## MESSAGE FROM THE POSTMASTER GENERAL

### Let's Stop Fraud and Abuse

The Federal Employees' Compensation Act (FECA) provides compensation benefits to postal employees for disabilities due to personal injury or disease sustained while in the performance of their duties. The Act also provides for payment to dependents if a work-related injury or disease causes an employee's death. The Postal Service fully supports the FECA program.

However, there is a small percentage of postal employees who abuse the system, resulting in millions of dollars in fraudulent claims and unnecessary costs each year. This is not only illegal, it undermines the work you do each day to deliver communications value for our customers.

Here are some examples of OWCP fraud, waste, and abuse:

- Concealing, with intent to defraud, prior injuries or physical impairment when hired.
- Reporting on-the-job injury when the injury actually occurred off the job.
- Fabricating an injury or falsifying the extent or seriousness of the real injury.
- Engaging in and concealing outside employment while receiving compensation payments.
- Regularly engaging in activities that are inconsistent with the alleged injury or medical restrictions.
- Failing to return to work after recovering from an injury.
- Continuing to accept compensation when no longer disabled, no longer an employee of the USPS, or without making any effort to return to work.
- The excessive, extravagant, or improper use of workers' compensation benefits in a manner contrary to its legal use in order to acquire additional benefits for personal gain; for example, prolonging the length of the recovery period needed for a job-related injury.


These actions constitute filing a fraudulent workers' compensation claim (18 USC 1920), and that is a felony. Anyone who does so will face firing and prosecution.

All of us must do our part to make sure that injured or sick employees receive the benefits they deserve. At the same time, though, we must be alert for fraud, waste, and abuse. We each have a stake in stopping these crimes. We can do something about it.

If you suspect a postal employee or a medical provider of abusing or defrauding the Workers' Compensation Program, please report the suspected crime to your supervisor, your local postal inspector, or the Inspection Service Hotline at 1-800-654-8896. All calls will be kept confidential, and all reports will be investigated.

By taking these steps, you will not only help protect our hard-earned postal dollars, but also you will be rewarded. The Inspection Service will pay up to \$10,000 to individuals providing information leading to the arrest and conviction of a postal employee or medical provider responsible for abusing or defrauding the Workers' Compensation Program.

Together, we can stop fraud and abuse.

# Domestic Mail

## DMM NOTICE

### Metered Mail Packaging — Single-Piece Rate Mail

Effective November 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E130.2.0, E620.1.4, and P030.5.2 are amended to remove the packaging requirement for letter-size metered mail and permit imprint mail paid at the single-piece rate for First-Class Mail or Standard Mail (A) if the mail can fill at least three-fourths of a 1-foot or 2-foot letter tray. Metered mail and permit imprint mail, however, may not be placed in the same tray.

The current requirement to prepare packages of five or more metered pieces is intended for small quantities of metered mail deposited into collection boxes. For larger mailings, this packaging only adds to the mailer's preparation cost while increasing labor costs for the Postal Service. This packaging standard also applies to permit imprint mail at the single-piece rate for either First-Class Mail or Standard Mail (A). This amendment will appear in DMM Issue 51 (scheduled for release on January 1, 1997).

### 2.0 SINGLE-PIECE RATE

[Revise 2.0 to read as follows:]

#### 2.1 Rate Application

The single-piece rates for First-Class Mail are applied as follows:

- a. The card rate applies to a card meeting the applicable standards in C100 that is not eligible for or claimed at the Presorted rate or an automation rate.
- b. The letter rate applies to any other First-Class Mail weighing 11 ounces or less that is not eligible for or claimed at the card rate, the Presorted rate, or an automation rate.

#### 2.2 Preparation

Single-piece rate First-Class Mail must have a delivery address but does not require the endorsement "First-

Class" or "First-Class Mail." No minimum quantity is required unless postage is paid with a permit imprint (in which case the mailing must contain 200 pieces or 50 pounds of pieces). There are no sortation standards for single-piece rate First-Class Mail, but five or more metered card-size or letter-size pieces and any permit imprint pieces must be faced with the addresses in one direction and packaged. Packaging of letter-size pieces is not required if they fill 3/4 of a 1-foot or 2-foot letter tray. Metered mail and permit imprint mail may not be packaged or trayed together.

#### 1.4 Preparation

[Revise 1.4 to read as follows:]

Keys and identification devices must be prepared under 1.2. All other single-piece rate Standard Mail (A) pieces must have a delivery address and the endorsement "Standard" or "STD." No minimum quantity is required unless postage is paid with a permit imprint (in which case the mailing must contain 200 pieces or 50 pounds of pieces). There are no sortation standards for single-piece rate Standard Mail (A), but five or more metered letter-size pieces and any permit imprint pieces must be faced with the addresses in one direction and packaged. Packaging of such pieces is not required if they fill 3/4 of a 1-foot or 2-foot letter tray. Metered mail and permit imprint mail may not be packaged or trayed together.

**Miscellaneous Preparation Standards**

Effective November 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) M011.1.2h, M011.1.2i, M031.2.1c, M032.2.2d, M130.2.1a, M200.1.4, M200.2.4c, and M610.3.1a are amended to correct or clarify current mail preparation standards as follows:

- *Sortation Levels.* DMM M011.1.2h clarifies that the presort term *origin 3-digit(s)* can include as an option the 3-digit ZIP Code area where the mail is entered but not necessarily verified. DMM M011.1.2i clarifies that mail prepared on pallets as an SCF sort may include mail for only a single 3-digit ZIP Code area for the SCF and still be considered an SCF sort.
- *Label Dimensions.* DMM M031.2.1c corrects the shortest permitted length for sack labels to 3.250 inches. DMM M032.2.3d corrects the maximum length for barcoded sack labels to 3.375 inches.
- *Periodicals Sacking.* DMM M200.1.4 clarifies that the exception for preparing packages with fewer than six pieces and sacks with as few as one package is an option available only for nonletter-size mail.
- *Optional Package Labeling.* DMM M130.2.1a, M200.2.4c, and M610.3.1a clarify that labeling nonautomation presorted First-Class Mail, Periodicals, and Standard Mail (A) is optional for mail placed in full 5-digit trays.

**Barcoded Tray and Sack Labels**

Effective November 1, 1996, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) M032.1.4 is amended to allow mailers the option of printing the zebra code as a series of vertical marks (rather than diagonal) to facilitate printing the code on mailer tray labels. The zebra code printed as a series of diagonal marks will continue to be permitted. This section of the DMM is also modified to clarify that the zebra code is a required format element on barcoded tray labels for trays containing barcoded automation rate mail.

Mailers are reminded that effective January 1, 1997, all mailings entered at letter and flat automation rates must be prepared with barcoded tray or sack labels. Mailers need to look at their printer requirements to ensure that they will be able to print the barcoded tray labels according to the specifications in DMM M032, including the paper stock requirements.

The diagonal or vertical marks must each be from 0.25 to 0.375 inch high, and from 0.125 to 0.25 inch wide, separated by blank spaces equal in size to the diagonal or vertical marks.

*DMMT REVISION*

**Issuance of Revised *Postal Operations Manual***

**Reason for Revision**

Effective August 1, 1996, the *Domestic Mail Manual Transition Book* (DMMT) is revised as shown in Table I. This revision reflects the transfer of many sections in the DMMT to *Postal Operations Manual* (POM) Issue 7, which was published with an effective date of August 1, 1996. All sections in DMMT chapter 3, chapter 5, chapter 6 (except 665), and chapter 7 (except 785) have been replaced by new requirements published on July 1, 1996, in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) Issue 50. These requirements were further amended by the *Federal Register* on August 15, 1996 (61 FR 42478-42489), for nonprofit mail standards that changed on October 6, 1996.

**Material in DMMT**

In revising the *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) for release as DMM Issue 46 on July 1, 1993, the Postal Service identified rules and procedures in the DMM that did not govern the eligibility for, and use of, domestic mail services. The Postal Service made a determination not to include that material in DMM Issue 46 and in subsequent issues of the DMM.

The identified material chiefly fell into two categories: (1) recommendations for voluntary customer action; (2) internal instructions to postal employees. Other identified material not relating to mail classification included post office discontinuances, delivery policies, and philatelic procedures.

**Publication of DMMT**

Pending the transfer of these rules and procedures to other documents, the Postal Service on July 1, 1993, published the identified material in a separate part of the DMM titled the *Domestic Mail Manual Transition Book* (DMMT). In creating the DMMT, the Postal Service provided that the rules included in that document remain in full force through June 30, 1994.

**Transfer of DMMT Material**

The purpose of that 1-year period was to allow the Postal Service to decide whether to rescind the rules in the DMMT or to incorporate them into other documents. As the following table shows, several changes have been made to the DMMT

since its publication; however, the evaluation process is not yet complete.

The Postal Service rescinded the June 30, 1994, expiration date of the DMMT in a notice published in the June 20, 1994, *Federal Register* (59 FR 31655–31656) and in *Postal Bulletin* 21870 (6-23-94). Additional time will be required to complete the transfer of the remaining material.

Table I shows the DMMT sections removed or transferred, the effective date, and if applicable, the sections of POM Issue 7 or title 39 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) into which such material was transferred.

Table II shows the DMMT sections that are still in force until further notice. Most of these remaining sections contain internal procedures for processing mailer applications.

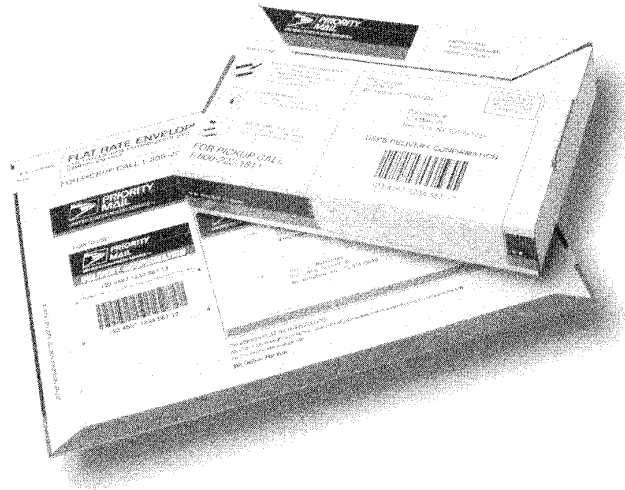
## Priority Mail Delivery Confirmation Test

Priority Mail Delivery Confirmation is the first in a series of new services that will expand the U.S. Postal Service's tracking capabilities. Priority Mail Delivery Confirmation will be tested nationally starting October 31, 1996. Initially, the test will be limited to large-volume Priority Mail customers who label their Priority Mail packages or flats with the new peel-off, barcoded Priority Mail Delivery Confirmation labels. They will transmit an electronic manifest, and retrieve delivery confirmation information electronically. Current CTT processes will be used to scan the labels of delivered packages and packages where delivery was attempted.

Training materials were mailed directly to all post offices, stations, branches, and plants for delivery by October 21. They contain all service talks, workroom posters (see page 17), and quick reference guides for all delivery employees and all employees who are involved with CTT scanning. If you have not received your training materials, please contact the manager, Post Office Operations, in your district.

**A.** Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

**B.** Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more. **Exceptions:** Prepaid mail from contractors addressed to a military organizations for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents for Official Use-Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or exemption endorsement. Known Mailers may use either Form 2976-A on each item or Form 2976 (or facsimile) with a mail manifest in conjunction with a packing list. Form 2976 must state "packing list enclosed." The packing list must include a description of the items, the dollar values of the items, and the complete address including the PSC box number and APO/FPO ZIP Code of the addressee, the date of mailing, the insurance registry number, if applicable, and the serial number of any item over \$25 in value and any electrical item over \$15 in value. The packing list should be enclosed in the parcel or attached to the outside of the parcel. The mail manifest which itemizes all parcels that a Known Mailer deposits will be given to Postal Official at Business Mail Acceptance Unit. Form 2976 may be used if the mailer does not wish to list the contents on the wrapper or in any case if the value exceeds \$400. Affix only the upper portion of the label on the package. A completed Form 2976-A (listing the contents and value in US dollars) must be enclosed in the package. Mail addressed to/from all 094XX ZIP Codes must use Form 2976-A only.

**B1.** Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** Mail addressed to/from all 094XX ZIP Codes must use only Form 2976-A. All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

**C.** Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

**C1.** Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

**D.** Coffee is prohibited.

**E1.** Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

**E2.** Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited.

**E3.** Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and hand-held transmitters are prohibited.

**F.** Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM C022.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.

**F1.** Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

**F2.** Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.

**G.** Only First-Class letters, second- and third-class mail are authorized.

**H.** Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

**H1.** Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

**I.** Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

Length	
42" .....	72" length and girth combined
over 42" to 44" .....	24" girth
over 44" to 46" .....	20" girth
over 46" to 48" .....	16" girth
Maximum length	48"

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

**I1.** This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

**I2.** This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

**K.** Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

**L.** All official mail is prohibited.

**M.** Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

**N.** Registered mail is prohibited.

**O.** Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.

**P.** APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

**Q.** Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

**R.** All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM C021, are prohibited.

**R1.** Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

**T.** Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

**U.** Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

**U1.** Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 11 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

**U2.** Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.

**U3.** Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

**W.** Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

**X.** Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

**Y.** Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All second-class, third-class, and fourth-class mail (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

**Z.** No outside pieces (OSPs).

**Z1.** Tin band seal required on all pouches.

# Finance

HANDBOOK F-1 REVISION

## Credit and Debit Card Acceptance

Effective immediately, Handbook F-1, *Post Office Accounting Procedures*, is revised to reflect procedures for processing credit and debit card overcharges:

#### 315.5 Overcharges

##### 315.51 Debit Cards Overcharges

When a postal employee overcharges a customer on their debit card transaction, the postal service owes the customer *change*. The following procedures must be followed when a debit overcharge occurs:

- a. Fill out PS Form 3533, *Application and Voucher for Refund of Postage and Fees*. Write **DEBIT OVERCHARGE** across the top of the form. Complete all pertinent information, including debit card receipt information and the amount overcharged.
- b. Issue the customer a cash refund if cash is available. If cash is not available, issue a no fee money order. Place money order information on Form 3533. If cash is given write amount given on Form 3533. Have the customer sign Form 3533.

**Note:** Do not record debit overcharges to AIC 536, Postage and Fees Refund.

- c. Staple Form 3533 to the USPS copy of the debit transaction receipt. Keep as documentation to support AIC 772, Debit Cards Remitted. Retain the receipt and

Form 3533 at the unit with all documents associated with Form 1412, *Daily Financial Report*.

- d. AIC 772 on the Form 1412 must match the debit transaction amount from the debit card terminal.

**Example:** A customer purchases \$2.00 in stamps. The clerk enters \$20.00 when completing the debit card transaction on the terminal. Receipt reflects \$20.00, USPS owes the customer \$18.00 in change. Complete Form 3533 and give the customer cash or issue a no fee money order.

##### 315.52 Credit Card Overcharges

When a postal employee overcharges a customer on their credit card transaction, the postal employee can void the transaction the same day. If the customer identifies the error on a subsequent day of the transaction, the overcharge must be processed under the refund guidelines as described in section 315.4.

This means that district accounting offices will have until 2 p.m. local time on Wednesday, November 13, 1996, to enter statement of account data via DDE/DR for offices reporting on an accounting period basis, and noon local time Wednes-

day, November 13, 1996, to transmit statement of accounts via the standard field accounting system.

Post offices that send statement of accounts to the district accounting office for processing must submit forms by close of business Tuesday, November 12, or sooner if possible.

## Pictorial Cancellations Announcement 96-22

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of upcoming events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items sub-

mitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self-addressed envelope.

## 1996 Commemorative Stamp Collection Now Available in Two Versions

The 1996 Commemorative Stamp Collection is currently in production. Distribution to stamp distribution offices (SDOs) began in mid-October and will be completed by early December. On November 3, this product will be on sale throughout the country and by mail order form:

The 1996 Commemorative Stamp Collection will be available in two versions:

Item 8996 — A 64-page hardbound book that includes all 93 commemorative stamps, with mounts, and sells for \$39.95. This beautifully illustrated book contains colorful pictures and text featuring stamp subjects such as Winter Garden Flowers, Olympic Classic Collection, Georgia O'Keeffe, American Indian Dances, James Dean, Folk Heroes, and Endangered Species, and 22 other subjects celebrated on 1996 commemorative stamps.

Item 8990 — A 36-page softbound book that includes 29 commemorative stamps, with mounts, and sells for \$15.95. This abbreviated version contains selected illustrations and pictures from the hardbound version, as well as similar text. The softbound version will include one randomly selected stamp from each of the 29 subjects celebrated on 1996 commemorative stamps.

The books and stamp packets are being shipped to SDOs separately, from different suppliers. SDOs must verify re-

ceipt of the quantities of stamp packets, as recorded on their Advice of Shipment. The books are shipped 15 per carton for the hardbound and 20 per carton for the softbound. The stamp packets will be shipped 150 per carton for the hardbound and 100 per carton for the softbound. SDOs should report all differences between quantities shown on the Advice of Shipment and those actually received. SDOs should verify that they have received equal quantities of books and stamp packets. SDOs and postmasters will have to exercise particular care to ensure that the correct stamp packets are shipped and sold with two different versions of the books.

Those SDOs that serve postal retail stores will receive additional quantities of the 1996 Commemorative Stamp Collection (books with stamp packets enclosed) as Item 8996E for hardbound, and Item 8990E for softbound. SDOs should not use these items to fill orders for offices without postal retail stores.

To obtain an initial supply of this product, all post offices must submit separate Forms 17, *Stamp Requisition*, to their designated SDO or Forms 17-S, *Stamp Distribution Network Stamp Requisition*, to their designated SDN.

Offices should report all sales of this product in AIC 092, Philatelic Product Sales, on Form 1412-A, *Daily Financial Report*.

# Postal Employees

## Annual Leave Exchange Option

The annual leave exchange option provides the opportunity for career nonbargaining employees and employees represented by the National Postal Mail Handlers Union (NPMHU) to receive a lump sum payment in exchange for a portion of the annual leave that would otherwise be advanced at the beginning of the 1997 leave year. This option provides eligible employees with a convenient source of extra cash. (Note: Annual leave earned and accumulated through the 1996 leave year, which ends January 3, 1997, cannot be exchanged for cash.)

A letter explaining the eligibility criteria and an annual leave exchange option election form will be mailed to all career nonbargaining employees and employees represented by the National Mail Handlers Union at their address of record by November 15, 1996. Undeliverable election forms

will be returned to the personnel office, which should ensure that they are forwarded to the employee's work location along with Form 1216, *Employee's Current Mailing Address*.

Employees who meet the eligibility criteria and desire to exercise this option must submit their completed election form to the local Finance office no later than December 15, 1996.

Payment under the Leave Exchange Option will be a lump sum calculated on the employee's base salary as of the first day of the 1997 leave year (January 4, 1997). Paychecks dated January 24, 1997, will include the 1997 lump sum payment.

### HANDBOOKS EL-806 AND EL-801 REVISION

## First Aid Cabinets

The national medical director, in consultation with both federal and private sector medical directors and the American Red Cross, has determined that the presence of orally administered medications in first aid cabinets constitutes a potential danger to Postal Service employees.

Postal Service personnel are asked, therefore, to replace the items in first aid cabinets with those listed in the revised charts shown below.

Effective immediately, Handbook EL-806, *Health and Medical Service*, and Handbook EL-801, *Supervisor's Safety Handbook*, are revised as follows.

### HBK EL-806, *Health and Medical Service*

#### Chapter 4 First Aid

\* \* \* \* \*

#### Definition

First aid is the immediate care given to a person who has been injured or has been suddenly taken ill.

\* \* \* \* \*

#### 420 First Aid Cabinets and First Aid Kits

The district occupational health nurse administrator advises the human resources manager concerning the recommended location, usage, and contents of the first aid

cabinets or kits. First aid cabinets or kits are to be made available in facilities that do not have a 24-hour operating health unit.

First aid kits are smaller than first aid cabinets but should have similar contents.

#### Requirements

A first aid cabinet or kit. . .

- Should be provided for every 50 to 75 employees. Facilities with fewer than 50 employees may have either first aid kits or first aid cabinets.
- Must be maintained under the direction of the local facility manager or supervisor and the district occupational health nurse administrator.
- Should store only authorized supplies.
- Must contain sterile materials that are individually wrapped so that unused portions do not become contaminated through handling.
- Must be locked to control access. The key may be retained by the first responder, facility supervisor, or designee.
- Should display the name and telephone number of the supplies provider.

- Must display the following telephone numbers on the inside and prominently on the cabinet or kit door or lid:

**Emergency Numbers:**

- Health unit
- First responder
- Ambulance service or rescue squad
- Hospital or clinic
- Fire department
- Police department

First aid cabinet or kit contents. . .

- Must be easily recognized in an emergency.
- Should be arranged so that the desired package can be found quickly without unpacking the entire contents.
- Must be items that can be refilled from most drugstores or through first aid equipment distributors.
- Must contain individually wrapped packets.

The first aid logbook. . .

Must have the following entries:

- The name of the employee for whom treatment was rendered.
- The name of the employee who assisted the injured employee.
- The nature of the injury.
- The service rendered, date, and supplies used.

Any irregularities concerning the first aid cabinet or kit should be reported to the supervisor or occupational health nurse administrator.

MEDICAL (See Handbook EL-806, *Health and Medical Service*, see also Animal Interference; Frostbite; Heat Exhaustion and Heatstroke; and Insect Stings.)

1. General

All employees should be encouraged to take first aid or cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training after work hours.

2. First Aid Cabinets

Facilities not having a medical/health unit must have first aid materials available. See 29 CFP 1910.15 (b).

Maintenance procedures should be established to see that first aid supplies are kept up to date, clean, and sanitary. Use only the following authorized first aid supplies:

*First Aid Cabinet Contents:*

- Adhesive tape — 1" and 2"
- Individually wrapped alcohol wipes
- Individually wrapped Betadine wipes
- Arm sling
- Gauze roll 2"
- Gauze pads 3" x 3" sterile and nonsterile
- Nonadherent dressings (adaptic)
- Band-Aids®
- CPR mask (microshield)
- Disposable gloves
- Eye irrigation solution
- Eye patches
- Logbook

No medications to be consumed orally are allowed in the first aid cabinets.

**Flexible Spending Accounts Open Season**

Open season for the Flexible Spending Account (FSA) program for career employees is November 11 through December 9, 1996. MetraHealth for the Travelers Insurance Company administers the FSA program for the Postal Service.

FSAs provide employees with the ability to set aside a portion of their pre-tax earnings for certain types of out-of-pocket health care and dependent care expenses. The money withheld for FSAs is not subject to income, Medicare,

or Social Security taxes. FSA BK1, *Flexible Spending Accounts* (November 1996), provides a good overview of FSAs. The following information should assist personnel services offices in conducting this open season. Enrollments received during this open season are effective for the 1997 plan year (January 1 through December 31, 1997). To assist in publicizing FSA open season, all offices must post the open season notice on page 57 on bulletin boards through December 9, 1996.

Headquarters (HQ) Compensation and Benefits is coordinating mailings of a leaflet, followed by a kit that contains a brochure, an enrollment form, and a withdrawal request form, to career employees at their mailing address of record. The return address for undeliverable kits is the employing office of record. While the disposition of returned kits is at the discretion of the Customer Service and Sales district office or other administering office, giving a returned kit to an employee offers the employee an opportunity to submit a correct Form 1216, *Employee's Current Mailing Address*. (Form 1216 may be ordered from the material distribution centers (MDCs) using Postal Stock Number 7530-02-000-7354 or Quick Pick number 118.)

### Eligibility

Participation in the FSA program is limited to career employees. In addition, to make an election during the open season, career employees must complete at least 26 full pay periods of postal career service based on their current appointment by the end of Pay Period (PP) 26-96 (December 20, 1996). Career employees who are in a leave without pay (LWOP) status for more than eight consecutive full pay periods as of December 20, 1996, are not eligible to participate in the FSA program.

### Election Opportunities

#### *Health and Dependent Care FSAs*

Eligible career employees may elect to participate in either or both of two FSAs: the Health Care FSA and the Dependent Care FSA. Each FSA covers eligible expenses for services received during the 1997 plan year (January 1 through December 31, 1997). Employees who elect to participate must submit an FSA enrollment form to their personnel services offices no later than close of business (COB) December 9, 1996. The brochure employees receive in the mail describes eligible expenses and guidelines for estimating future expenses.

#### *Contribution Levels*

During the 1997 plan year, career employees may elect to contribute up to \$2,600 to the Health Care FSA and up to \$5,000 to the Dependent Care FSA. Contributions are withheld in equal amounts through payroll deductions covering 26 pay periods (PP 01-97 through PP 26-97). The minimum contribution employees may make to either FSA is \$130, which equals \$5 per pay period.

### Election Changes and Enrollment Processing

Participants may not change or cancel enrollments or contribution levels during the plan year except following qualified life status changes, as explained in the brochure.

Personnel services offices that are Distributed Data Entry/Data Reporting (DDE/DR) sites are responsible for

processing FSA enrollments through the DDE/DR system. Offices process elections received during the FSA open season (November 11 through December 9, 1996) using the DDE/DR system's FSA open season screen. *Offices must process FSA enrollment forms received during the open season by no later than December 20, 1996.*

### Open Season Materials

#### *Leaflet*

All career employees will receive at their mailing address of record:

- FSA LF1, *Flexible Spending Accounts Overview and Tax Savings Estimator* (October 1996), a leaflet that outlines how FSAs work in a simple question and answer format, and which also contains a tax savings estimator.

#### *Enrollment Kit*

Shortly after receipt of the leaflet, all career employees will receive at their mailing address of record an enrollment kit, which contains:

- FSA BK1, *Flexible Spending Accounts* (November 1996), a brochure explaining plan policies and provisions.
- PS Form 8200, *Flexible Spending Account Enrollment Form* (November 1996), the election form used to elect to establish an FSA from which reimbursements may be withdrawn.
- FSA1, *Flexible Spending Account (FSA) Withdrawal Request* (November 1996), the form used to request to withdraw funds from an FSA for reimbursement of eligible expenses for services received during the plan year.

#### *Residual Supplies of Materials*

HQ Compensation and Benefits will coordinate the distribution of residual supplies of the leaflet, brochure, enrollment form, and withdrawal request form to Human Resources at Customer Service and Sales district offices, area offices, processing and distribution centers, bulk mail centers, airport mail centers, remote encoding centers, the Employee Service Center for the DC Metro Area, Headquarters, and selected Headquarters field units by the beginning of the open season.

Additional copies of FSA LF1 (7610-MD-000-7253, no Quick Pick number) may be ordered from the MDCs using Form 7380, *MDC Supply Requisition*. Additional copies of FSA BK1 (7530-02-000-9910, no Quick Pick number), PS 8200 (7530-02-000-9846, no Quick Pick number), and FSA1 (7530-02-000-9911, no Quick Pick number) may be ordered from the MDCs using Form 7380 or TTOE.

### *Administration Manual*

HQ Compensation and Benefits is also coordinating the distribution to Human Resources at Customer Service and Sales district offices and area offices of a small stock of FSA BK2, *FSA Administration Manual* (November 1996), which outlines for personnel services offices how to process enrollment forms, follow FSA procedures, and maintain appropriate records. This item is not available from the MDCs.

### *Information for Other Offices*

Installations receiving the administration manual must ensure that subordinate installations know their responsibility to verify and forward FSA enrollment forms to their DDE/DR processing sites expeditiously.

### *FSA Videotape*

A videotape providing an overview of FSAs entitled *It's Your Money You Save* (November 1994) was distributed in noncaptioned and open-captioned versions during the 1994 FSA open season. Although the videotape provides no open season information, personnel services offices are strongly encouraged to use the videotape to promote the FSA open season. In addition, the videotape may be used throughout the year, for example, in orientations for new career employees. Refer employees who view the videotape to the brochure for more detailed information.

## **Responsibilities of Personnel Services Offices**

The FSA Administration Manual explains personnel services office responsibilities and processing procedures. Responsibilities include (1) determining eligibility to participate, (2) accepting and processing enrollment forms, (3) determining eligibility to change contribution levels during the plan year based upon participants' qualified life status changes, and (4) filing Copy 1 of PS Form 8200 in employees' official personnel folders.

Offices should make sure that employees specify annual, not pay period, contribution amounts, and that they provide the correct employing office finance number and pay location in Part A of PS Form 8200.

Offices may wish to remind employees to include health care expenses for dependents in the Health Care FSA contribution amount, not in the Dependent Care FSA. Although the brochure and the enrollment form advise employees of this provision, in past open seasons some employees did not understand this distinction.

Offices may also wish to remind employees of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) annual limits on the Dependent Care FSA contribution: \$5,000 per family and \$2,500 for a married employee filing a separate return. These limits are explained fully in the brochure.

Offices do not process form FSA1 (request to withdraw FSA funds for the reimbursement of eligible expenses). Participants are responsible for mailing these directly to the FSA Customer Service Center at the address on the form.

Offices must not provide tax advice. Offices must refer employees with tax questions to their tax advisors or the IRS toll-free information line, 800-TAX-1040 (800-829-1040). In addition, a section of the brochure presents certain tax information related to FSAs.

Offices should refer employees with questions about the FSA program to the toll-free hotline described below.

## **FSA Customer Service Center Toll-Free Hotline**

The FSA Customer Service Center provides a toll-free hotline for inquiries about FSAs. Employees with FSA questions may use the hotline by calling 800-842-2026. Following enrollment, participants may use the hotline to make account inquiries, discuss expenses eligible for reimbursement through the FSA program, and obtain other plan information. The FSA Customer Service Center also provides a Telecommunications Device for the Deaf (TDD) line for the hearing impaired: 801-523-6955. The FSA Customer Service Center encourages employees using the TDD line to place an advance call to the toll-free hotline.

## Thrift Savings Plan Open Season

The next Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) open season is November 15, 1996, through January 31, 1997. TSP BK-08, *Summary of the Thrift Savings Plan for Federal Employees* (July 1995), provides a good overview of TSP. The following information should assist personnel services offices in conducting this open season.

### Direct Mailing to Employees

Career employees receive from the national level a direct mailing of TSP-1196, *TSP Open Season*, at their mailing address of record. Career employees newly eligible to participate in TSP also receive a direct mailing of an enrollment package from the national level that contains a cover letter; TSP BK-08, *Summary of the Thrift Savings Plan for Federal Employees* (July 1995); and TSP-1, *Election Form* (February 1991). Career employees should receive these materials no later than the end of November.

The return address for undeliverable enrollment packages for newly eligible employees is the employing office of record. While the disposition of returned enrollment packages is at the discretion of the Customer Service and Sales district office or other administering office, giving a returned enrollment package to an employee offers the employee an opportunity to submit a correct Form 1216, *Employee's Current Mailing Address*. (Form 1216 may be ordered from the material distribution centers (MDCs) using Postal Stock Number 7530-02-000-7354 or Quick Pick number 118.)

### Eligibility

Career employees hired before July 1, 1996, are eligible to participate in this open season. Also, career employees hired before January 1, 1997, previously eligible to participate in TSP during a prior appointment are eligible.

All employees who participated in TSP and stopped their TSP contributions after July 31, 1996, are not eligible to participate in this TSP open season. They must wait for the TSP open season beginning May 15, 1997.

### Effective Dates

The effective dates for TSP open season elections are as follows:

Personnel services staff must initiate completion of Form 6886, *Thrift Savings Plan Request for Retroactive Contributions*, for all Forms TSP-1 not processed by the applicable processing date shown in the above chart, whether the reason for delay is a belated election or an administrative error. The effective dates for these elections must be made retroactive to January 4, 1997; January 18, 1997; or February 1, 1997; depending on the date the employee initially filed his or her election form with the personnel services office. (Form 6886, which was published in *Postal Bulletin* 21665 (3-31-88), must be reproduced locally as needed.)

**Note:** Processing deadlines and the closing date of this TSP open season require the use of a third pay period effective date for elections received January 30 and January 31, 1997.

### Open Season Materials

In addition to the direct mailing of TSP information to employees, the MDCs will automatically distribute residual supplies of the open season leaflet (TSP-1196), election form (TSP-1), and summary (TSP BK-08) to Human Resources at Customer Service and Sales district offices, area offices, processing and distribution centers, bulk mail centers, airport mail centers, remote encoding centers, the Employee Service Center for the DC Metro Area, Headquarters, and selected Headquarters field units. (The September 1990 version of the TSP-1 is still valid and may be used if the February 1991 version is unavailable. All prior versions are obsolete and must be discarded or recycled where appropriate.) Offices that would like any other TSP materials for use during the open season must order a supply from the appropriate MDC.

### Participant Statements

Employees with a TSP account will receive a participant statement from the TSP Service Office in November 1996.

### Publicity

Human Resources at Customer Service and Sales district offices, area offices, processing and distribution centers, bulk mail centers, airport mail centers, remote encoding centers, Headquarters, and selected Headquarters field units will receive a supply of posters this open season from TSP. Installations that receive the posters must widely distribute and post them on bulletin boards.

To assist in publicizing the TSP open season, all offices must post the open season notice on page 59 on bulletin boards through January 31, 1997. Also post the current TSP fact sheet on bulletin boards.

## 1996 to 1997 Leave Year Annual Leave Carryover

The 1996 leave year ends on January 3, 1997. The 1997 leave year begins on January 4, 1997. The maximum amounts of annual leave that employees may carry over from 1996 into the 1997 leave year appear below.

Care is to be exercised to ensure that employees are not required to forfeit annual leave. No provisions exist for employees to carry over annual leave in excess of the applicable carryover maximums on January 4, 1997. Employees should coordinate with their supervisors to schedule any excess leave before January 4, 1997.

## SAFETY BULLETIN

## Disposal of Mercury-Containing Lamps

Fluorescent lamps and other lamps that contain trace amounts of mercury and other metals must be disposed of properly to prevent harm to human health and the environment. The amount of mercury or other metal in a single lamp is not a significant risk, but disposal of large numbers of lamps can create a potential hazard, and may be regulated by federal or state environmental laws.

Under no circumstances should fluorescent or other lamps containing mercury be mechanically crushed or ground into smaller pieces. Lamps should be re-boxed prior to disposal. Each state has jurisdiction regarding proper disposal of lamps, and regulations are becoming more stringent. Managers and supervisors must consult with district environmental compliance coordinators on proper disposal of these lamps. Ask for the policy memorandum from Environmental and Maintenance Policy groups at Headquarters, dated December 16, 1994. Whenever feasible, recycling is the recommended alternative to disposal.

## SAFETY BULLETIN

## Welding Safety

Managers and supervisors are responsible for ensuring that welding, cutting, and brazing are conducted in a safe manner. Safety and health personnel should review safe work practices and regulatory requirements with line managers responsible for welding operations.

Potential hazards from welding and similar operations include fire and explosion, toxic gases and fumes, intense visible light and UV radiation, electricity, and noise. Basic welding safety includes these elements:

- Training for welders and their supervisors.
- Hot work permit system.
- Fire watch with fire extinguishers.
- Adequate ventilation.
- Personal protective equipment: eye protection suitable for the process, hood, gloves, apron, clothing.
- Safe work practices, e.g., cleaning the work, checking for lead coatings or other toxic materials. If lead coatings are present, follow regulations in reference 5.
- Inspect and maintain all welding equipment.

5. CFR 1926.62, Lead Exposure in Construction.
