 - 5 package feed systems.
 - 6 robust bulk unloading systems.
 - 18 automatic tray unsleivers.
 - 6 sack shakeout systems.
 - 9 bed load/unload systems.
 - 40 overhead scanning systems.

Custom Solutions for Sending Holiday Packages

The Postal Service is uniquely qualified to deliver the holidays by offering a variety of custom solutions designed to make sending holiday packages easy:

- Packages that have stamps as postage and are more than one-half inch thick and/or weighing more than 10 ounces *must* be taken to a retail counter for drop off. Alternatively, customers can use a self-service kiosk for a postage label and drop off the package in a Post Office package slot, *not* a mail slot.
- Get free Priority Mail and Priority Mail Express boxes and envelopes in Post Offices or online at usps.com/freeboxes.*

- Skip the line and use self-service kiosks located in larger Post Offices to weigh, pay postage, and deposit your packages.
- Use Click-N-Ship online at usps.com/ship to create shipping labels with USPS Tracking®, pay postage, or use flat rate shipping products to avoid weighing packages.
- With free Package Pickup, your package can be handed to your mail carrier on his or her regular delivery route or you can schedule a pickup. For details on availability, visit usps.com/pickup.
- Take your packages to the retail counter at any Post Office.

Custom Solutions to Help With Receiving Holiday Packages

The Postal Service also offers a variety of custom solutions designed to make receiving holiday packages more convenient:

- Informed Delivery® (informedelivery.usps.com/box/pages/intro/start.action) is the free daily digital preview of what is coming to your mailbox. You can see what mail is coming to your mailbox, manage your packages by providing delivery instructions or reschedule delivery online, and see some exterior images of magazines and catalogs — all from your mobile app, dashboard, tablet, or computer.
- Customers can also request the package be held at a Post Office by choosing the Hold for Pickup option in the Informed Delivery app, or online.
- Customers who know they won't be home when a package is delivered can use USPS Package Intercept® (usps.com/manage/package-intercept.htm). Before delivery, most domestic package shipments can be redirected back to the sender, to a new address (a neighbor, perhaps), or to the Post Office to be held for pickup.

Help Customers Avoid a Shipping Glitch

There are a number of things that customers can do to ensure their holiday mail gets delivered safely and correctly:

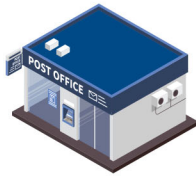
- Print addresses clearly and include all address elements, such as apartment numbers and directional information (ex., 123 S. Main St., Apt. 2B).
- Remove batteries from toys, if applicable. Wrap and place them next to the toys in the mailing box. Customers should include new batteries in the unopened, original manufacturer's packaging.
- Place a card inside the package that contains the delivery and return address. This ensures the package can be delivered or returned if the mailing label gets damaged or falls off.



SIX WAYS TO PROTECT MAIL AND PACKAGES



1. Don't leave delivered mail and packages unattended. Just as wallets and purses shouldn't be left on the front seat of an unlocked car overnight, mail and packages shouldn't be left uncollected in mailboxes or on front porches for any length of time.



2. Going out of town? Hold mail at the local Post Office. Instead of risking leaving a package unattended for an extended period of time, customers planning on being away from home for a few days are encouraged to take advantage of the Hold Mail service on *USPS.com*. Letters and packages will be held securely at the local *Post Office* until the customers return.



3. Plan ahead. Ship using Hold for Pickup. When shipping packages, customers can choose the *Hold for Pickup* option, and the recipients can collect the packages at their local *Post Office*. For customers receiving packages, they can redirect incoming packages to their local *Post Office* by selecting *Hold for Pickup* using *USPS Package Intercept* on *USPS.com*.



4. Customize the delivery. If the package doesn't fit in the mailbox and the customer won't be home to receive it, the customer can provide delivery instructions online and authorize the carrier to leave it in a specified location. Visit *USPS.com*, enter the tracking number and select Delivery Instructions.



5. Secure the shipment using USPS Special Services. *Signature Confirmation* helps ensure the package ends up in the right hands by requiring a signature at the time of delivery. For the most valuable packages, customers can opt for *Registered Mail* service. A *Registered Mail* piece receives special handling from the time it's mailed until it's delivered, documenting the chain of custody.



6. Monitor your front door. If you have a home security camera system, ensure it captures activity at your front door and mailbox. If you catch any mail thieves in the act, save the video and alert your local Postal Inspectors.

Provide this listing to Contract Postal Units and acceptance clerks in non-POS locations without intranet access to validate a USPS Corporate Account (USPSCA) number online. For all other locations, online USPSCA validation is preferred. This list supersedes all previous notices, which you must recycle.

Acceptance clerks must not accept Priority Mail Express® shipments bearing an invalid USPSCA number in the “Payment by Account” or “Agreement Number” section of the label or form.

Note: The first 6 digits of a 9-digit Custom Designed Service and Next Day Pickup Agreement make up the Corporate Account Number.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals, including in their raw, unmanufactured state, are prohibited. Official Mail shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Reserved for future use.

T. Mailings of household shipments and case lots of food to or from an MPO require military transportation office approval prior to mailing. Mailings to or from a DPO require pre-approval from the Diplomatic Pouch and Mail Director.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

V1. Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on *USPS.com*. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.

W. Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Cremated remains are prohibited.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

- Never guess a ZIP Code. NO ZIP is better than a WRONG ZIP. Look up a ZIP Code at usps.com under Quick Tools.
- Include both “to” and “from” information on packages and only on one side.
- Do NOT reuse mailing boxes — they weaken in the shipping process.
- Select a box that is strong enough to protect the contents. Priority Mail and Priority Mail Express boxes are free at the local Post Office.
- Leave space for extra cushioning inside. Stuff glass and fragile, hollow items, like vases, with newspaper or packing material, to avoid damage. When mailing framed photographs, take the glass out of the frame and wrap it separately.

2019 Holiday Information

Holiday Advertising Campaign

Our 2019 holiday campaign will feature direct mail, TV, radio, print, digital, and social media promotions highlighting the organization’s proud tradition of delivering cheer and value to consumers and businesses.

The first of several TV spots began airing in November and can be viewed on the Postal Service YouTube channel, USPS TV (youtube.com/user/uspstv/custom). A direct mailpiece with information customers need to know for the holidays will be mailed to more than 100 million homes by Thanksgiving.

Holiday Operating Hours

Post Offices nationwide will be closed on Christmas Day, Wednesday, December 25, and New Year’s Day, Wednesday, January 1, 2020. All Post Offices will be open and regular mail delivery will resume on December 26 and January 2.

Some Post Offices *may* have extended hours leading up to the holidays, and limited hours on Christmas Eve, Tuesday, December 24, and New Year’s Eve, Tuesday, December 31. Customers should *always* check with their local Post Offices for hours of operation.

As a reminder, mail is not picked up from blue collection boxes on Sundays.

Holiday Hiring

The Postal Service will be hiring seasonal employees across the country to meet operational needs and the needs of our customers. Hiring decisions are made at a local level. Instead of just hiring seasonally, the Postal Service is focusing its resources on actively hiring year-round.

Employee Tipping

All Postal Service employees, including mail carriers, must comply with the Standards of Ethical Conduct for Employees of the Executive Branch. Under these federal regulations, carriers may accept a gift worth \$20 or less (this includes store, restaurant, or mall gift cards). However, cash and cash equivalents, such as checks or gift cards that can be used like credit cards (with Visa, MasterCard, or American Express logos) must never be accepted in any amount.

Carriers and Dogs

The Postal Service asks customers to place their dogs in a separate room before opening the front door to accept packages from carriers. Dogs are protective in nature and may jump through screen doors or squeeze through door openings. Dogs attacked nearly 6,000 carriers last year. The Postal Service places a high priority on employee and customer safety, including dog bite prevention.

Safety and Wellness

Learn Proper Lifting Techniques

On or off the job, lifting is a part of the daily routine that most individuals don't think about it. All it takes is one wrong move to cause an injury. Lifting incorrectly is a major cause of on-the-job injuries, such as:

- Strains,
- Pulled muscles,
- Disc lesions, and
- Painful hernias.

Injuries like these can affect daily activities, and often result in doctor's fees and lost work days. Learn how to prevent injuries by lifting properly:

1. When you are ready to lift the object, stand close to it with legs in a shoulder-width stance.
2. Bend at the hips and knees into a squatting position, while keeping the feet flat.
3. Squat down close to the load, while keeping your back straight.
4. Pull the load close to your body and lift with your legs, not your back.
5. Check your footing and lift slowly, using "leg power."

Use a step stool or platform instead of reaching above your shoulders to lift an object, and never carry a load that blocks your view. Also, remember these important tips:

- **Always think before you lift.** Size up the load and get help if the object is heavy or bulky, or use material-handling equipment, such as hand trucks and mail transport equipment (MTE).
- **Inspect your path.** Be wary of stairs, curbs, or other tripping and slipping hazards. Choose the flattest, straightest, and clearest route before you lift the object, even if it is a little longer.
- **Get a firm grip.** Check the object for nails and sharp edges. If the load is wet or slippery, wipe it off.

- **Keep the object stable.** Make sure the weight of the object is stable and distributed evenly, if possible.
- **Move with caution.** Pivot your feet to change direction; don't twist.

Additionally, proper use of hand trucks and MTE can save a lot of manual effort. When manually moving materials, you could potentially pinch or crush toes and fingers when unloading the object to the ground, a shelf, or another location. Before you unload, make sure your fingers and toes are not underneath the object.

Keep in mind that when stacking large pieces of material, you could become trapped between the materials; or, if you stack objects in an unstable manner, you could be caught under a fallen load.

Remember to always push MTE instead of pulling it. Pulling a load while facing the direction of travel keeps your arm stretched behind your body, and places your shoulder and back in an awkward position. Pushing uses stronger leg muscles, instead of weaker arm muscles. Pushing equipment also prevents employees from being involved in accidents.

Supervisors must ensure that employees have been trained in proper lifting techniques during orientation. Review job safety analyses that focus attention on lifting tasks. Use work practice observations to monitor employees' safe and unsafe lifting techniques.

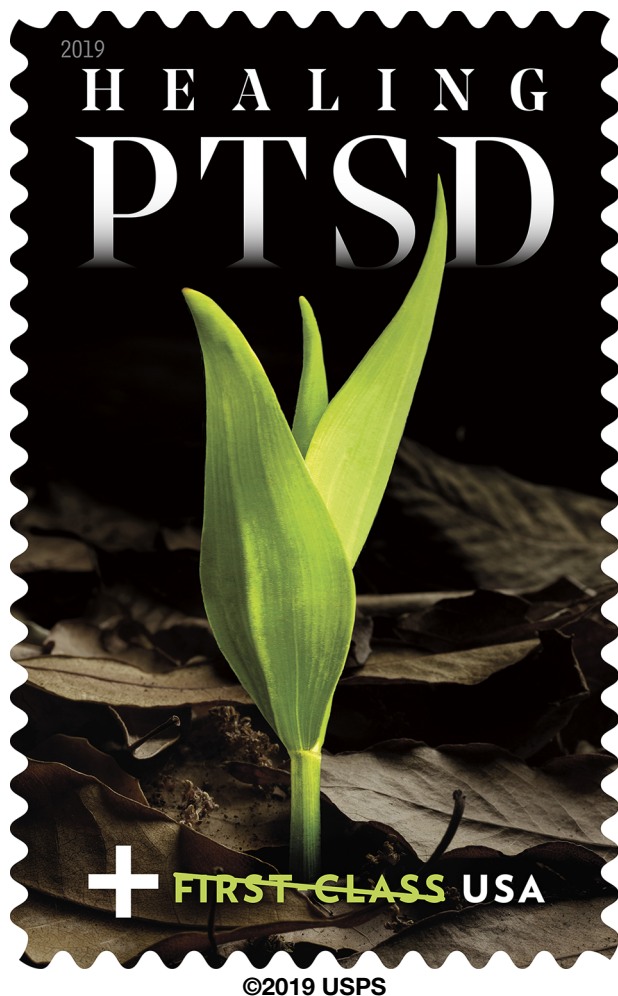

Stamp Announcement 19-34: Healing PTSD Semipostal Stamp



On December 2, 2019, in Charlotte, NC, the United States Postal Service® will issue the *Healing PTSD* semipostal stamp (Non-denominated, First-Class Mail® priced at 65 cents) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 572100). The stamp will go on sale nationwide December 2, 2019, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

With this semipostal stamp, the United States Postal Service will raise funds to help treat those impacted by post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). The stamp features a photo illustration of a green plant sprouting from the ground, which is covered in fallen leaves. The image is intended to symbolize the PTSD healing process, growth, and hope. Art director Greg Breeding designed the stamp with original art by Mark Laita.

Availability to Post Offices: Item 572100, Healing PTSD Semipostal (Non-denominated, First-Class Mail priced at 65 cents) PSA Pane of 20 Stamps

Stamp Fulfillment Services will make an automatic push distribution to Post Offices of a quantity to cover approximately 30 days of sales. Distribution quantities for the automatic push distribution will be available by logging on to SFS Web at sfsweb.usps.gov. Post Offices may begin ordering stamps on the first-day-of-issue through SFS Web; offices must also check the amount they will receive on their automatic push distribution.

Sales Policy

As has been the case with current and previous semipostal stamp issues, all Post Offices must maintain a sufficient inventory level of this item until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale. The *Healing PTSD* semipostal stamp is supported by a variety of organizations and individuals who expect the stamp to be available at all Post Offices. If supplies run low, Post Offices must reorder additional quantities using normal ordering procedures.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Postmark

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™ or at The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop. They must affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark up to a quantity of 50. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. All orders must be postmarked by April 2, 2020.

How to Order First-Day Covers

The Postal Service also offers first-day covers for new stamp issues and Postal Service stationery items postmarked with the official first-day-of-issue cancellation. Each item has an individual catalog number and is offered in the USA Philatelic catalog and online at usps.com/shop. Customers may register to receive a free USA Philatelic catalog online at usps.com/philatelic.

Locally produced items are not authorized. Only merchandise that has been approved and assigned an item number by Headquarters Retail Marketing may be produced and sold.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

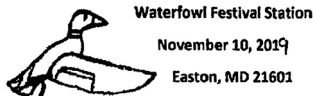

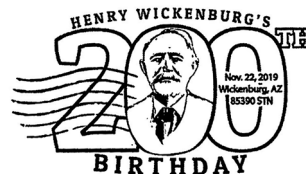

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as “laser safe.” The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches (vertically) by 4 inches (horizontally). Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of

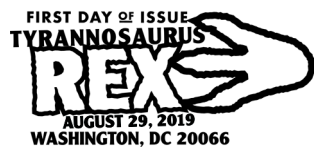
