

Building on the success of past promotions that combined mail and digital technology, the United States Postal Service® developed the 2021 promotions calendar for marketers, printers, and mailers at *postalpro.usps.com/promotions/2021-calendar*.

Here is a brief overview of the opportunities for business mailers who participate in USPS[®] 2021 mailing promotions:

Tactile, Sensory, and Interactive Mailpiece Engagement Promotion

- Promotion runs February 1 through July 31, 2021.
- Registration period: December 15, 2020 through July 31, 2021.

Leveraging the physical aspects of mail as well as the advances in print technology, marketers can enhance how their customers interact and engage with mail to drive response rates. Earned Value Promotion

- Promotion runs April 1 through June 30, 2021.
- Registration period: February 15 through March 31, 2021.

This promotion is intended to help slow the decline of First-Class Mail[®], which includes Business Reply Mail[®] (BRM) and Courtesy Reply Mail[™] (CRM) pieces. Mailers who register their Mailer ID (MID) information and use eligible Intelligent Mail[®] barcodes on their BRM, CRM, and Share Mail pieces may receive a postage credit for each mailpiece that is placed in the mailstream by the recipient and scanned during the promotion period. Personalized Color Transpromo Promotion

- Promotion runs July 1 through December 31, 2021.
- Registration period: May 15 through December 31, 2021.

ELM Revision: Waiver of Claims for Erroneous Payment of Pay

Effective March 31, 2021, the Postal Service™ will revise the *Employee and Labor Relations Manual* (ELM), section 437.5, to update the name of the Eagan Accounting Service Center (ASC) branch where the servicing Human Resources official, after reviewing the file, must send the complete file of an employee requesting a waiver of claims for erroneous payment of pay.

The file must be sent to Eagan ASC's Financial Processing Branch. Additionally, revisions include reformatting text in sections 437.1 and 437.4 to enhance clarity and to meet ELM list formatting standards.

Although the Postal Service will not publish these revisions in the ELM until March 31, 2021, the updates are effective immediately.

437.1 Purpose

- Requesting a waiver of a claim made by the Postal Service against a current or former employee for the recovery of pay that was erroneously paid, and
- Applying for a refund of money paid by or deducted from a current or former employee as a result of such a claim.

437.4 Review by Installation Head

[Revise the text of item c. to read as follows:]

- c. If available, a listing of the following for each pay period in which an overpayment was made:
 - (1) The employee's pay rate;
 - (2) The gross amount due the employee; and
 - (3) The gross amount that was actually paid.

437.5 Review by Human Resources

[Revise the text of item d. to read as follows:]

d. Forwards the entire file to the Financial Processing Branch of the Eagan Accounting Service Center.

[Add new item e. to read as follows — because the article entitled "IMM Revisions: Changes to Pricing for International Shipping Services" in Postal Bulletin 22562 (12-31-20, pages 5–15) also had revisions to the items in 251.22 that are effective January 24, 2021, we are including items a. through e. for clarity:]

- a. Minimum length: 6 inches.
- b. Minimum height: 4 inches.
- Maximum length: 24 inches. Length is the longest dimension.
- d. Maximum length, height, and depth (thickness) combined: 36 inches.
- e. The postage, address, customs form, and other required elements must appear on a side that meets the minimum length and height dimensions (6 inches x 4 inches).

292.482 Preparation

292.48 Presort Mailings - Price Groups 3-6

[Revise item b. to read as follows:]

b. Prepare mail in sacks for letter-size and flat-size mail as defined in 292.483 and 292.484.

292.483 Direct Country and Mixed Country — Optional **Sack Preparation**

[Revise the first paragraph and 292.483a(1) to read as follows:

The mailer may optionally prepare direct country sacks or mixed country sacks of presorted IPA letter-size and flatsize mail when sacks are used for the following processing categories:

- a. Full-Service and ISC Drop Shipment Direct country sacks.
 - 1. Preparation. Mail (letter-size and flat-size) that is addressed to an individual country and that contains 2 pounds or more must be sorted into direct country sacks. Mail that cannot be made up into direct country sacks must be prepared and entered as mixed country sacks or as worldwide nonpresort sacks. The mailer must bundle lettersize and flat-size items as defined in 292.44. The mailer must bundle letter-size items and flat-size items separately, although nonidentical items may be commingled within each of these categories. Face all letter-size items and flat-size items in the same direction and apply a label (facing slip) to the top item as defined in 292.472.

Note: When using this option, the mailer may not place package-size items in the sacks.

b. ISC Drop Shipment - Mixed country sacks.

[Revise 292.483b(1) to read as follows:]

1. Preparation. Mixed country sacks can be prepared only after all possible direct country sacks have been prepared. The mailer must prepare mixed country sacks for items that contain 5 pounds or more and that are destined within the same price group. Mail that ultimately cannot be made up into direct country sacks or mixed country sacks must be prepared and entered at the worldwide nonpresort price. The mailer must bundle letter-size and flat-size items as defined in 292.44. The mailer must bundle letter-size and flat-size items separately, although nonidentical items may be commingled within each of these categories. Face all letter-size items and flat-size items in the same direction and apply a label (facing slip) to the top item as defined in 292.484.

Note: When using this option, the mailer may not place package-size items in the sacks.

Federal Reporting Requirements for Hazardous and Toxic Chemicals

United States Postal Service[®] policy requires all USPS[®] facilities to comply with the reporting requirements of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA), if applicable. Postal Service[™] sites that store certain quantities of hazardous and toxic chemicals must complete and submit the EPCRA Tier II Form by March 1 every year.

Reporting requirements apply to any location that stores threshold quantities of EPCRA-regulated hazardous and toxic chemicals.

Applicable Chemicals

Commonly reported chemicals and thresholds applicable to USPS facilities include:

- Lead-acid batteries. USPS facilities can meet the 500-pound threshold for sulfuric acid by having more than six tow motor batteries or more than two forklift batteries, or a combination of these batteries, onsite. Estimate the percent weight of sulfuric acid in each battery by multiplying the battery weight by 18 percent.
- Gasoline, diesel, or heating fuel. The 10,000-pound threshold for these fuels is equivalent to 1,639 gallons of gasoline (6.1 pounds/gallon) or 1,351 gallons of diesel/heating fuel (7.4 pounds/gallon).
- Ice melt/anti-skid products. Rock salt, calcium magnesium acetate, and sand have a 10,000-pound threshold. The threshold applies whether the materials are stored in one bulk location or dispersed in bags or on pallets throughout the site.

Reporting Process

By March 1, 2021, USPS Installation Heads must submit the emergency and hazardous chemical inventory reporting form, known as the EPCRA Tier II Form, to the following organizations:

- The State Emergency Response Commission;
- The Local Emergency Planning Committee; and
- The local Fire Department that would respond to an emergency at your facility.

States may require report submission via the following ways:

- Submittal of the hard copy EPCRA Tier II Form;
- Electronic reporting through the EPA Tier2 Submit software program; or
- Through state-specific software programs or websites. Access each state's individual reporting requirements, procedures, and forms at epa.gov/epcra/state-tier-ii-reporting-requirements-and-procedures.

For states that require report submission through the EPA Tier2 Submit 2020 software, USPS facilities can request a download of the Tier2 Submit 2020 software through eAccess. If other state electronic reporting software or website applications are not accessible or authorized on your USPS ACE computer system, you must submit the EPCRA Tier II Form in a hard copy format.

Note: USPS facilities are not required to pay any fees associated with reporting (including electronic reporting user and registration fees); however, as a matter of individual discretion, electronic submittal fees may be paid if the convenience benefits the Postal Service.

2020 Tax Information: Form W-2 Wage and Tax Statement; Form 1099

General Form W-2 Information

If an employee has earnings from more than one state or locality, a separate Form W-2 (see pages $\underline{15}$ and $\underline{16}$) will be issued for each.

The Postal Service[™] will mail the 2020 Form W-2, Wage and Tax Statement, to all employees, except those employees who elected not to receive mailed copies of Forms W-2

(through the *PostalEASE* W-2 module) in lieu of official, electronic Forms W-2. The *PostalEASE* W-2 module makes online viewing and printing of Forms W-2 available to all employees for the last 7 years.

The format of the 2020 Form W-2 remains unchanged from the 2019 version.

An employee may be able to take the Earned Income Credit (EIC) for 2020, if he or she meets qualifying requirements. Details are printed in the "Notice to Employee" section of the Form W-2. An employee may also qualify for a state EIC credit. Employees must visit applicable state taxing authority websites to determine eligibility.

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act created the "Additional Medicare Tax" effective January 1, 2013. All wages and other compensation that are subject to regular Medicare tax in excess of \$200,000 are subject to an additional Medicare tax of 0.9 percent. All Medicare tax withheld is reported in Box 6 of the Form W-2.

General Questions

Source of Reported Wages

The Wages and Other Compensation amount reported in Box 1 of Form W-2 is derived from year-to-date totals reflected on the employee's Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement, plus several other totals from the Form W-2. The employee's Earnings Statement year-to-date amounts and the Reconciliation Formula calculation specific to the employee are printed on the employee's Form W-2 (top left section of the page). In addition, employees can access this information via the *PostalEASE* W-2 module.

Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAs): Dependent Care (DC) and Health Care (HC)

Employee contributions to an FSA for dependent care are pre-tax and are reported in Box 10 (Dependent Care Benefits). Per the Reconciliation Formula, FSA contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Employee contributions to an FSA for health care are pre-tax and are not reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, FSA contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement year-to-date amount to determine your total Health Care FSA contributions made in 2020.

Thrift Savings Plan (TSP)

Employee TSP traditional (pre-tax) contributions including TSP Catch-up (employees 50 years old and older) are reported in Box 12 (letter code "D").

Per the Reconciliation Formula, traditional TSP contributions (Box 12, letter code "D") are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

TSP Roth (post-tax) contributions including TSP Roth Catch-Up are reported in Box 12 (letter code "AA"). TSP Roth contributions do not reduce gross pay; they are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). Roth contributions (letter code "AA") are reported for your information only.

Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB)

FEHB premiums are considered pre-tax unless the employee declined the pre-tax benefit. Payroll deductions for pre-tax FEHB premium payments are no longer reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for pre-tax FEHB premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pre-tax FEHB premium payments made in 2020.

The Cost of Employer-Sponsored Health Coverage (employer cost plus employee pre-tax or post-tax cost) is reported in Box 12 (letter code "DD"). Reporting is required by the Affordable Care Act but is reported for informational purposes only.

Health Savings Accounts (HSAs)

Employee HSA contributions are pre-tax and are reported in Box 12 (letter code "W"). Per the Reconciliation Formula, employee HSA contributions (Box 12) are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP)

FEDVIP premiums are considered pre-tax. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for FEDVIP premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pre-tax FEDVIP premium payments made in 2020.

USPS Health Benefits (HB)

USPS[®] HB premiums are considered post-tax, unless the employee opts for pre-tax deductions. Post-tax premiums are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

For those employees who elected pre-tax premiums, the pre-tax premium payments are not reported separately in any box on the Form W-2. Per the Reconciliation Formula, payroll deductions for pre-tax USPS HB premiums are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement year-to-date amount to determine your total pre-tax USPS HB premium payments made in 2020.

The Cost of Employer-Sponsored Health Coverage, (employer share plus employee pre-tax or post-tax share), is reported in Box 12 (letter code "DD"). Reporting is required by the Affordable Care Act, but such reporting is for informational purposes only.

Commuter Program

Employee contributions for the Commuter Program are considered pre-tax for 2020 up to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) \$270 monthly limit for public transportation and the IRS \$270 monthly limit for parking. Per the Reconciliation Formula, employee pre-tax commuter contributions are subtracted from gross pay and are not included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). See your Pay Period 26-2020 (or the last pay period in pay status 2020) Earnings Statement year-to-date amount to determine your total Commuter Program contributions made in 2020. Any commuting contributions elected over the IRS limits are considered post-tax. Post-tax contributions do not reduce gross pay; they are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Relocation Payments

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) of 2017 eliminated the federal exclusion for relocation expenses. As a result, moving expenses incurred on or after January 1, 2018, and reimbursed to an employee or vendor on the employee's behalf, are reportable income (included in Boxes 1, 3, and 5, and considered subject to federal tax withholding).

Most states have conformed to TCJA and relocation expenses will be included in box 16 (State Wages) and box 18 (Local Wages), if applicable. The states that did not conform to TCJA as of December 2020, and continue to exclude certain relocation expenses from state taxable wages (and local, if applicable) are Arkansas, California, Hawaii, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania.

For more information, see the statements issued by the Postal Service Relocation Management firm (Sterling Lexicon).

Employee Business Expense (EBE)

Equipment maintenance allowance (EMA), carrier driveout, vehicle hire, and supervisor vehicle usage are considered employee expenses paid by the U.S. Postal Service[®]. The nontaxable (not the total) EBE amount is reported in Box 12 (letter code "L"). If there is a taxable amount, it is reported in Box 14 (Other). Per the Reconciliation Formula, taxable vehicle (Box 14) is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Imputed Life Insurance

Imputed Income Life Insurance is reported in Box 12 (letter code "C"). The IRS requires employers to report as income the employer cost of Group Term Life Insurance in excess of \$50,000.

Per the Reconciliation Formula, Imputed Income Life Insurance (Box 12) is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Locality Pay, LEAP, AUO

Per the Reconciliation Formula, Locality Pay, LEAP (Law Enforcement Availability Pay), and AUO (Administratively Uncontrollable Overtime) are added to gross pay and are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Geographic (GEO) Pay

Per the Reconciliation Formula, GEO Pay is added to gross pay and is included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).

Military Differential Payments

Military Differential Payments are reported in Box 14 (Other) and are included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). Differential payments made to an individual while on active duty for more than 30 days are not subject to Social Security and Medicare taxes. Differential payments made to an individual while on active duty for 30 days or less are subject to Social Security and Medicare taxes.

Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA)

Qualified Sick Leave Wages and Qualified Family Leave Wages aree reported separately in Box 14 (Reference IRS notice 2020-54) and included in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation). The leave types are identified in box 14 as follows:

- Emergency Sick Leave Other is labeled SL \$200 DAY
- Emergency Sick Leave Self is labeled SL \$511 DAY
- Public Health FMLA is labeled EMERG FAM LV.

Oregon Statewide Transit Tax

Oregon Statewide Transit Tax (ORSTT) is reported in Box 14 (Other).

State/Territory Reportable Wages

The amount in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.) will equal Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation) with the following exceptions:

- Hawaii includes territorial cost-of-living allowance (TCOLA) in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.).
- California does not allow income deferral for HSAs.
- Mississippi does not allow income deferral for commuter program public transportation and parking.
- New Jersey allows no income deferral. Therefore, there is no income deferral for TSP, FSA DC, FSA HC, HB, HSA, FEDVIP, or a commuter program (public transportation and parking).
- Pennsylvania does not allow income deferral for TSP,
 FSA Dependent Care, or a commuter program (public transportation and parking); however, Pennsylvania

- does not require the addition of Imputed Income Life Insurance to state gross pay.
- Puerto Rico does not allow income deferral for employee FSA DC, FSA HC, HB, HSA, FEDVIP, or a commuter program (public transportation and parking) contributions.
- Arkansas, California, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania still have exclusions for certain relocation expenses. See section on "Relocation Payments."

Local Reportable Wages

The following statements do not take into account taxable wage limits that exist for certain localities. For those localities, amounts in Box 18 (Local wages, tips, etc.) will not exceed local taxable wage limits.

The amount in Box 18 (Local wages, tips, etc.) will equal gross pay with the following exceptions:

- New York City, NY; St. Louis, MO; and MI Locals (Battle Creek, Detroit, Flint, Grand Rapids, Lansing, Pontiac, and Saginaw): Local taxable wages are the same as the federal taxable wages reported in Box 1 (Wages, tips, other compensation).
- Kansas City, MO: Local taxable wages equals federal taxable wages plus HSA.
- OH Locals (Akron, Brecksville, Brook Park, Canton, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, Dayton, Fairview Park, Heath, Kettering, Mansfield, Newark, Oberlin, Sharonville, Springfield, Toledo, Whitehall, and Youngstown): Local taxable wages equals federal taxable wages plus TSP and minus Life Insurance Imputed Income.
- With the exception of Philadelphia and Pittsburgh, PA Locals (Bethlehem, Erie, Greene, Hanover, Harrisburg, Horsham, Lancaster, Middletown, Reading, Scranton, South Park, Sunbury/Gregg, Tinicum, Warminster, Wilkes-Barre, and York) are the same as the PA taxable wages reported in Box 16 (State wages, tips, etc.).
- New York and Pennsylvania still have exclusions for certain relocation expenses. See section on "Relocation Payments."

Obtaining Duplicate Forms W-2 for Tax Years 2014 to the Present

PostalEASE

Employees may use the *PostalEASE* W-2 module to view and print official, electronic copies of their Forms W-2 for any of the last 7 years, including the most recent W-2 year.

Except for an approximate 6-week period (mid-December through late January), an employee may also exercise the option to have reprinted copies of any of the seven most recent Tax Year Form(s) W-2 mailed to his or her home address. Requests are processed weekly (daily during March and April). Employees must allow 2 weeks to receive the W-2 reprint(s) by mail to the address of record. In mid to late January 2021, Tax Year 2020 will be loaded to the *PostalEASE* W-2 module. At the same time, Tax Year 2013 will be removed from the W-2 module.

PostalEASE Interactive Voice Response (IVR)

USPS Employees now have the option to request a duplicate Form W-2 reprint by telephone using the *PostalEASE* automated Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service ${}^{\text{TM}}$ money order:

- Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
- 2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word "USPS" repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

- **B.** Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:
 - Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
 - All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.
- **B2.** All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.
- **C.** Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.
- C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.
- **C2.** E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.
 - **D.** Coffee is prohibited.
- **E.** Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.
- **E1.** Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.
- **E2.** Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

- **E3.** Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited
- **F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.
 - F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.
- **F2.** Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.
- **F3.** Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.
 - G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.
- **H.** Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.
 - H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.
 - I. Reserved for future use.

- **U.** Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."
- **U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail
 - U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.
 - U3. Reserved for future use.
 - **U4.** Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.
 - V. PMEMS is not available.
- **V1.** Electronic Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on *USPS.com*. Manual record of delivery may be available upon request.
- **W.** Hermetically sealed packages of meat products bearing USDA certification, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed. 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.
 - X. Cremated remains are prohibited.
- Y. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail and Priority Mail items only. This restriction also applies to Official Mail.
 - Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).
- **Z1.** The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No 0817E or 0818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Freely Associated States

Glaucoma Awareness Month: Don't be Blindsided

January is Glaucoma Awareness Month, a time to learn more about the second leading cause of blindness worldwide.

Glaucoma is a group of eye diseases that damage the eye's optic nerve, which can cause vision loss and blindness. According to the National Institutes of Health, the most common type of glaucoma in the United States is open-angle glaucoma, which is usually asymptomatic.

Anyone can get glaucoma, but certain groups are at higher risk, including people over age 60, African Americans over age 40, those with a family history of the disease, and individuals who have diabetes. Many people with glaucoma experience high eye pressure that develops slowly. Only 50 percent of these people know they have the condition.

Vision loss from glaucoma generally affects peripheral vision first (what you can see on the side when looking ahead) and central vision later (what you can see straight ahead).

Glaucoma is detected by having a comprehensive dilated eye exam. Once discovered, treatment can slow

disease progression and save remaining vision; however, lost vision cannot be restored. Glaucoma is treated with the following options:


- Eye drops,
- Medication,
- Laser treatment,
- Surgery, or
- A combination of treatments.

Without treatment, glaucoma can cause blindness. There is no cure, but early detection, treatment, and management are crucial measures to prevent damage and protect your vision.

Information Security

Make Passphrase Security a Top Priority

When creating a passphrase, many Postal Service™ employees have likely received at least one of these error messages:

- "Doesn't meet length requirements,"
- "Missing special character," or
- "Can't contain username."

Creating a passphrase strong enough to meet security requirements, yet memorable enough that you don't need to write it down can be challenging. Use these steps to create a secure and unique passphrase:

- Select a memorable phrase, such as "Be Cyber-Safe."
- Change specific letters into special characters or numbers to increase security and originality (e.g., B3_Cyb3rS*f3).
- Add a unique identifier to further differentiate passwords across your other accounts (e.g., B3_-Cyb3rS*f3_w0^k).

If you need to write down your passphrase, protect it by safely securing it in a locked file cabinet or container that only you can access.

Additionally, make sure that passphrases comply with the requirements listed in Handbook AS-805, *Information Security* (about.usps.com/handbooks/as805/as805c9_019.htm):

- Minimum of 15 characters.
- Uses three of the four character types described below:
 - One uppercase letter,
 - One lowercase letter,
 - One number, or
 - One special character (e.g., @, #, \$).

Statutory Requirement to Review and Post OSHA Form 300A Summary for Calendar Year 2020

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requires all Postal Service™ installation and establishment heads to complete and post the OSHA Form 300A, Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses, for calendar year (CY) 2020, in accordance with 29 CFR 1904, and the Employee and Labor Relations Manual (ELM), part 821, Actions in the Event of Accident, Injury, or Illness.

From February 1 through April 30, 2021, installations are required to post a copy of the OSHA Form 300A for CY 2020 in a conspicuous place at every establishment where employees work or report to work.

When reviewing the OSHA 300 Log, installation heads must pay close attention to the following columns:

- Column F, which includes:
 - A description of the injury or illness,
 - The parts of the body affected (including which side of the body), and
 - The object or substance that directly injured or made the person ill (e.g., Second-degree burns on right forearm from acetylene torch).
- Columns K and L. If an injury is identified as "days away from work" in column K or "on the job transfer or restriction" in column L, installation heads must ensure that the number of days entered is accurate.

For every entry on the OSHA 300 Log, the installation head must ensure that there is a corresponding Accident Report Form 1769/301 in the Employee Health and Safety application, which populates the OSHA Form 301, *Injury and Illness Incident Report*.

The left side of OSHA Form 300A contains sets of information data points with a letter, such as the letter "K," that corresponds to each data point. The data points come from the OSHA 300 Log summary columns with the same letter.

The right side of the OSHA Form 300A is self-explanatory except for the North American Industrial Classification code. The code for Vehicle Maintenance Facilities is 811111, and the code for all other Postal Service establishments is 491110.

Before posting and signing the OSHA Form 300A, the installation or establishment heads must review the OSHA 300 Log and the OSHA 300A Summary Reports. When they sign the OSHA Form 300A, they are affirming that they have reviewed both OSHA forms for accuracy and completeness, whether they use manual or automated versions of the forms.

USPS Enhances Loyalty Program with the Introduction of Loyalty Tiers

Small businesses have unique needs and challenges, and the USPS[®] Loyalty program was launched in 2020 as part of a strategic effort to attract and support them. The USPS Loyalty program allows registered businesses and frequent shippers to earn credits for using Click-N-Ship[®] to purchase Priority Mail[®] (PM) and Priority Mail Express[®] (PME) services to use for future shipping product purchases. Program participants have the following options:

- Registered users receive a \$40 credit for every \$500 spent.
- New users earn an additional \$40 for their first \$500 spent.

Loyalty Benefits will Increase with Loyalty Tiers Launch

As of January 1, 2021, the Postal Service™ will add tiers to the USPS Loyalty program. Assigned tier levels are based on qualified shipping totals from the previous year. A higher tier equals a larger benefit. See the table shown in this article for details on tier levels and eligibility.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.

All requests must include a stamped envelope or post-card bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail[®] postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4[®] Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail[®] requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post OfficeTM, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store[®] website at *usps.com/shop*.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches (vertically) by 4 inches (horizontally). Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of

Environmental Compliance Reminder: Training Requirements

Environmental compliance training requirements vary based on the operations and systems at each site, the local jurisdiction, and, most importantly, an employee's roles and responsibilities.

The corporate Environmental Training Matrix at blue.usps.gov/sustainability/_pdf/env-training-matrix.pdf outlines the training courses required for employees at U.S. Postal Service[®] sites that generate hazardous or regulated waste, store oil in aboveground or underground storage tanks, and conduct vehicle maintenance activities. Site installation heads must use the corporate Environmental Training Matrix to determine the applicability of environmental training requirements and to identify employees that must attend each course.

Several environmental courses that satisfy training requirements are available in the HERO system at *usps.csod.com/LMS/catalog/Welcome.aspx*. The majority of HERO environmental courses are now web-based (i.e., virtual) and available on demand.

Some training materials are not available through HERO. This includes certain service talks, self-guided PowerPoint presentations, and other courses where regulations mandate specific third-party providers.
