Health Benefits Open Season

The 1995 Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Open Season is scheduled from November 13 through December 11, 1995, according to the Office of Personnel Management (OPM). Enrollment changes and new enrollments made during the 1995 open season are effective January 6, 1996 (Pay Period 02-96).

Distribution of Open Season Materials

Employees. Career employees will receive a direct mailing of the *1996 FEHB Guide*, RI 70-2, which contains a comparison of biweekly premium costs of participating plans, an explanation of the pretax payment feature, and the results of an FEHB Customer Satisfaction Survey.

Installations. Some of the required materials will be distributed automatically by Headquarters and OPM, while the personnel services offices must requisition others. All customer service and sales district offices, processing and distribution centers, airport mail centers, bulk mail centers, and selected Headquarters field units will obtain open season materials in the following manner:

Automatic Distribution:

- RI 70-2, *1996 FEHB Guide* (Postal employees).
- RI 70-5, *1996 FEHB Guide* (Temporary continuation of coverage and coverage under the spouse equity law or similar statutes providing coverage to former spouses).
- Fee-for-service plan brochures, except NAPUS and Rural Carrier closed plans.

Requisition from the Material Distribution Centers (MDCs):

- RI 70-8, *1996 FEHB Guide* (Certain Temporary Employees — Those eligible to enroll in FEHB under 5 U.S.C. 8906a).

- SF 2809, *Health Benefits Registration Form* (August 1992 edition only).
- Plan brochures for closed enrollment fee-for-service plans (NAPUS, RI 72-3, and *Rural Carriers*, RI 72-5).

Additional Information

In past years, a special *Postal Bulletin* has been issued to address open season administrative issues in more detail. This year, additional administrative and processing information will still be provided to postal installations as a separate document, but it will not be issued as a *Postal Bulletin*. Publication 12, *Health Benefits Open Season Administrative and Processing Information* (November 1995) (NSN 7610-03-000-5937), will be distributed to the same postal facilities that receive the *Postal Bulletin*; however, additional copies may be requisitioned from the MDCs after November 1. Publication 12 will be published on October 19, 1995, and will contain:

- Information on distribution of open season materials.
- Eligibility requirements for coverage.
- A list of participating health plans and their premium rates.
- A list of health maintenance organization contacts.
- A list of FEHB health plan withdrawals and other changes.
- Additional instructions pertaining to open season administration.

ALL IRT, WRU, CTT, AND DEBIT AND CREDIT CARD OFFICES

Setting Clocks for Standard Time

The correct system time in integrated retail terminals (IRTs) and weighing and rating units (WRUs) is critical because their internal clocks are used to verify Express Mail acceptance times, service commitments, and network status. The IRT system time is also printed on customer receipts and employee reports. Computerized Tracking and Tracing (CTT) scanner clocks are used to record Express Mail arrival times. It is very important that the Credit Card Terminals clock be set to the correct day, date, and time as this will help reduce the possibility of accepting an expired card.

Managers must ensure that before opening for business on Monday, October 30, 1995, the clocks in all IRTs, WRUs, CTT scanners, and Debit and Credit Card Terminals under their control are set *back* 1 hour to reflect the change (in most locations) to Standard Time. Facilities with Saturday night operations should reset the time as soon as possible after the 2 a.m. Sunday start time.

On the UNISYS III Supervisor Disk, select menu item 11, Set System Date and Time, from the Control Menu. On the UNISYS II Supervisor Disk, select item 10, Set System Date and Time. On the MOS IRT Control Disk, select menu item 5, Change Fees and Tables, from the Main Menu, then select item 5, Set Unit Date and Time, from the Change Fees and Tables Menu.

Laser Scanner

For a laser scanner, follow these steps:

1. Press the control (CTRL) key and the T key. The current date and time appear.
2. Press the clear (CLR) key. A prompt to enter a date appears. Enter the current date as MMDDYY (Example: 103095).
3. Press the Enter key. The scanner then prompts the user to enter the time. Enter correct standard time in military format (Examples: 8 AM = 0800, 1:30 PM = 1330).
4. Press the Enter key. The scanner returns to the first screen.
5. Press the CTRL key and the T key to verify the time and date.
6. Press the Enter key if correct; if not, reenter correct information.

WRU Clocks

For the WRU, follow these steps:

1. Select item 2, Change System Data, from the Maintenance Menu.
2. Select item 1, Change System Date and Time, from the Change System Data Menu. The Set System Date and Time screen appears.

3. Press the Yes key to accept the current date. The time appears. Press No to clear the time.
4. Enter correct standard time in military format (Examples: 8 AM = 0800, 1:30 PM = 1330).
5. Press Yes to save the corrected time. The Change System Data Menu appears.
6. Verify the time and date and correct any errors.

Debit and Credit Card Terminals

For Debit and Credit Card Terminals, follow these steps:

Display	Action
U.S. Postal Service	Press the asterisk (*) key and the 3 key at the same time (if you are having trouble, simply hold the * key and tap the 3 key).
Diagnostics	Press the Alpha key.
Year	Key in the current year. Press the Enter key.
Month	Key in a number (1 through 12) for Current Month. Press the Enter key.
Date	Key in a number (1 through 31) for Current Date. Press the Enter key.
Hour	Key in a number (1 through 24) for Current Hour. Press the Enter key.
Minutes	Key in Number of Minutes (0 through 59). Press the Enter key.
Seconds	Key in Number of Seconds (0 through 60) or press the Enter key to bypass.

You must make an entry for each selection even if the display is correct. To verify the existing date and time of the clock in the terminal, follow the steps below:

Display	Action
U.S. Postal Service	Press the Enter key
Function	Press the 4 key
Day, Date, Time	Press the Clear key
Exit	Press the Clear key
U.S. Postal Service	

Retail Consolidation Unit (RCU)

Also enter the correct time into each RCU system. RCU operators must perform a system shutdown on Monday morning, October 30, 1995. Reboot the system and enter the correct date and time.

DMM REVISION

Delivery Statistics

Effective immediately, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) A930.5.0 is revised to include all post offices with rural delivery, highway contract box delivery, and post office box delivery, not just offices without city delivery service. This revision changes the term “boxholders” to “post office boxes rented” and adds seasonal route data when applicable to route delivery information. The term “highway contract box delivery route” replaces the more general term “highway contract route,” which can refer to a transportation route, a box delivery route, or a combination route. This revision will appear in DMM Issue 50.

5.0 DELIVERY STATISTICS

In post offices with rural delivery, highway contract box delivery, and post office box delivery, postmasters must provide, at no charge, the following information for their respective offices:

- a. Number of post office boxes rented.
- b. Route numbers, number of boxes, and number of families on each rural and highway contract box delivery route (including seasonal data, if applicable).
- c. Number of families served or number of business places served by rural or highway contract box delivery routes within the total delivery area.

Disposal of Postal Service capital property follows the normal disposal process described in Chapter 7, Asset Recovery: Redistribution, Recycling, and Disposal. The key difference in the process for capital property is forwarding Form 969, *Material Recycling and Disposal*, to the St. Louis ASC. Additionally, a copy of the Form 969 is sent by the MAO to the finance or accounting office, showing the undepreciated balance. Any undepreciated value on a disposed item is immediately charged to the installation's expense budget as soon as the St. Louis ASC processes the Form 969.

675.2 Verification Procedure

Verify the ACPL with subcustody records and resolve any discrepancies. All information on the ACPL should be identical to the local records and files. Research and resolve so that both the St. Louis ASC and the property records are the same. An incorrect record at any activity most likely means a corresponding incorrect record at another activity. The proper way to correct errors is to process the correct document, rather than adding or deleting the record using a Form 2880, *Physical Inventory Certification/Adjustments*. Form 2880 is a tool of last resort. Like a disposal action, any undepreciated value on an item deleted by a Form 2880 is immediately charged to the activity's expense operating budget. This information must be provided to the finance or accounting office prior to processing the Form 2880. All Forms 2880 must be signed by the installation head prior to submission to the St. Louis ASC.

Note: The August 1994 revised version of Form 2880 is the only version of the form that will be accepted for processing by the St. Louis ASC. The new version of the form can be obtained from the Material Distribution Centers. Orders for the new form should be placed as soon as possible to ensure having a supply at the start of FY 1996. Upon receipt of the new version of the form, all copies of the old version should be destroyed.

HANDBOOK F-1 REVISION

International Postal Money Orders

Postal Bulletin 21895, page 38, dated June 8, 1995, stated that all retail clerks should maintain a supply of the pink international money order forms (MP1) and the Authorization to Issue an International Money Order Form set. Due to this requirement, all postal units that sell domestic money orders are now authorized to sell international money orders.

Effective with this Postal Bulletin, it is no longer required to obtain an authorization from the District Manager, Finance, to sell international money orders. Section 544 of Handbook F-1, Post Office Accounting Procedures, is being revised to reflect this change.

Change in PCES Relocation — Miscellaneous Expense Allowance

As of the beginning of fiscal year 1996 (September 16, 1995), the miscellaneous expense allowance for PCES employees who relocate is increased to \$10,000.

In order to be eligible for the increased miscellaneous expense allowance, the employee's PS Form 50, Notice of Personnel Action, must have an effective date of September 16, 1995, or later, and the PS Form 178,

Specific Travel Order — Relocation and Relocation Agreement, must have an effective date later than that of the Form 50. PCES employees who have already claimed their miscellaneous expense allowance are not eligible for the increase.

International Mail — Service Restrictions and Disruptions Update

The following list of suspensions and/or restrictions remains in force and supersedes the list published in *Postal Bulletin* 21898, 7-20-95. The only change is the resumption of surface mail to Kuwait (see *Postal Bulletin* 21901, 8-31-95). Except for Kuwait, this information is included in the *International Mail Manual* (IMM), Issue 15, 7-9-95.

Afghanistan: All mail services are suspended.

Ascension: No air parcel post service.

Cambodia: No small packet or parcel post service. Air and surface mail service is limited to postcards, letters, and/or letter packages not exceeding 2 pounds and to printed matter, including books and publishers' periodicals, not exceeding 4 pounds.

Chad: All surface mail is suspended. Air mail service, including International Priority Airmail (IPA) and Express Mail International Service (EMS), continues.

Cuba: No air or surface parcel post or small packet service. Service is limited to letters in the usual form, braille letters for the blind, postcards, and printed matter sent as air mail, surface mail, IPA, or International Surface Air Lift (ISAL).

Falkland Islands: Air parcel post service is suspended because transportation is not available.

Gabon: Surface mail service resumed on June 1, 1995.

Iraq: Due to U.S. sanctions, mail is restricted to a maximum weight of 12 ounces and may contain only personal communications not involving a transaction of anything of value. Air mail, EMS, and IPA services continue, subject to the content restriction. Surface mail, including ISAL and special services, is not available.

Korea, Democratic People's Republic of (North Korea): No parcel post or small packet service. Air and surface service is limited to letters, postcards, printed matter, and matter for the blind.

Kuwait: Surface mail resumed on August 31, 1995.

Lebanon: All surface mail is suspended. Service is limited to air postcards, letters and/or letter packages, small packets, printed matter, including books and publishers' periodicals not exceeding 4 pounds, and parcel post items up to 11 pounds. IPA and ISAL services continue.

Liberia: All surface mail, including ISAL, is suspended. Air mail, EMS, and IPA services continue.

Libya: ISAL service is suspended because transportation is not available. Air mail, IPA, and regular surface mail services continue.

Mongolia: No surface or air parcel post service.

Rwanda: ISAL service is suspended.

Serbia/Montenegro (Yugoslavia): Due to U.S. sanctions, mail is limited to a maximum weight of 12 ounces and may contain only personal communications not involving a transfer of anything of value, publications, or other informational materials. Air mail, regular surface mail, EMS, and IPA services continue, subject to the content limitations. ISAL service is not available.

Somalia: All mail services are suspended.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 95-20

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail post-

age (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 Code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

STAMP DISTRIBUTION

32-Cent Antique Autos Stamps, Item 4497

The Postal Service will issue five Antique Autos 32-cent commemorative stamps in New York, New York, on November 3. The stamps go on sale nationwide November 4.

All stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive an automatic distribution of their standard distribution for a 25-stamp-per-pane issue, rounded to the nearest master carton size (87,500 stamps). SDOs and SDNs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to post offices, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Ship Invoice*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before October 25. There will not be back-up quantities of this item at the accountable paper depositories or the SDNs.

Philatelic Requirement

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale, generally 1 year from the date of issue. Automatic distribution of commemorative issues is based on a 60-day supply. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.
