Express Mail Service Directory — Distribution of IRT Update Diskettes

All post offices that use UNISYS II, UNISYS III, or MOS integrated retail terminals (IRTs) to accept Express Mail should have received by *August 30* an Express Mail service directory update diskette from UNISYS or MOS. If more than one type of IRT is used for Express Mail, offices should receive a separate diskette for each type. If an office has a weighing and rating unit (WRU), it should receive a UNISYS III or WRU diskette to update the directory on the WRU.

The Express Mail service directory network on the diskette you received is *effective immediately and must be installed* on your IRT diskettes and WRUs at once (instructions for updating are included with the diskettes). Also enclosed is a form to complete and send to your expedited service specialist indicating receipt and your compliance

with the mandatory installation of the Express Mail service directory on your IRT diskettes and WRUs.

If your office did not receive the appropriate type of IRT diskettes for the IRTs or WRUs, *immediately* contact your expedited service specialist (Express Mail office). If you have difficulty loading the directory from the diskettes you receive, contact the IRT vendor hotlines:

Publication 75, *Mover's Guide*

Publication 75, *Mover's Guide*, NSN 7610-03-000-4795, is being revised and will be available to CAGs A through F through the regular automatic distribution *from the supplier* by mid-October.

The *material distribution centers* (MDCs) will be receiving stock in late September and will be shipping regular orders placed by CAGs H through L and emergency orders only for CAGs A through F. Until the new stock is received, orders

placed at the MDCs for Publication 75 (except for emergency orders) will be held. CAGs H through L that have placed regular orders and cannot wait until mid-October to receive stock should place an emergency order with their servicing MDC customer service staff.

Announcement of *FASTforward*SM License Availability

The U.S. Postal Service (USPS) is seeking mailers and mail preparation service bureaus interested in a license agreement with the USPS to provide the USPS *FASTforward*SM service in conjunction with their own multiline optical character reader (MLOCR) equipment. *FASTforward*SM is a USPS-developed and -owned system that will enable licensees to readdress mailpieces, if the intended recipient has moved, as part of normal mail preparation activities.

The *FASTforward*SM system is one of the four authorized methods by which mailers may meet the move update requirement of the USPS Classification Reform. Prerequisites to being considered for a *FASTforward*SM license are that the potential licensee must operate the *FASTforward*SM process on their owned, or leased, MLOCR system that is Multi-Line Accuracy Support System (MASS) certified. In addition, this MLOCR system must have obtained USPS *vendor* certification as one that can successfully interface with the USPS *FASTforward*SM computer system.

Interested parties should contact their MLOCR equipment *vendor* to ascertain whether this feature is available for their particular equipment and its associated costs. An annual licensing fee of \$10,000 will be paid to the USPS by the licensee for each USPS-provided *FASTforward*SM computer system that it wishes to operate. Form 3907, Post Office Box — Mail Pickup Notice

Form 3907, *Post Office Box — Mail Pickup Notice*, is used to notify post office box customers when they have mail that is too large (in size or quantity) to fit into their boxes; requires a signature; or requires payment of postage due. The proper procedure for using Form 3907 is for box section distribution clerks to complete distribution of all mail into post office boxes before placing Form 3907 or any other USPS forms or notices (such as Form 3849, *Delivery Notification/Reminder/Receipt*, or Notice 32, *Post Office Box Fee Due*) directly on top of the customer's mail, where such notices should be readily seen.

In response to customer and employee suggestions, Form 3907 was revised in December 1993 to make this form larger (3 3/4" x 8 1/2") and thus more noticeable than the

previous, smaller card. It is clear that many post offices are still using older, smaller, and *obsolete* editions of Form 3907. Those offices not having and using the December 1993 edition should requisition a supply immediately from their servicing material distribution center. Upon receipt of the current forms, offices should recycle or discard all previous editions of Form 3907.

The current version of Form 3907 (December 1993; NSN 7530-03-000-3749) is bilingual, with information instructions in Spanish and in English for the benefit and convenience of Spanish-speaking postal customers.

Periodicals — Original Entry Application

Effective October 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E213.1.7 is amended to remove the standard requiring the submission of two copies each of at least four issues of publications that are primarily distributed through news agents. This amendment will be included in DMM Issue 51 (scheduled for January 1, 1997).

In-County Rate Clarification

Effective October 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E212.2.0, E270.1.0, and E270.4.0 are reorganized to clarify the advertising standards for publications of institutions and societies and the eligibility standards for in-county and non-profit Preferred Periodicals. These changes will be included in DMM Issue 51 (scheduled for January 1, 1997).

2.0 PUBLICATIONS OF INSTITUTIONS AND SOCIETIES

[Revise E212.2.3 to read as follows:]

2.3 Advertising Standards

Advertising is defined in E211. A publication qualifying for Periodicals mailing privileges under 2.2 may contain advertising of other organizations or persons if:

- a. It is not designed or published primarily for advertising purposes.
- b. It is originated and published to further the purposes of the qualifying organization.
- c. Its mailed circulation is limited to copies mailed to members who pay, either as a part of their dues or assessments or otherwise, at least 50% of the subscription price regularly charged to other members; to other actual subscribers; to exchanges; and to 10% of such circulation as sample copies. When members pay for their subscriptions as a part of their dues or assessments, individual subscriptions or receipts are not required.

[Revise the heading and text of E212.2.4 to read as follows:]

2.4 In-County Rates

Solely to determine the number of copies of an issue of a publication qualifying under 2.0 that also qualify for in-county rates:

- a. For a publication authorized under 2.3 to contain advertising, the total paid circulation of such a publication is the sum of the number of copies distributed to members, plus the number of copies distributed to other subscribers.
- b. For a publication not authorized under 2.3 to contain advertising, all circulated copies are considered subscriber copies and the total number of such copies is the total paid circulation.

[Amend E270.1.0 by removing 1.3 and by redesignating current 1.4 and 1.5 as 1.3 and 1.4, respectively.]

4.0 NONPROFIT—PUBLICATIONS OF OTHER QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS

[Revise E270.4.1 and 4.2 to read as follows:]

4.1 Basic Eligibility

Subject to 4.2, a publication (other than a requester publication) may qualify for the nonprofit rates regardless of the nonprofit status of the publishing organization if it is a:

- a. Publication issued by and in the interest of an association of rural electric cooperatives.
- b. Program announcement or guide published by an educational radio or television agency of a state or political subdivision thereof or by a nonprofit educational radio or television station.
- c. Publication of the official highway or development agency of the state that meets the standards for a general publication in E212 and contains no advertising other than the publisher's own advertising.
- d. Conservation publication published by a state agency responsible for management and conservation of the fish or wildlife resources of that state.

4.2 Eligibility Limitation

Only one publication (other than a requester publication) per qualifying organization may qualify for the nonprofit rates under 4.1c or 4.1d.

DMM NOTICE

Minor Editorial Revisions

Effective October 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) A010, A040, A920, A930, C010, C023, C100, C500, C600, C810, D010, D020, D042, D072, D100, D910, D920, E060, E110, F010, M072, M500, P023, and S020 are amended to reflect minor organizational changes that combine and renumber certain sections. These amendments represent no substantive changes to current mailing standards. Most of the exhibits removed from the DMM by this notice are published in the *Quick Service Guides*, which accompany each issue of the DMM. These amendments will appear in DMM Issue 51 (scheduled for January 1, 1997).

A010 General Addressing Standards

Amend A010 by removing Exhibit 1.2; by removing the first two sentences in 2.2 and combining current 2.1 and amended 2.2 as new 2.1; by redesignating current 2.3 through 2.5 as 2.2 through 2.4, respectively; and by removing Exhibit 2.3 and Exhibit 5.1.

A040 Alternative Addressing Formats

Amend A040 by combining current 4.2 and 4.3 as new 4.2; and by redesignating current 4.4 and 4.5 as 4.3 and 4.4, respectively.

A920 Address Sequencing Services

Amend A920 by replacing the last sentence in 2.5 with "Examples of the required format for the route header card can be obtained from the National Customer Support Center (see G043 for address)"; by replacing the last sentence in 2.6 with "Examples of the required format for the Delivery Unit Summary can be obtained from the National Customer Support Center (see G043 for address)"; by removing Exhibit 2.5 and Exhibit 2.6; by redesignating current 5.0 as 2.12; and by redesignating current 6.0 and 7.0 as 5.0 and 6.0, respectively.

A930 Other Services

Amend A930 by removing the first sentence in current 3.2 and combining amended 3.2 and current 3.3 as new 3.2; by

redesignating current 3.4 as 3.3; and by removing current 4.1 through 4.5 and redesignating current 4.6 as 4.0.

C010 General Mailability Standards

Amend C010 by redesignating current 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, and 7.6 as 7.1a, 7.1b, 7.1c, 7.1d, and 7.1e, respectively; and by moving current 7.7 to the end of 7.1 and redesignating current 7.8, 7.9, 7.10, and 7.11 as 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, and 7.5, respectively.

C023 Hazardous Matter

Amend C023 by redesignating current 10.8 and 10.9 as 10.7a and 10.7b, respectively.

C100 First-Class Mail

Amend C100 by combining current 1.1, 1.2, and 1.4 as new 1.1 and redesignating current 1.5 as 1.2.

C500 Express Mail

Amend C500 by combining current 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 as new 1.0; and by redesignating current 1.4 as new 2.0.

C600 Standard Mail

Amend C600 by redesignating current 1.1b, 1.1c, and Exhibit 1.1c as 1.1c, 1.1d, and Exhibit 1.1d, respectively; by adding new 1.1b to read as "Single-piece rate, nonautomation rate Regular, and nonautomation rate Nonprofit Standard Mail (A) are subject only to the basic mailability standards in C010"; by revising redesignated 1.1c to read as "All automation rate Standard Mail (A) is subject to the size and weight limits in C810 (letters) and C820 (flats), as applicable"; and by removing Exhibit 1.2b.

C810 Letters and Cards

Amend C810 by removing Exhibit 7.2b.

D010 Pickup Service

Amend D010 by combining current 4.4 and 4.5 as new 4.4 and redesignating current 4.6 as 4.5.

D020 Plant Load

Amend D020 by moving current 5.0 to end of 1.1.

D042 Conditions of Delivery

Amend D042 by combining current 9.1 and 9.2 as new 9.1 and redesignating current 9.3 through 9.9 as 9.2 through 9.8, respectively; by combining current 10.1 and 10.2 as new 10.1 and redesignating current 10.3 through 10.7 as 10.2 through 10.6, respectively; and by combining current 11.1 and 11.2 as new 11.1 and redesignating current 11.3 through 11.5 as 11.2 through 11.4, respectively.

D072 Metered Mail

Amend D072 by redesignating current 1.2, 1.4, and 1.5 as 1.1a, 1.1b, and 1.1c, respectively, and redesignating current

1.3 as 1.2; by moving current 1.6 to the end of redesignated 1.1a; and by redesignating current 1.7 as 1.3.

D100 First-Class Mail

Amend D100 by combining current 3.1, 3.2, and 3.3 as new 3.1 and redesignating current 3.4 and 3.5 as 3.2 and 3.3, respectively.

D910 Post Office Box Service

Amend D910 by combining and amending current 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 as new 2.1 and redesignating current 2.4 and 2.5 as 2.2 and 2.3, respectively.

D920 Caller Service

Amend D920 by combining and amending current 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 as new 2.1 and redesignating current 2.4 and 2.5 as 2.2 and 2.3, respectively; and by combining current 5.1 and 5.2 as new 5.1 and redesignating current 5.3 as 5.2.

E060 Official Mail (Penalty)

Amend E060 by moving current 9.7 to end of 9.1 and redesignating current 9.8 as 9.7.

E110 Basic Standards

Amend E110 by removing current 1.6d and 1.6e and redesignating current 1.6f through 1.6i as 1.6d through 1.6g, respectively; and by redesignating current 3.3 as 3.1 and current 3.1 and 3.2 as 3.2a and 3.2b, respectively.

F010 Basic Information

Amend F010 by combining current 4.1 and 4.2 as new 4.1 and redesignating current 4.3 through 4.6 as 4.2 through 4.5, respectively; and by redesignating current Exhibit 4.2 as Exhibit 4.1.

M072 Express Mail and Priority Mail Drop Shipment

Amend M072 by revising the heading of 2.0 to read as "Additional Standards for Enclosed Mail"; by redesignating current 3.0, 4.0, and 5.0 as 2.3, 2.4, and 2.5, respectively, and redesignating current 6.0 as 3.0.

M500 Express Mail

Amend M500 by revising the heading of 1.0 to read as "Express Mail Same Day Airport Service"; by redesignating the text of current 1.0 as 1.1 and by adding the heading "Security Measures"; by removing current 2.0 (heading only) and redesignating current 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 as 1.2, 1.3, and 1.4, respectively; by redesignating current 3.0 and 4.0 as 2.0 and 3.0, respectively; and by revising the headings of redesignated 2.0 and 3.0 to read as "Express Mail Custom Designed Service" and "Express Mail Next Day, Second Day, and Military Services," respectively.

Amend P023 by removing Exhibits 1.8, 1.11a, 1.11b, and 1.12.

S020 Money Orders and Other Services

Amend S020 by revising current 1.1 as 1.1a and 1.1b and redesignating current 1.6 as 1.1c.

Mail exceeding the 10% limit must be prepared in sacks under the standards for the rate claimed. Mixed pallets must be labeled to the BMC or ADC (as appropriate) serving the post office where mailings are accepted into the mailstream. The processing and distribution manager of that facility may issue a written authorization to the mailer to label mixed BMC or mixed ADC pallets to the post office or processing and distribution center serving the post office where mailings are entered. These pallets contain all mail remaining after required and optional pallets are prepared to finer levels of sortation under M045, as appropriate.

5.3 Minimum Load

In a single mailing, the minimum load per pallet is 250 pounds of Periodicals or Standard Mail packages, parcels, and sacks (or three tiers/layers of letter trays of Periodicals or Standard Mail (A)), *except that*, for mail *not* entered at a BMC, the processing and distribution manager of the facility where the mailing is entered may issue a written authorization to the mailer allowing preparation of 5-digit, 3-digit, or SCF pallets containing less volume if the mail on those pallets is for that facility's service area. In a mailing or mailing job presented for acceptance at a single postal facility, one overflow pallet may be prepared containing less than 250 pounds or 3 tiers/layers of letter trays if the mail is for the service area of the entry facility and the pallet is properly labeled under M045, based on its contents. No special authorization is required.

5.4 Maximum Load

The maximum weight (mail and pallet) is 2,200 pounds. The maximum height of a single pallet (mail and pallet) is 77 inches for packages, bundles, parcels, sacks, or pallet boxes, or 77 inches or 12 layers of trays (whichever occurs first) for letter trays.

5.6 Sacked Mail

Mail that is not palletized (e.g., the mailer chooses not to prepare BMC or mixed BMC pallets, or the packages do not meet the machinability standards in M020) must be prepared under the standards for the rate claimed. For Periodicals, mailers must separately sack packages of each publication that are not palletized under M045 or that are excluded from palletization. Trays that are not palletized must be bed-loaded. Sacks (including sacks of packages not placed on pallets) containing packages remaining after all pallets are prepared may be presented with the palletized mail (and reported on the same postage statement) if separated from the palletized portion of the mailing.

The mailer must have an automated mail production system that produces mail consistent with postal standards and calculates postage accurately. For letter-size mail, the automated system must also fully determine the qualifying presort level and the correct rate of postage for each piece, perform the presort routines, and assign a unique number to each piece consecutively. The mailer must assign a unique identification number to each mailpiece in a manifest mailing. Letter-size mail must bear the "keyline" information in 3.0. The automated system must provide a computer-generated manifest list for each mailing that enables USPS verification of the postage amount and levels of presort, as applicable. The manifest list must account for every piece in the mailing, as follows:

- a. For letter-size mail, the manifest must list destination ZIP Codes, presort categories, batch number ranges or unique identification numbers, postage amounts, cumulative postage amounts, and bar-

code information if applicable. A computer-generated postage statement facsimile or a summary list showing the required information on the postage statement must be included as the last page of the manifest.

3.0 KEYLINE

3.4 Keyline Location — Letter-Size Mail

The keyline must be readily identifiable and placed anywhere on the address side that does not conflict with other standards (see Exhibit 3.1 for examples). For window envelopes, the keyline may be printed on the insert above the address if the address and keyline are entirely visible through the window with at least 1/8-inch clearance between the window and the panel edge.

The unique number must be printed on each piece of nonletter-size mail. It may be a product number or any other

number that is unique within the mailing. The unique number must be printed directly above the address, in the lower left corner of the mailing label, or one space/line below the permit imprint. The numbers must be printed in overall ascending order or ascending order within each zone or 5-digit, 3-digit, or BMC ZIP Code area on the manifest list.

REMINDER

Periodicals—Forwarding, Return, and Address Correction

This article clarifies the regulations for the forwarding, return, and address correction for periodicals. For a complete reference to these mailing standards, see *Domestic Mail Manual (DMM) F010.5.2*

Temporary Forwarding Orders

Post office and delivery unit personnel are reminded that when a customer files a temporary forwarding order, the Postal Service forwards periodical publications without charge for 60 days. When a temporary forwarding order has been filed, however, address correction service is not provided.

Publications With No Endorsement

Forward periodical publications with no endorsement nationwide for 60 days at no charge. After the 60-day period, a separate address correction notice, Form 3579, *Undeliverable 2nd, 3rd, 4th Class Matter*, is sent, along with the publication cover, masthead, or identification page, and collect the address correction fee. If the publication is undeliverable, the reason for nondelivery is furnished and the address correction fee is collected. Electronic notifications are provided for Address Change Service (ACS) customers.

Publications Endorsed “Return Postage Guaranteed”

Forward periodical publications with the endorsement “Return Postage Guaranteed” nationwide for 60 days at no charge. After the 60-day period, return the entire mailpiece to the sender along with the new address on Form 3579. If the mailpiece is undeliverable, provide the reason for nondelivery. Charge the appropriate single-piece Standard Mail (A) rate or Standard Mail (B) zone rate for return of the mailpiece only. Do not collect the address correction fee.

Disposal of Periodical Publications Not Forwarded or Undeliverable

Dispose of copies of periodical publications locally that are not forwarded or undeliverable after the 60-day period has elapsed unless they are endorsed “Return Postage Guaranteed.” In those cases, return them according to the procedures mentioned above.

Account Identifier Code (AIC) Deactivation

To facilitate the implementation of the Point of Service (POS) system, the AICs listed below will be deactivated at the statement of account reporting level, effective accounting period 2, fiscal year 1997.

In the POS system, the GLA/SUB account number must be the AIC code. Currently, 23 account codes have a GLA/SUB account number other than the corresponding AIC code. For example, AIC 552 GLA/SUB code is 51403.101 instead of 51403.552.

Twenty-one of the current 23 AIC accounts are being deactivated. AICs 610, Uniform Cap Reimbursement—City Delivery Carrier and TE Uniforms, and 614, Vehicle Repair Parts and Materials, will remain active.

Payment of these accounts will be centralized at the district accounting office and paid through the Accounts Payable Accounting and Reporting Systems (APARS). When entering invoices in APARS for these accounts, use the GLA/SUB account number listed in column 2 below.

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be post-marked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail

postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserviced.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

First day covers remain on sale for at least 1 year after the stamp's issuance.

Distribution

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) and stamp distribution networks (SDNs) will receive approximately half their standard distribution for a 40-stamps-per-pane issue, rounded up to the nearest master carton size of 100,000 stamps. SDOs and SDNs will make subsequent automatic distributions to post offices, using Form 3309, *Advice of Shipment/Stamp Invoice*, and Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. SDOs and SDNs must not distribute stamps to post offices before October 1, 1996.

Philatelic Requirement

SDOs with authorized philatelic centers will receive the following automatic distribution for subsequent distributions to each center.

Additional Supply

All accountable paper depositories (APDs) will receive 2,600,000 stamps as back-up quantities. The Kansas City SDN will receive 2,800,000. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate APD, using a separate Form 17. All other post offices requiring additional stamps must requisition them from their designated SDO on a separate Form 17, or SDN, using a separate Form 17-S, *Stamp Distribution Network Stamp Requisition*.

Sales Policy

All post offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale, generally 1 year from the date of issue. If supplies run low, post offices must reorder additional quantities through their normal ordering procedures.
