Mailbox Improvement Week, May 16–22, 2021

Each year, the Postal Service™ designates the third full week of May as “Mailbox Improvement Week” to encourage customers on city motorized, rural, or contract delivery service routes (formerly highway contract box delivery routes) to examine and, where necessary, improve the appearance of their mailboxes. Neat, attractive mailboxes make a significant contribution to the appearance of the countryside and streets in suburban areas. Mailbox Improvement Week calls attention to the need for providing mailboxes that are:

1. Approved by the Postmaster General®.
2. Fully operational.
3. Designed to protect the mail from weather.
4. Safe to use.
5. Conveniently located.
6. Neat in appearance.
7. Large enough within allowable size limits to support the customer’s daily mail and package volume (see about.usps.com/what-we-are-doing/current-initiatives/delivery-growth-management/welcome.htm).

Mailboxes designed to meet these seven important requirements help delivery and collection operations while improving service to the entire route. There are two main design groups of curbside mailboxes:

1. Non-locked designs (full or limited service):
 - a. Traditional design (see Exhibit A1, page 4).
 - b. Traditional design — wide; USPS® preferred (see Exhibit A2, page 4).
 - c. Contemporary design (see Exhibit B, page 4).
2. Locked designs (full or limited service):
 - a. Mail slot design.
 - b. Wide or large-capacity design; USPS preferred.

USPS-STD-7C governs the design and specifications of curbside mailboxes and includes provisions for improved product quality.

Notice 209

Postmasters must send Notice 209, *Mailbox Improvement Week*, to all rural and highway contract box delivery route customers the week before Mailbox Improvement Week as a reminder of the event. Postmasters may order

City Motorized, Rural, and Contract Delivery Service Routes

Customers must only use approved traditional, contemporary, or locked full/limited service curbside mailboxes for new installations or replacements. When new delivery is established or extended, postmasters must ensure that customers use delivery equipment that the Postmaster General has approved. However, a customer may use a custom-built *curbside mailbox* if the local postmaster approves and the mailbox conforms generally to the same requirements as approved manufactured curbside mailboxes (i.e., relative to the flag, size, strength, and quality of construction).

Postmasters *do not have the authority* to approve mailbox systems, such as USPS-STD-4C wall-mounted units or cluster box units (CBUs), that the Postmaster General has not approved through the USPS® approval process.

Carriers on motorized city routes may continue to serve mailboxes that are designed primarily for use by customers receiving door delivery that have been erected and served under previous regulations (see Exhibit C, page 4). However, carriers must advise customers that they may only use approved curbside mailboxes when replacing these types of mailboxes. Exhibit A1, Traditional Design

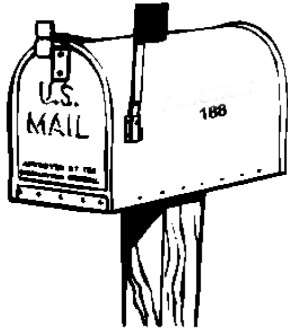


Exhibit A2, Traditional Design - Wide

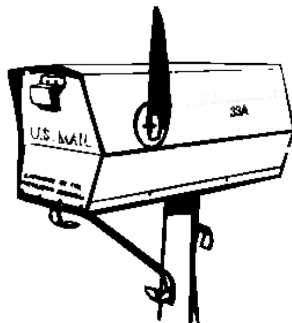
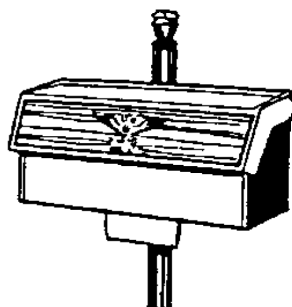


Exhibit C, Door Delivery



For motorized city routes, and where the use of street names and house numbers is authorized on rural and contract delivery service routes, the mailbox must display the number on the side of single mailboxes or on the door of grouped mailboxes. If the mailbox is on a street other than the one on which the customer resides, the street name and house number must be on the mailbox. When rural and contract delivery service route customers have assigned box numbers, the numbers must appear on the side of single mailboxes or on the doors of grouped mailboxes, visible to the approaching carrier. The street number, box number, and any other address information must be inscribed in contrasting color in neat letters and numerals not less than 1 inch in height. In all instances, placing the owner's name on the box is optional, but not recommended by the Postal Service.

The Postal Service encourages but does not require motorized city, rural, and contract delivery service route customers to group mailboxes whenever practical, especially where many mailboxes are located at or near crossroads, service turnouts, or similar locations. Customers must also paint mailboxes and supports/posts and keep them rust-free. The Postal Service prohibits advertising on mailboxes and mailbox supports.

In areas where snow removal is a problem, the Postal Service suggests using a semi-arch or extended arm-type support (see Exhibit D), which allows snowplows to sweep near or under mailboxes without damaging supports and provides easy access to the mailboxes by carriers and customers.

Generally, customers must install mailboxes at a height of 41–45 inches from the road surface to the bottom of the mailbox or point of mail entry. Also, customers must set mailboxes back 6–8 inches from the front face of the curb or road edge to the mailbox door. However, because of varying road and curb conditions and other factors, the Postal Service recommends that customers contact their local Post Office® before erecting or replacing mailboxes and supports.

Location

Customers must place mailboxes on motorized city, rural, and contract delivery service routes so a carrier can safely and conveniently serve them without leaving his or her vehicle. The mailboxes must be on the right-hand side of the road in the carrier's travel direction in all cases where traffic conditions make it dangerous for the carrier to drive to the left to reach the mailboxes, or where doing so would constitute a violation of traffic laws and regulations. *Postal Operations Manual* (POM) 632.6 specifies postal regulations regarding mailbox locations for apartment houses and other multiple-unit dwellings.

On new rural and contract delivery service routes, all mailboxes must be on the right-hand side of the road in the direction of the route line. Mailbox placement must conform to state laws and highway regulations. City motorized, rural, and contract delivery service route carriers are subject to the same traffic laws and regulations as other motorists. Customers must remove obstructions, including vehicles, trash cans, and snow, that might impede safe and efficient delivery. Except when a mailbox is temporarily blocked, carriers must have access to the mailbox without leaving the vehicle, unless authorized to dismount.

For new developments, builders and USPS officials discuss the location of centralized delivery equipment during planning and before the start of construction, whenever possible. Centralized delivery is the Postal Service's preferred mode of delivery for all new addresses. Discussing equipment locations early in the process allows builders and USPS officials to determine the safest, most efficient equipment locations. By co-locating boxes, USPS and the building industry realize the best return on the investments of centralized delivery. Factors to consider when determin-

ing locations for centralized delivery equipment include the following:

- Co-locating delivery equipment.
- Carriers' line of travel.
- Customer and carrier safety.
- Customer accessibility (sufficient turnaround space or access for customers with mobility disabilities from nearest public right-of-way).
- Equipment security.

Mailbox Supports

The Postal Service does not regulate mailbox supports in any way except for purposes of carrier safety and delivery efficiency. Customers own and control posts and other supports for curbside mailboxes; they are responsible for ensuring that posts are neat and adequate in strength and size. Heavy metal posts, concrete posts, and miscellaneous items of farm equipment, such as milk cans filled with concrete, are examples of potentially dangerous supports. The ideal support is an assembly that bends or falls away when struck by a vehicle. Post or support designs may not represent effigies or caricatures that disparage or ridicule any person. Customers may attach the box to a fixed or movable arm. POM 632.5 specifies postal regulations for construction and placement of mailboxes and supports on motorized city, rural, and contract delivery service routes.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has determined that wooden mailbox supports no larger than 4-by-4-inches, or a 2-inch diameter standard steel or aluminum pipe, buried no more than 24 inches, should safely break away if struck by a vehicle. According to FHWA, customers must also securely attach the mailbox to its post to prevent separation, if struck.

Exhibit E Cantilever Mailbox Supports

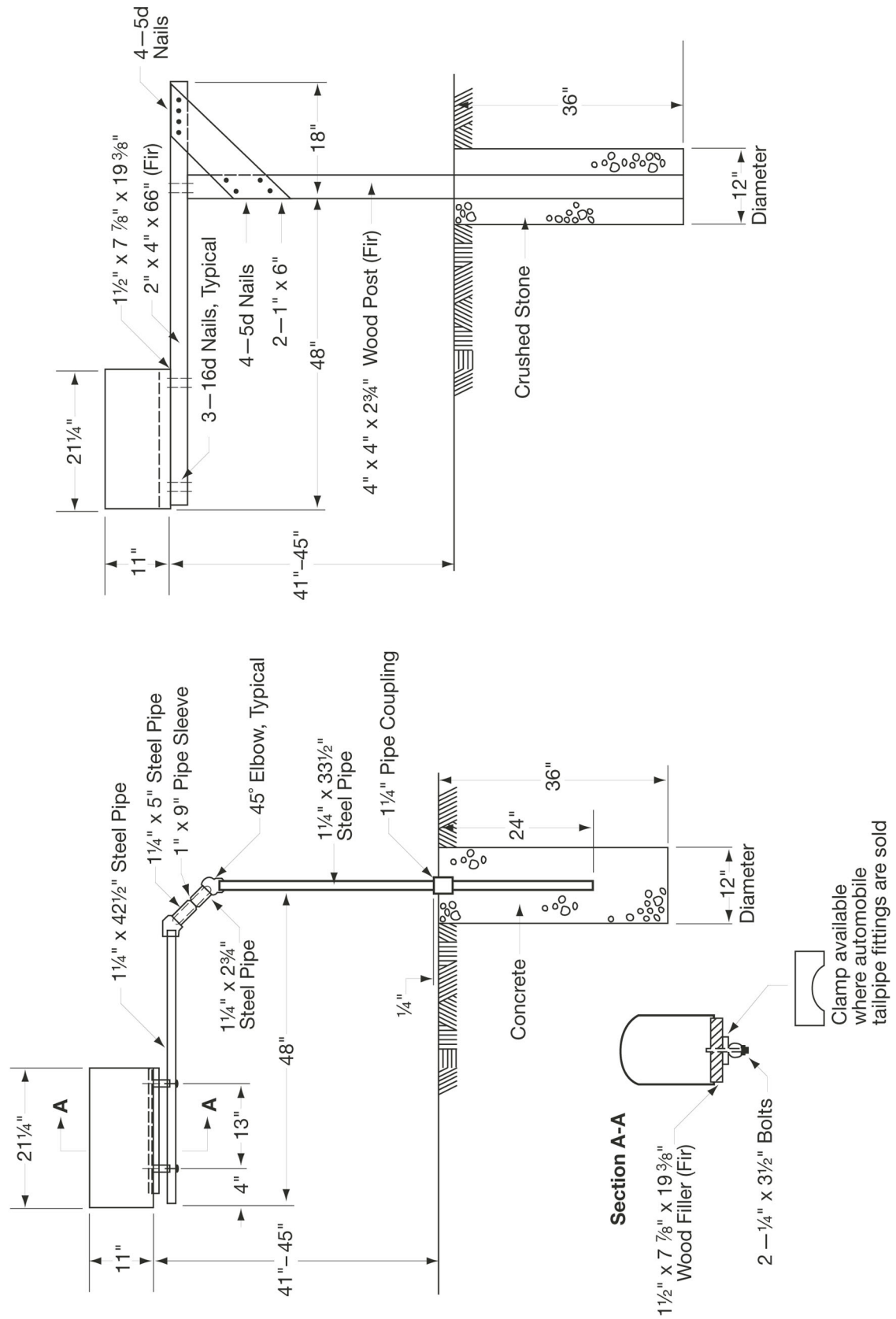
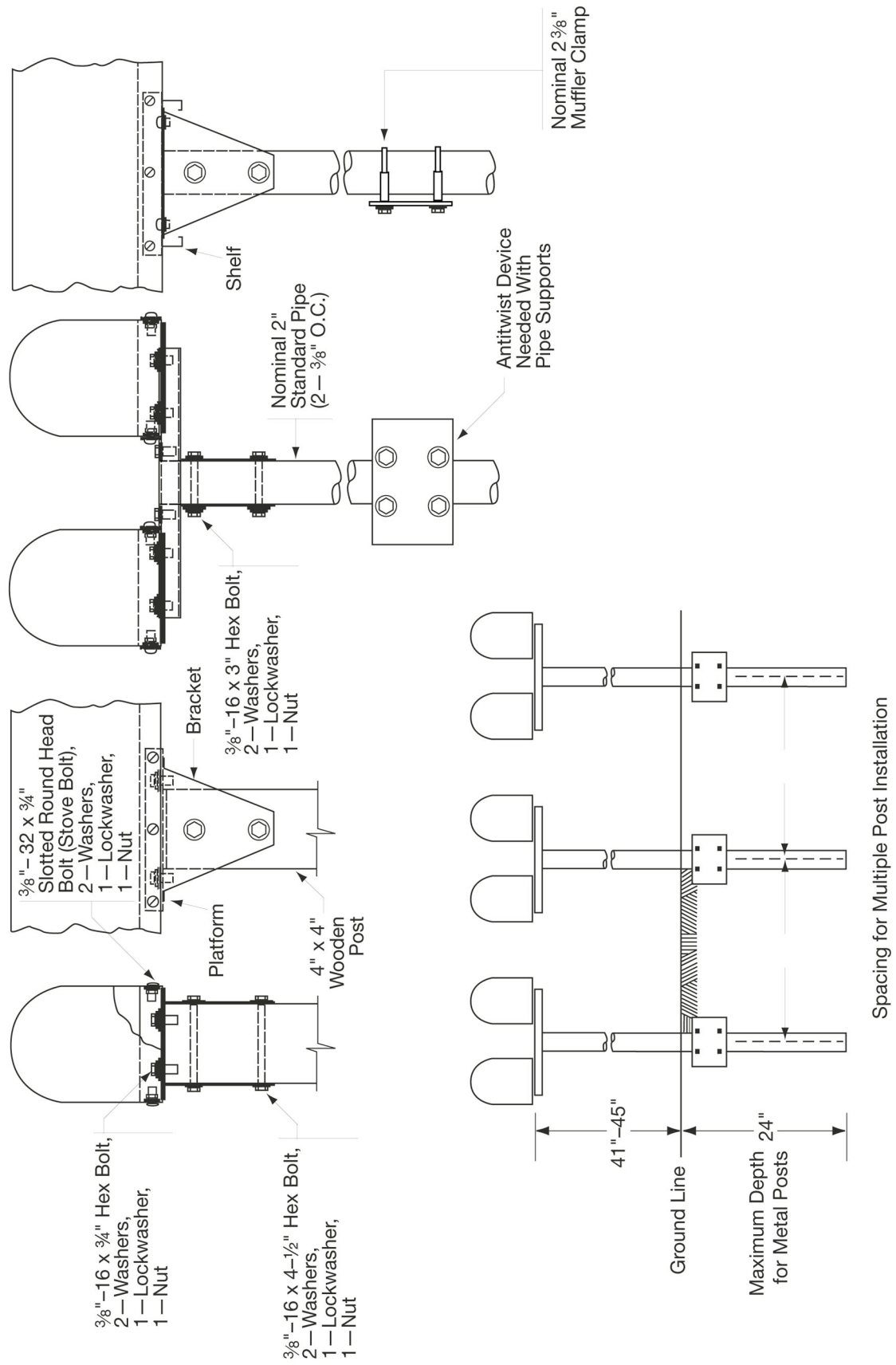


Exhibit F Single and Double Mailbox Installations



Choose the Right Size and Make Your Mailbox Green

When selecting a curbside mail receptacle, customers may want to consider:

- A mail receptacle that can hold small packages, protect them from inclement weather, and offer a safe haven for packages that the carrier might otherwise leave on your doorstep.
- A mail receptacle that can hold larger packages so carriers can pick up outgoing packages through the USPS free Carrier Pickup™ program. Saving a trip to the Post Office saves fuel and time, and helps the environment.

Greener Mailboxes Lead to Greener Neighborhoods

When mailboxes are appropriately constructed, installed, and in good physical condition, the Postal Service delivers the mail safely and efficiently. Customers avoid a trip to the Post Office, which saves fuel and reduces carbon emissions.

However, the greenest forms of mail delivery are centralized mail delivery systems that are located in neighborhoods serving multiple residents from a single location.

Sometimes referred to as a “cluster box unit” or “community mailboxes,” these neighborhood mailbox centers offer the greatest amount of fuel savings and carbon emission reductions because carriers can deliver mail to multiple customers during a single stop with less truck idle time. Increasing the use of centralized delivery for new and existing customers helps the Postal Service create “greener” neighborhoods across the country.

In addition to fostering a sense of community, centralized delivery provides the added benefit of security for mail and package delivery as well as outgoing mail collection.

Curbside Mailboxes Approved by the Postmaster General

USPS-STD-7C (Supersedes all previously published lists of approved manufacturers)

USPS-approved curbside mailboxes are required to have both “Approved by the Postmaster General” and “U.S. Mail” on the front of the mailbox. An exception to this is a curbside mailbox built by the customer for their own use. Carriers and postmasters should follow the guidelines in POM section 632.53, “Nonconforming Mailboxes,” to notify customers if their mailbox does not meet postal regulations.

Cluster Box Units and All-Weather Parcel Lockers

During Mailbox Improvement Week, postmasters and managers or their designees must review all CBUs, neighborhood delivery and collection box units (NDCBUs), and outdoor parcel lockers (OPLs) in their delivery areas to identify any hazards or irregularities, and record the results of the review.

For both physical security and operational improvement, the Postal Service has not allowed NDCBUs for use in new delivery or as replacement units for existing NDCBUs since 1999, even when privately purchased. Postal Service officials will not install Arrow locks in new NDCBUs or initiate delivery to NDCBUs installed as replacements. For new delivery or replacement units to single family home and townhome housing developments, cluster box units (CBUs) must be installed.

Finally, due to their inadequate physical security, their operational inadequacy, their typical years of service (from over 20 years to well over 40 years) and the resulting general decline of their typical condition, NDCBUs are no longer supported for any continued centralized mail delivery service in the field. All reasonable efforts must be made to

identify all NDCBUs still in service and to get them all replaced in the field as quickly as possible. Provisions, both internal and external, must be used to the greatest extent possible to make this happen for the overall benefit of both the USPS and its centralized customers still using these out-of-date boxes.

Note: USPS-STD-4C mailboxes are not approved for any USPS mail delivery as either stand-alone pedestal-mount units or cabinet-mount units. This is especially true as centralized delivery mailboxes for single family and townhome developments where CBUs are the only approved outdoor, pedestal-mount centralized mailbox option. STD-4C units are intended solely for multi-family housing developments or certain business mode delivery scenarios. They are not to be installed where CBUs are the only approved mailbox option.

After completing the reviews, keep a copy in the local office and send consolidated copies to the designated growth coordinator for each district. Use PS Form 8143, *Equipment Checklist and Followup Review*, for conducting and recording the reviews. PS Form 8143 is available in this *Postal Bulletin* (see Exhibit G on page 16). PS Form 8143 is also available on the PolicyNet website at blue.usps.gov/formmgmt/forms.htm. Employees who conduct the reviews must complete PS Form 1624, *Delivery/Collection Equipment Work Request*, for any equipment that poses a safety hazard to Postal Service customers or employees. The Postal Service has revised USPS-STD-4B. The new standard is USPS-STD-4C. Due to the revision, there are now security-enhanced versions of both the horizontal and vertical box, which can be used to replace existing STD-4B equipment. These enhanced versions are referred to as “USPS-STD-4B+” boxes and are designed to fit cleanly into buildings with old USPS-STD-4B boxes.

The Postal Service approves USPS-STD-4B+ boxes for mail delivery for existing indoor installations or existing protected outdoor locations. However, the Postal Service does not approve the purchase of this equipment for new installations and will not install Arrow locks in any such equipment. You may only order *replacement* parts for previously installed Postal Service-owned equipment.

Equipment Review Procedure

Employees must use the CBU and parcel locker equipment checklist and follow-up review procedure when examining the condition of CBUs, NDCBUs, and OPLs. You must:

1. List the unit's 5-digit, USPS-marked postal ID number. This is usually visible on the front or side of the body or pedestal. If a postal ID number is not available, list the unit location, equipment type, and manufacturer in the left-hand column. If you are able to access the back of the unit, list the unit's vendor-supplied serial number. You *must* distinguish the type listed as an NDCBU or CBU.
2. Assign each checklist item one of the following ratings:
 - a. OK — Equipment does not need attention for this item.
 - b. X — Equipment needs attention for this item.
 - c. NA — Item does not apply to this particular piece of equipment.
3. When examining the equipment, use the instructions below to complete PS Form 8143:
 - a. Check equipment. All delivery and collection equipment must be straight, vertical, and firmly mounted. For safety concerns, please ensure that customer compartments are facing away from the

street or are oriented such that safe collection and delivery of the mail may occur. Visually verify that four bolts/nuts are firmly in place securing the pedestal to the concrete pad and to the delivery equipment. Apply hand pressure to the top edge of the unit from the front side. While the unit may flex under the load, verify that the pedestal stays firmly mounted to the concrete and that the unit does not separate from the pedestal.

- b. For safety concerns, ensure that customer compartments are located such that customers do not have to stand in the street to access their mail or that letter carriers do not have to stand in the street to deliver mail. Consider all factors of equipment location including setbacks from streets that may allow customer compartments to face the road, but at such a distance so as not to affect the safe delivery and collection of mail.
- c. Check visible welds. Take note of cracked, broken, or rusted welds. For NDCBUs and OPLs only, tap the pedestal with a lightweight hammer, especially along the seams, to check for corrosion from the inside out or perforated corrosion.
- d. For CBUs and NDCBUs, observe whether the carrier access door is locked and secure. Open it and observe whether it is bowed or warped and whether the door and locking bar operate smoothly. With the carrier access door open, check whether restraining devices prevent the two master doors from blowing closed. These devices, which you may have to set manually, must be serviceable.
- e. Ensure that the Arrow lock operates smoothly and easily and that the mounting hardware is tight. For NDCBUs, CBU parcel doors, and OPLs, the protective cover that shields the Arrow lock from customer tampering or theft must be serviceable and firmly attached.
- f. For OPLs, secure the cover that protects the Arrow lock from theft with the proper quantity of tamper-resistant screws.
- g. Ensure that all customer access doors are present, closed, and locked with no visible damage or signs of forced entry. Check that customer door numbers are legible.
- h. Ensure that the exterior surface of the unit is free from rust and graffiti.
- i. Examine the unit for defects or damage and whether it reflects a proper Postal Service image.
- j. Check whether the unit and any protecting structure appears watertight and in good repair. Look for any noticeable watermarks inside the unit or any wet mail.

- k. Note any other conditions that require attention. Also, look for signs of vandalism such as pry marks on doors and locks.
4. Record the results of the inspection on the checklist.
5. Submit the completed PS Form 1624 for each unit reviewed to the maintenance office responsible for centralized delivery equipment installation or repair in the area.

Carriers must note equipment deficiencies and report them to the postmaster, supervisor, or designee. The postmaster, supervisor, or designee must then submit PS Form 1624 to report the equipment defects. In addition, carriers must complete PS Form 1767, *Report of Hazard, Unsafe Condition, or Practice*, for items that pose an immediate threat to safety, such as an improperly secured or leaning NDCBU/CBU. The postmaster or supervisor must immediately notify (by telephone) the office responsible for repair of reported hazards. The postmaster or supervisor must follow up to ensure that the work is satisfactorily completed and documented. The office responsible for repair must use its local buying authority to accomplish the repairs.

In January 1999, the Postal Service announced that NDCBUs cannot be installed for delivery of mail beginning in FY 2000. As previously stated, the Postal Service does not grant waivers for this policy. Place all orders for CBUs and OPLs against the national contracts. Use eBuy+ to place all orders.

For graffiti on mailboxes, there is a new soy-based cleaner available through eBuy+ or the MDC identified as “Cleaner, Graffiti Remover, Collection Box.” To order, use PSN: 7930-13-000-4764; the cost is \$17.41 per 22 oz. bottle.

This product successfully removes graffiti from collection boxes. While most effective on the most current collection boxes, this cleaner may still prove effective with any legacy equipment that has a good quality paint coating. For

older collection boxes, test the product in an inconspicuous spot to ensure it does not damage the current paint coating.

Postmasters may also find it helpful to alert the media to locations of particularly interesting mailboxes in their delivery area.

Motorized city, rural, and contract delivery service route carriers must cooperate to ensure the success of this endeavor, and later report the results to the postmaster. In addition, postmasters must use the most up-to-date list of manufacturers and mailbox suppliers when providing motorized city, rural, and contract delivery service route customers with information about the type of box to install.

Mailbox Improvement Week Arrives in Time for Spring Cleaning

DMM Revision: Parcel Select Permit Imprint Minimum Volumes

Effective June 20, 2021, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)*, section 604.5.1.2, to clarify the minimum volume standards for Parcel Select® destination entry mailings.

Currently, section 253.4.1.2 states that a Parcel Select destination entry mailing must contain 50 or more pieces that are eligible for and claimed at any Parcel Select destination entry price. Section 604.5.1.2 states that permit imprint mailings must contain at least 200 pieces or 50 pounds of mail.

The Postal Service is revising 604.5.1.2f to include an exception for Parcel Select destination entry mailings to the permit imprint minimum volume requirement of 200 pieces or 50 pounds.

Although this revision will not be published in the DMM until June 20, 2021, the standard is effective immediately.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international Postal Service money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - When there is discoloration around the dollar amounts, this might indicate the amounts were changed.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at usps.com/shop/money-orders.htm.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals, including in their raw, unmanufactured state, are prohibited. Official Mail shipments are exempt from this restriction.

B. Other than for PMEMS and the exceptions listed below, a customs declaration PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more, and for all items (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from this ZIP Code. Other than the exceptions listed below, all PMEMS mailpieces (regardless of mail contents or weight) addressed to or from this ZIP Code must bear a properly completed PS Form 2976-B. The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply to known mailers, who for this purpose are defined as follows:

- Business mailers who enter volume mailings through business mail entry units or other bulk mail acceptance locations, pay postage through advance deposit accounts, use permit imprints for postage payment, and submit completed postage statements at the time of entry that certify that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations. Such business mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters and printed matter.
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail." Such agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation, except for any items addressed to an MPO or DPO to which restriction "B2" applies.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this MPO or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products, including tobacco leaves, chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, and cigars are prohibited, including those that are authorized in Publication 52 under PACT.

C1. Obscene and horror articles, images, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, comic books, etc., are prohibited.

C2. E-cigarettes and related products (e.g., nicotine liquids, e-liquids, parts, or supplies) are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as Official Mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Mailers are responsible to ensure that all medicines and vaccines conform to host nation laws.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic, or sexual items are prohibited. Non-authorized political materials are prohibited. Religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, but individual items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless/cellular telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited, except firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed from this MPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms do not require an ATF form.

F1. Weapons of any type are prohibited.

F2. Mailing firearms to or from this MPO ZIP Code is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

F3. Replica weapons and inert explosive devices (such as grenades) and weapons parts are prohibited.

G. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, and wool samples whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Reserved for future use.

U. Mail addressed to Retirees (Box R) is limited to 16 ounces and up to a 90-day supply of TRICARE medications. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail items, including audio and video media, weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to Official Mail.

U2. Retirees (Box R) are not authorized mail service.

U3. Reserved for future use.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 lbs.

V. PMEMS is not available.

What to Expect During a Water Quality Site Visit

Rainfall and melting snow from paved streets, parking lots, and building rooftops runs off these non-porous surfaces into culverts, ditches, drains, and other conveyances, ultimately leading to waterways. This stormwater (or runoff) contains pollutants that can harm rivers, streams, lakes, and coastal waters.

Compliance Requirements and Policy

The United States Postal Service® (USPS®) has a Zero Discharge policy for stormwater. This means no pollutants (i.e., oil and grease, soaps, metals, acids/bases, or other chemicals) will be released or discharged into stormwater systems, by USPS or by USPS third-party contractors.

Under federal law, USPS vehicle maintenance facilities and other USPS sites with fueling operations are typically required to obtain a stormwater permit or, if eligible, apply for a special exclusion from permit requirements. Additionally, USPS sites are required to follow all applicable federal, state, and local regulations for herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers. Certain USPS facilities that store oil or fuel in bulk, such as storage tanks and large drums, are further subject to federal regulations on spill prevention and planning.

Current Water Quality Compliance Support

In response to federal regulatory requirements, the USPS Office of Sustainability (OoS) has developed a standardized national approach for water quality regulatory compliance. This includes targeted site visits at regulated facilities to review compliance with water quality environmental laws and gather information necessary to develop and update required permits or plans. Water quality site reviews include visual inspections of:

- Storage tanks,
- Drums,
- Kitchen grease collection containers and systems,
- Waste receptacles,
- Materials and equipment stored outside,
- Fueling operations,
- Vehicle washing areas,
- Spill response supplies, and
- Drainage systems.

The OoS maintains a listing of sites identified for water quality support (and other types of compliance support) for FY 2021 at blue.usps.gov/sustainability/environmental/planned-comp-support.htm.

The water quality support process may be conducted by professionals on the OoS East or West Regional Field Support teams or by an approved OoS Environmental Management Professional and Technical Support Services supplier.

Site visits follow a standard process:

- **Virtual (Zoom) entrance meeting.** The OoS will host a virtual meeting with facility personnel to discuss the purpose of the site visit and the data collection process.
- **Self-certification/Data collection form.** The site is expected to complete the form, which will provide information about equipment and operations at that location.
- **Site visit.** Site visits are limited to areas addressed in required permits and plans to minimize onsite time as well as interactions during the pandemic. The OoS will take photos to document material storage, stormwater drainage systems, and potential compliance issues. The OoS will also review records, including documents related to training, inspection and testing, and spill response.
- **Virtual (Zoom) follow-up meeting.** The OoS will host a follow-up meeting with facility personnel to discuss items identified during the site visit and to present draft versions of required permits and implementation plans. The OoS will also communicate the site's ongoing compliance responsibilities, including conducting regular visual inspections, completing records and self-certifications, ensuring employees complete required training, and adhering to site-specific permit conditions.
- **Permit documents and plans.** The OoS will submit the required permits to the regulatory agency on behalf of the facility once the appropriate signatures have been obtained, and will forward final copies to the site via email. The OoS will also mail hard copies of implementation plans, which detail ongoing site-level compliance responsibilities.

On the Nose: Learn about Allergies and Asthma

Allergy and Asthma Awareness Month is recognized each May, which is the peak season for people who have these conditions. Allergies are your body's immune reactions to foreign substances — allergens — that are typically harmless for most people.

Common allergens include:

- Pollen,

Food allergies, including those linked to milk, eggs, fish, and tree nuts, are also common.

Symptoms include a runny nose, sneezing, watery eyes, breathing problems, itching, and swelling. Some allergies can even be life-threatening.

Asthma is a type of allergic reaction and a chronic condition that affects the lungs. While the exact cause of asthma is unknown, genetic, environmental, and occupational factors have been linked to developing asthma.

Allergies and asthma affect people of all ages. They often exist together, and the likelihood for occurrence runs in families.

Allergies are diagnosed by skin and blood tests, and treated with medication, allergy shots, and avoiding substances that cause reactions. Asthma is diagnosed by reviewing medical history, allergies, and pulmonary diagnostic tests.

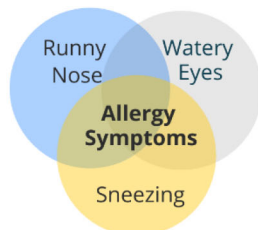

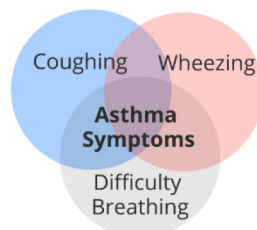
Allergies are your body's immune reactions to foreign substances (allergens) that are typically harmless for most people.

Food Allergies are an adverse immune system reaction that occurs after exposure to certain foods. Symptoms generally develop within minutes or up to two hours after a person has consumed foods to which they are allergic.

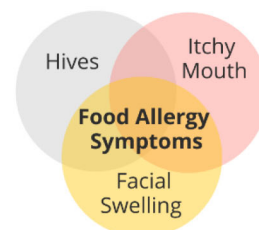
DID YOU KNOW?



Common allergens include pollen, dust mites, pet dander, mold, food, medication, and venom from insect stings and bites.



Asthma can often be affected by stress, infections, poor air quality, very cold air, medicine, tobacco smoke, and food.



The eight leading causes of food allergies are: milk, eggs, fish, shellfish, tree nuts, peanuts, wheat, and soybeans.

Treatment for these conditions vary and may be revised over time based on changes in your life. After being diagnosed, work with your doctor to create an action plan to manage symptoms and adjust your treatment.

Watch Out for Phishing

Firewalls, encryption, and intrusion detection systems are all ways that USPS® protects the network and information vital to delivering 43 percent of the world's mail. However, despite all the cutting-edge defensive technology, it still isn't the best way to protect the organization from a phishing attack.

USPS employees and contractors are the best defense against a phishing cyberattack. Since the average office employee receives a daily volume of almost 100 emails, knowing how to identify a phishing email is important. Use these tips to help protect the USPS network:

- **Slow down.** Pause and evaluate messages before acting. Be wary of "urgent" requests.
- **Verify sender.** If the email is from an "[EXTERNAL]" address, proceed with caution.
- **Hover, don't click.** Ensure all hyperlinked descriptions match their destination by hovering your mouse over the link.

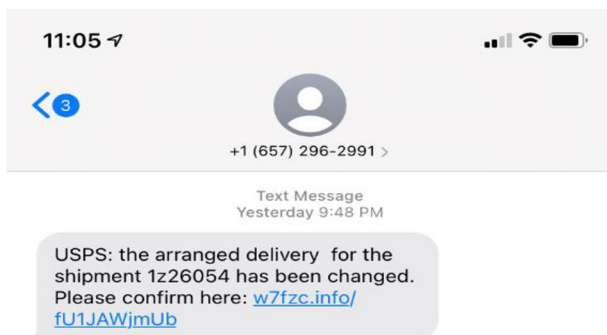
What is Smishing?

By now, most Postal Service™ employees are familiar with phishing scams; however, a new scheme called "smishing" can also put sensitive information at risk.

Smishing is a phishing attack delivered through text message that contains a fraudulent link or attachment. Smishing is particularly threatening because people are more inclined to trust a text message than an email.

Often, smishing attacks are delivered from spoofed phone numbers, meaning the original sender's number is changed to display messages from false identities.

There have been recent reports of smishing attempts on USPS-issued devices — particularly targeting the executive leadership team. These attacks are delivered from unknown senders and contain misleading texts regarding a USPS® parcel and a fraudulent link, as shown here:



- **Beware of attachments.** Don't open or click on anything attached to a suspicious email.
- **Spell check.** Spelling and grammar mistakes can indicate a phishing attempt.

If you think you've received a suspicious email, report it. Select the suspicious email in your inbox — multiple messages can be selected, if needed — and click the "Report to CyberSafe" button found in the Outlook toolbar. If the email is already open, the button will appear in the email toolbar as well.

If you do not see the "Report to CyberSafe" button on your Outlook toolbar, install the add-on at usps.servicenowservices.com/kb_view.do?sysparm_article=KB0046151.

Avoid smishing scams and keep the USPS network secure by following these tips:

- **If in doubt, do not click.** Do not open any link or attachment from a phone number you don't have saved in your contacts list or if you cannot verify the sender.
- **Filter messages.** Filtering unknown senders will block notifications from unsaved phone numbers, decreasing the likelihood of falling for a smishing scam. To filter unknown numbers:
 - **Apple users:** Go to Settings > Messages and toggle on the "Filter Unknown Senders" option. This will create an "Unknown Senders" tab in your Messages app.
 - **Android users:** Go to Settings > Spam Message Settings and select the "Block Unknown Senders" option.

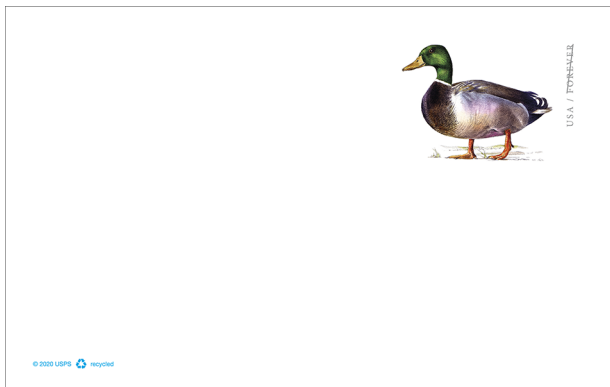

On June 1, 2021, in Fargo, ND, the United States Postal Service® will issue the *Mallard Forever*® stamped card priced at 40 cents (36-cent postage plus 4-cent surcharge) in one design. These stamped cards will go on sale nationwide June 1, 2021, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

The Postal Service™ issues a new stamped card for 2021 featuring an illustration of a mallard drake (*Anas platyrhynchos*) from pre-existing artwork by famed illustrator and designer Dugald Stermer (1936–2011). The full-body, left-facing profile was created in pencil and watercolor. Art director Ethel Kessler designed the stamped card.

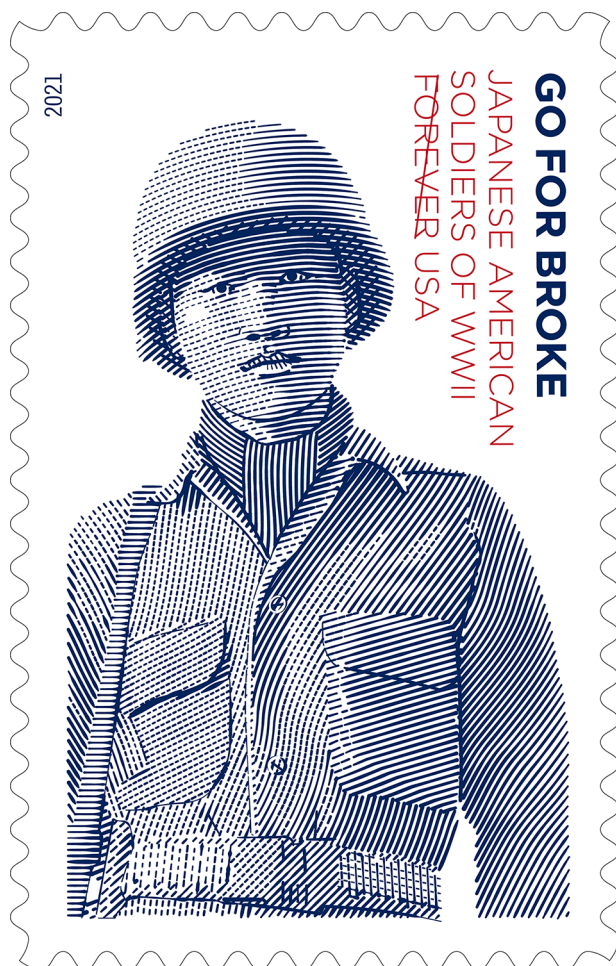

Stamp Announcement 21-14: Go for Broke: Japanese American Soldiers of WWII Stamp

On June 3, 2021, in Los Angeles, CA, the United States Postal Service® will issue the *Go for Broke: Japanese American Soldiers of WWII* stamp (Forever® priced at the First-Class Mail® rate) in one design, in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 480500). This stamp will go on sale nationwide June 3, 2021, and must not be sold or canceled before the first-day-of-issue.

With this commemorative stamp issuance, the Postal Service™ recognizes the contributions of Japanese American soldiers, some 33,000 altogether, who served in the U.S. Army during World War II. The stamp, made to resemble an engraving, was printed in the intaglio print method. The image is based on a photograph taken in 1944, in France, of a member of the 442nd Regimental Combat Team, whose motto was “Go for Broke.” The stamp was designed by art director Antonio Alcalá.

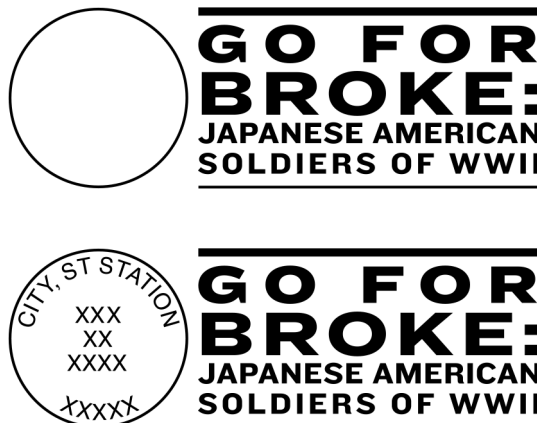

The word “Station” or the abbreviation “STA” is required somewhere in the design because it will be a temporary station. Use of any image other than the following special pictorial image is prohibited.

Guidelines for Finalizing Go for Broke: Japanese American Soldiers of WWII Stamps Pictorial Postmark Art



To finalize the *Go for Broke: Japanese American Soldiers of WWII* stamp pictorial postmark art, insert the date, city, state, and ZIP Code™ of the physical location of your event adjacent to the stamp image. Overall dimensions of the pictorial postmark must not exceed 4 inches (horizontally) by 2 inches (vertically). Collectors prefer the dimensions 3-1/2 inches by 1 inch.

The Postal Service must make all special postmarks known to collectors through advance publicity in the *Postal Bulletin*. Therefore, all special dedication cancellations must be reported to Stamp Services 4 weeks before the event using PS Form 413, *Pictorial Postmark Announcement/Report*. Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears on the following pages. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark must affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed next to the postmark.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

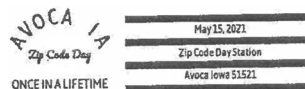

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 120 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. Each cover must have sufficient postage to meet First-Class Mail® requirements. Customers may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by phone at 800-782-6724, or on The Postal Store® website at usps.com/shop.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service™ recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16-inch side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2 inches (vertically) by 4 inches (horizontally). Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers must submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers must affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of

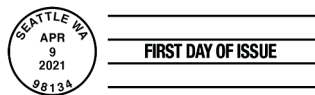

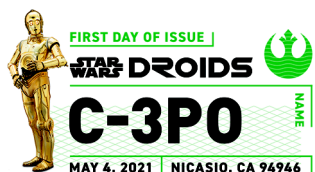
