Domestic Mail

DMM REVISION

Merchandise Return Service Labels

Effective June 3, 1999, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) S923.1.0 and S923.5.0 are amended to clarify the standard that requires merchandise return service permit holders to include instructions with merchandise return service labels that tell customers how to use the labels when returning parcels.

Mailers are reminded that all merchandise return service labels, regardless of the method of transmission (see PB 21988 (12-31-99)), must include instructions to customers for how to affix and use the labels.

1.0 BASIC INFORMATION

1.5 Distribution

[Amend 1.5 by clarifying instructions to customers to read as follows:]

Merchandise return service labels may be distributed to customers as an enclosure with merchandise, as a separate item, as part of a double postcard (see 5.4), as a facsimile transmission (fax), as an electronic transmission for customer downloading and printing, or through one of the permit holder's designated pickup facilities. Any such label distributed to a customer must meet the format standards in 5.0, including the requirement to furnish instructions.

[Revise the heading of 5.3 as follows:]

5.3 Acknowledgment Form

[Amend current 5.3 by clarifying to read as follows:]

If the permit holder includes a mailing acknowledgment as described in 4.12, that acknowledgment must not bear adhesive but must be attached to the label and perforated or designed for easy separation at the time of mailing.

5.5 Instructions

[Revise 5.5 to read as follows:]

Written instructions must be provided with the label that, at a minimum, direct the customer:

- a. To affix the label squarely on the address side of the parcel, covering up any previous delivery address and barcode. If tape or similar material is used, it must not cover any part of the label where postage and fee information is to be recorded.
- b. To obliterate any other addresses and barcodes on the outside of the parcel.
- c. To take the parcel to a post office, drop it in a collection box, or give it to a postal carrier. If a mailing acknowledgment is attached or insurance is marked on the label, the parcel must be taken to a post office.

DMM REVISION

Clarification of Minimum Weights for Standard Mail (B)

Effective June 3, 1999, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) E613.1.0 is revised to clarify minimum and maximum weights for Standard Mail (B) subclasses. This revision does not change existing weight limits.

DMM REVISION

Addressing Standards

Effective June 3, *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) A010, General Addressing Standards is amended to correct information on the placement of private mailbox numbers. A revision to DMM A010 was previously published in *Postal Bulletin* 21994 (3-25-99). Private mailbox numbers are to be placed on a line above the delivery address line, not included as a secondary address designation.

REMINDER

Mailing Adult Birds

Only the types of adult fowl or birds specifically named in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) C022.3.3 and 3.4 are eligible for mailing in domestic mail. No other types of adult birds (including: canaries, emus, finches, parakeets, parrots, etc.) may be sent through the mail. Postal Service standards covering the mailability of adult birds are based on these factors:

- Humane consideration and the ability of the live animals to survive without food or water while in transit.
- Possible health hazards to postal employees.
- Possible damage to other mail and postal equipment.

All types of fowl and birds are prohibited in international mail. As information, day-old poultry or birds may be mailed as domestic mail only as allowed in DMM C022.3.1.

Adult Fowl

Under DMM C022.3.3, adult turkeys, guinea fowl, doves, pigeons, pheasants, partridges, and quail, as well as ducks, geese, and swans, are mailable in domestic mail. These types of birds must be sent via Express Mail in biologically secure containers that have been approved by the manager, Business Mail Acceptance, USPS Headquarters (see DMM G043 for address). The number of birds per mailpiece must not exceed the limits of the container as specified by the manufacturer and each bird must weigh more than 6 ounces. Currently, three firms manufacture and distribute biologically secure containers that have been approved for mailing the types of adult birds allowed in 3.3. These firms are:

Adult Chickens

Under DMM C022.3.4, adult chickens may be mailed only in domestic mail when sent as Express Mail. The containers used to mail adult chickens must pass the standards in the International Safe Transit Association (ISTA) Test Procedure 1A, which are contained in Publication 2, *Packaging for Mailing* (January 1998). The containers must be designed to remain intact during normal handling, be constructed to totally confine the adult chickens, contain shavings or other

material to prevent damage to the bottom of the container, and be ventilated properly to ensure humane treatment during transit. The number of adult birds per mailpiece must not exceed the container manufacturer's limit.

Indemnity

Under the applicable standards, indemnity for a mailpiece containing adult birds may be paid only for loss of, damage to, or rifling of the parcel. Indemnity may not be paid for death of the adult birds during transit if there is no visible damage to the container.

Arrangements

Post offices may ask customers to make advance arrangements to ensure the availability of Express Mail service from the point of origin to the point of destination, and to ensure that adequate postal and nonpostal equipment to handle the shipment is available.

Acceptance

DMM C022.3.11 states that a mailpiece containing live animals that cannot reach its destination in a viable condition should not be accepted. Factors that can be taken into consideration in assessing the viability of a mailpiece containing live animals include use of proper packaging methods that protect against suffocation and crushing during transport, expected time in transit, and very extreme weather conditions (i.e., outside of normal ranges). However, this provision does not extend postal personnel the authority to refuse mailpieces containing live animals that are properly packaged or to impose local blackout periods for reasons based on temperature conditions, heavy mail volumes, etc. Postal acceptance personnel must have reasonable justification to refuse a mailpiece and before taking any such action they must confer with the manager, business mail entry, at their district office or their rates and classification service center (RCSC), as appropriate.

Postal Handling

Any mailpiece containing live birds must be handled with care and sensitivity by postal employees. Such mailpieces should not be commingled with other mailpieces that could cause damage to their mailing containers or to other mail while in transit.

The Postal Service's Traffic Control System may be used to advise destination and transfer offices when any significant quantities of animals are moving through the mail. Because mailable adult birds must be sent using Express Mail service, their movement almost always involves air transportation. Postal personnel must assign and tender

mailpieces containing adult birds to commercial/cargo air carriers as outside parcels. Flight assignment may only be made to certified airlines that are authorized to transport adult birds and whose corporate policy permits the carriage of adult birds aboard their aircraft. Postal field personnel should also ensure that the duration of any movement on ground transportation (via trucks) is limited to a four-hour time period.

ICM UPDATE

International Customized Mail

On March 3, 1999, the Postal Service entered into an International Customized Mail (ICM) service agreement with a qualifying mailer. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 294, the Postal Service hereby makes public the following information concerning the agreement:

- a. **Term:** March 26, 1999, through March 26, 2001.
- b. **Type of mail:** *Parcels*.
- c. **Destination countries:** France and Germany.
- d. **Service provided by the Postal Service:** The Postal Service has agreed to:
 1. Furnish the mailer with equipment and other supplies that the mailer is required to use for qualifying mail.
 2. Provide the mailer or mailing agent with the training necessary for them to prepare ICM mail in conformity with the requirements for qualifying mail.
 3. Arrange with air and surface carriers, as appropriate for qualifying mail to be transported internationally for delivery by foreign postal authorities.
 4. Accept and verify all mail pursuant to the agreement at the USPS facility where the mailer tenders its mail.
- e. **Minimum volume commitments:** The mailer has agreed to tender a minimum of 10,000 parcels annually in accordance with IMM 622.11.
- f. **Worksharing:** The mailer has agreed to:
 1. Package mail in accordance with the applicable Postal Service requirements set forth in the IMM.
 2. Pay postage for qualifying mail using a Mailing Manifest System (MMS).
 3. Maintain an established number of pieces over the course of the service agreement.
 4. Tender qualifying mail to the Postal Service at designated Postal Service facilities.
 5. Provide projections of mailings including date, weight, volume, and location where mail will be tendered.
 6. Use the USPS for all of its parcels destined for France and Germany that meet USPS size and weight requirements during the term of the agreement.

ICM UPDATE

International Customized Mail

On February 15, 1999, the Postal Service amended an International Customized Mail (ICM) service agreement dated March 8, 1998. In accordance with *International Mail Manual* (IMM) 294, the Postal Service previously announced entering into an International Customized Mail Service agreement with a qualifying mailer and hereby makes public the following information concerning the amendment:

- a. **Term:** March 4, 1999, through March 31, 1999
- b. **Type of mail:** *Printed Matter and Small Packets.* Every item must conform to the mailing requirements set forth by the USPS for all qualifying Global Direct Canada Advertising Mail and to the requirements set forth in the IMM for all qualifying ISAL and IPA mail.
- c. **Destination countries:** Worldwide.
- d. **Service provided by the Postal Service:** The Postal Service has agreed to:
 1. Furnish the mailer with the sacks, tags, and other supplies that the mailer is required to use for qualifying mail.
 2. Provide the mailer or mailing agent with the training necessary for them to prepare ICM mail in conformity with the requirements for qualifying mail.
 3. Arrange with air and surface carriers, as appropriate for qualifying mail to be transported internationally for delivery by the Canadian Postal authority.
- e. **Minimum annual volume commitments:** The mailer has agreed to tender a minimum of 15,000,000 pieces of ISAL mail, and a minimum of 18,000,000 pieces of Global Direct Canada Admail.
- f. **Worksharing:** The mailer has agreed to:
 1. Package mail in accordance with the applicable Postal Service requirements based on the class of mail and the mail preparation and sorting requirements for Global Direct Canada Admail
 2. Prepare ISAL and IPA mail in accordance with the applicable Postal Service requirements set forth in the IMM.
 3. Pay postage for qualifying mail in accordance with IMM using a system approved by the appropriate Rates and Classification Service Center (RCSC).
 4. Maintain an established number of pieces over the course of the service agreement.
 5. Tender qualifying mail to the Postal Service at the designated Postal Service facility.
 6. Coordinate a schedule of mailings and provide notifications as specified in the service agreement.

g. Rates:

Rates for ISAL and IPA are dependent on the total annual volume of ISAL, IPA, and Global Direct Canada Mail combined as outlined in Table 1. Global Direct Canada Mail rates, which include both Admail and Publication Mail are listed in Tables 2 and 3 respectively.

Philately

STAMP DISTRIBUTION

Distribution — Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp, Self-Adhesive, Item 332200; and Gummed, Item 332100

The \$15 Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamp for the 1999–2000 hunting season goes on sale nationwide, July 1, 1999, and will remain on sale through June 30, 2000. The Department of the Interior will formally issue the stamp at the National Postal Museum in Washington, DC on July 1, 1999.

The Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamp will be issued in two formats — the traditional gummed version and a “Self-Adhesive Federal Duck Stamp Single.” The stamp size of this self-adhesive version is the same size as the gummed, and can be peeled from its carrier sheet which is the size of U.S. paper currency and fits easily in cash drawers. **Postmasters should order enough of Item 332100 and 332200 to meet the expected appreciable demand for this item by stamp collectors and the general public.**

Distribution

Post Offices. To allow postmasters to order the 1999–2000 Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamp in quantities approximating customer demand, the minimum ordering quantity for both formats is five stamps. However, when practical, postmasters should order full panes of 30 stamps for the gummed version. Postmasters should review their records to determine the average number of Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamps previously sold and use this information to determine the appropriate number of the 1999–2000 Bird stamps to requisition, rounded up to multiples of five (5) or 30 stamps.

Postmasters must immediately send a separate Form 17, *Stamp Requisition*, to their SDOs for enough Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamps, self-adhesive, Item 332200, and/or gummed version, Item 332100, to last until February 29, 2000. If the initial supply is exhausted before February 29, 2000, postmasters must requisition an additional supply. Postmasters with philatelic centers should order both formats and have them available to meet philatelic demand. **Postmasters must order and ensure that Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamps are available to meet public demand.**

Stamp Distribution Offices. Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) must review their inventory records for past issues and postmasters’ requisitions for the 1998–1999 Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamps to determine the

quantity needed of the 1999-2000 Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation stamps.

SDOs requiring gummed stamps, Item 332100, in bulk quantities or self-adhesive stamps, Item 332200, should requisition them from the Bureau of Engraving and Printing using Form 3356, *Stamp Requisition — Bulk Quantities*. Order Item 332100, gummed stamps in quantities of 3,000; 6,000; 9,000; 12,000; 15,000; 30,000; 45,000; 60,000; and 75,000 stamps and in multiples of 75,000 to a maximum of 675,000 stamps per requisition. Order Item 332200, self-adhesive stamps in quantities of 1,000; 2,000; 3,000; 4,000; and 8,400 stamps and in multiples of 8,400 to a maximum of 42,000 stamps per requisition.

SDOs requiring fewer than 3,000 gummed or 1,000 self-adhesive stamps must send Form 17 to their accountable paper depository.

Hunting Regulations Pamphlets

The Department of the Interior does not automatically distribute pamphlets on hunting regulations because migratory game bird laws vary by state. Direct inquiries about hunting regulations to the Department of Fish and Wildlife Agency or Natural Resources for the state. Do not forward to the federal U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Poster 3-124, *Waterfowlers Attention* (July 1992), is no longer available.

Migratory Waterfowl Survey — Duck Stamps

The Postal Service is again helping the Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior, conduct its annual survey to measure the harvest of migratory waterfowl during the coming hunting season. Only certain post offices, stations, and branches have been randomly selected to participate in the survey.

The Department of the Interior will send the materials directly to the postmaster or to the selected stations and branches of some larger post offices, after notifying the postmaster. Only the selected units may distribute the Federal Duck Stamp Cards.

Each shipment includes:

1. Federal Duck Stamp Cards for the hunter’s name and address.
2. Instructions for window personnel.

3. Acknowledgment postcard (Fish and Wildlife Service Form M.S. 7).

Managers should:

1. Inform employees of survey instructions.
2. Acknowledge receipt of the materials using enclosed postcard (Fish and Wildlife Service Form M.S. 7).

Window personnel should:

1. Give a Federal Duck Stamp Card to all purchasers of Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation (Duck) stamps, including collectors and non-hunters, at the time of purchase.
2. Ask the customer to fill in the name and address portion and return the card to the window clerk for mailing. The customer detaches and keeps the stub (hunting diary) portion of the card to record daily hunting activity.

3. If customers purchase stamps for resale or for distribution to other hunters, give them one instruction sheet and a name and address card for each stamp. Ask them to request the actual stamp recipient to fill in, detach, and mail the business reply portion of the card without delay. Stamp collectors should receive only one card.

Customer participation is voluntary but essential to the survey's success. The cooperation of all postmasters, managers, and window personnel involved is appreciated.

Pictorial Cancellations Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service offers pictorial cancellations to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial cancellations are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial cancellation appears in italics under the date. Also provided, as space permits, are illustrations of those cancellations that were reproducible and available at press time.

People attending these local events may obtain the cancellation in person at the temporary post office station established there. Those who cannot attend the event, but who wish to obtain the cancellation, may submit a mail order request. Pictorial cancellations are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial cancellation date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail postage (33 cents per envelope or 20 cents per postcard). Items

submitted for cancellation may not include postage issued after the date of the requested cancellation. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a cancellation should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL CANCELLATIONS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP + 4 CODE, exactly as listed below (using all capitals and no punctuation, except the hyphen in the ZIP + 4 code).

After applying the pictorial cancellation, the Postal Service returns the envelope or postcard through the mail. Customers who want their serviced item returned under protected cover should include a larger, stamped, self addressed envelope.

Safety talks are required once a week as part of this important effort to promote safety and health. Line supervisors can use these safety talks to provide the basic structure for their presentations, varying them to fit the local situation and securing maximum employee participation.

SURE MONEY/DINERO SEGURO UPDATE

New Transaction Amount Limit

This is an update to all participating Sure Money/Dinero Seguro post offices in California, Texas, and Illinois about the Dinero Seguro transaction amount limit.

Starting **May 29, 1999**, the Sure Money/Dinero Seguro computer system will reflect a new transaction limit amount of **\$2000.00**. The new dollar limit amount is in keeping with Bank Secrecy Act (BSA) regulations and money laundering prevention processes. Postal policy requires that these purchase restrictions be followed rigorously in order to avoid fines and legal action against the Postal Service and its employees. Dinero Seguro and BSA training efforts will include the following points:

- The maximum amount of any single money-by-wire transfer is **\$2000.00**.
- **Without exception**, no one customer may transfer more than **\$2000.00** in any one day. The **\$2000.00** daily limit applies regardless of the number of visits made by a customer to one of our postal facilities.

- Dinero Seguro transactions combined with money orders or Liberty Cash purchases that exceed **\$2000.00** will require the customer to fill out PS Form 8105-A, *Funds Transaction/Transfer Report*. All clerks will fill out PS Form 8105-B, *Suspicious Transaction Report (STR)*, for suspicious transactions.

The policy for this money-by-wire service has always reflected a limitation in daily and per transaction transfer amounts. When combined transactions of Dinero Seguro money-by-wire transfers (not exceeding \$2000.00, of course), money orders, and or Liberty Cash purchases exceed \$2000.00, PS Form 8105-A must be completed and submitted. Both the Inspection Service and the BSA Compliance Office require that all employees adhere to these regulations. Prerequisites for Logon IDs

Beginning June 7, 1999, the procedure below must be followed when requesting a Dinero Seguro logon ID from Minneapolis.

In addition to completing a PS Form 1357, *Request for Computer Access*, you must also complete the BSA/Dinero Seguro Training Confirmation PS Form 5011 (see below). This form requires the signature of the supervisor and the signature of the requester, stating that the requester has received training for both Dinero Seguro and the Bank Secrecy Act (BSA), and the dates they were completed.
