

## MESSAGE FROM THE POSTMASTER GENERAL

### Policy Statement on Firearms in the Workplace

It is the policy of the United States Postal Service to provide a safe, secure, and violence-free workplace for all of our employees and customers. Violence in the workplace has developed over the last decade into a significant societal problem. These seemingly relentless episodes have indiscriminately plagued workplaces large and small throughout the country. We can take little solace in the fact that our workplace has been determined by the Centers for Disease Control to be two and one-half times safer from violence precipitated homicides than other workplaces nationwide, when we are still confronted by intolerable acts such as that which occurred in California on July 9.

The Postal Service is unequivocal in its pronounced opposition to all forms of violent behavior including those involving firearms. Accordingly, it is well established that postal policy and federal law prohibit the possession of a firearm within postal installations. In order to ensure the effective and uniform application of that prohibition, the bringing, storing or in any way possessing of a firearm within postal installations is cause for immediate removal from postal employment without regard to past record or other elements of progressive discipline. This applies to all bargaining unit employees and supervisors and managers alike with the obvious exceptions of Postal Inspectors and uniformed postal police officers.

### Disposal of Post Office Box Fronts

Do not ship 700-, 1300-, or 1500-series post office box fronts to the Mail Equipment Shops for disposal. Dispose of these post office box fronts following instructions in Handbook AS-701, *Material Management*, Section 746.5. Direct questions concerning normal disposal procedures to your local manager of Purchasing and Materials Service Center.

### Requisitioning Post Office Box Keys

Use Form 3915, *Post Office Box Key Requisition*, December 1992 or June 1994 editions, to order keys from the Mail Equipment Shops (MES). These editions have a peel-off label that post offices complete for returning shipments to ordering offices. This process reduces MES shipping costs.

Dispose of all previous editions and order the December 1992 and June 1994 editions from your material distribution center.

### Highway Contract Route Box Delivery Service

In accordance with Handbook PO-504, *Highway Contract Routes Box Delivery Service*, section 134.27, administrative officials must conduct surveys of contract box delivery routes each fall by riding the routes with the contractors and performing a 1-week count of mail during the survey period of September through October.

Administrative officials receive guidelines concerning the surveys and mail count from the manager of Transportation Purchasing located at the applicable Distribution Network office. That individual must approve in advance any variation in inspection method or date.

Administrative officials must complete Form 5406, *Box Delivery Contract Route Survey*, along with the Route Data Volume Count form provided by the transportation contracting officer. Once complete, both forms must be forwarded to the manager of Transportation Purchasing by November 15, 1995.

## DMM NOTICE

### Revisions to Certain Priority Mail Rates

Effective Sunday, August 27, 1995, 12:01 a.m., *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) R100.10.0 is amended as shown below to implement revised Priority Mail rates adopted on July 31, 1995, by the Governors of the Postal Service.

On March 8, 1994, pursuant to 39 U.S.C. 3622, the Postal Service had filed a request with the Postal Rate Commission (PRC) for a recommended decision on increased fees and postage rates for its domestic mail services; that filing was docketed as R94-1. The PRC issued a recommended decision on November 30, 1994, that was allowed under protest by the Governors of the Postal Service on December 12, 1994, and implemented on January 1, 1995.

Subsequently, the Postal Service filed a request for reconsideration that, among other items, sought reconsideration of the rates for Priority Mail that had been recommended by the PRC and adopted and implemented by the Postal Service. After reconsidering the record of R94-1, the PRC issued a further recommended decision on June 7, 1995, that recommended changes in certain of the Priority Mail rates recommended and implemented earlier. As stated above, the Governors of the Postal Service accepted the PRC's further recommended decision and

the Board of Governors set August 27, 1995, for its implementation.

The rates for single-piece Priority Mail and Presorted Priority Mail are changed as follows:

**Local zone and zones 1, 2, and 3:** 10 pounds

- Single-piece rate changes from \$7.85 to \$7.80.
- Presorted rate changes from \$7.74 to \$7.69.

**Zone 4:** 7 through 70 pounds

- Single-piece rates change from \$7.80 through \$49.00 to \$7.50 through \$47.65, respectively.
- Presorted rates change from \$7.69 through \$48.89 to \$7.39 through \$47.54, respectively.

**Zone 5:** 8 through 14 pounds

- Single-piece rates change from \$9.05 through \$13.65 to \$9.00 through \$13.60, respectively.
- Presorted rates change from \$8.94 through \$13.54 to \$8.89 through \$13.49, respectively.

These revised rates are indicated by bold type in the following two tables. All other Priority Mail rates revised effective January 1, 1995, remain unchanged. Revised DMM Exhibits R100.10.0a and R100.10.0b will be included in DMM Issue 49.

### Oldest Usable Edition of Certified Mail Labels

Postmasters must check their stock of Forms 3800, *Receipt for Certified Mail (Label)*, to make sure that all editions older than the April 1995 edition are discarded. If the April 1995 edition of the certified label is not in stock at that facility, postmasters should order no more than a two-month supply of new Forms 3800 from the material distribution centers (MDCs) and destroy all previous editions when the April 1995 version is received. Old stock must not be returned to the MDCs.

The April 1995 edition of Form 3800 contains an area that fluoresces under long-wave, ultraviolet (black) light for detection by certified mail detectors installed on carrier sequence barcode sorters and delivery barcode sorters. This change allows certified mail to be segregated from the rest of the mail processed on automated equipment.

Certified mail detectors will be fully deployed on all automated equipment by the spring of 1996. For this reason, it is important that only the latest edition of Form 3800 be stocked at post offices and made available to customers.

As further information, the practice of handwriting the certified mail number next to a rubber stamped certified endorsement on the article was discontinued January 6, 1994. Postmasters were instructed in *Postal Bulletin* 21858, January 6, 1994, to no longer issue blocks of six-digit numbers for certified mail and to ask customers still endorsing certified mail with a rubber stamp to use the postal-provided forms. With the deployment of the certified mail detectors, it is necessary that postmasters make sure that certified mail entered at their facilities is properly labeled.

If customers do not want to use postal-provided labels, they may privately print certified mail labels if they are nearly identical in design and color to postal-provided labels. Specifications for privately printed certified mail labels, including specifications for the fluorescent taggant, were published in *Postal Bulletin* 21893, May 11, 1995.

### Oldest Usable Edition of Domestic Return Receipts

Postmasters must check their stock of Forms 3811, *Domestic Return Receipt*, to make sure that all editions older than the December 1994 edition are discarded. If the December 1994 edition of the return receipt is not in stock at that facility, postmasters should order no more than a two-month supply of new Forms 3811 from the material distribution centers (MDCs) and destroy all previous editions when the December 1994 version is received. Old stock must not be returned to the MDCs.

The return receipt was modified in December 1994 to add a barcode clear zone, to replace the standard penalty indicia with the penalty permit imprint indicia, and to

change the color to a lighter shade of green to enhance the optical read rate on postal automation equipment. In addition, a block was added for recipients of articles with return receipt service to print their names next to their signatures.

If customers do not want to use postal-provided return receipts, they may privately print forms if they are nearly identical in design and color to postal-provided return receipts. Specifications for privately printed return receipts were published in *Postal Bulletin* 21893, May 11, 1995.

The accountbooks and statements of account forms will not be revised for FY 1996.

## Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 95-16

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

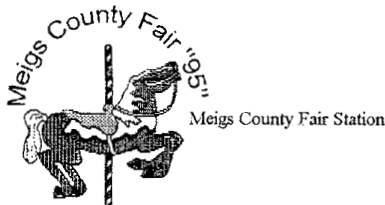
All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail post-

age (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 Code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

## Jazz Musicians Commemorative Stamps

The Postal Service honors Jazz Musicians with the issuance of ten 32-cent commemorative stamps (Item 4471), in a pane of 20, on September 16, in Monterey, California, at the Monterey Jazz Festival. The stamps, designed by Dean Mitchell of Overland Park, Kansas, and Thomas Blackshear of Colorado Springs, Colorado, feature pianists Eubie Blake, Jelly Roll Morton, James P. Johnson, Erroll Garner, and Thelonious Monk; saxophonists Coleman Hawkins, Charlie Parker, and John Coltrane; cornetist Louis Armstrong; and bassist Charles Mingus.

James Hubert "Eubie" Blake, born in 1883, the son of former slaves, studied organ and music theory as a child. In his twenties he became a successful songwriter with his partner, band leader Noble Sissle, and together they wrote the hit Broadway show "Shuffle Along" in 1921. At 95, Blake told an interviewer he had written a couple of thousand pieces, but only about 350 had ever been published.

Jelly Roll Morton was born Ferdinand LaMenthe Morton in 1890. A professional pianist from the age of twelve, Morton left his home in New Orleans and went on the road playing ragtime in Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and Florida. Among Morton's more than 150 jazz classics are "King Porter Stomp," "Kansas City Stomp," and "Dead Man Blues."

James P. Johnson, born in 1894, is credited as the "father of stride piano." Johnson approached the keyboard with powerful, recurrent, octave-spanning, left-hand innovations and rhythmic and harmonic intensities that became acknowledged influences on many of the jazz performers who followed him. Johnson wrote his first major Broadway musical, "Runnin' Wild," in 1923.

Erroll Garner, born in 1921, composed more than 200 works without ever learning to read or annotate music. He began playing by ear at the age of three and throughout his life could perform any piece of music he had heard once. "Misty," which became the title song of the 1971 Clint Eastwood film "Play Misty For Me," was Garner's best-known composition. He also wrote the often-recorded "La Petite Mambo," "Dreamy," "Solitaire," and "Nightwind." His album "Concert by the Sea" is regarded as a landmark work and is one of the best-selling jazz albums of all time.

Thelonious Sphere Monk Jr. was born in 1917. He was a brilliantly unorthodox pianist and composer who was venerated and studied by musicians years before he was accepted by the public. His audacious musical ideas, dissonant chords, and haunting melodies were unprecedented. He wrote his most famous composition, "Round Midnight," while with trumpeter Cootie Williams' band.

Coleman Hawkins, born in 1904, was the first artist to move the tenor saxophone from the reed section to the status of a solo instrument in jazz. Hawkins first emerged as a composer while playing in the Fletcher Henderson Orchestra. From 1934 to 1939, he toured England and Europe freelancing and appearing as guest star with prestigious groups. In New York on October 11, 1939, at the first session on his return to the United States, he cut the record that was to be his life-long definitive performance, "Body and Soul."

Charlie Parker Jr. was born in 1920. An alto saxophonist and composer, Charles Parker, Jr., variously called "Charlie," "Bird," and "Yardbird," was an undisputed genius

who, with colleagues trumpeter Dizzy Gillespie, pianist Thelonious Monk, and drummer Kenny Clarke, led jazz in new directions with the creation of bebop. At 15, with 2 years' professional experience, he quit school for a full-time career as a musician. He played with leaders Jay McShann, Earl Hines, Billy Eckstine, and Dizzy Gillespie.

John Coltrane was born in 1926. Coltrane blew the tenor saxophone to new thresholds of intensity and rescued the soprano saxophone from obscurity. He initially won notice as a romantic interpreter of ballads, moving rapidly forward into explorations of complex harmonics and unprecedented improvisation extensions. Still regarded by many as a musical messiah, Coltrane's most revered compositions include "A Love Supreme," "Giant Steps," "Moment's Notice," and "Equinox."

Louis Armstrong, born in 1901, learned to play the cornet and bugle at the Waif's Home in New Orleans. At 17, he joined Edward "Kid" Ory's New Orleans band, replacing his mentor Joseph "King" Oliver. Four years later, he joined Oliver's group in Chicago. A series of recordings with Oliver's band resulted in such pieces as "Chimes Blues" and "Dippermouth Blues." Armstrong later played with Fletcher Henderson's orchestra and in 1925 led a recording band, The Hot Five. With his deep range and raspy vocal quality, Armstrong switched from trumpet to voice in such classics as "Ain't Misbehavin'," "Blueberry Hill," "What a Wonderful World," and "Hello Dolly."

Charles Mingus Jr., born 1922, was a jazz composer, pianist, and bassist. As a bassist, he developed a strong, unmistakable identity, melding counter melodies and inner harmonies. But his lasting legacy was as a composer. In the early 60s, Mingus composed "The Black Saint and the Sinner Lady" and "Meditations on Integration." He composed over 300 works and left the largest body of jazz composition after Duke Ellington. His original scores are housed in the Library of Congress, along with Mozart's and Beethoven's.

The Jazz Musicians stamps, which go on sale nationwide September 18, are the last addition this year to the Postal Service's Legends of American Music Stamp series. This series began in 1993 and will run for several years, featuring all generations of American music, including folk, classical, and gospel.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service returns the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by October 16, 1995.

The Philatelic Fulfillment Service Center also offers first day covers for new stamp issues and postal stationery items postmarked with the official first day of issue cancellation. First day covers remain on sale for at least 90 days after the stamp's issuance.

**Distribution**

All stamp distribution offices (SDOs) will receive one-half their standard automatic distribution quantities for 20-stamps-per-pane commemorative stamps, rounded to the nearest master carton size (70,000 stamps).

SDOs and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will make shipments to post offices for half their standard automatic distribution for 20-stamps-per-pane, using Forms 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*. SDOs must not distribute stamps to post offices before September 7.

**Philatelic Requirements**

All SDOs and SDNs with authorized philatelic centers will receive automatic distributions of these stamps in the

**Additional Supply**

Each accountable paper depository (APD) and SDN will receive limited quantities of stamps for filling supplemental orders. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from their APD, using a separate Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. All other post offices requiring additional stamps should requisition them from their designated SDO on a separate Form 17, or designated SDN on a separate Form 17-S, *Stamp Distribution Network Stamp Requisition*.

**Sales Policy**

These stamps should be available at regular service windows until they are officially removed from sale, generally 1 year from date of issue. All post offices must initially acquire at least a 60-day supply of each new commemorative stamp before the sale date and have the stamps available at all service windows on the sale date. *If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.*

The 32-cent Women’s Suffrage Commemorative Stamp goes on sale August 26 nationwide. This stamp recognizes the contributions of the women’s suffrage movement and the landmark ratification of the 19th amendment (women’s right to vote) to the U.S. Constitution.

All stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive one-half their standard automatic distribution quantities for a 40-stamp per pane rounded to the nearest master carton lot size of 100,000.

SDOs and SDNs will ship to post offices half their standard automatic distribution quantity, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before August 17.

make a subsequent automatic distribution to post offices using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before August 24.

Advices of Shipments will state the quantity of panes shipped, not the number of stamps shipped. When ordering additional stock, quantities must be designated in panes.
