
## MESSAGE FROM THE POSTMASTER GENERAL

The United States Postal Service wants all employees to know that sexual harassment is improper and unlawful, and that it undermines employee morale. It is the responsibility of every employee to learn about sexual harassment because the only way to achieve a workplace free of such harassment is to make sure everyone knows what it is and what to do about it when it happens.

The law requires employers to take all reasonable steps to end sexual harassment in the workplace. Employees also have a role in eliminating sexual harassment. Read this policy. Read the *Employees' Guide to Understanding Sexual Harassment* recently mailed to every postal employee's home.

If you feel you are being sexually harassed, report it, if not to your immediate supervisor then to another supervisor, or to someone who can do something about it. Help is available, but you have to do your part by reporting it.

Know your rights. Take responsibility. Stop sexual harassment in the workplace.

## NOTICE

### Postal Service Policy on Sexual Harassment

The United States Postal Service is committed to providing a work environment free of sexual harassment.

Sexual harassment is improper and/or unlawful conduct that undermines the employment relationship as well as employee morale. Examples of such harassment include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Making or threatening to make employment decisions based on an employee's submission to or rejection of sexual advances or request for sexual favors.
- Deliberate or repeated unsolicited remarks with a sexual connotation or physical contacts of a sexual nature that are unwelcome to the recipient.
- A sustained hostile and abusive work environment so severe and pervasive that it interferes with or changes the conditions of one's employment.

Employees who engage in sexual harassment will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including removal.

If an employee engages in inappropriate conduct in the workplace, it may also violate the Postal Service's standards of conduct. Disciplinary action may result even if the conduct is not sexual harassment under the law.

All managers and supervisors are responsible for preventing sexual harassment in the workplace and must

respond promptly when they learn of any conduct that may be sexual harassment. Managers and supervisors must see that a prompt and thorough investigation of the conduct takes place. If sexual harassment is found, they must take prompt and appropriate remedial action.

Postal employees who believe that they are the victims of sexual harassment should bring the situation to the attention of any supervisor or manager, or to Human Resources.

In addition, employees can seek relief through the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) complaint process, grievance arbitration procedures for bargaining unit employees under the collective bargaining agreements, and the grievance procedures, where appropriate, under the ELM for applicable nonbargaining employees. If pursuing an EEO complaint, you must contact an EEO counselor within 45 days of the act(s) giving rise to your claim in order to preserve your rights under federal law.

Report any possible criminal misconduct to the Postal Inspection Service.

The U.S. Postal Service will not tolerate sexual harassment.

Effective August 13, 1998, *Domestic Mail Manual* E010.2.6 is revised to clarify when customs declarations are required on mail sent between government agencies and APO or FPO ZIP Codes. This revision will appear in DMM Issue 54.

Any mailpiece weighing 16 ounces or more that is addressed to an APO or FPO ZIP Code must bear Form 2976 and must be presented to an employee at a post office or as designated by the postmaster. Certain destination APO and FPO addresses require Form 2976-A, as shown in the chart Conditions Applied to Mail Addressed to Military Post Offices Overseas, published in the *Postal Bulletin. International Mail Manual* (IMM) 123 contains procedures for completing customs forms. Regardless of postage payment method, mail from government agencies and their contractors going to, from, or between APO or FPO ZIP Codes is exempt from the requirements of this section unless customs declarations are necessary for customs treatment as specified in the chart. Any known mailer (see IMM 123.62) presenting bulk mailings that are declared on a postage statement is not required to use customs forms if the destination ZIP Codes do not require the form as indicated in the chart.

## Periodicals Identification Statement

Effective August 13, 1998, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E211.10.4 is revised to allow publishers to print the Periodicals identification statement on one of the last three editorial pages inside the back cover when the publication is mailed with a First-Class Mail or Standard Mail (A) enclosure paid with permit imprint. In addition, M071.1.2 and P070.2.6 are revised to no longer require that a permit imprint be printed in the identification statement when the marking “First-Class Mail Enclosed,” or “Standard Mail (A) Enclosed,” as appropriate, is placed in the identification statement. The use of the marking in the identification statement indicates postage has been paid by permit imprint.

**1.1 Definitions**

The following definitions apply:

- c. *ORM-D (Other Regulated Material--Domestic) material* is a limited quantity of a hazardous material that meets the DOT definition of a "consumer commodity." An ORM-D material presents a limited hazard during transportation due to its form, quantity, and packaging. In almost all instances, the proper shipping name for an ORM-D material is "consumer commodity." Not all hazardous material permitted to be shipped as a limited quantity can qualify as an ORM-D material.
- d. *Consumer commodity* is a hazardous material that is packaged and distributed in a quantity and form intended or suitable for retail sale and designed for consumption by individuals for their personal care or household use purposes. This term can also include certain drugs or medicines. Not all hazardous material permitted to be shipped as a limited quantity can qualify as a consumer commodity.

**1.5 Mailability Rulings**

[Amend 1.5 by adding new subsection i to read as follows:]

Generally, the acceptability for mailing chemicals and other types of hazardous materials depends on container fluid/vapor capacities, the ability of the complete package to contain the product, and the method of absorbing and containing the product, in case of accidental leakage of the primary receptacle. To determine mailability of a specific product, a mailer must submit a material safety data sheet (MSDS) and the following information to the appropriate rates and classification service center (RCSC):

- i. Proposed number of pieces to be mailed, class of mail, and post office(s) of mailing.

**1.6 Warning Labels**

[Revise the text to read as follows:]

Most hazardous materials acceptable for mailing by the USPS, except infectious substances (etiologic agents), magnetized material, and matches under certain conditions, fall within the ORM-D regulations of CFR 49 173.144, which do not require DOT hazard class warning labels. Any hazardous material bearing or required to bear a DOT hazard class warning label is prohibited from mailing. The only postal exceptions are for mailable division 6.2, infectious substances required to bear a DOT class 6 infectious substance label, as cited in 8.3, or shipments containing dry ice sent via air transportation required to bear a DOT class 9 miscellaneous label, as cited in 11.4. Mailable ORM-D materials must be marked as required by 49 CFR 172.316 and as cited in 1.7. DOT handling labels (i.e., orientation arrows, magnetized materials) must be used as required by 49 CFR.

**3.0 GASES (HAZARD CLASS 2)**

(2) Poisonous drugs and medicines may be sent only from the manufacturer or dealer of the drugs and medicines to licensed physicians, surgeons, dentists, pharmacists, druggists, cosmetologists, barbers, and veterinarians (18 USC 1716).

b. *Packaging.* The toxic substance is held in an inner receptacle(s) not exceeding 8 ounces per mailpiece; enough cushioning material surrounds the primary receptacle to absorb all potential leakage; the cushioning and primary receptacle(s) is packed in another securely sealed secondary packaging that is placed within a strong outer packaging; and, each mailpiece is plainly and durably marked on the address side with “ORM-D” or “ORM-D AIR”, as applicable, immediately following or below the proper shipping name. Mailable material sent via surface transportation must be marked on the address side as “Surface Mail Only”. For air transportation, each mailpiece must bear a shipper’s declaration for dangerous goods.

DMM NOTICE

**Four-Tier Pallets Allowed**

Effective August 13, 1998, and continuing through February 28, 1999, mailers may stack pallets four tiers high subject to certain limitations. The *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) currently allows mailers to double- and triple-stack pallets. This easing of the pallet stacking rules is on a trial basis and is intended to make the busy fall mailing season easier by allowing mailers to prepare smaller, more finely separated pallets to better utilize transportation.

Mailers who prepare four-tier pallets must meet all other pallet requirements currently contained in DMM M041, including the 84-inch maximum height requirement, the 2,200-pound maximum limitation, and the strapping of the tiered load to provide stability. All preparation requirements for the class of mail and rate claimed remain unchanged.

Based on the success of the trial period, the Postal Service will decide whether to amend the DMM pallet rules to allow four-tier pallets permanently.

RETURN SERVICE UPDATE

Mail Sent Under Merchandise Return Service Labels

Recent feedback indicates that there are problems when customers attempt to send merchandise back to a company using the merchandise return service label provided by the company. Merchandise return service allows permit holders to guarantee postage and fee payment on items returned by their customers. At the permit holder's discretion, other special services may be added. Companies use merchandise return service so customers can return merchandise for credit or replacement at no cost.


Because merchandise return service is not used frequently, there is some confusion about how certain special services such as insurance are applied. When insurance is included by the permit holder as an option, it appears on the merchandise return service label. In this instance, the permit

holder pays the insurance fee. Customers MAY NOT add insurance unless the permit holder has specified as such on the label.

A claim for damage can be filed by either the sender OR the permit holder. A claim for total loss can be filed ONLY by the sender, who has the insured mailing receipt. The addressee (i.e., the merchandise return service permit holder) cannot file a claim for total loss.

Whenever an insured mailing receipt is presented as proof of mailing when filing a claim, the procedures under Domestic Mail Manual (DMM) S010 must be followed. DMM S923 contains complete information about merchandise return service.

### UTILITY POLICY UPDATE

#### Purchasing Utilities

Postal Service postmasters and plant managers are being contacted with increasing frequency by utility companies offering significant proposed savings from present rates in return for a long-term agreement. Earlier *Postal Bulletin* (PB) notices (PB 21940, 2-27-97 and PB 21949, 7-3-97) directed that those offers be referred to the servicing Purchasing and Materials Service Center (PMSC) for evaluation pending the outcome of studies by the National Energy Policy Committee (NEPC), formerly the Utilities Deregulation Oversight Committee (UDOC).

After nearly 2 years' experience with this issue, the NEPC guidance remains the same: check the facts with your supporting Area/District Environmental Compliance Coordinator (A/DECC) and refer any signature document to your servicing PMSC.

The specific policy statement is as follows: Any proposal for a long-term agreement (1 year or more), should be carefully reviewed to determine the benefit of the proposal to the Postal Service (especially in view of potential deregulation actions during the term of the agreement), and it must be coordinated with your PMSC and A/DECC. Any proposal for a short-term agreement (under 1 year), will probably be beneficial to the Postal Service and may be processed using local buying authority and procedures in accordance with the *Administrative Support Manual* (ASM) 542.2. Postmasters and plant managers seeking to develop requirements for long-term agreements for the purchase of natural gas and/or electricity should coordinate such requirements with their A/DECC and PMSC.

Any changes to the facilities resulting from an agreement with a utility company/provider (such as re-lamping, re-roofing, and other energy-saving measures) must be coordinated with the appropriate Facilities Service Office.

Four primary reasons for coordination are:

1. Signing a long-term agreement for services usually exceeds all local signature authorities. In the past, you have had authority to engage in utility services on an ongoing tariff basis, because there was no contract; the whole transaction was subject to regulated tariffs. Making a long-term agreement, even if it is with a regulated utility, bypasses the tariffs and takes you out of the protection of the utilities commission, as well as creating a long-term obligation that may include penalties for early termination.
2. Many service offers include confusing or misleading terms. Some of the entities now marketing electricity may appear to be, but are not, legally part of the regulated utilities with which they were (or still may be) affiliated. The PMSC and A/DECC, through the NEPC support structure, can help determine the real value (and the real offeror) behind any proposal.
3. Utility deregulation will offer cost-saving opportunities to the Postal Service, and some regulated utilities are seeking savings agreements prior to formal deregulation. Most of those opportunities are not based on our individual facility loads (which are quite small by industrial standards) but on our collective load. Usually, we must aggregate our load across several districts, either to get a statewide contract or because the electricity service providers' territories do not match Postal Service boundaries (nor state boundaries, in many cases). In short, we need a concerted effort. A contract for service to a set of facilities can be undermined by the emergence of many preexisting agreements executed (with or without proper authority) at the individual facility level.

4. You may believe that your state is not scheduled to de-regulate soon and, therefore, you should take what savings you can. In fact, all of the states currently engaged in deregulation are doing so in much less than the time originally forecasted; most are 3 to 4 years ahead of schedule. (Even California's present "delays" are only in terms of the most recent plan; their original plan, issued barely 2 years ago but now "ancient history," called for phased-in deregulation beginning this year.)

Something else to watch out for: Utility companies are sliding long-term service clauses into all sorts of documents. Some facilities have had fixtures installed, and the fine print included that the fixtures cost required a multi-year service obligation. Other facilities have tried to execute a normal rate change-over based on their load histories; the rate change documents came with 5-year service agreements hidden in them. Before you sign one document agreeing to an action "... under the provisions of clause ..." of another document that is not provided, review the second document. Whenever a document has to be signed, read it carefully, and check with your PMSC and A/DECC if there is anything you do not understand.

**Global Package Link**

Global Package Link (GPL) is a bulk mailing system that provides fast, economical international delivery of packages containing merchandise. GPL is designed to make it easier and less costly for mail order companies to export goods. The U.S. Postal Service provides GPL on a destination country-specific basis pursuant to the terms and conditions stipulated in *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 620 and the Individual Country Listings.

**Expansion of GPL Return Service to Germany and France**

Effective 8-4-98, IMM 620 is revised to reflect the addition of GPL return services to Germany and France.

There currently is no method for GPL customers to Germany and France to receive return packages beyond traditional means such as international mail. In response to requests from these mailers, a GPL return service has been established in Germany and France. These services will allow our GPL customers to receive returns as well as advanced data on those returns, providing them a means to more effectively service their customers.

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (32 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued

after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self addressed envelope.

## POSTCARD BOOKS

### Popular Postal Card Books to Be Made Available Nationwide

To meet the growing demand for postal cards, the U.S. Postal Service will make two additional book sets available nationwide in 1998. All post offices requiring postal card books should requisition them from their designated stamp distribution office (SDO) or stamp distribution network (SDN) using a separate Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*. Requisitions must be in multiples of 5.

- **Tropical Birds Postal Card Book**, item 8803, contains 20 postal cards (four designs) with the 20-cent Tropical Bird postage printed on the back. The Tropical Birds Postal Card Book retails at \$6.95 per set and went on sale July 29, 1998.
- **American Ballet Postal Card Book**, item 8800, will contain 10 postal cards featuring the Ballet stamp image on the front and the 20-cent Ballet postage printed on the back. The American Ballet Postal Card Book retails at \$5.95 per set of 10 cards and will go on sale September 17, 1998.
