GSA FEDSTRIP Requisitions

The General Services Administration (GSA) has advised that some offices are paying for FEDSTRIP orders with no-fee money orders. In many cases GSA has returned payments, and in others they have deposited them and waited for requests for credit. If you have a FED-STRIP number and have not signed up to pay via credit

card, payment is made automatically by the Accounting Service Center when GSA bills the Postal Service. Do not use money orders to pay for FEDSTRIP orders.

DMM REVISION

Miscellaneous Clarifications and Corrections

Effective July 1, 1996, several *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) sections are amended as described below to clarify or correct current mailing standards. These revisions will appear in DMM Issue 51. In the interim, the July *Mailroom Companion* will carry the full text of significant amendments, prepared as replacement pages for inserting into DMM Issue 50. The principal revisions include the following sections:

1. *Reply Pieces Enclosed in Automation Mail.* DMM C810.8.1, E140.1.5, E241.1.2, E641.1.2, and E641.2.4 are revised to clarify that the standards for letter-size reply cards and envelopes enclosed in automation rate mail apply only if those reply pieces are returned to a domestic address.
2. *Carrier Route Coding With Simplified Address.* DMM E140.1.4, E231.2.1, E632.1.4, and E641.2.3 are revised to clarify that mailings prepared with a simplified address under DMM A040 are exempt from the standard for use of CASS-certified software for carrier route coding.
3. *Overflow Tray Use.* DMM M033.2.1j is added to clarify that, as a general exception, an overflow tray is always permitted when the minimum number of pieces required for rate or presort eligibility is available but exceeds the capacity of a 2-foot tray. (For example, if 150 pieces are available for a 5-digit destination but exceed the capacity of a 2-foot tray, an overflow tray may be prepared even if overflow trays are not otherwise permitted.)
4. *Scheme Designation on Tray Label.* DMM M810.2.3c and 3.2a are revised to clarify that, when appropriate, "SCHEME" is replaced on the second line of tray labels with the specific information shown for the corresponding destination in DMM L002, Column B.
5. *Bound Printed Matter.* DMM M630.2.6d is corrected to show that the ADC sortation for bound printed matter is required, not optional as erroneously printed in DMM Issue 50.

Effective January 1, 1997, all letter-size reply cards and envelopes (business reply, courtesy reply, and metered reply mail) provided as enclosures in automation First-Class Mail, automation Regular Periodicals, and automation Regular and Enhanced Carrier Route Standard Mail, and addressed for return to a domestic delivery address, must meet the applicable standards in 1.0 through 7.0, bear a facing identification mark meeting the standards in 8.2, and bear the correct delivery point barcode (or, for business reply mail (BRM), the correct ZIP+4 barcode) for the delivery address on the reply piece as defined by the USPS, subject to the barcode standards in C840. Mailers must certify that these standards have been met when the corresponding mail is presented to the USPS. BRM pieces must also meet the applicable standards in S922.

FINANCE

Customs Collections

All post offices handling customs duty parcels must strictly adhere to procedures in the *International Mail Manual* (IMM), sections 712 and 713, and Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, section 610. The Department of the Treasury, U.S. Customs Service, has indicated that personnel are not following certain established procedures.

The U.S. Customs Service states that the following reporting instructions must be followed:

1. Submit Customs Form 3419, *Customs Mail Entry*, with remittances. Handbook F-1, section 613, covers CAG A–G post offices, and section 614 covers CAG H–L offices. When the Postal Service does not submit these forms, customs must create billings for missing mailing entries.
2. Send remittances to the correct address. Effective October 1, 1995, use the following address:

3. Send reports of uncollected items to the correct

address. Submit the mailing slips, along with Form 2933, *Register of Uncollected Customs Charges*, to:

4. Use Form 2932, *Customs Collections Summary*, with the Pittsburgh address.
5. Submit remittances in a timely manner. Handbook F-1, section 613.2, specifies the reporting schedule for CAG A–G offices, and section 614.1 specifies the schedule for CAG H–L offices.

The automated system at the U.S. Customs Service requires timely remittances with proper documentation. Whenever delays cause mail entries to remain unpaid for 90 days, either for lack of Forms 3419 or lack of timely submissions of collections, unnecessary costly billings occur at customs.

All post offices must report customs collections correctly and in a timely manner to avoid additional processing costs at customs.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 96-14

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*


All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail

postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Iowa Statehood Commemorative Stamp

The Postal Service commemorates the 150th anniversary of the admission of Iowa into the Union with the issuance of a 32-cent stamp, in a pane of 50 (Item 4494) and a self-adhesive convertible booklet of 20 (Item 6662), on August 1, 1996, in Dubuque, Iowa. The stamp and booklet go on sale nationwide August 2.

Designed by Carl Herrman of Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida, the stamp features a rendering of the painting *Young Corn*. The Iowa countryside is shown in carefully composed patterns and warm rich colors that reflect American painter Grant Wood's respect and affection for the American farmer.

Iowa became the 29th state admitted to the Union on December 28, 1846. The state capital, Des Moines, is the largest city and is located in the middle of the state. Iowa is in the north-central part of the United States, covering an area of over 56,000 square miles. The state is bordered by Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois, Missouri, Nebraska, and South Dakota. Iowa's winters are cold, the summers warm and humid. Approximately 90 percent of its total land area is devoted to farming, making Iowa a major agricultural state, as well as a leading state in livestock production.

SDOs and SDNs will make subsequent automatic distributions to post offices, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before July 31, 1996.

Philatelic Requirement

Additional Supply

All accountable paper depositories (APDs), except the Kansas City SDN, will receive 2,800,000 stamps as back-up quantities. The Kansas City SDN will receive 3,430,000. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate APD, using a separate Form 17. All other post offices requiring additional stamps must requisition them from their designated SDO on a separate Form 17, or SDN, using a separate Form 17-S, *Stamp Distribution Network Stamp Requisition*. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from their APD using a separate Form 17.

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale, generally 1 year from the date of issue. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.

Uniform and Work Clothes Program — Bulk Mail Entry Unit Allowance

Postal Bulletin 21922 (6-20-96) contained an incorrect statement about the application of work clothing allowances to the purchase of work garments. The first sentence of the third paragraph should read:

“The eligible employees at the bulk mail entry units may

apply their work clothing allowance only to the purchase of the following certified work clothing garments:”

Equipment Maintenance Allowance Schedules for Rural Routes

In accordance with the provisions of Article 9, Section 2.1.3 of the Rural Carrier National Agreement, effective July 6, 1996 (Pay Period 96-15), the equipment maintenance allowance (EMA) will increase from 35.5 cents per mile to 36.5 cents per mile. The EMA will be 36.5 cents per mile or a minimum of \$14.60 per day, whichever is greater.

Employees providing auxiliary assistance or serving auxiliary routes (auxiliary rural carriers, rural carrier reliefs, rural carrier associates, and auxiliary assistance under provisions of Article 9, Section 2.1.5) will receive an EMA of

36.5 cents per mile or \$4.25 per hour, whichever is greater, not to exceed the amount provided in the special equipment maintenance for the route stops and miles.

The EMA schedule on pages 42–43 supersedes all previously published EMA schedules. The optional EMA rate, effective October 28, 1995, remains at 39.9 cents per mile.
